Figure 1. *Statewide Average Daily Population of County Jails for 2006 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

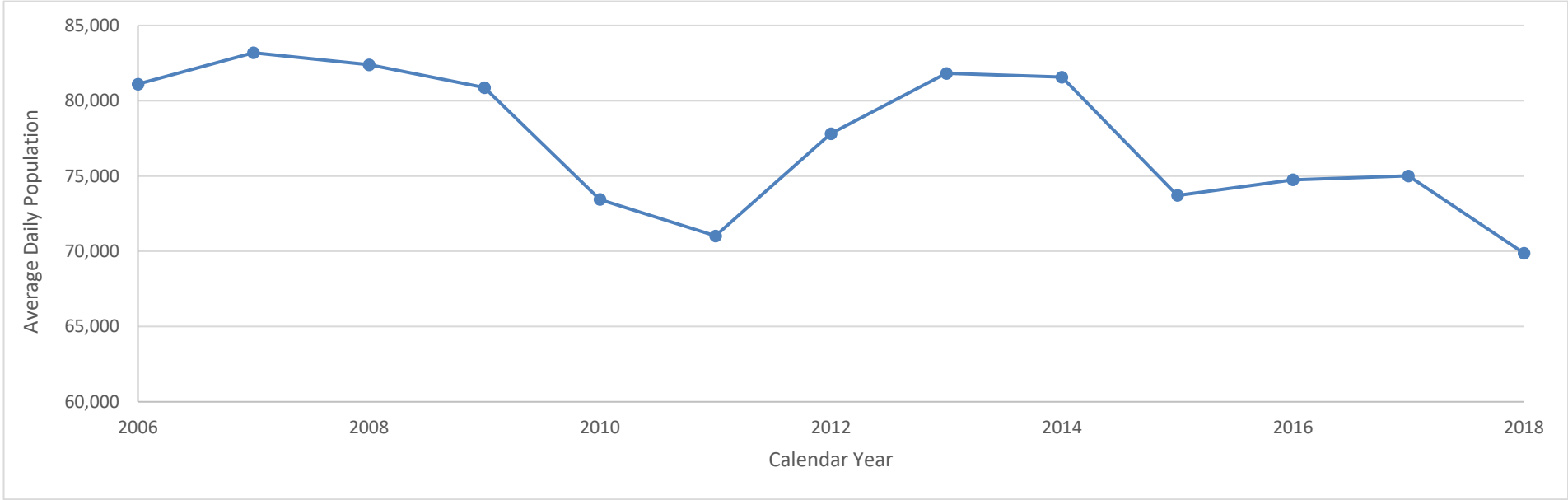


Figure 2. *Statewide County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2006 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

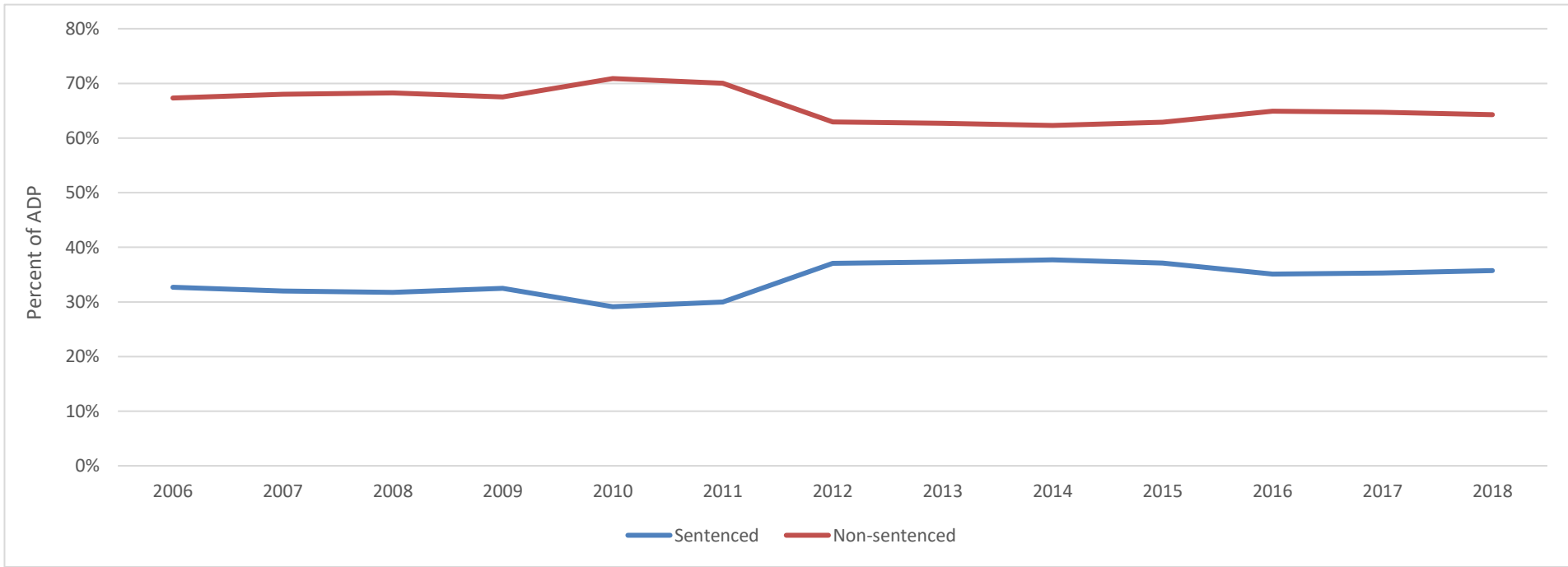


Figure 3. *Statewide County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2006 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

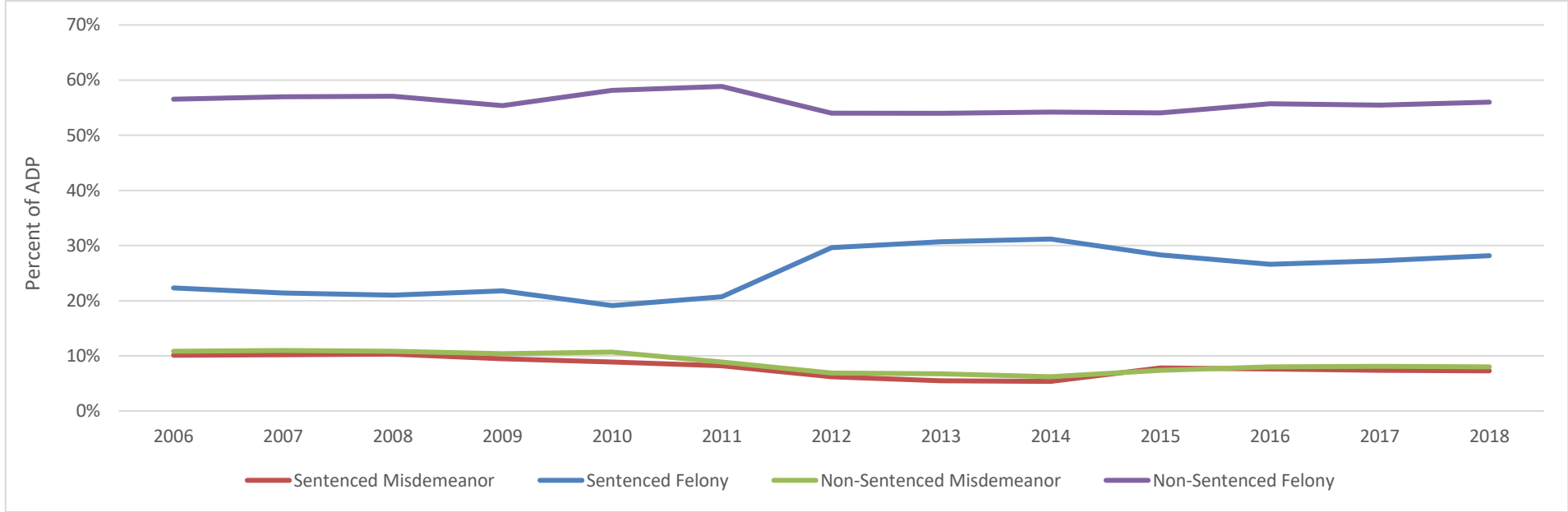


Figure 4. *Statewide County Jail Population by Gender as a Percent of ADP for 2006 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

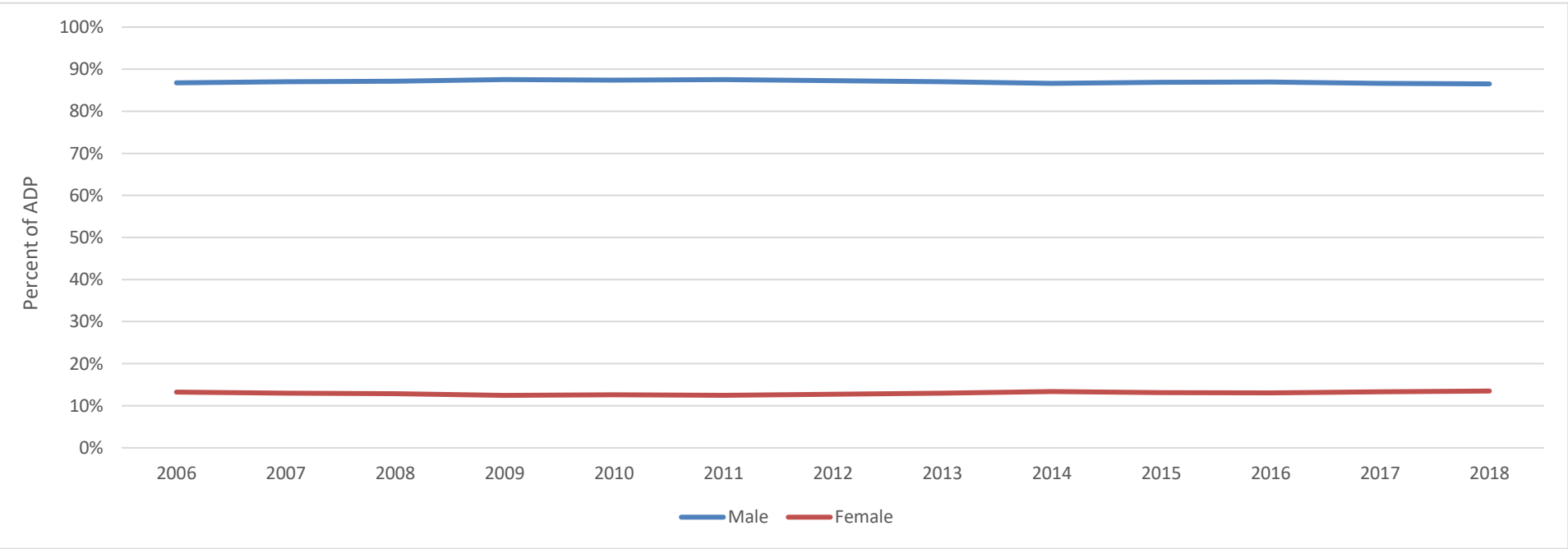

Figure 5. Alameda County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

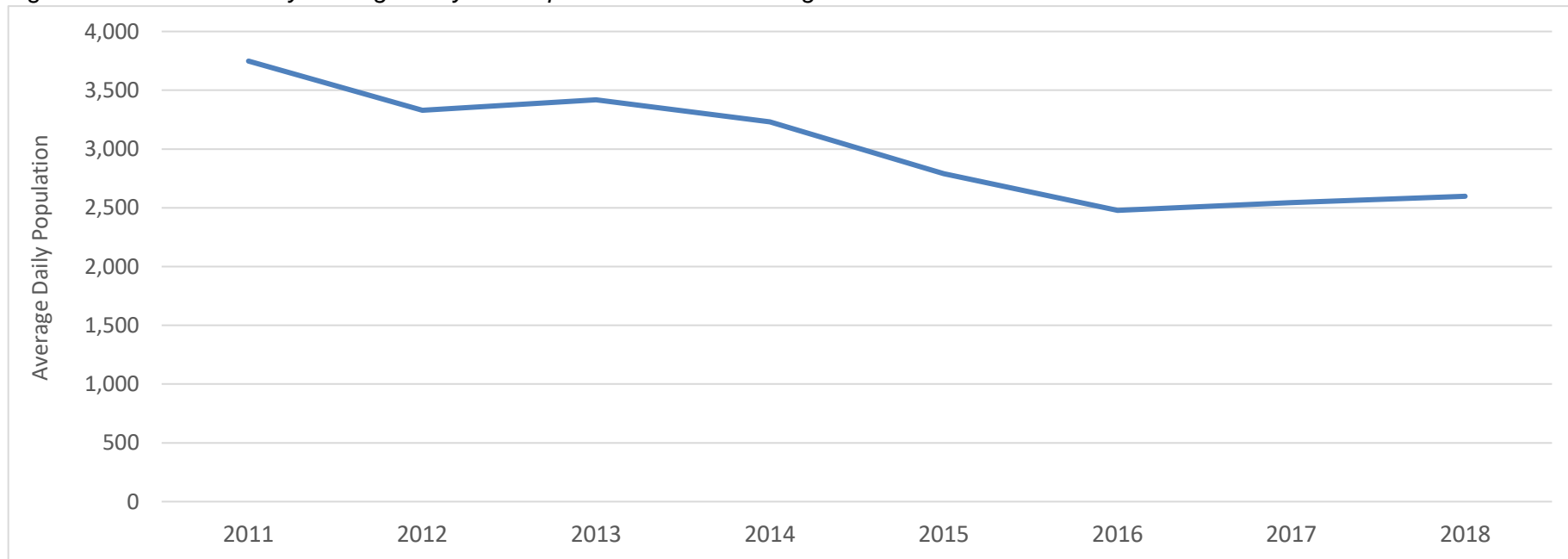


Figure 6. Alameda County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

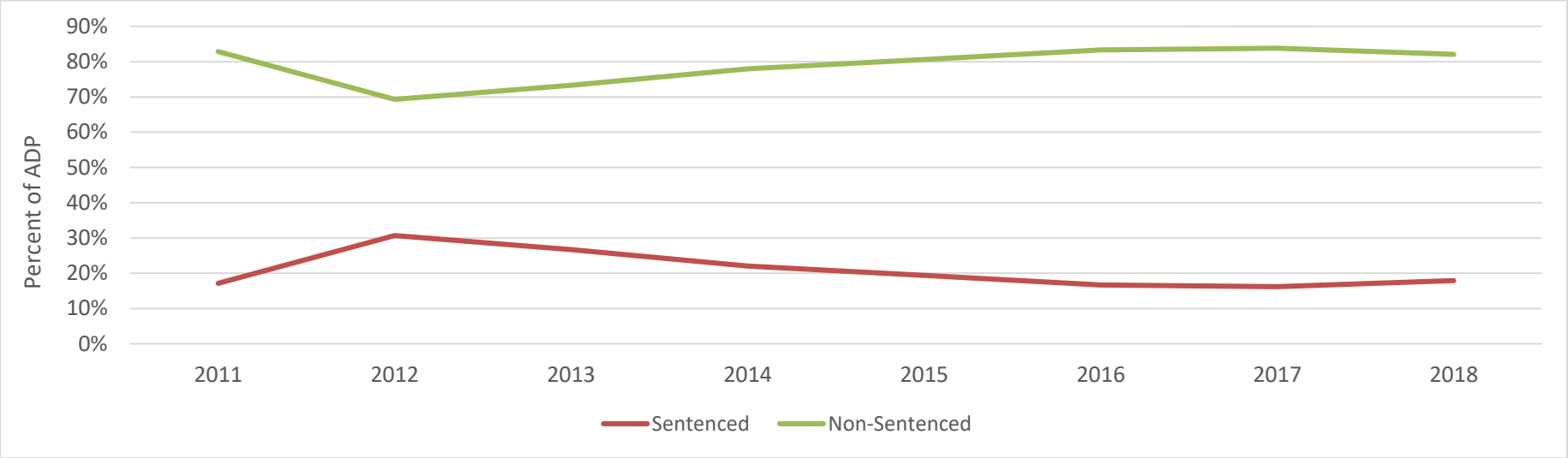
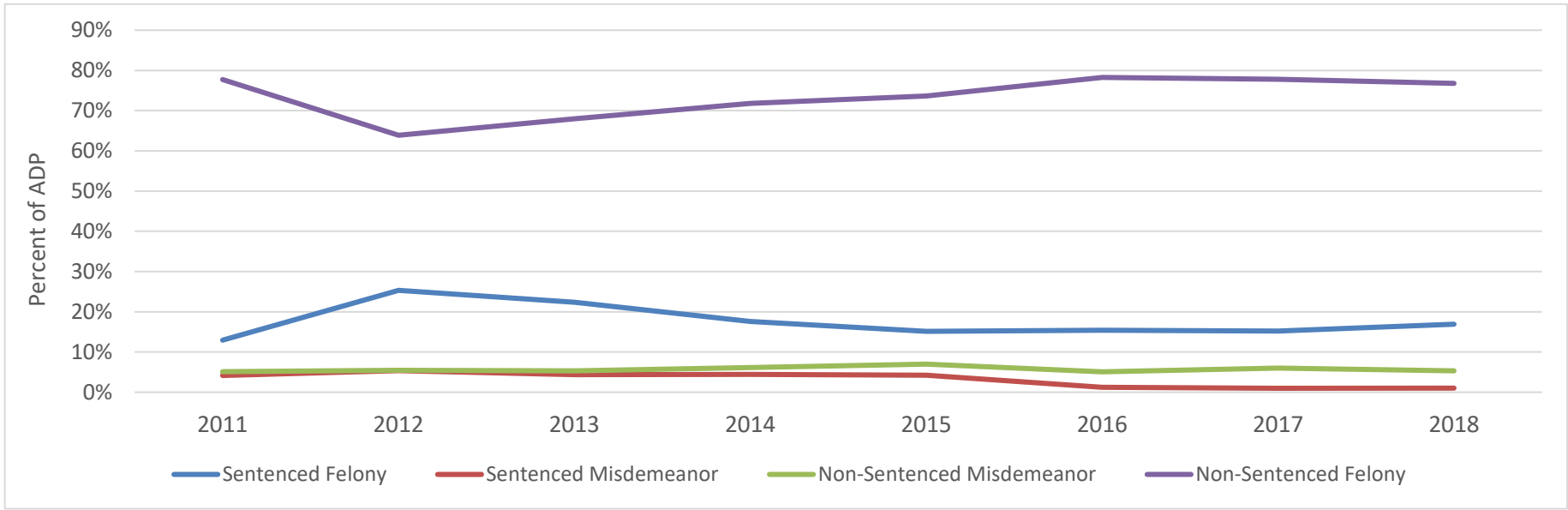


