² AB114 (Governor's 2015 Budget) increased SB1022 financing authority by \$9,060,000, for a total of \$509,060,000. Tehama County was conditionally awarded the \$9,060,000 by the BSCC Board in July 2015.

³ One March 11, 2014 the BSCC held an Appeals Hearing for Humboldt, Monterey, and Stanislaus Counties. Stanislaus County's appeal was granted which reordered the ranking of the Medium County category. San Joaquin and Tulare Counties had both been conditionally awarded, however with the appeal ruling San Joaquin lost the award and Tulare's award was reduced to a partial amount.

* San Mateo County relinquished their conditional award of \$23,374,000.
