

**SB 81 LOCAL YOUTHFUL OFFENDER REHABILITATIVE FACILITIES
PROPOSALS RECEIVED JANUARY 6, 2009**

PROPOSAL SUMMARIES

County	State Funds Requested
Alameda	\$35,000,000
Replace the existing aged and dilapidated camp in San Leandro with a new 150-bed camp and related ancillary space, providing residential treatment and rehabilitation for male and female youth.	
Colusa	\$5,655,740
Construct a new 10-bed juvenile rehabilitation facility and related ancillary space in Colusa.	
Humboldt	\$12,930,869
Construct a new 30-bed juvenile hall replacement facility and related ancillary space in Eureka.	
Los Angeles	\$28,728,123
Demolish and reconstruct a camp facility in Calabasas to include 120 beds and related ancillary space.	
Merced	\$8,897,708
Construct a new 60-bed camp facility and related ancillary space in El Nido.	
Monterey	\$35,000,000
Construct a new 150-bed juvenile hall and related ancillary space in Salinas replacing the existing 50 year old facility.	
Riverside	\$24,698,105
Construct a new 100-bed treatment (camp) facility and related ancillary space in Riverside replacing an outdated facility.	
San Luis Obispo	\$13,120,983
Add 20 new detention beds, classrooms, treatment area and related ancillary space to the existing juvenile hall located in the city of San Luis Obispo.	
Santa Clara	\$12,950,000
Add seven 12-bed therapeutic units (84 beds total) and related ancillary space to the existing Boys Ranch located in Morgan Hill. The project also includes constructing additional classrooms and converting an existing dormitory into recreation and visiting space.	

Santa Cruz **\$1,355,608**

Construct an indoor multi-use recreation and programs facility at the existing juvenile hall site in Felton to serve both in-custody youth at the existing juvenile hall and probationers under community supervision.

Shasta **\$15,050,000**

Replace the existing, antiquated 56-bed juvenile hall located in Redding with a new 90-bed juvenile detention facility and related ancillary space.

Stanislaus **\$18,000,000**

Construct a 60-bed youth treatment facility and related ancillary space in Modesto.

Tuolumne **\$16,000,000**

As the host county, construct a new 30-bed regional juvenile hall and ancillary space in Sonora for Tuolumne's youths and the youth in the neighboring counties of Calaveras, Amador, Mariposa and Mono.

Yolo **\$4,784,536**

Construct an indoor multipurpose recreation, programs and visitor center on the grounds of the existing juvenile hall located in Woodland to serve the youth in-custody and youth under community supervision after their release.