Figure 7. Alameda County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 8. Amador County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

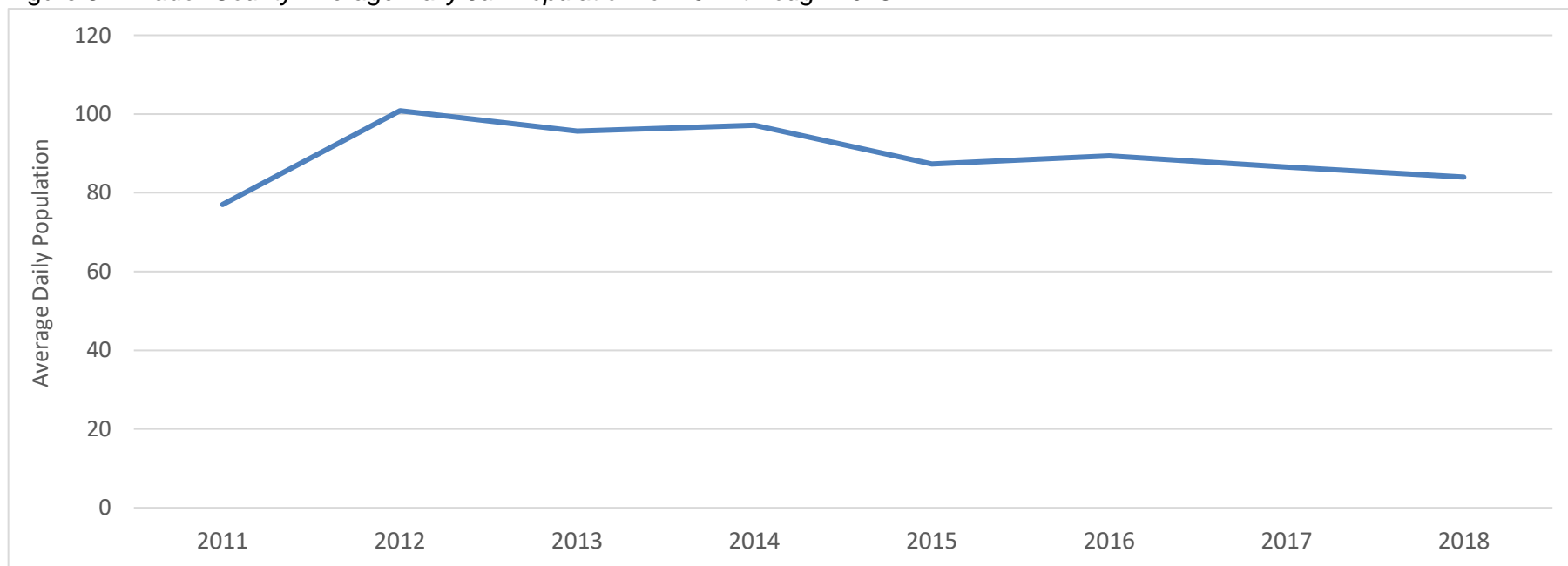




Figure 9. Amador County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

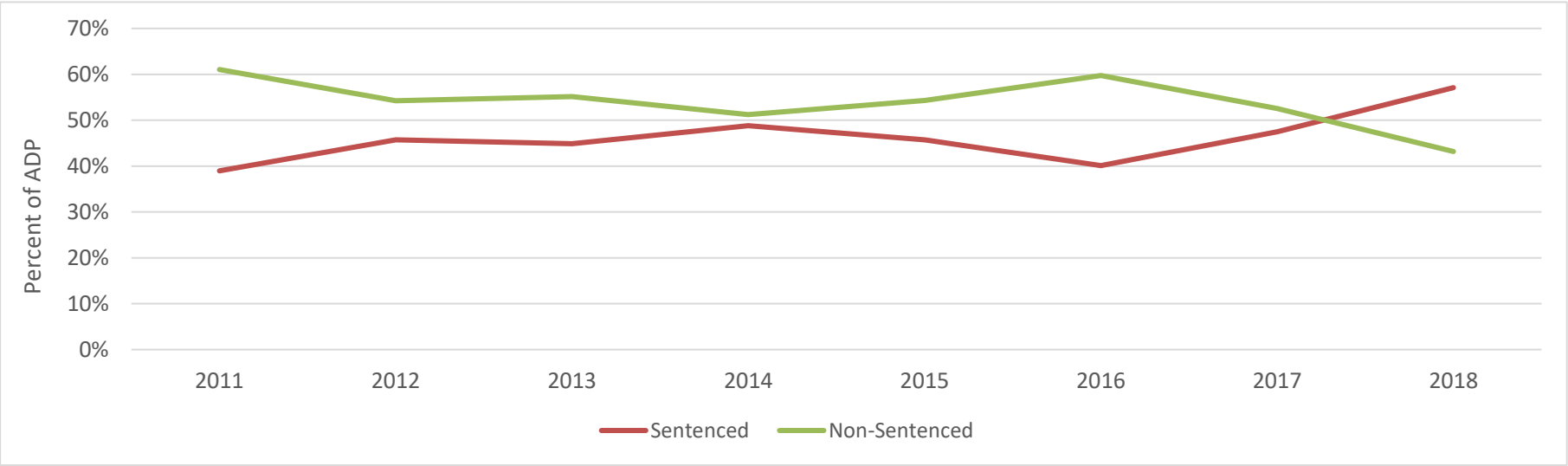
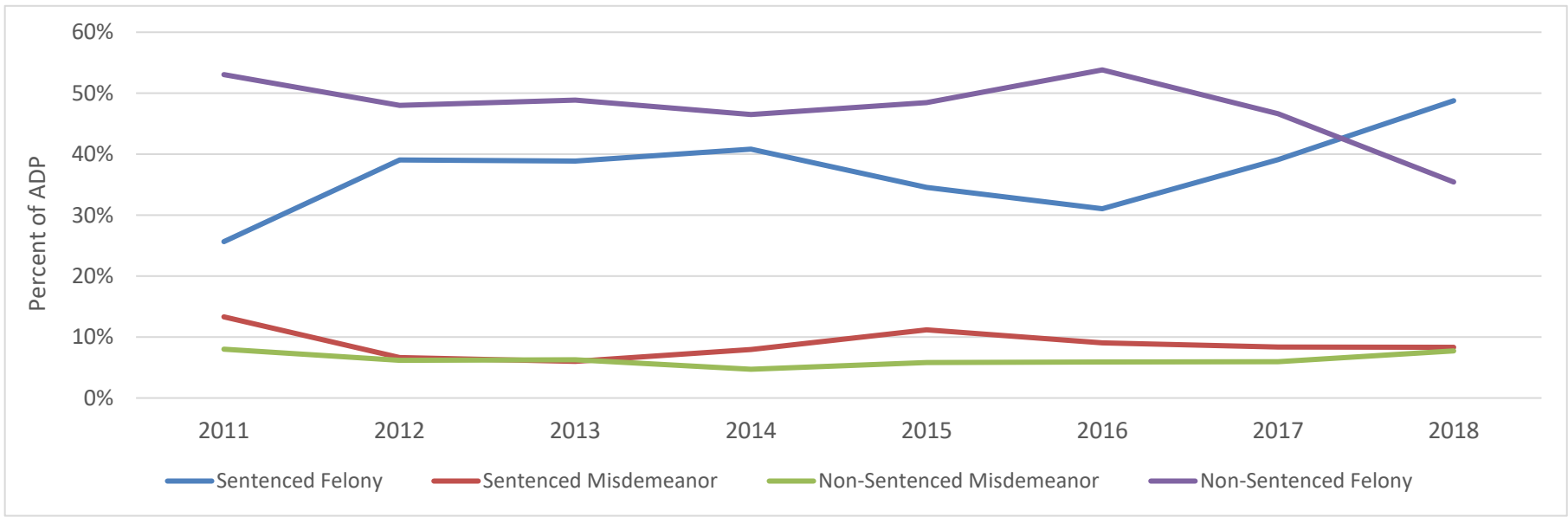


Figure 10. Amador County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 11. *Butte County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

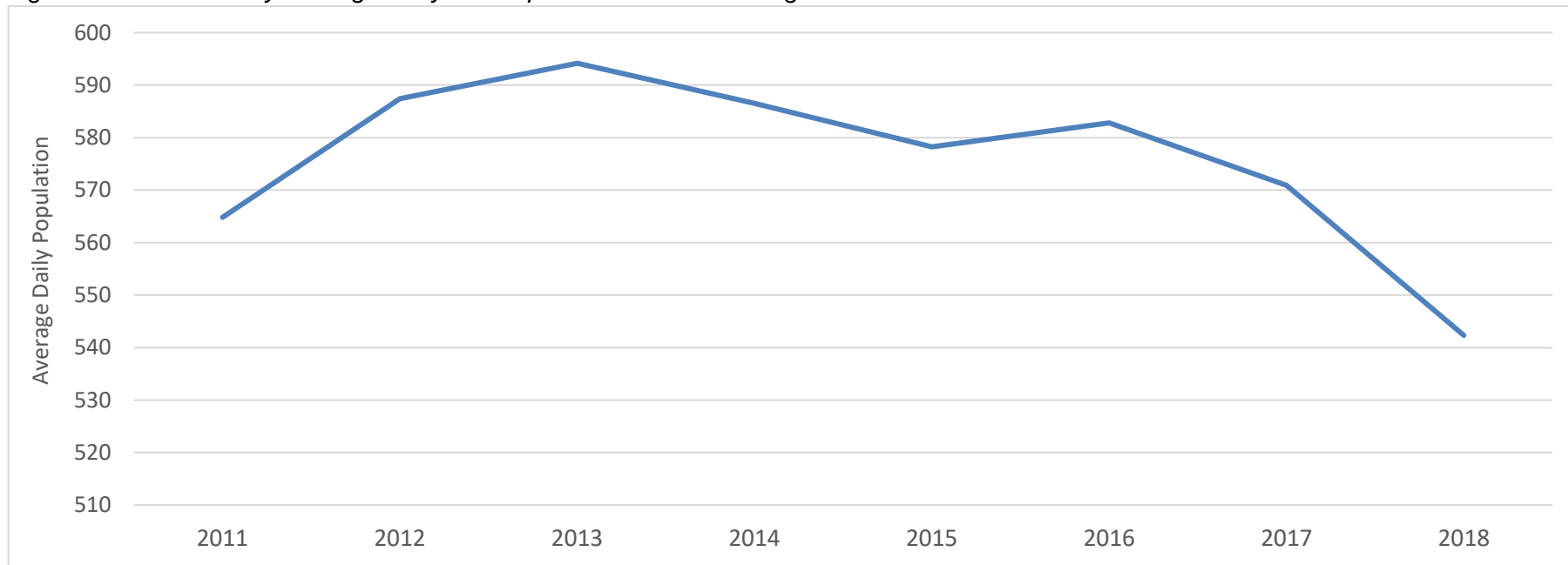


Figure 12. Butte County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

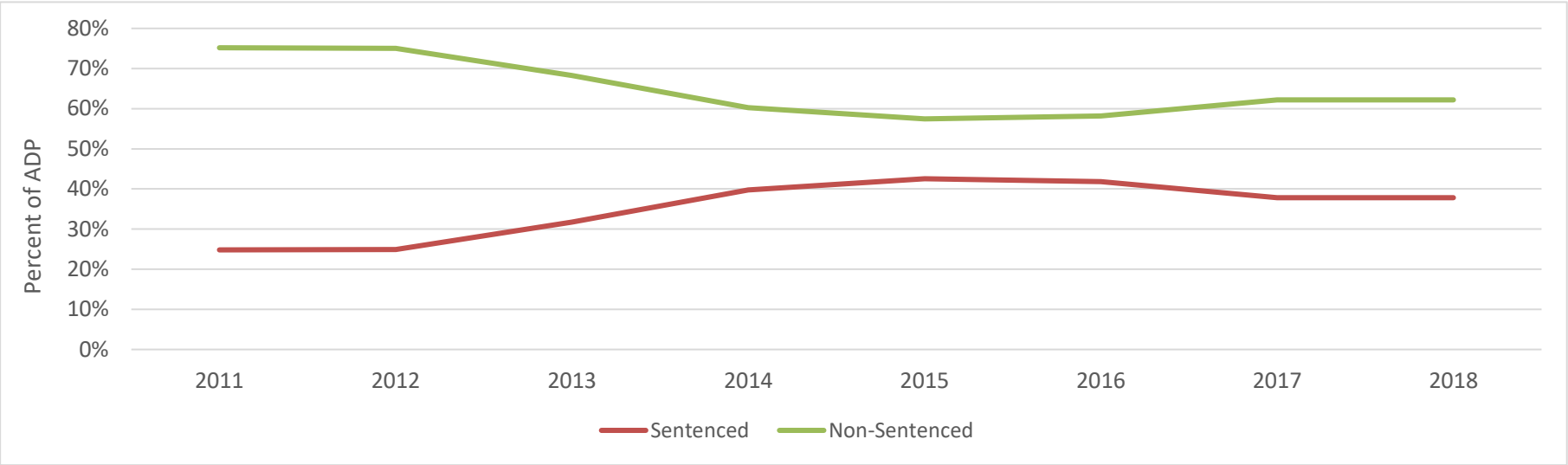
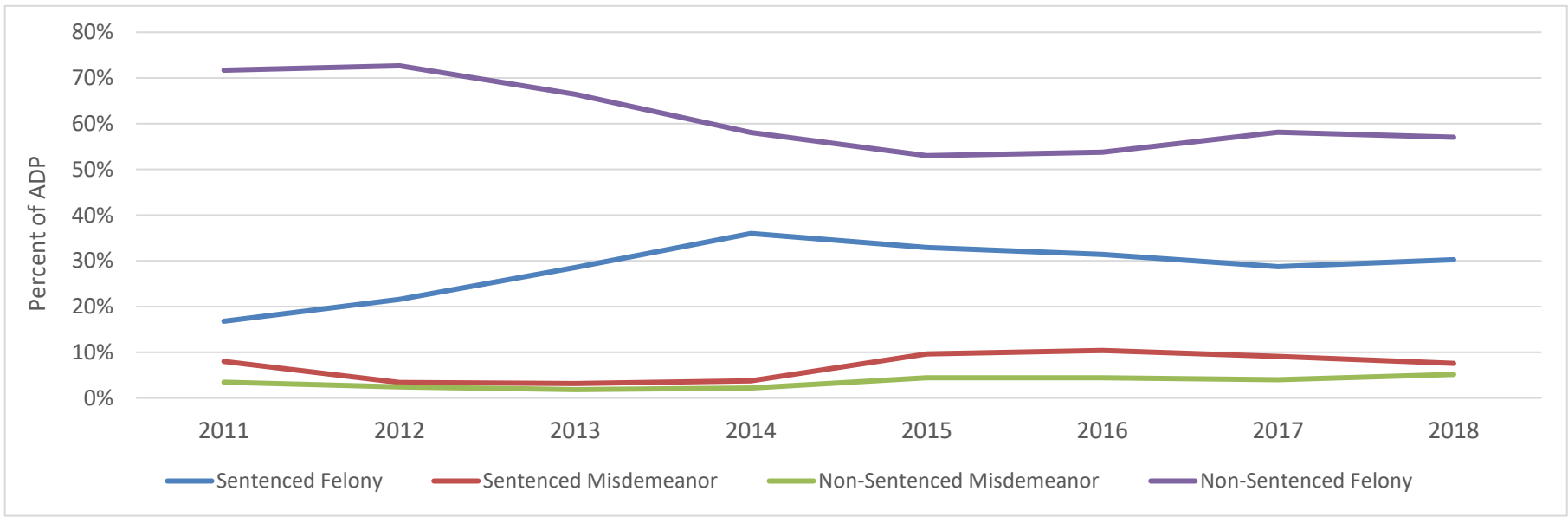


Figure 13. Butte County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 14. Calaveras County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

