2019 Tribal Youth Diversion Grant

This ESC will update a Request for Proposals, read and rate applications, and develop grant award recommendations for the BSCC. This grant program provides funding for Federally Recognized California Tribes to implement diversion programs for Indian children that use trauma-informed, community-based, and health-based interventions. The diversion programs are to address the needs of Indian children who experience high rates of juvenile arrests, high rates of suicide, high rates of alcohol and substance abuse, and low high school graduation rates.

The BSCC is looking for people who have expertise relevant to the 2019 Tribal Youth Diversion Grant including but not limited to tribal communities, diversion, alternatives to incarceration, trauma-informed care, health and wellness. Please note that individuals who served on the prior Tribal Advisory Group or the Youth Reinvestment Grant ESC that ended in May and June of 2019 respectively will be given priority consideration for placement on this ESC.
