Dear Mr. Scott:

On behalf of the County of Tulare, I would like to express our appreciation in receiving an award from the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) for the construction of the Sequoia Field Program Facility as part of the Senate Bill 1022 (SB 1022) Adult Local Criminal Justice Facilities Construction Financing Program. With these funds, the County will be able to construct a state of the art facility that will allow our law enforcement personnel to provide enhanced programmatic services.

On March 18, 2014 the County received a letter indicating that the amount awarded by the BSCC for this project has been reduced from the original amount requested. The original request was for \$40 million, and the conditional award is for \$33,352,000. The letter also outlined four options to move forward with the project with the reduced amount. Finally, the letter requested that the County select an option and notify BSCC staff of the selected option by no later than April 18, 2014.

At this time, the County does not have the funding to make up the \$6,648,000 in reduced funding. Therefore, the County of Tulare is requesting an extension through August 1, 2014 to select an option for our project. With this additional time, the County will be able to investigate other sources of funding to bridge the gap between the original request and the reduced amount. The County remains committed to constructing a facility that provides new beds and enhanced programs and believes this additional time would help us in achieving our goals. The project has met all of the four funding criteria established by the BSCC.