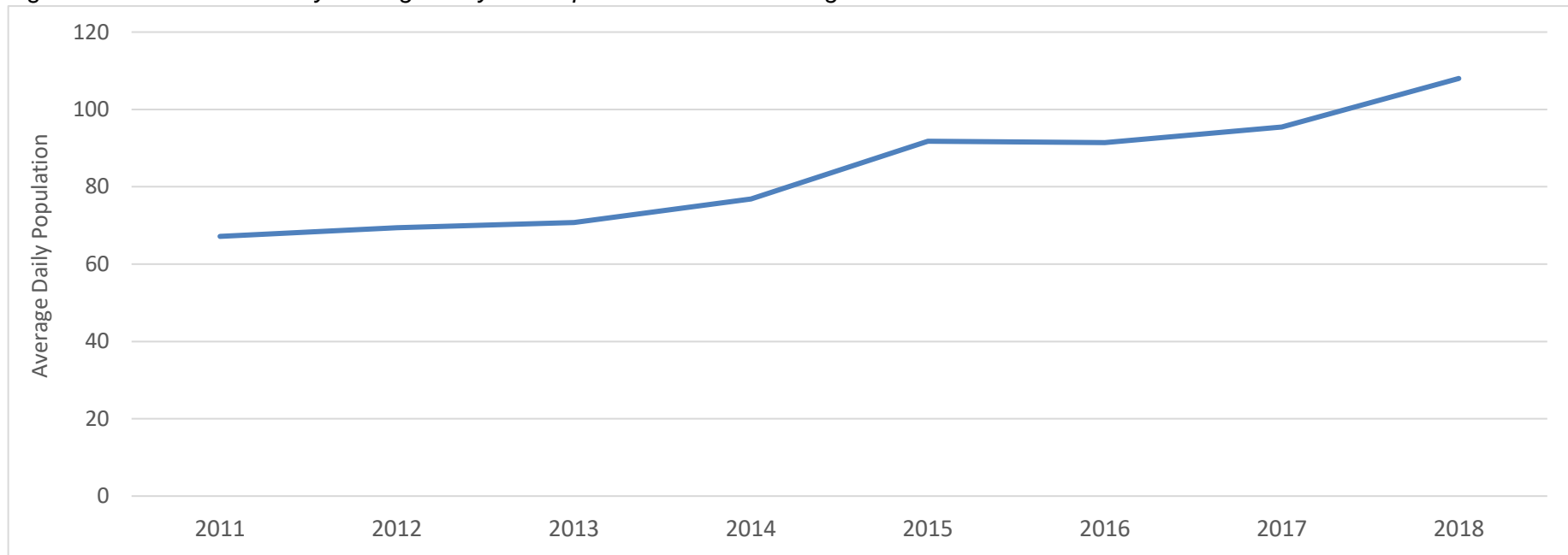


Figure 15. Calaveras County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

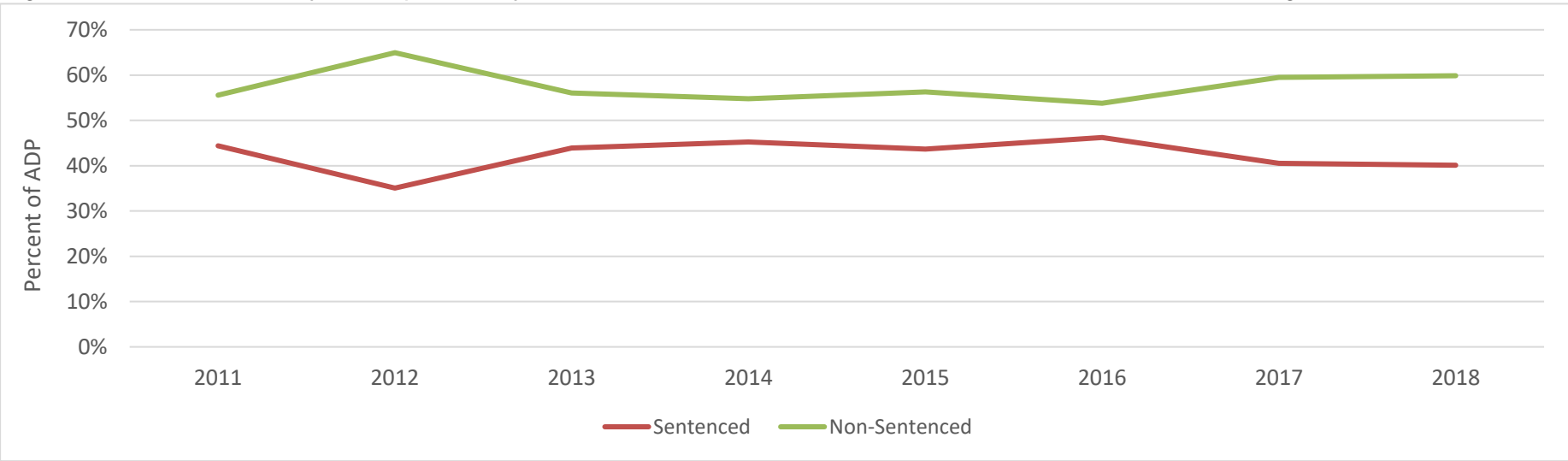
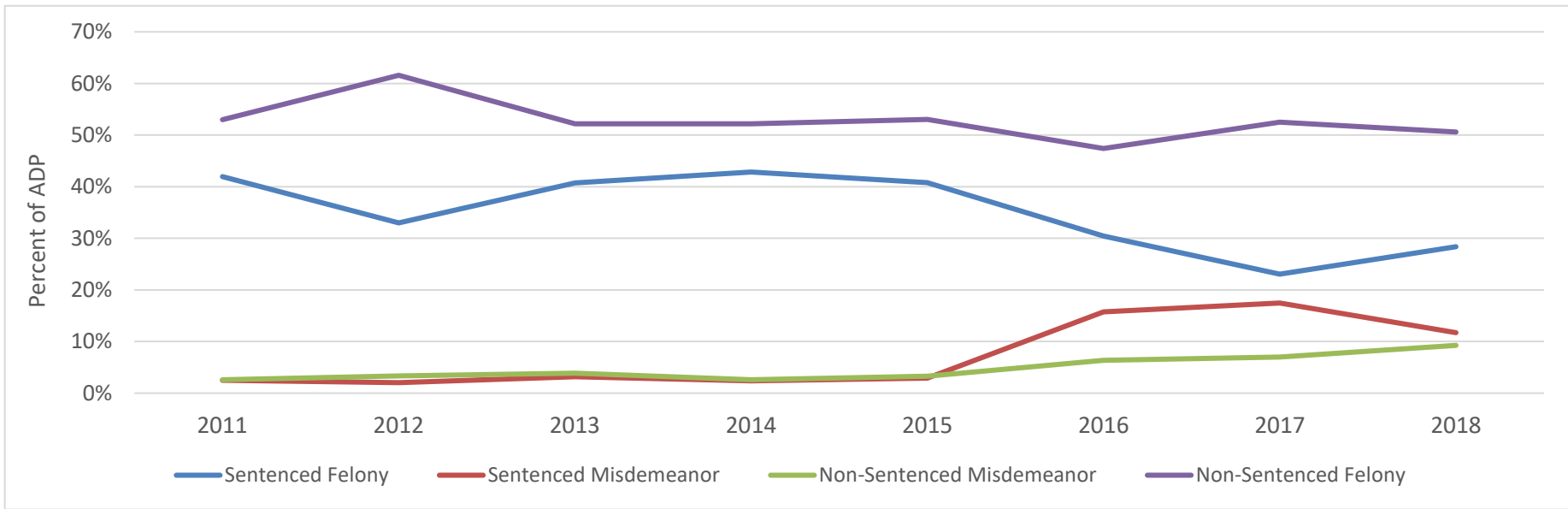


Figure 16. Calaveras County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 17. Colusa County Average Daily Jail Population for Calendar Years 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

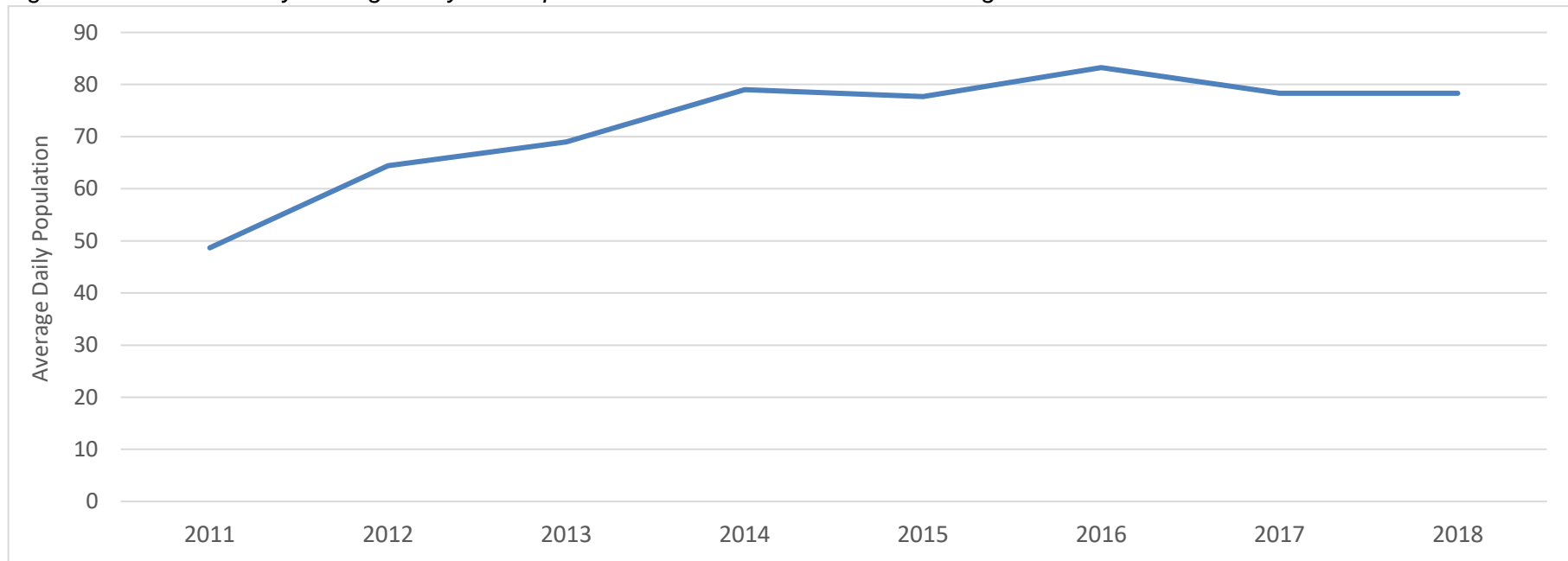


Figure 18. Colusa County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

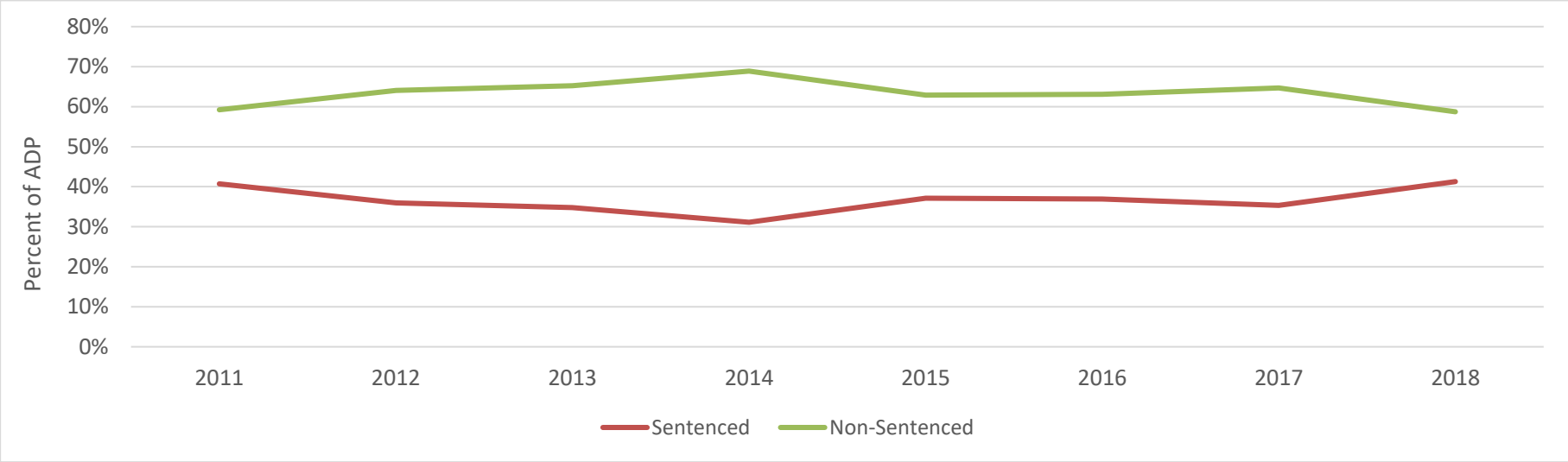
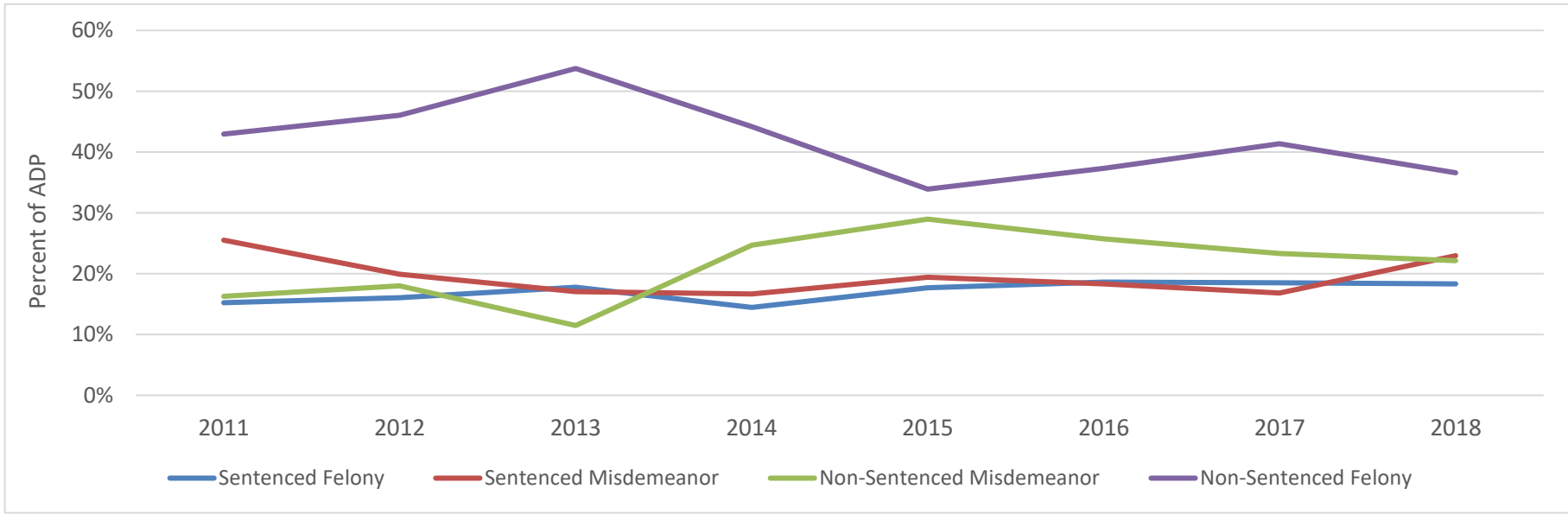


Figure 19. Colusa County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 20. Contra Costa County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

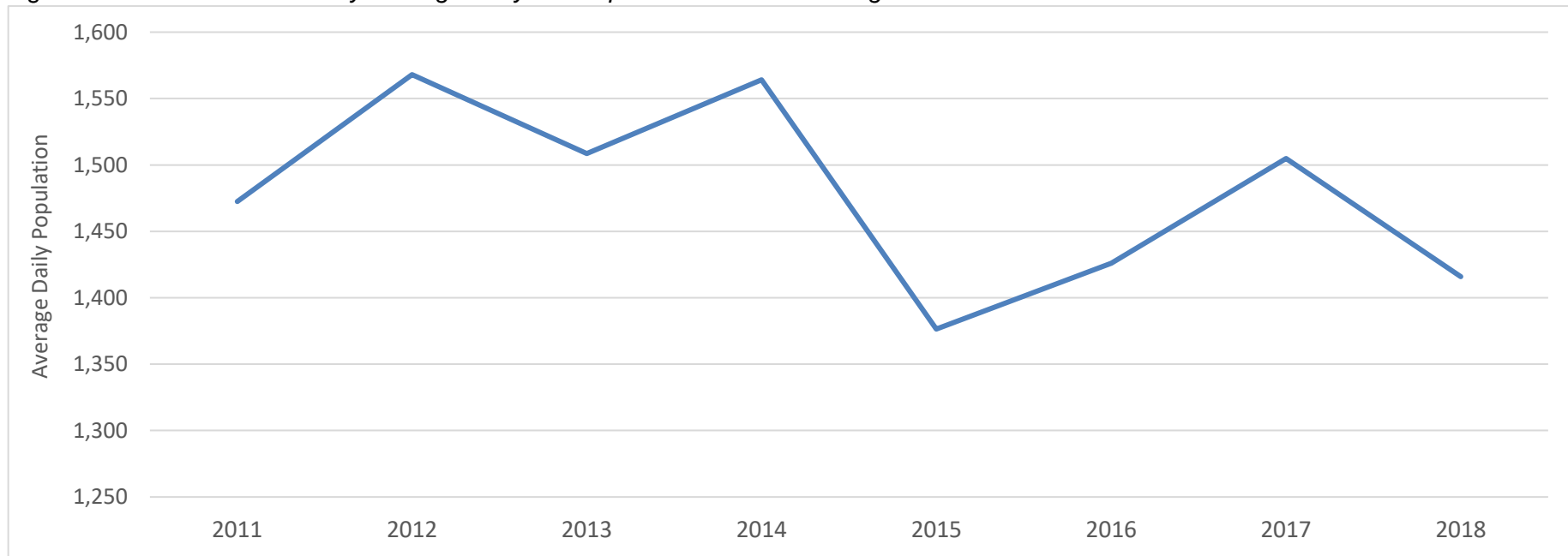




Figure 21. Contra Costa County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

