2024 FEDERAL YOUTH DETENTION REPORT

- When a youth is held in a secure juvenile detention facility **solely for a federal detention hold (e.g., illegal entry)¹**, administrators are required to report the name of that individual and their length of stay to the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC).
- Please submit this form to the BSCC by the 10th of the month if any youth were held for the federal government and released during the preceding month. **Submit the report after the youth has been released.**
- A separate form must be completed for **each youth** detained for the federal government.
