Hello,

I am responding to the inspection on April 5th and 7th. After CAREFULLY reviewing the inspection I find that it is UNSUSTAINABLE.

Probation is shifting resources from the field offices to juvenile hall. These officers were FORCED to return to these DEPLORABLE conditions.

Probation has shown they can NOT hire quick enough to sustain their operation. When a recruit completes his 11 weeks training and SEES the juvenile hall they quit within DAYS.

Officers on light duty have been sent home WITHOUT PAY. This means that an officer who needs NO ACCOMMODATION to work the field is now sitting at home because Probation has RETALIATED against their own officers.

FULL duty field officers are in juvenile hall.
Light duty field officers are at home.
Probation's FAILED strategy was to send more officers to juvenile hall.
Probation's NEW strategy is to send
more officers to juvenile hall.

My recommendation is to CLOSE juvenile hall. Send field officers to their PRIMARY assignments and move forward. Probation's credibility is BANKRUPT!