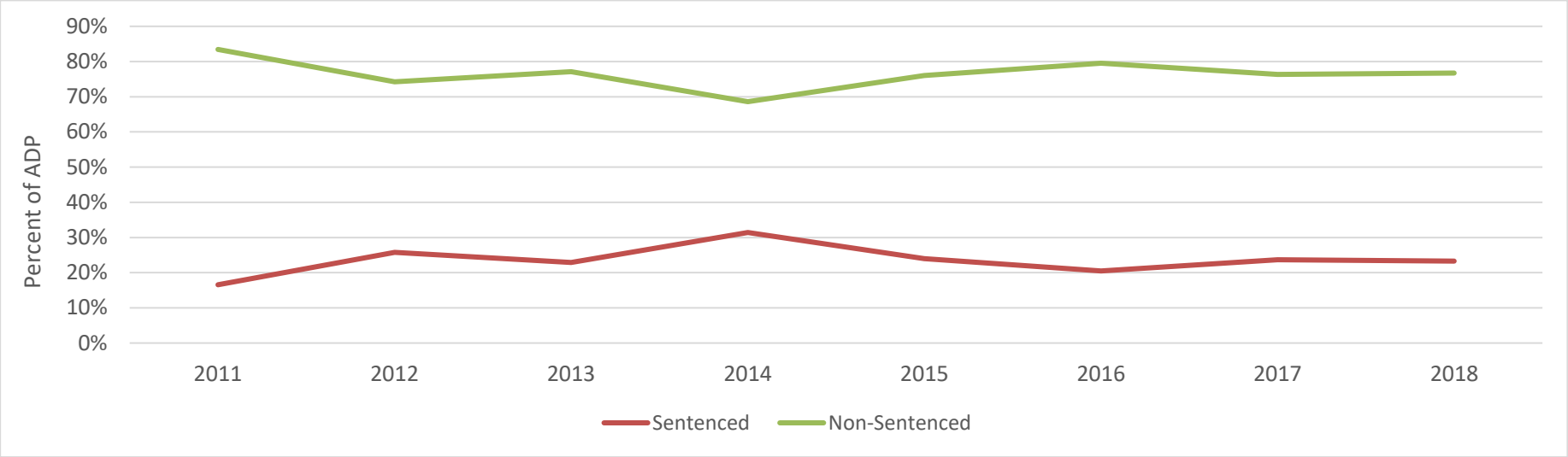
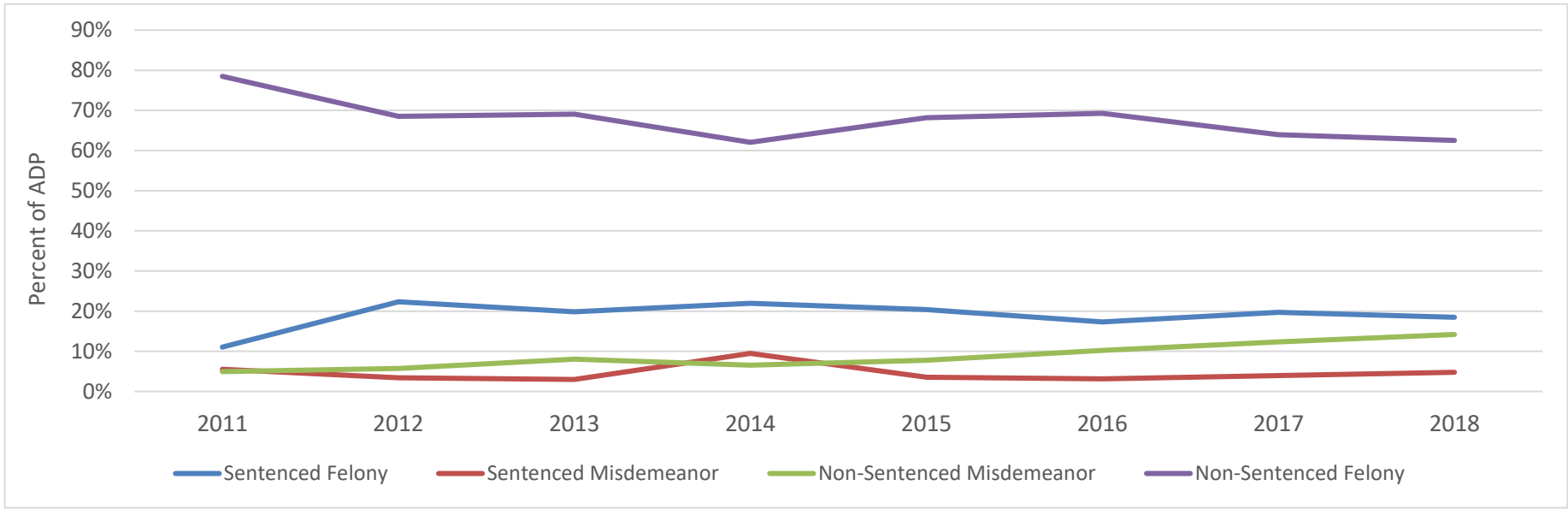


Figure 22. Contra Costa County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 23. *Del Norte County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

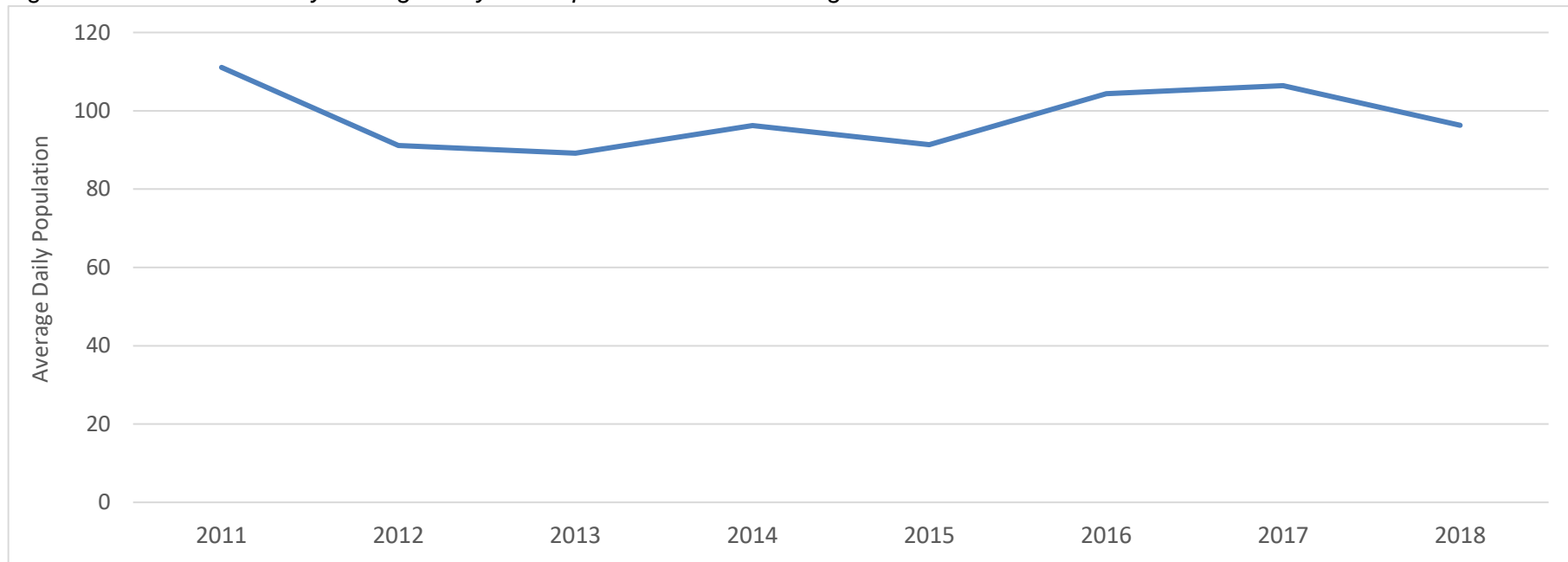


Figure 24. Del Norte County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

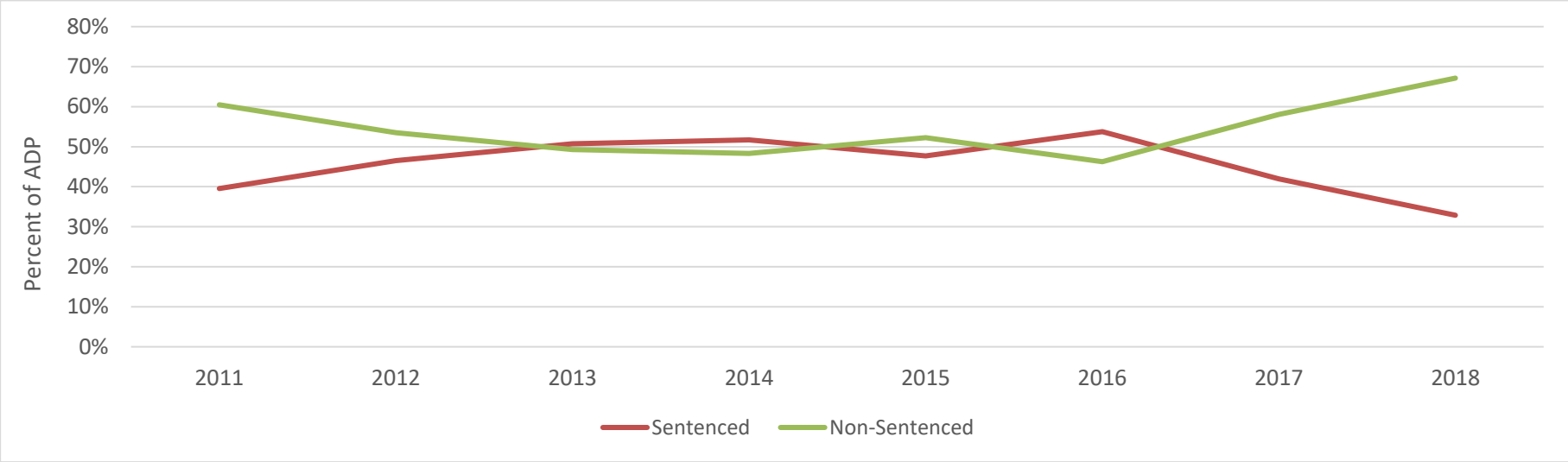
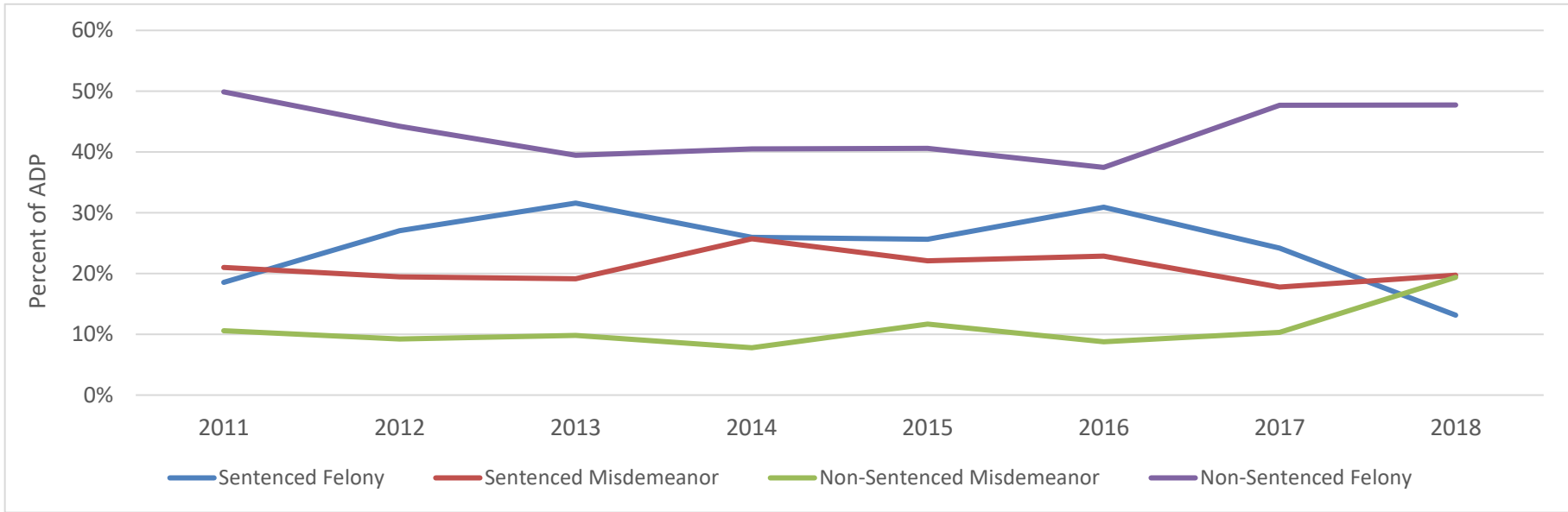


Figure 25. Del Norte County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 26. *El Dorado County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

