

1990 JAIL PROFILE DATA SUMMARY

AVERAGE DAILY POPULATION (ADP)

An average of 70,822 persons were incarcerated in California county jails in calendar year 1990 (excluding Type I facilities). This represents a 42% increase since 1985 and a 3% increase over 1989 (see Table 1). It is reasonable to assume that the increase in ADP from 1989 to 1990 was artificially deflated due to court-imposed population caps. Twenty-two counties, which account for 69% of the total ADP, are currently operating under these population caps.

The statewide ADP totals include 62,243 males (88%) and 8,579 females (12%). The overall distribution of female to male prisoners has risen two percent since 1985.

There were 37,619 pretrial inmates (53%) and 33,203 sentenced inmates (47%). The pretrial category included 90%, or 33,763, males and 10%, or 3,856, females. The majority of sentenced inmates were males (28,480 or 86%). Fourteen percent, or 4,723, were females (Table 2).

On the average, there were 35 juveniles held in adult detention facilities on any given day in 1990. The number of juveniles decreased 34% from 1985, when the average number of juveniles held in adult detention facilities was 47, but increased by 80% over the 28 juveniles held in 1989.

JAIL BOOKINGS

The Jail Profile Data Summary also collects data on the total number of pretrial bookings and sentenced commitments to county jails. The total number of bookings statewide in calendar year 1990 was 1,448,582, up 1% from 1989 and 18% since 1985.

Of the total number of bookings for 1990, 22% were sentenced and 78% were pretrial (see Table 3). This ratio may understate the percentage of pretrial bookings. A number of counties' pretrial/sentenced ratios are based on a four-day sample.

AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY

The statewide average length of stay per booking (including both pretrial and sentenced bookings) based on the calendar year 1990 data was 17.8 days (see Table 4). This is somewhat higher than the 14.9 days recorded for 1985.
