# THE STRATEGIC PLAN-BACKGROUND

- **Current Strategic Plan: January 2022 - December 2026**
  - Developed over a 10-month period in 2021
- **Significant Policy & Organizational Changes**
  - New positions on the Board
  - Changes to Individual Board Membership
  - Broadening of Board Mission: In-Custody Death Review (Senate Bill 519)
  - Executive Order N-16-22: Governor has directed that strategic plans further advance equity and opportunity to address disparities in access and outcomes.

# PROCESS



## Step 1: Goals

The strategic planning process will begin with the development of clear organizational goals and priorities that will consider input from the Board, as well as stakeholder groups and the interested public.

## Step 2: Objectives

Objectives are specific and measurable actions that are aligned with the identified vision and goals. Objectives will be defined for each program area.

## Step 3: Strategies, Measures, & Targets

BSCC program staff and special subject committees will develop specific strategies for each objective as well as performance indicators to measure success.

## Step 4: Board Approval

Once the strategic plan is approved by the Board, BSCC staff will regularly assess, report progress, and make recommendations to the Board for adjustments as necessary.