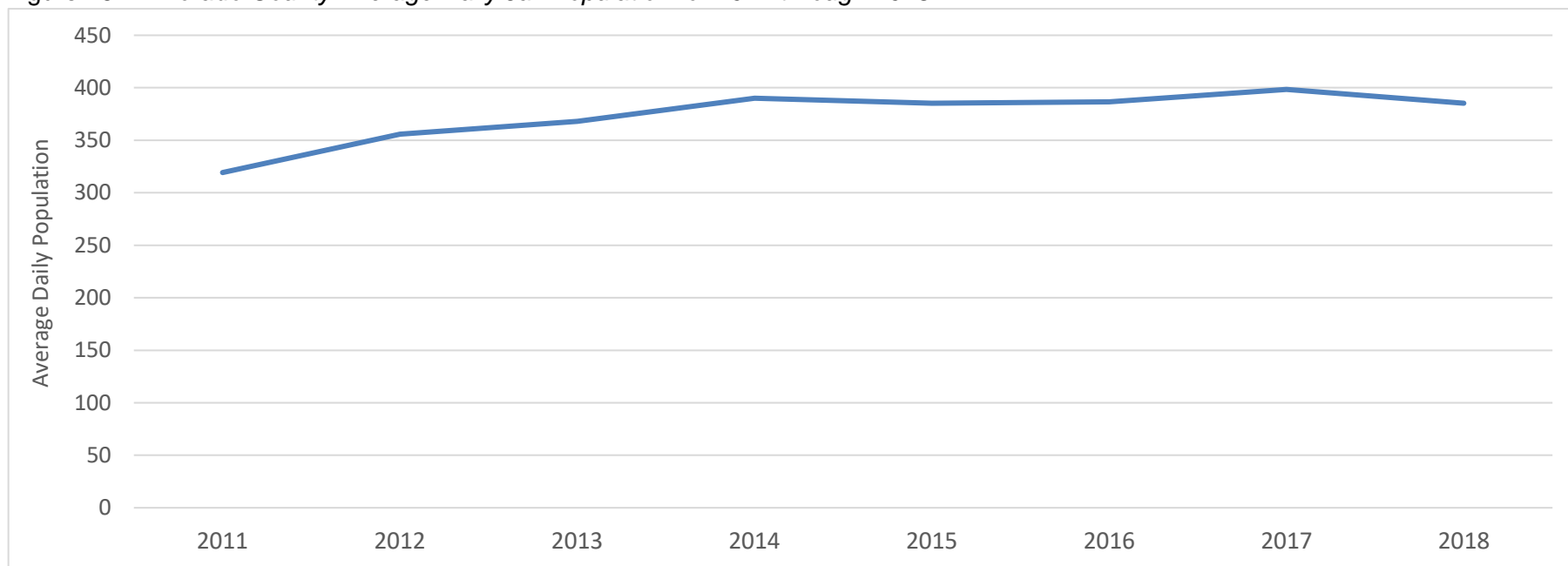


Figure 27. El Dorado County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

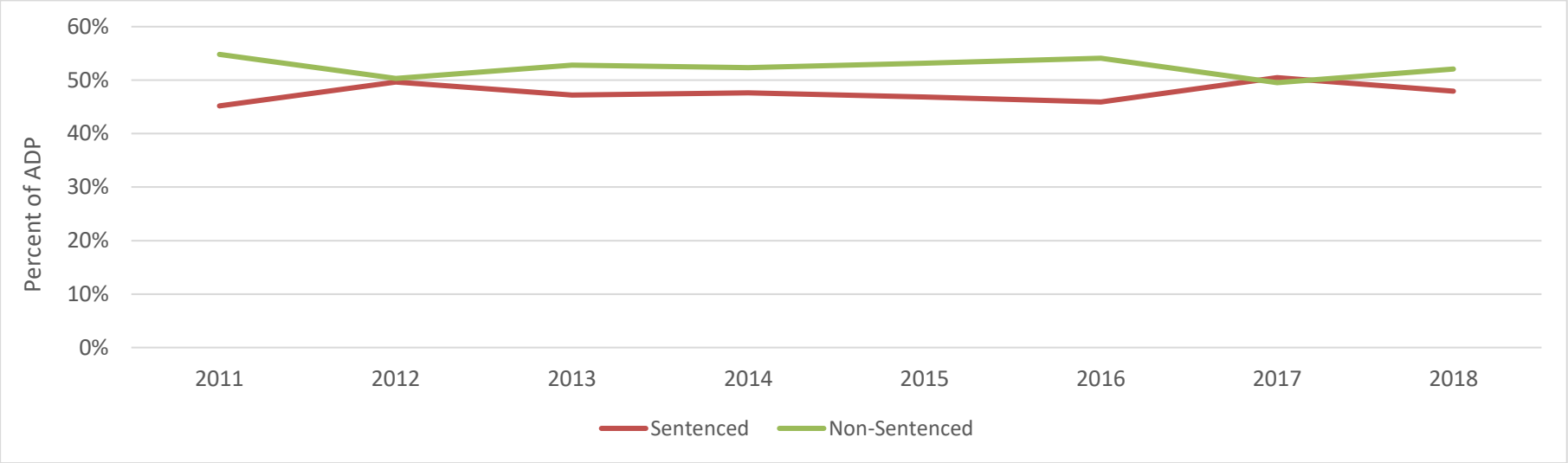
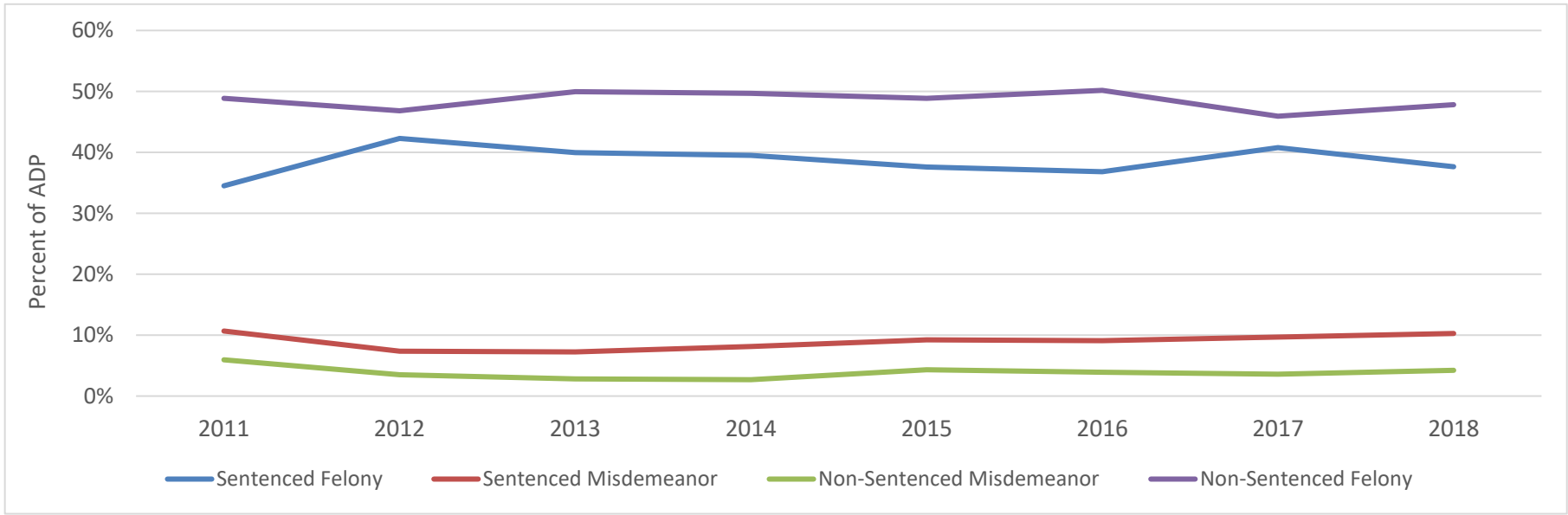


Figure 28. El Dorado County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 29. *Fresno County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

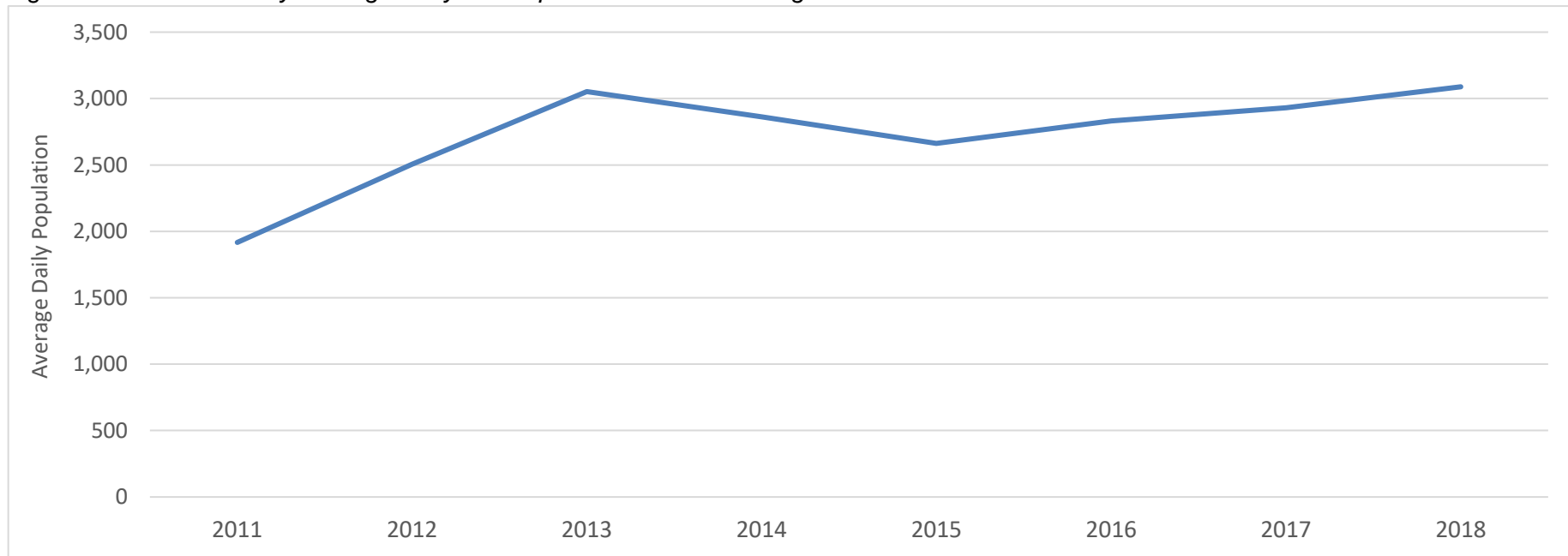


Figure 30. Fresno County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

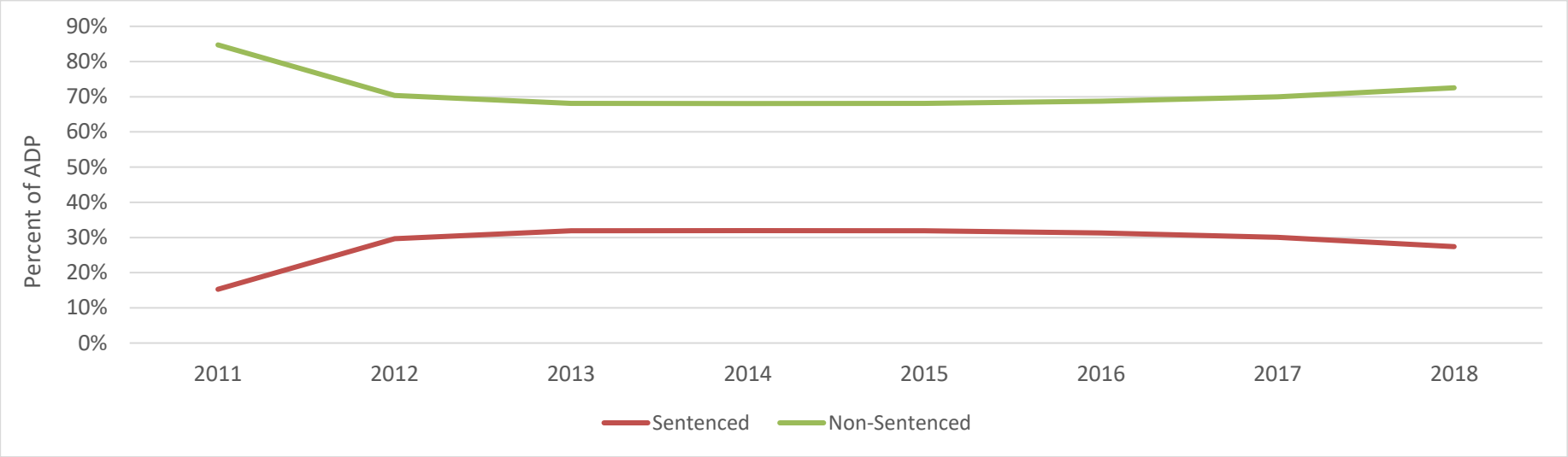
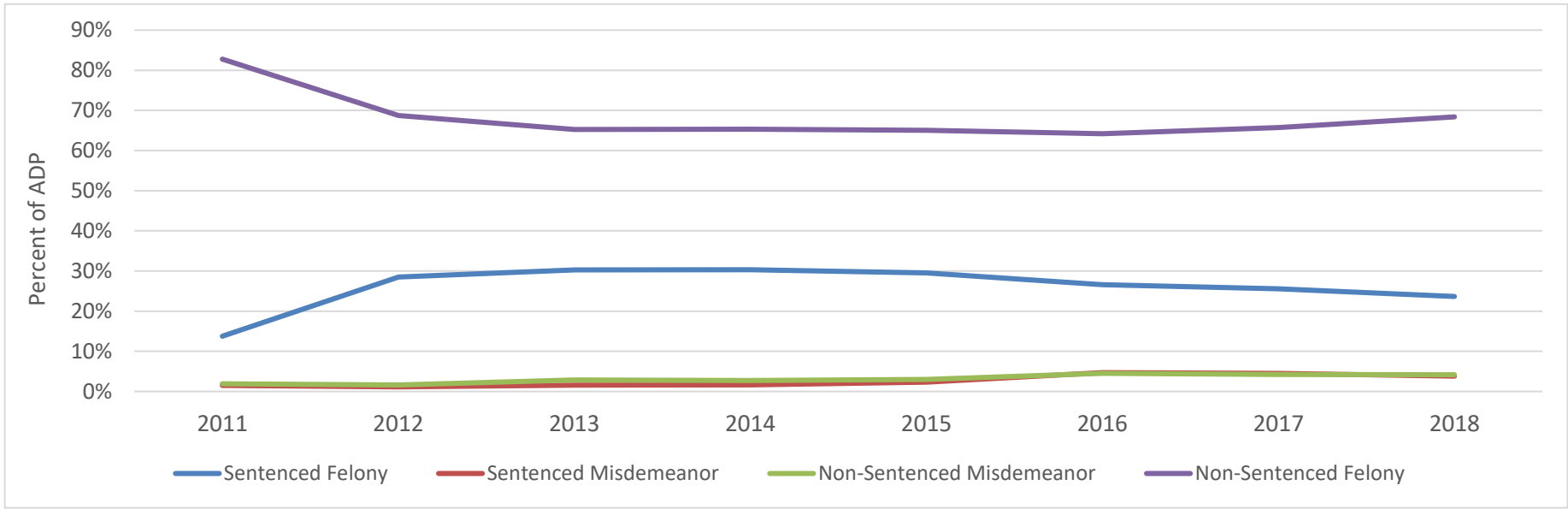


Figure 31. Fresno County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 32. Glenn County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

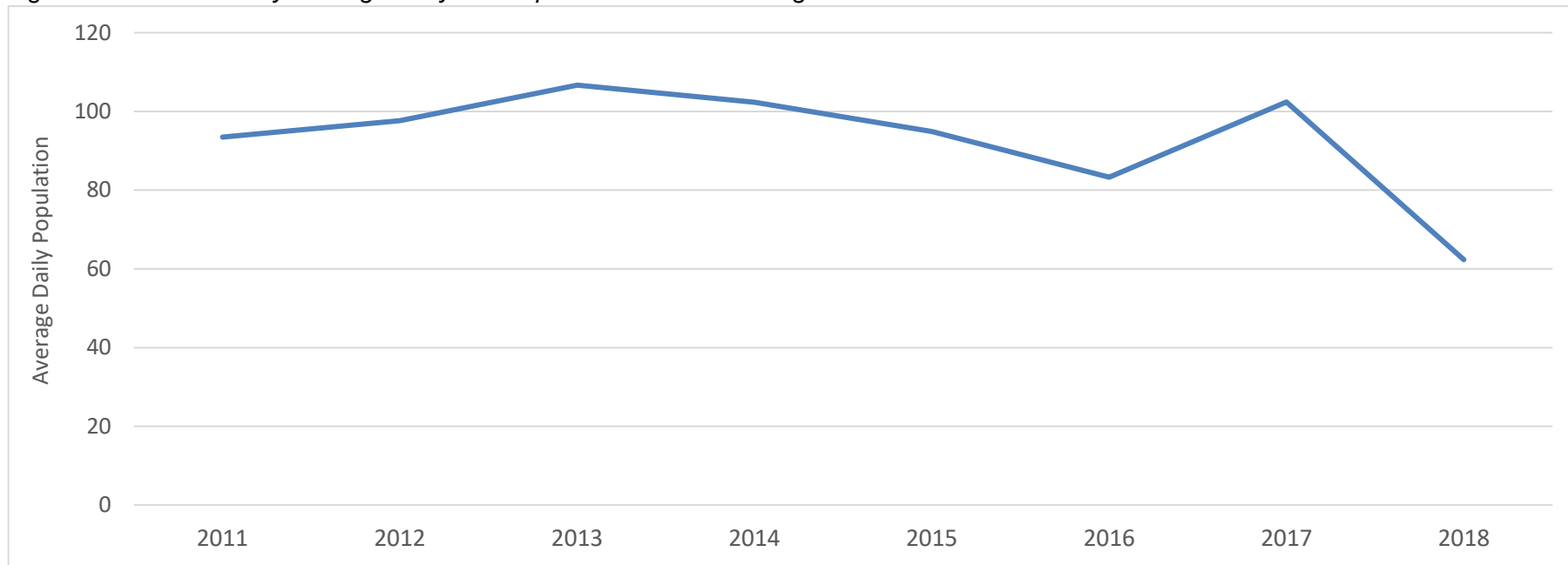




Figure 33. Glenn County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

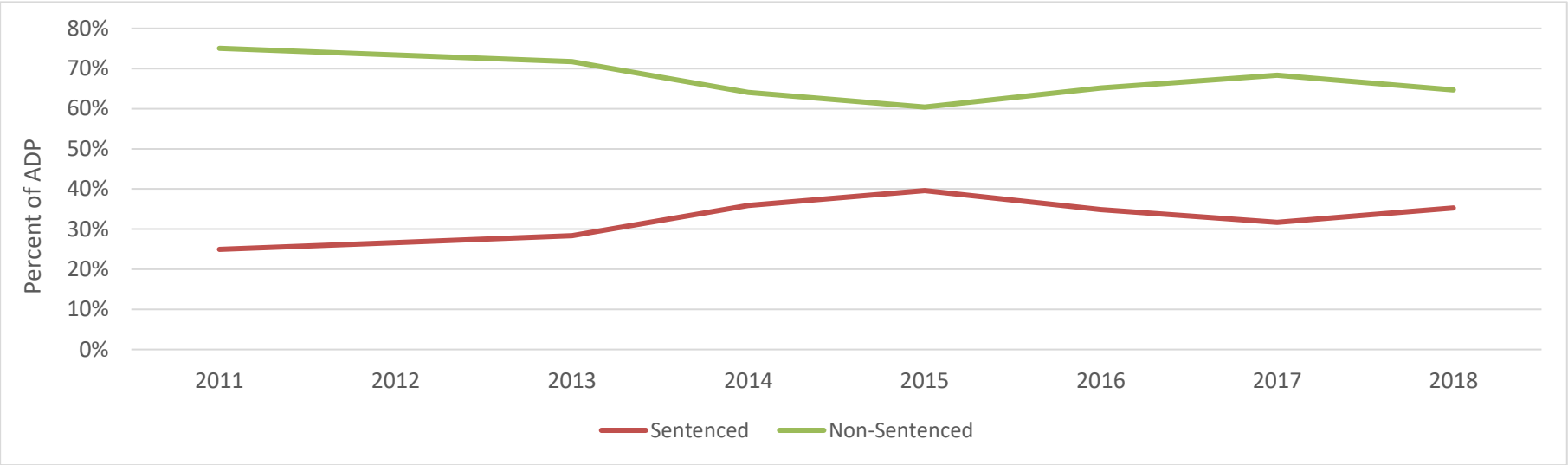
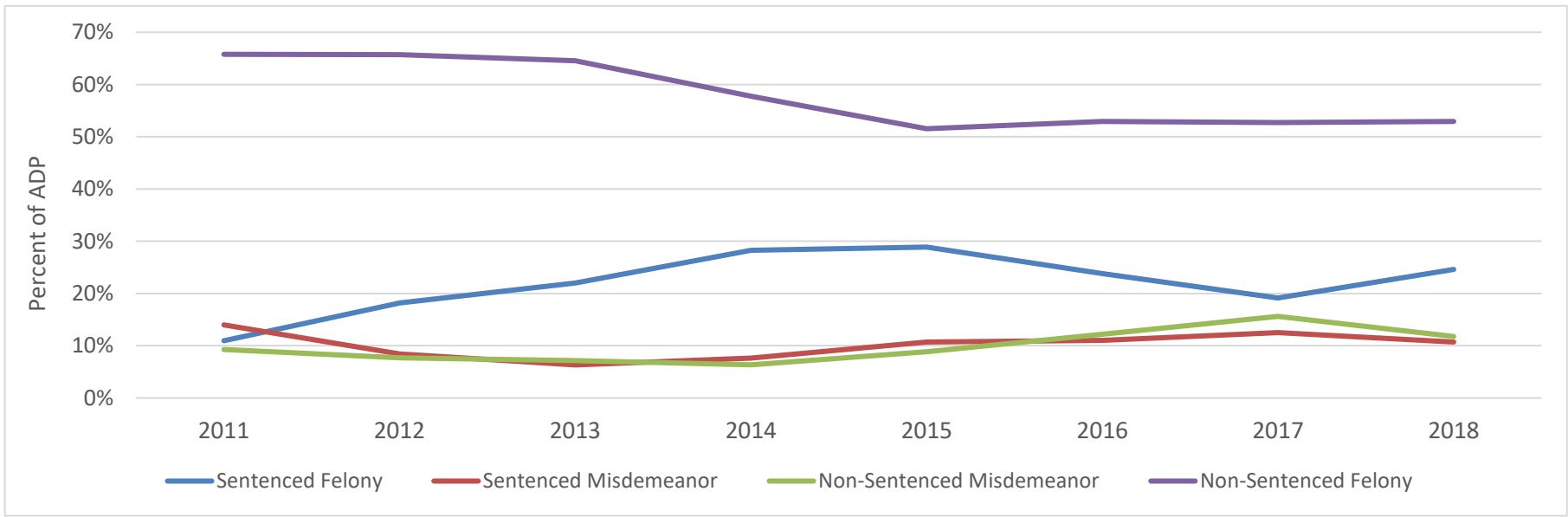


