The 2014-15 State Budget Act appropriated Recidivism Reduction Funds through Assembly Bill 1468, Article 4, California Penal Code Section 6045 for the establishment of MIOCR grants. The purpose of this funding is to support appropriate prevention, intervention, supervision, and services through promising and evidence-based strategies to reduce recidivism in managing California's mentally ill offender population, as well as improving outcomes for these offenders.
