Issue: Assembly Bill 2276 (Bocanegra) – Update from California Department of Education

In 2014, the Governor signed AB 2276 establishing a workgroup to develop a process for the successful transition of juvenile justice youth from the court school system back to a regular school placement. The legislation designated California's Superintendent of Public Instruction as the lead on this effort. Brian Uslan, Education Programs Consultant with the Department of Education, was identified as the lead staff person for the workgroup and has been in collaboration with the BSCC throughout the time of the workgroup's existence. Although Mr. Uslan will not be available the day of the SACJJD meeting, Gordon Jackson will present information regarding the efforts and findings of the workgroup.
