Hello and thank you for your interest in the State Advisory Committee on Juvenile Justice & Delinquency Prevention (SACJJDP)!

California's SACJJDP is made up of Governor-appointed subject matter experts who are committed to enhancing the quality of life for all youth in California. There are currently 19 SACJJDP members. These members represent many different geographical areas of California and bring expertise from a wide variety of disciplines and life experiences.

The SACJJDP's mission is to serve the Governor, the Legislature and the people of California by promoting effective juvenile justice policies and programming in compliance with goals set forth in the federal Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act (JJDPA). To accomplish this, committee members come together for five to six half-day meetings each year. These meetings are often held in Sacramento though sometimes occur elsewhere in the State. During these meetings, committee members discuss options and develop recommendations related to the expenditure of federal funds received under Title II of the JJDPA. In this way, the SACJJDP plays an important role in shaping policy and setting direction for federally-funded juvenile justice programming throughout California.
