Thank you for your request from Division Director Kevin Moore, regarding the implementation timeline for the Orange County Probation Department's Corrective Action Plan. After reviewing the details provided, I have approved the full 90-day implementation period to ensure the Department achieves full compliance.

As noted in the Corrective Action Plan submitted on November 11, 2025, the Department projected completion of all required updates to policies and procedures, along with proof of practice, by Friday, February 6, 2026 (Day 87 of the implementation period). Allowing the maximum statutory resolution date of Monday, February 9, 2026, will provide sufficient time to confirm that all policies and procedures are fully aligned with BSCC and Title 15 regulations.


