Re: Juvenile Probation and Camps Funding (JPCF)—CAMP Disbursement
Fiscal Year 2012/2013

For Fiscal Year 2012/2013, the State Controller's Office (SCO) shall, on a quarterly basis beginning October 1, allocate funds deposited in the Enhanced Local Law Enforcement Services Account in the Local Revenue Fund 2012. Disbursement of these funds will be among counties that operate juvenile camps and ranches based on the number of occupied beds in each camp as of 12:01 a.m. each day, up to the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC; *formerly Corrections Standards Authority*) rated maximum capacity. The monthly Camp Population Report is attached for your use.

The BSCC will continue to administer the camp funding portion of the Juvenile Probation and Camp Funding Program (JPCF) by collecting information associated with the number of occupied beds and rated capacity. Each quarter, the BSCC will calculate the county's Average Daily Population (ADP), which will determine the county's allocation. To facilitate this process for FY2012/2013, please complete the attached Camp Eligibility Form, will be available on the BSCC web page at:

Please complete the FY2012/2013 Camp Eligibility Form whether or not your county plans to participate in the JPCF camp disbursement portion of the program. Since we require an original signature, please mail the completed form as soon as possible but in no case later than September 15, 2012.

Once the BSCC receives notification of the quarterly camp allocation from the SCO, each county's allocation will be determined; the BSCC will then forward the breakdown of disbursement funds to SCO, who will release the camp funds via electronic fund transfer.
