Summary: This agenda item provides the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) with an update on Alameda County's project status specific to meeting the establishment requirement as part of the Senate Bill (SB) 81 Local Youthful Offender Rehabilitative Facility Construction Financing Program.

Background: On March 19, 2009, Alameda County was provided a \$35 million conditional award by the BSCC for the construction of a new 150-bed camp. The county has provided adequate site assurance that it possesses a suitable project site.

The State Public Works Board (SPWB) is responsible for the approval and oversight of local youthful offender rehabilitative facility construction projects financed through the SB 81 lease-revenue bond program. The SPWB must approve the proposed project scope, cost and schedule. Pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code Section 17331 all SB 81 projects must be established by the SPWB by June 30, 2017.

Alameda County Probation Department will provide an update at today's meeting to demonstrate how the project will comply with the SPWB establishment process by June 30, 2017.
