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1993 JAIL PROFILE DATA SUMMARY

- The 1993 ADP* of 67,576 represents a 4.6% decrease from 1992 when the ADP reached an all-time high of 70,853. 88.6% of the 1993 ADP (or 59,866) were males and 11.4% (or 7,710) were females (see Table 1). 35,899 (53%) were pretrial inmates and 31,677 (47 percent) were sentenced inmates (Table 2). On the average, 70 juveniles were held in adult detention facilities on any given day in 1993, a 43% increase over the 49 juveniles held in 1992.
- The total number of bookings statewide decreased once again from 1,344,106 in 1992 to 1,267,711 in 1993. Of the total bookings in 1993, 23 percent were sentenced and 77 percent were pretrial (Table 3). Please note, however, that the percentage of pretrial bookings may be understated as a number of counties report these ratios based upon a four-day sample. The statewide average length of stay per booking, including pretrial and sentenced bookings, for 1993 was 19.4 days (see Table 4), up .2 days from 1992.
- It is presumed the decrease in bookings can be attributed to:
 - ▶ the effects of Senate Bill 2557 (Chapter 466, Statutes of 1990) which allowed counties to charge cities, special districts and others a fee for booking prisoners into county jail;
 - ▶ declining drug arrests attributed to the fiscal crises of local and state government, the fact that law enforcement is targeting fewer, more serious offenders for prosecution, drug arrest and seizure laws and lower drug use; and,
 - ▶ the closure of some county facilities as cost saving measures.
- The most volatile variable (in terms of year-to-year changes) associated with California's jail population has been the "incarceration rate" (the percentage of the general population in jails). With the exception of 1991 and 1993, the incarceration rate has increased every year since 1980. However, in 1990 and 1992, the amount of increase in the incarceration rate over the previous year was small. In 1991 and 1993, the incarceration rate actually decreased slightly.
- Faced with this uncertain fluctuation, the Board of Corrections decided that the best estimate of future incarceration rates would be the average rate of increase or decrease over the relatively recent time span for which data are available, and will continue to watch the data carefully.

* Average daily population (ADP) refers to the average number of people incarcerated in California county jails and private work furlough facilities in calendar year 1993 (excluding Type I facilities).
