SUBJECT: AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING FOR THE ADULT REENTRY GRANT

PROGRAM- REHABILITATION OF EXISTING PROPERTY

The Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) is announcing the release of the Adult Reentry Grant Program - Rehabilitation of Existing Property Request for Proposals (RFP).

The Adult Reentry Grant Program was established in the Budget Act of 2018 (Senate Bill 840, Chapter 29, Statute of 2018). The grant program is aimed at providing support to individuals formerly incarcerated in state prison.

Senate Bill 840 allocated \$50 million in funding of which \$15 million is to be awarded through a competitive-bid process to community-based organizations for the rehabilitation of existing property or buildings for housing people released from prison.

Eligible applicants are non-governmental Community-Based Organizations located in the State of California that have been determined by the IRS to have 501(c)(3) status (i.e., nonprofit).

Proposals must be received by the BSCC by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, November 1, 2019. A copy of the RFP is attached and is available on the BSCC website.
