REVISED 1988 JAIL PROFILE DATA SUMMARY

AVERAGE DAILY POPULATION

The jail population in California continues to rise. There were 64,332 prisoners, on the average, in county jails in California (excluding Type I facilities) in 1988. This represents a 49% increase since February 1984 and 5.8% over 1987 (see Table 1).

The statewide average daily population (ADP) totals include 56,498 males (88%) and 7,834 females (12%). The overall distribution of male and female prisoners has remained fairly constant in county jails for the past decade.

There were 31,957 pretrial inmates (50%) and 32,375 (50%) sentenced inmates. The pretrial category included 89% (28,443) males and 11% (3,514) females. The vast majority of sentenced inmates were also males—87% (28,055). Thirteen percent (4,320) were females (see Table 2).

There were a total of 30 juveniles held, on the average, in adult detention facilities (excluding Type I facilities) in 1988. Twenty-six of the juveniles were held in Los Angeles County. The number of juveniles held in county jails in 1988 decreased 6% compared to 1987 when a total of 32 juveniles were detained in adult detention facilities.

JAIL BOOKINGS

The Jail Profile Data Summary also collects data on the total number of pretrial bookings and sentenced commitments to county jails. The total number of bookings statewide in calendar year 1988 was 1,438,053, up 105,590 (7.9%) from 1987.

Of the total number of bookings for 1988, 81% were pretrial and 19% were sentenced. This ratio may understate the percentage of pretrial bookings. A number of counties' pretrial/sentenced ratios are based on a four-day sample (see Table 3).

AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY

The statewide average length of stay per booking (including both pretrial and sentenced bookings) based on the calendar year 1988 data was 16.4 days (see Table 4). This is lower than the 16.3 recorded for 1987.
