Notes: Arrive early to hide contraband throughout room.

Time	Objective WST/BST	Trainers Script	Materials/Notes
0800-0815 Or 15 min.	6.1.3	<p>Group Activity – Tell the students that there are several items of contraband hidden in the training room. Give them 2 minutes to locate them. Take note of whether the class works together or individually. Debrief after time has expired and show class any missed contraband.</p> <p>Test – No WST/BST</p> <p>Note – Prior to the class starting, hide contraband in various locations. Make note of locations of items.</p>	Contraband – 10 handcuff keys, 5 shanks, 5 cigarettes, 5 pill bottles.
0815-0830 Or 15 min.	6.1.2	<p>Group Activity –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrange four flip charts (Weapons, Drugs, How does it get in? and Hiding Places) around the room. Have the students count off by 4's and report to the assigned flip chart. Tell the students to list as many answers to their flip chart as possible. Give them 2 min. • After 2 minutes, have each group rotate around the room for 1 min until they are back to the original flip chart. • Ask each group to look at the chart and see what has been added and highlight 3 of the most potentially dangerous answers on the list. • Have the each group report out on top three. <p>Test – No WST/BST</p> <p>Note – Pre-label flip charts prior to start of class.</p>	4 flip charts Markers List of answers of each category