Figure 34. Glenn County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 35. *Humboldt County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

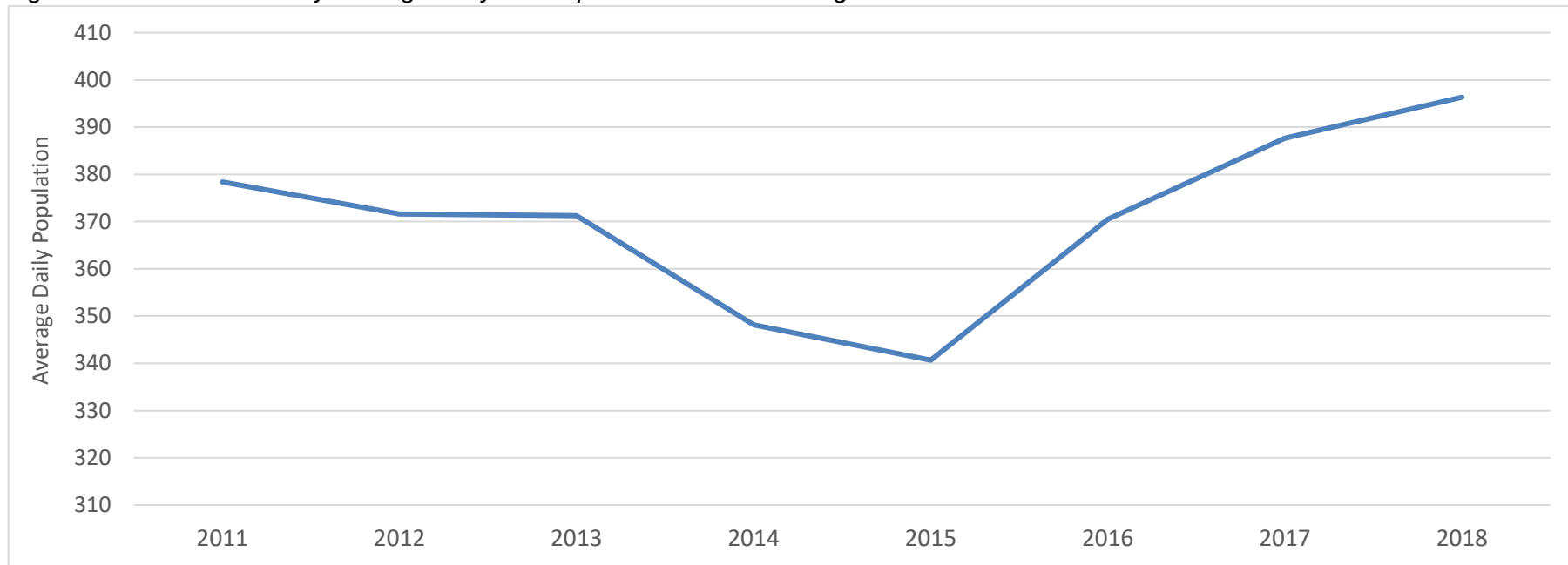


Figure 36. Humboldt County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

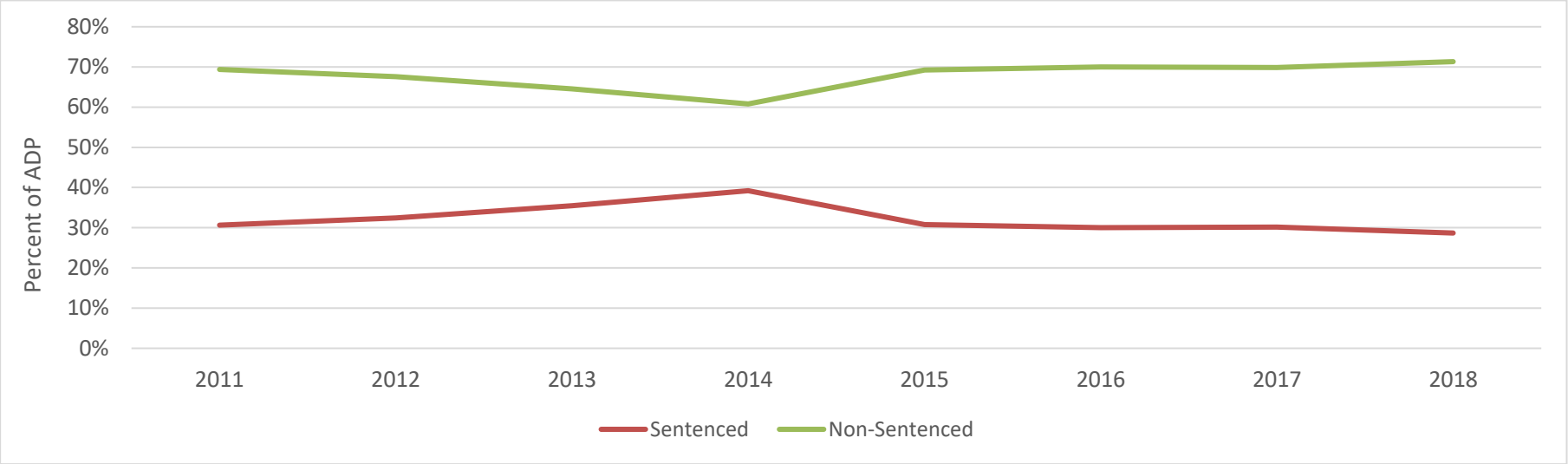
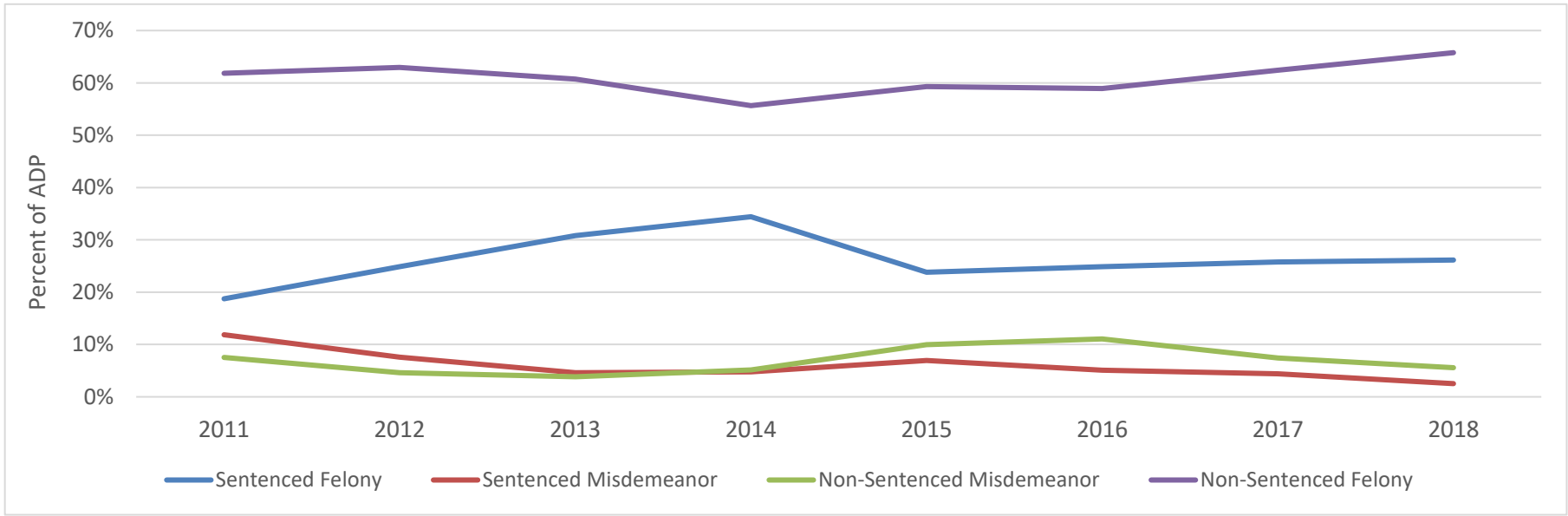


Figure 37. Humboldt County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 38. *Imperial County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

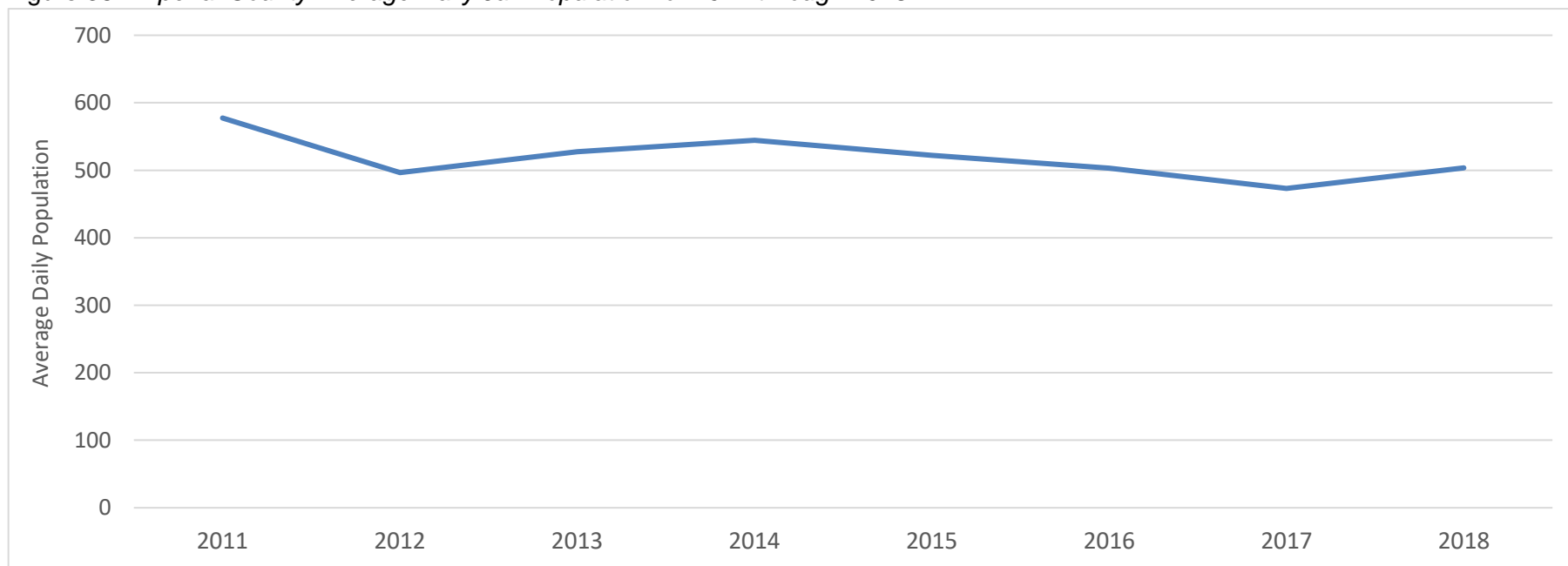


Figure 39. Imperial County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

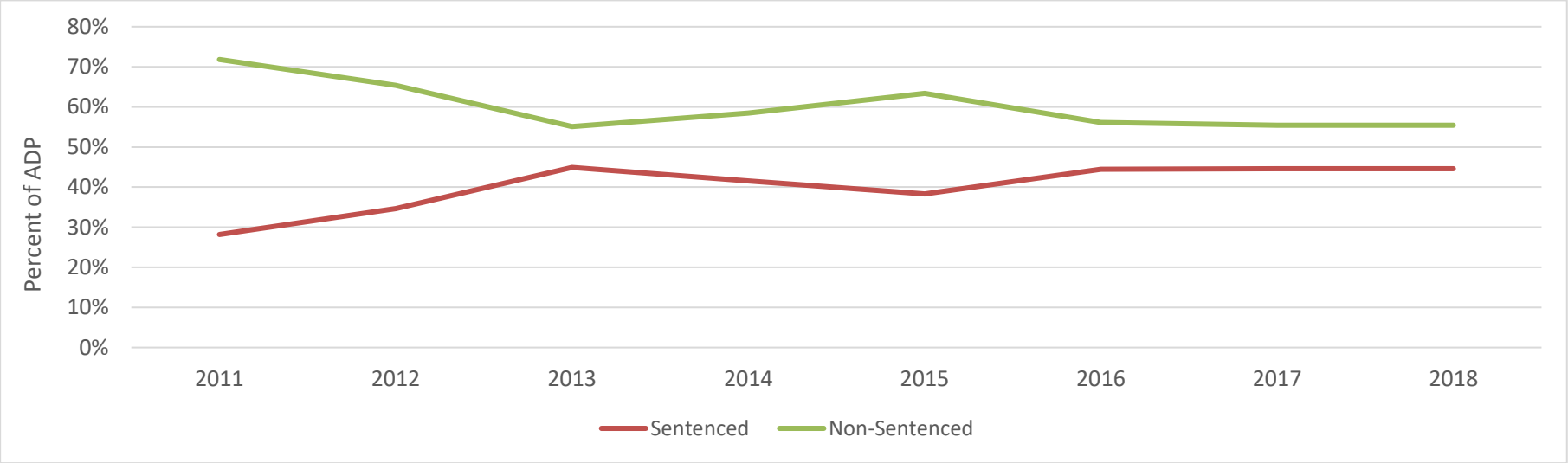
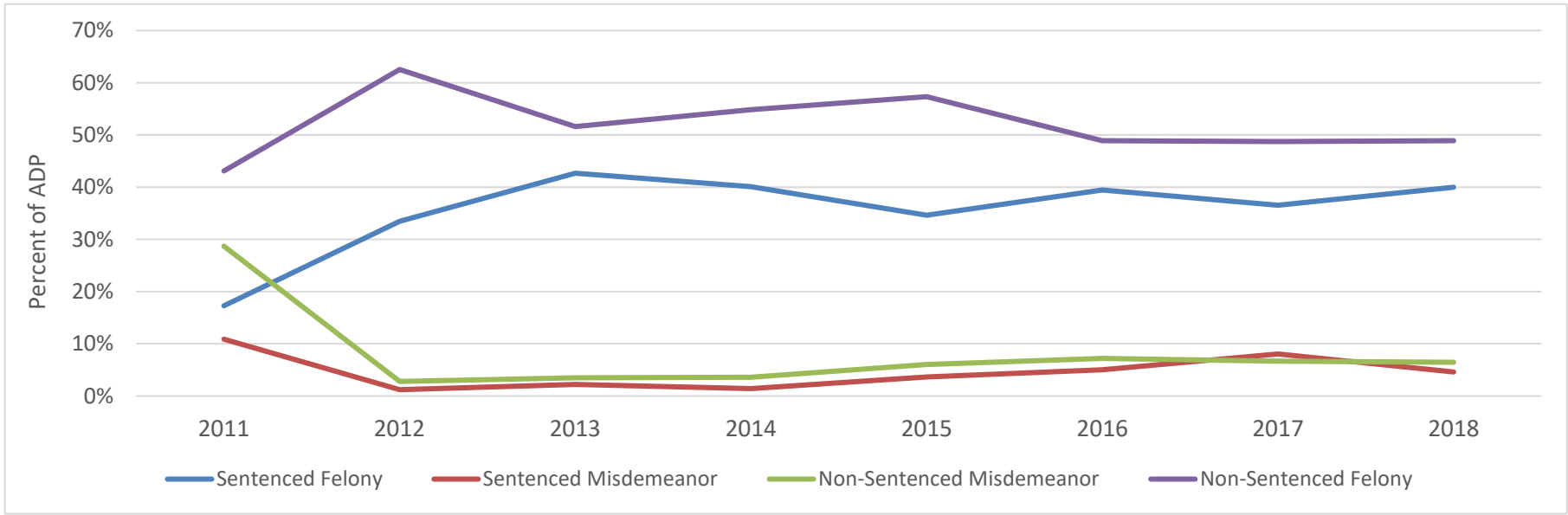


Figure 40. Imperial County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 41. *Inyo County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

