## Agenda Item G: Development of New State Plan

**Issue:** This item will be presented by Field Representative Kimberly Bushard regarding the process for developing the new Title II State Plan.

Under Title II, state planning occurs in 3-year cycles. As early as next Spring, California will be asked to submit its State Plan covering the period 2018-20, which serves as the State's application for funding under Title II. Based on this year's federal schedule, we anticipate the solicitation will be released in January 2018 and our plan/application will be due in April 2018. To meet that timeline, the SACJJDP meetings in September and October 2017 will be used to address the various stages of plan development.

A key role of SACJJDP members in the State Plan development process is the identification of priorities. Arriving at those priorities, involves working through a number of steps which build upon each other. During this meeting, staff will present information that will inform the development process and will lay a foundation upon which further work can occur. Specifically, staff will:

- Provide a general overview of the requirements for the State Plan, making special note of those components that require a significant contribution by SACJJDP members and will be the focus of our work over the next few months.
- Summarize calendar year 2016 data recently released by the California Department of Justice;
- Present a preliminary summary of results obtained from the SACJJDP community survey and describe the other qualitative data which will be available during the development process.
- Describe a road map for how the two-day meeting on October 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> will be used to complete the process of State Plan development within federal timelines.
- Review the federal program purpose areas and provide guidance on prioritizing those program purpose areas. Materials will be provided to assist committee members in the task of prioritizing and members will be asked to work on this before the next meeting in October.
