**SUBJECT:** **AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING FOR THE PROPOSITION 47 GRANT - COHORT 4**

The Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) is announcing the release of the Proposition 47 Request for Proposals (RFP). This RFP makes approximately \$152 million available for a grant period that covers October 1, 2024 through June 30, 2028. Eligible applicants are **public agencies** located in the State of California. “Public agency” is defined within the RFP.

Proposition 47 grant funds must be used for mental health services, substance use disorder treatment, and/or diversion programs for people in the criminal justice system. Applicants are also encouraged to provide supplemental housing-related services and other community-based supportive services, such as job skills training, case management, and civil legal services.

Proposition 47 proposals must be received by the BSCC by **5:00 p.m. on June 10, 2024**. The RFP and detailed application instructions are available on the BSCC [website](#).

A virtual Grant Information Session will be held via Zoom on April 30, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. A link to the Bidder’s Conference is provided within the RFP and will be posted on the BSCC website.
