We have \$900K that was not spent by our county sub-recipients. We would like to reallocate this money to two of the counties who applied during the most recent (FY14) competitive process. As the State Administering Agency, we have the discretion to do this, correct? We may need to request an extension on the FY12 funds; I'll let you know. Is there any other paperwork we would need to do?

I am on a deadline, so if you could provide confirmation by tomorrow, it would be much appreciated. We will have to take this matter before our Board for approval shortly and before we do that, I need to know that we have the authority to do so. Thank you!
