
LOCAL EVALUATION PLAN

LOGIC MODEL


A visual representation of the project depicting the logical relationships between the inputs/resources, activities, outputs, and outcomes/impacts of a project.

Two-Year and Final Evaluation Reports

Two-Year Preliminary Report

- Purpose is to assess whether project is making progress toward achieving its goals and objectives described in their proposal.
- Due to the BSCC by <u>August 15, 2021</u>

Final Local Evaluation Report

- Purpose is to determine project results and document definitive evidence regarding the project's efficacy and overall impact.
- Due to the BSCC by <u>May 15, 2023</u>
