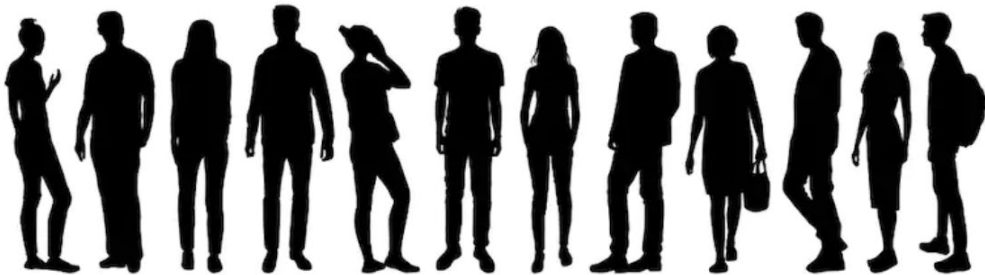

- Final Evaluation Report

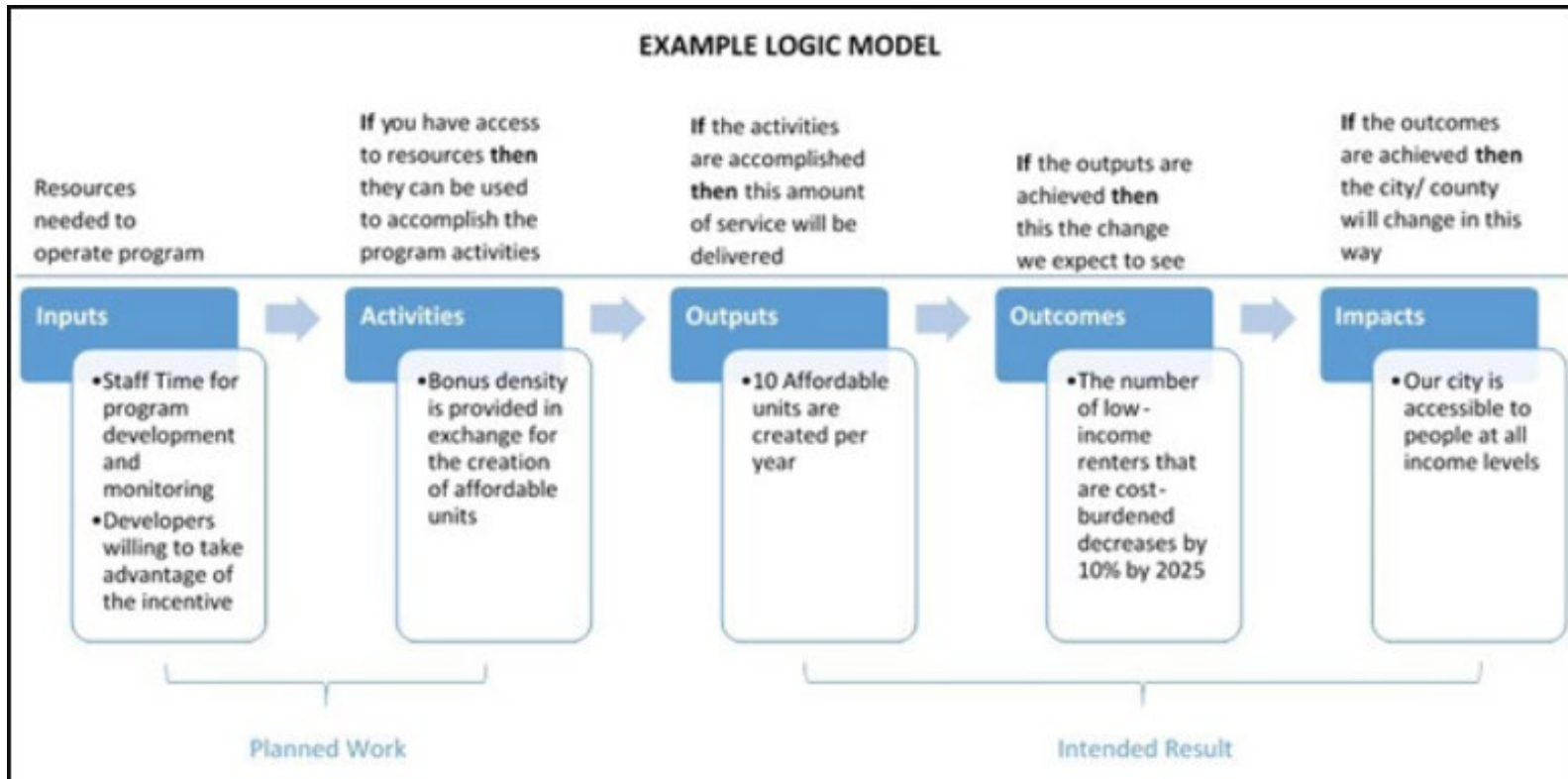


LOCAL EVALUATION PLAN

- ◆ **Logic Model**

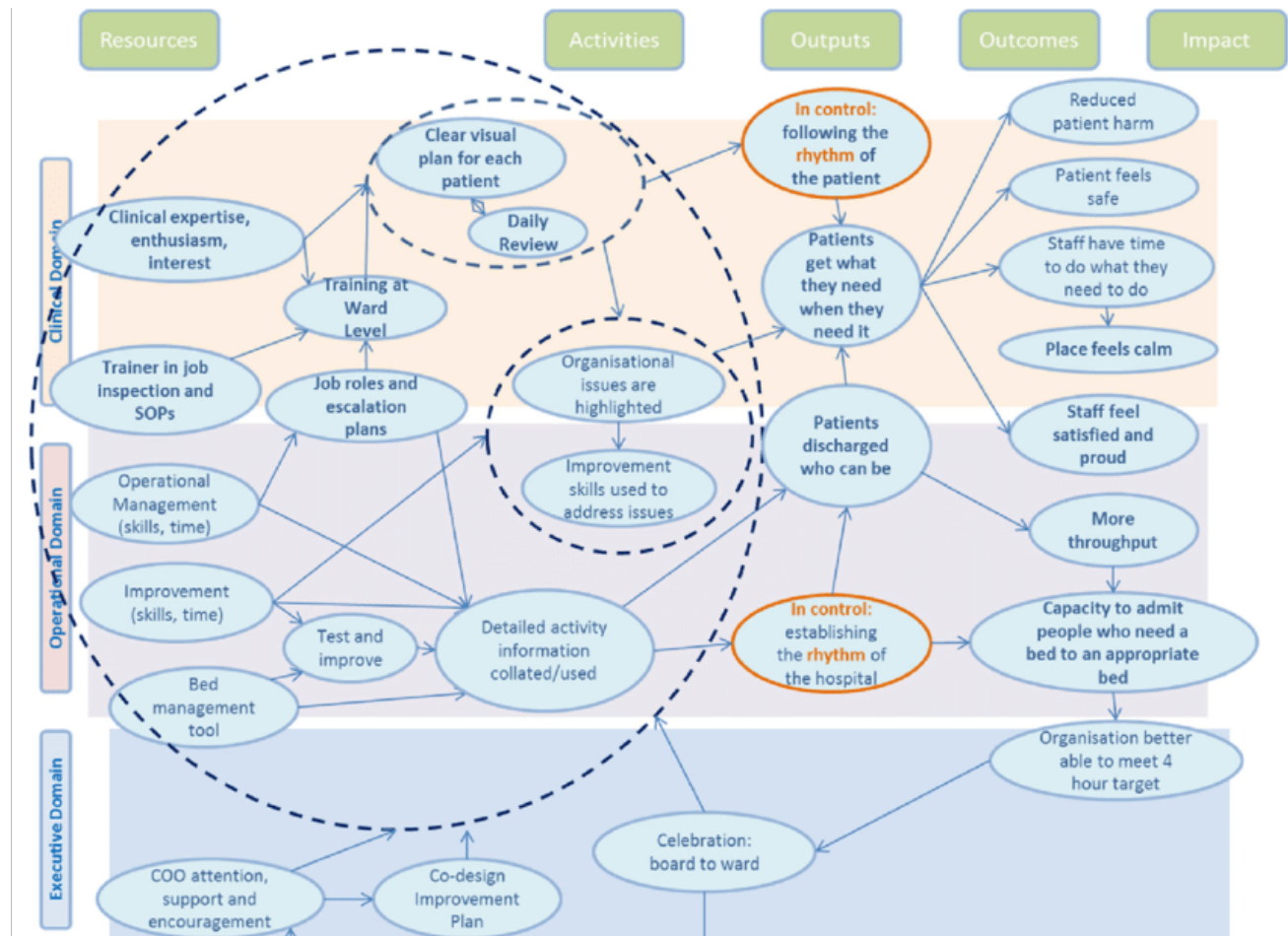
LOGIC MODEL

◆ Two-Year Preliminary Report

- ◆ Purpose is to assess whether project is making progress toward achieving its goals and objectives described in their proposal.
- ◆ Due to the BSCC by August 15, 2021

◆ Final Local Evaluation Report

- ◆ Purpose is to determine project results and document definitive evidence regarding the project's efficacy and overall impact.
- ◆ Due to the BSCC by May 15, 2023
