Re: SB 81 Relinquish Funds

Dear Mr. Fitzpatrick,

Tulare County has carefully evaluated the requirements to proceed with our SB 81-funded project and, although the County is grateful to have been selected to receive these funds, we have decided to relinquish our \$3,000,000 in program funds back to the State.

These funds were to be used for the construction of a new Vocational Education Building to be operated by the Tulare County Probation Department. In order to proceed with the State-funded project and ensure the subject property is eligible for funding, the County will be required to pursue several actions in order to release the property from any encumbrances.

The County has chosen to proceed with a much smaller project scope utilizing the funds that were previously set-aside for this project. As such, the County will continue to provide improved training opportunities for youth within our Probation Department in order to address long term recidivism rates within our juvenile population.

I would like to thank the BSCC for the consideration and consistent support of Tulare County and our public safety projects. We look forward to working with the Board on projects for years to come.

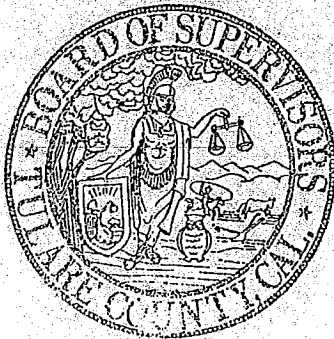