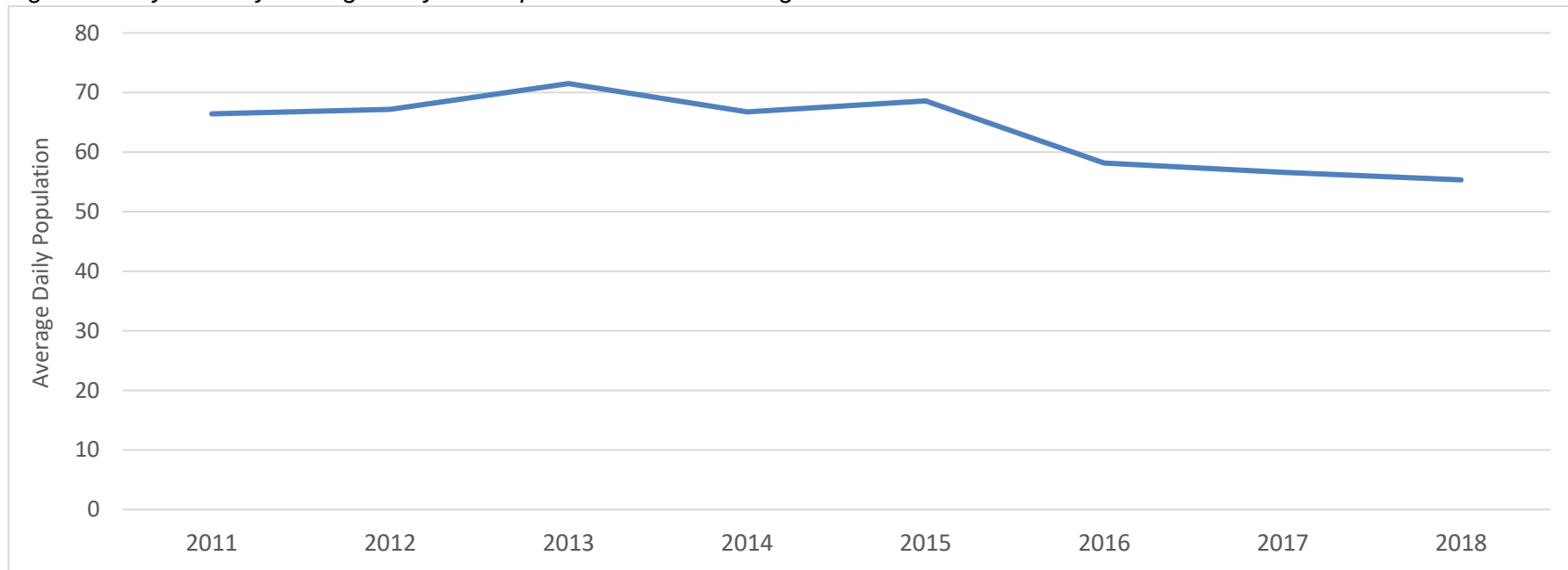


Figure 42. Inyo County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

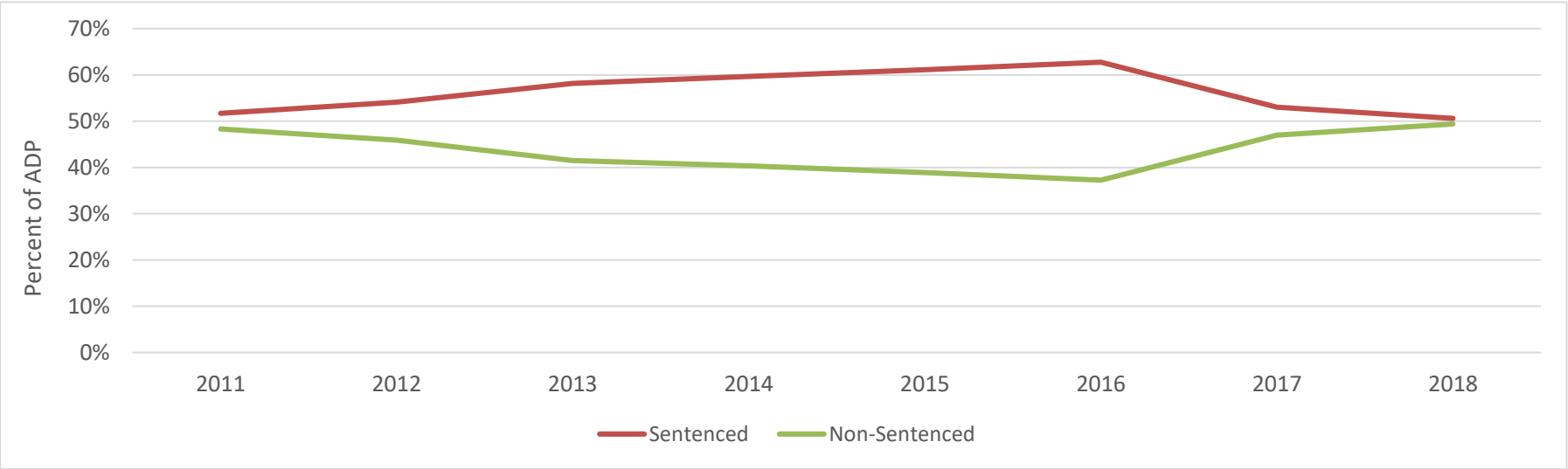
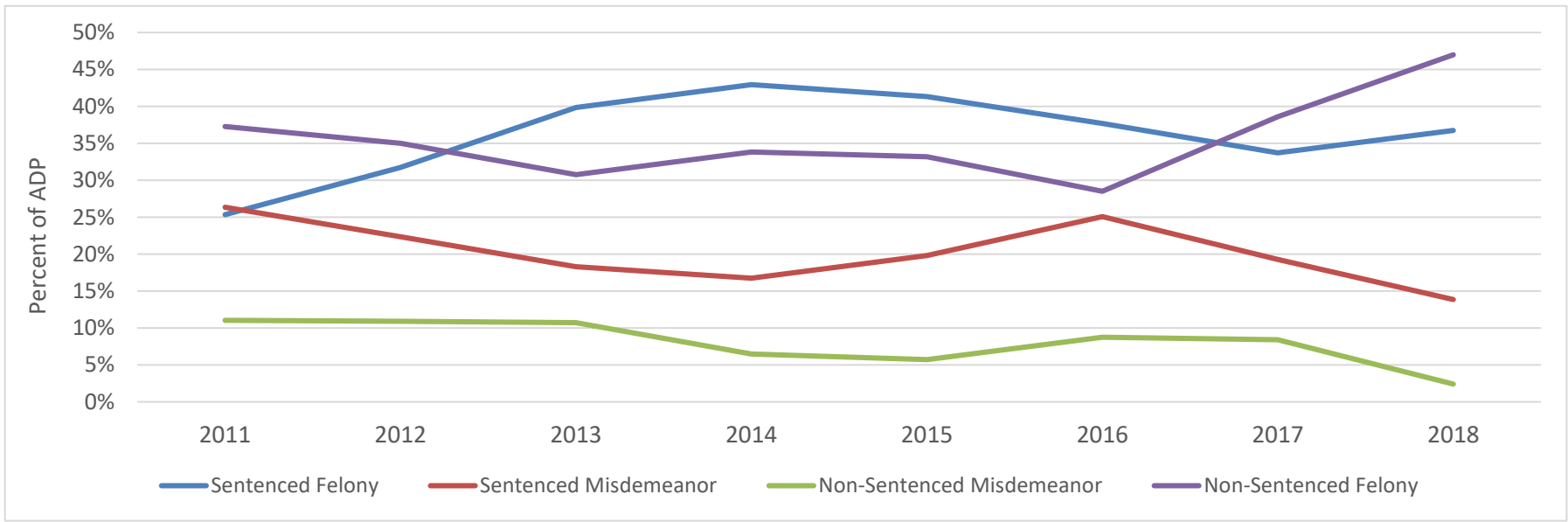


Figure 43. Inyo County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 44. Kern County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018 <sup>1</sup>

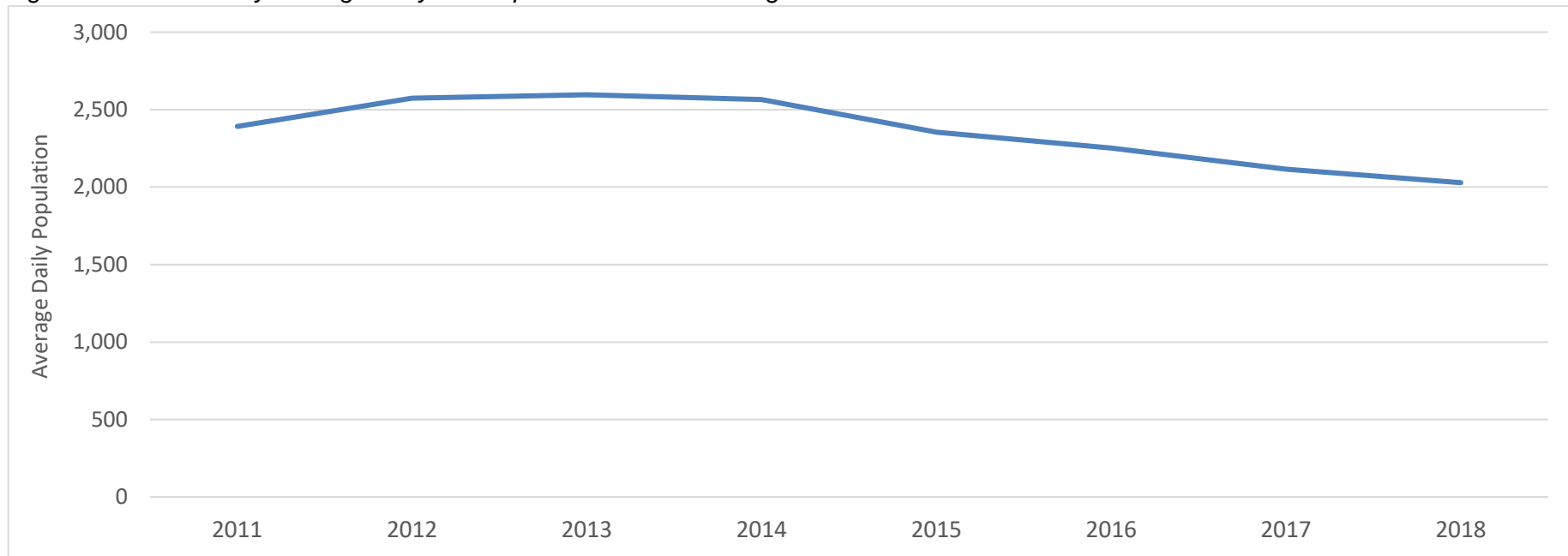




Figure 45. Kern County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

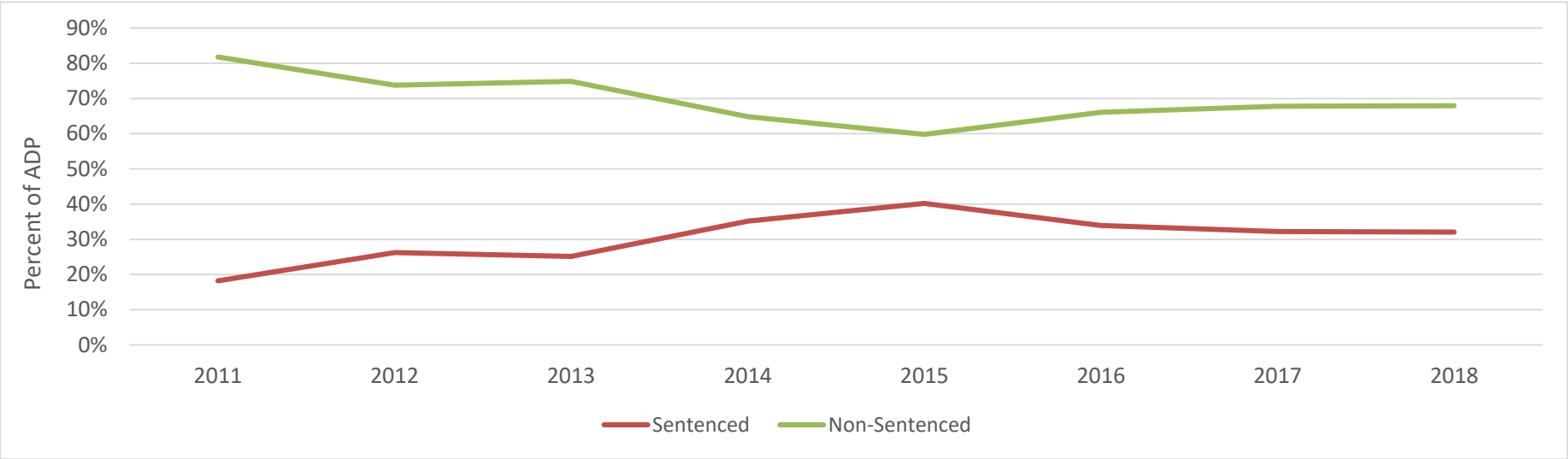
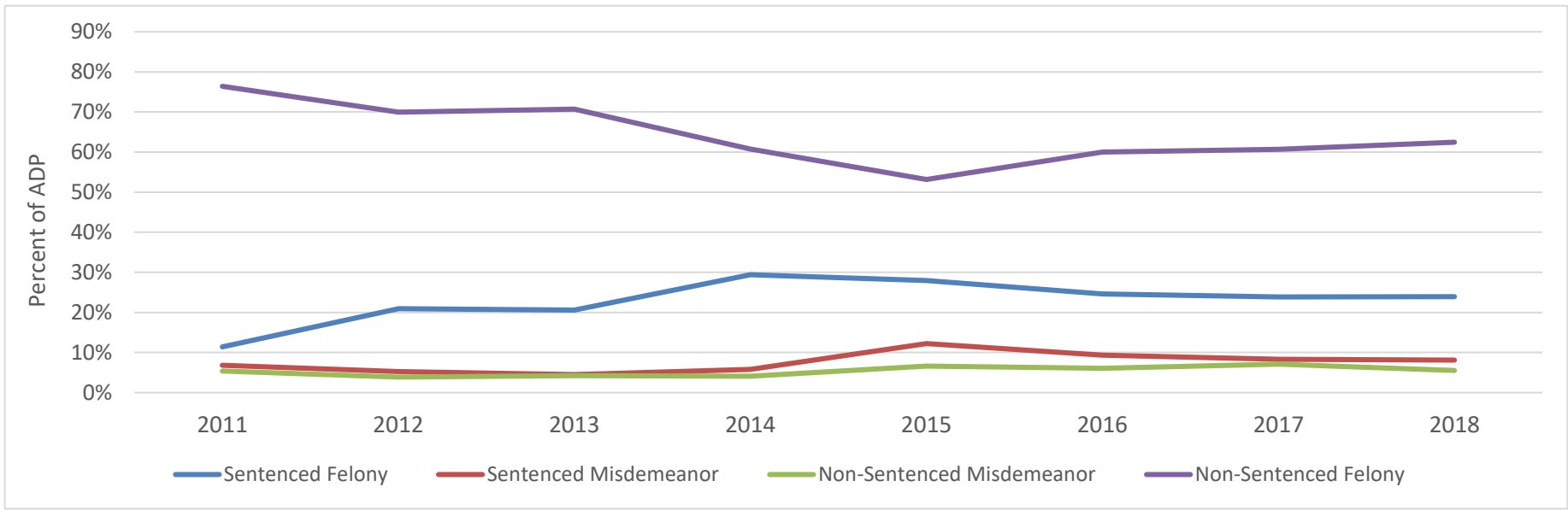


Figure 46. Kern County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 47. *Kings County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

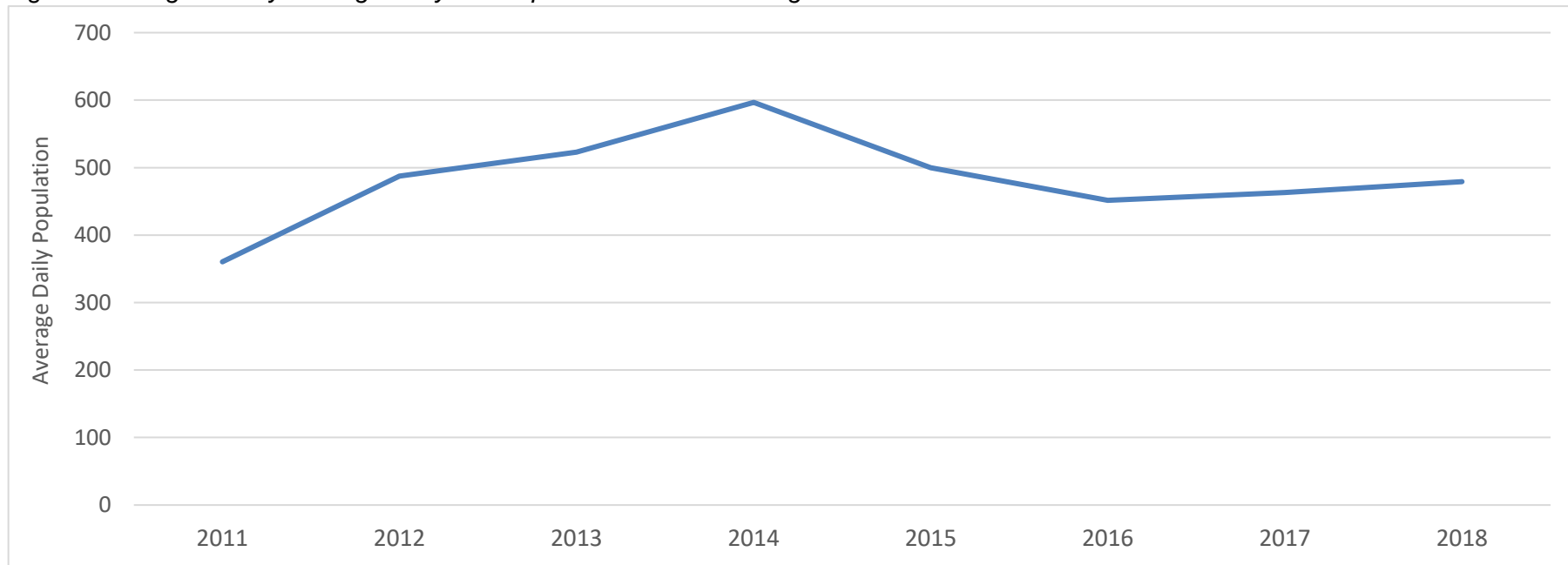


Figure 48. Kings County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

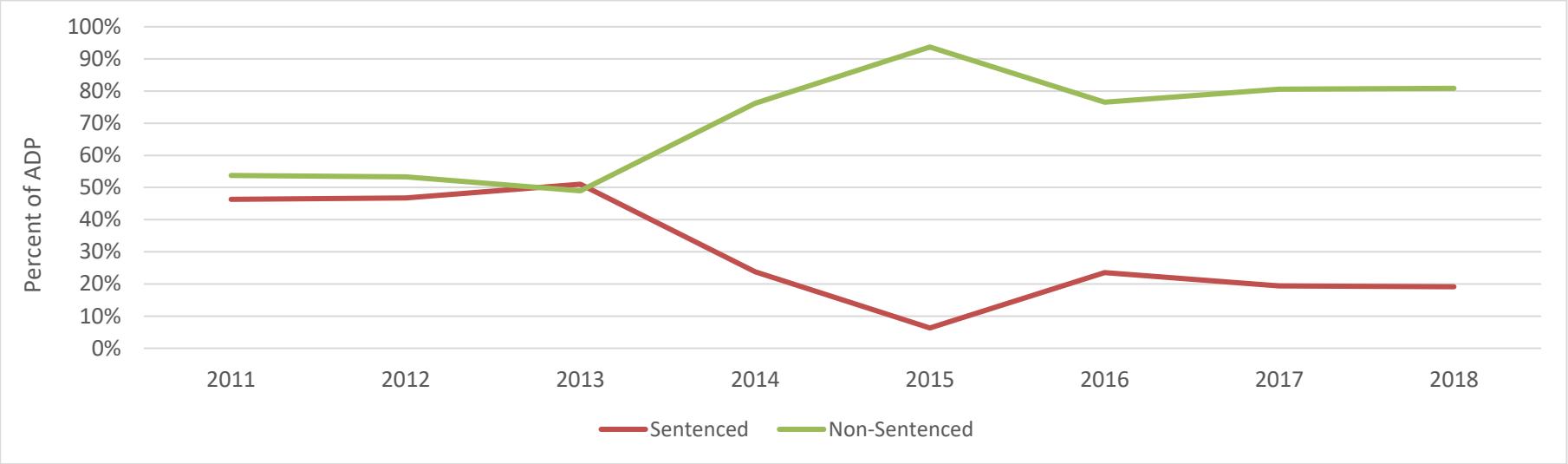
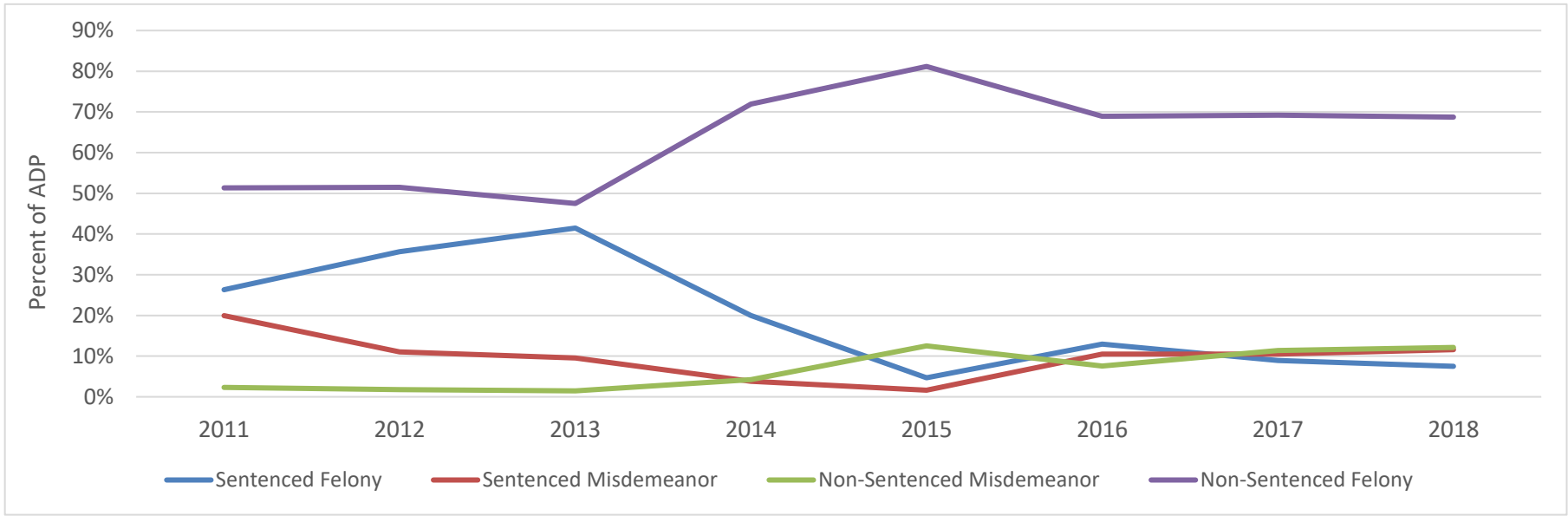


Figure 49. Kings County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 50. Lake County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

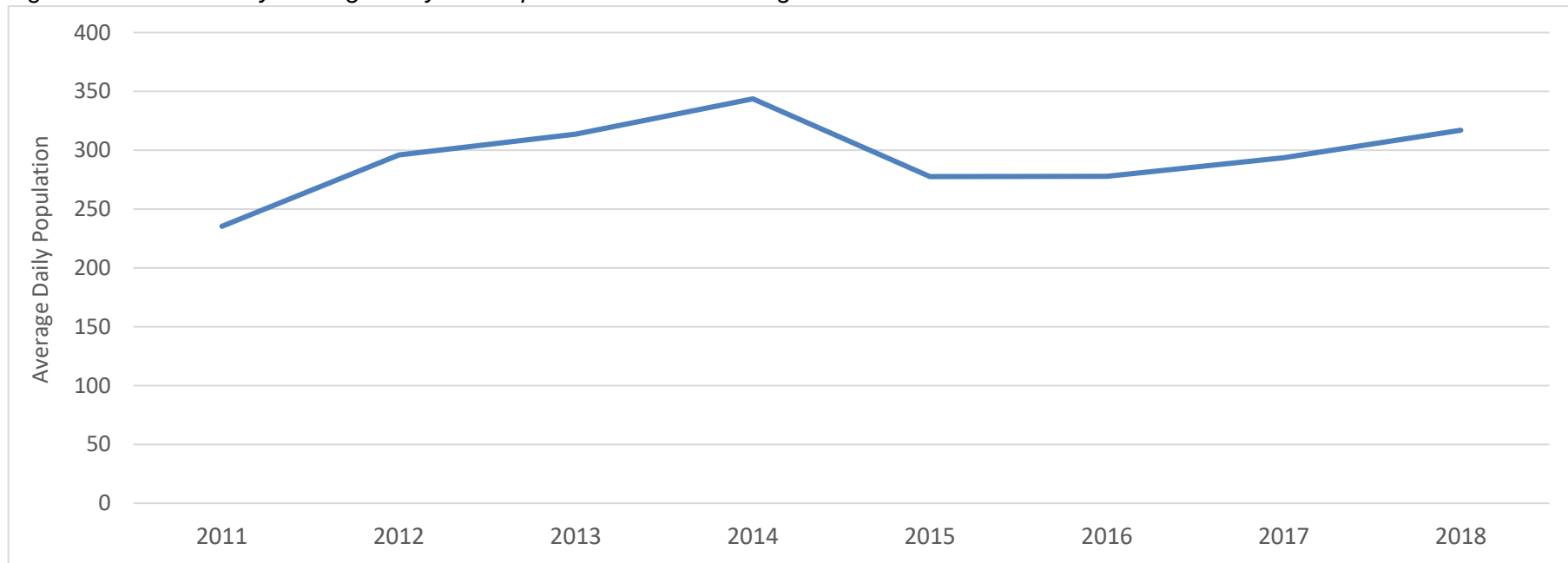


Figure 51. Lake County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

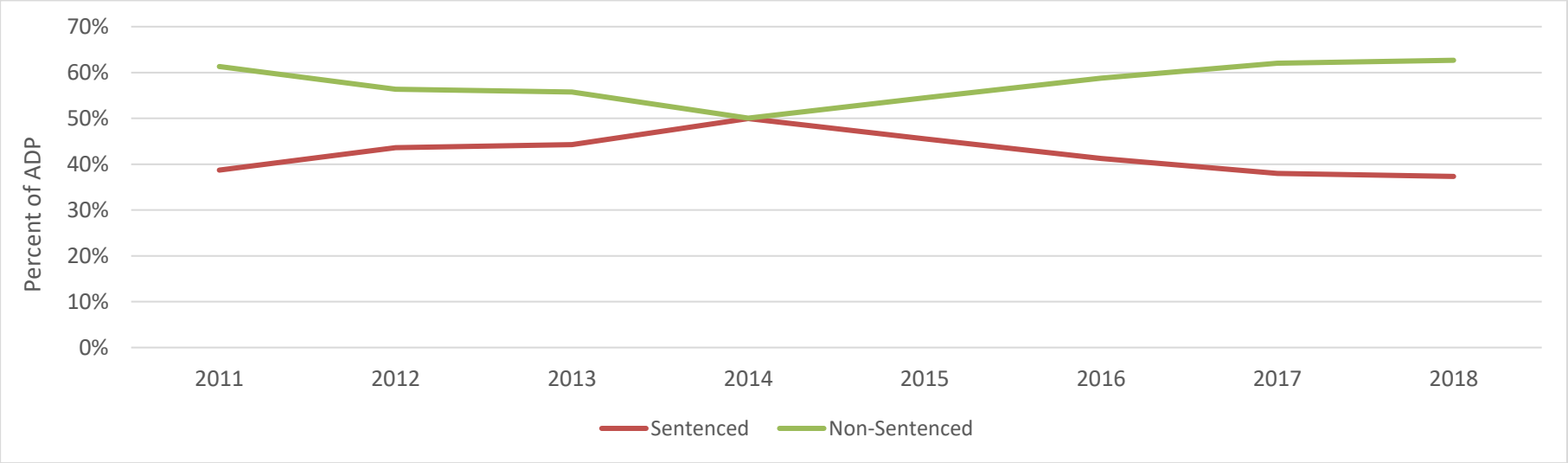
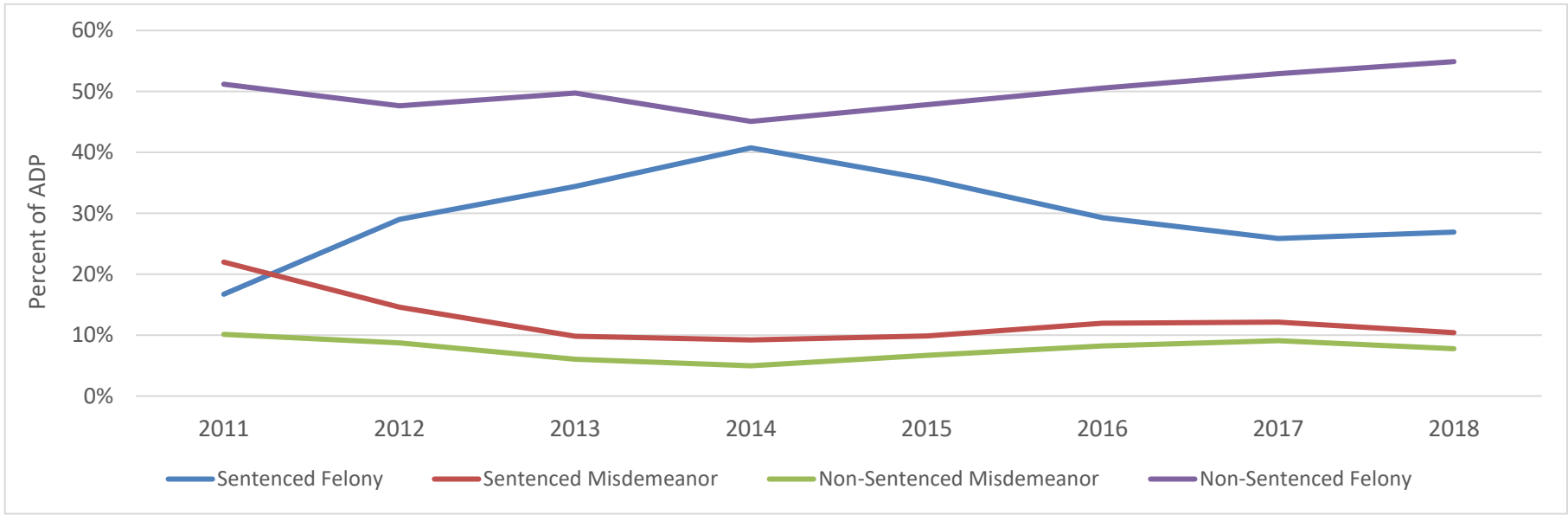


Figure 52. Lake County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 53. *Lassen County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

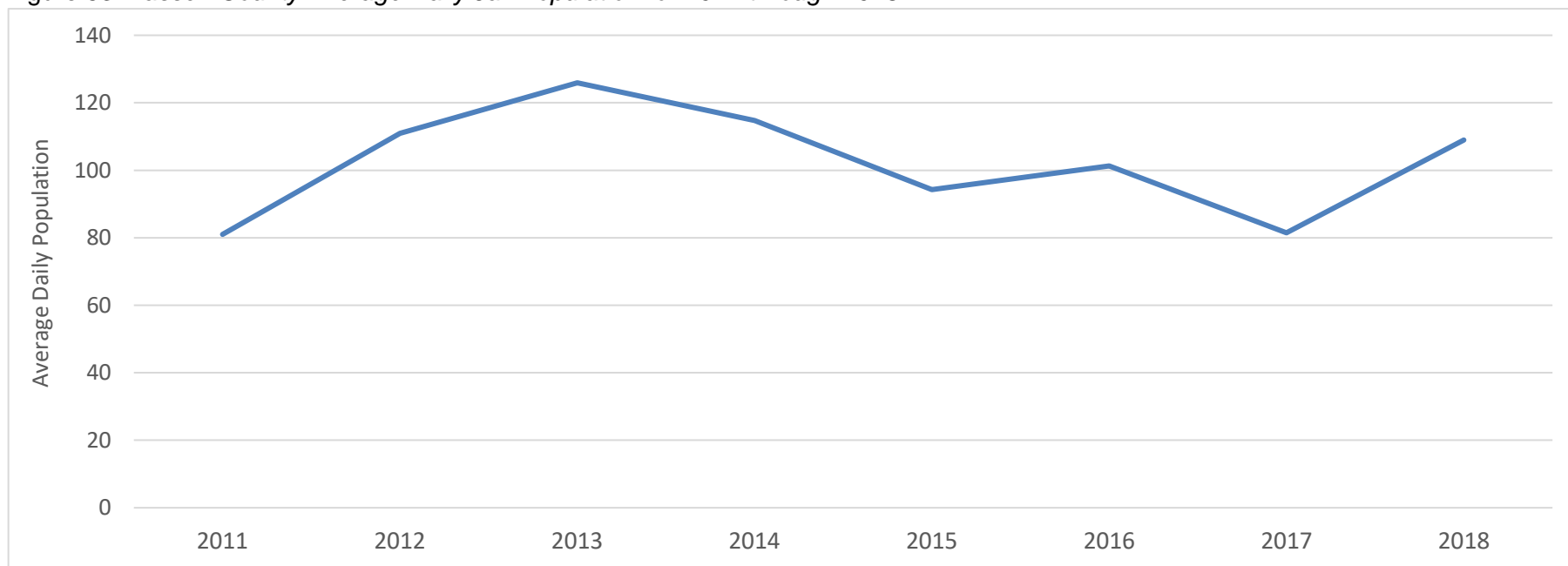


Figure 54. Lassen County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

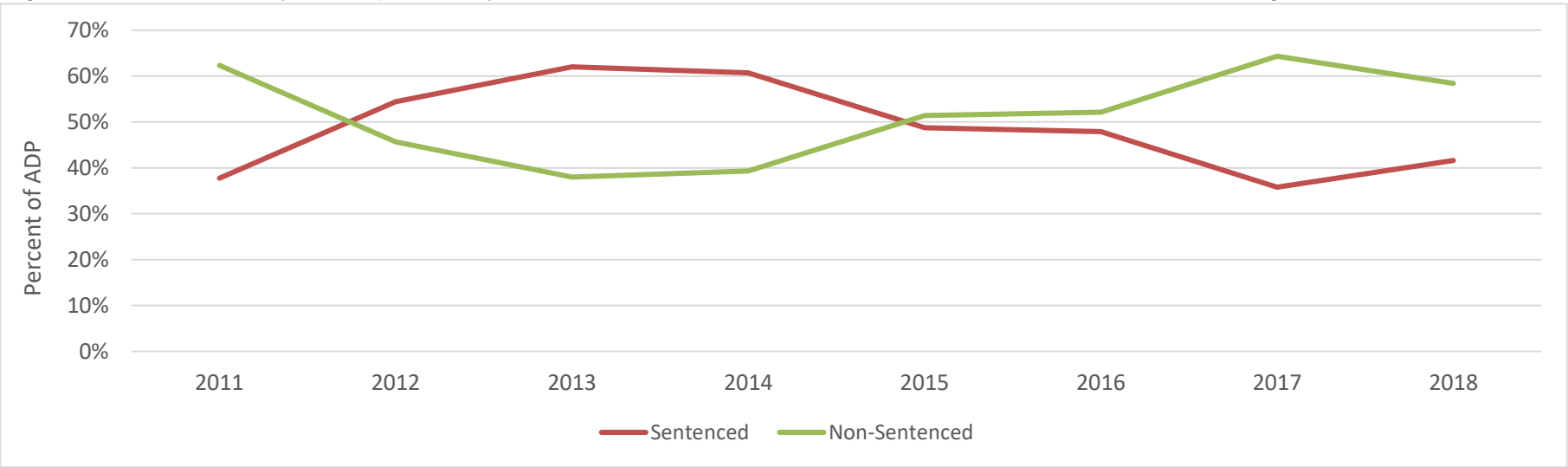
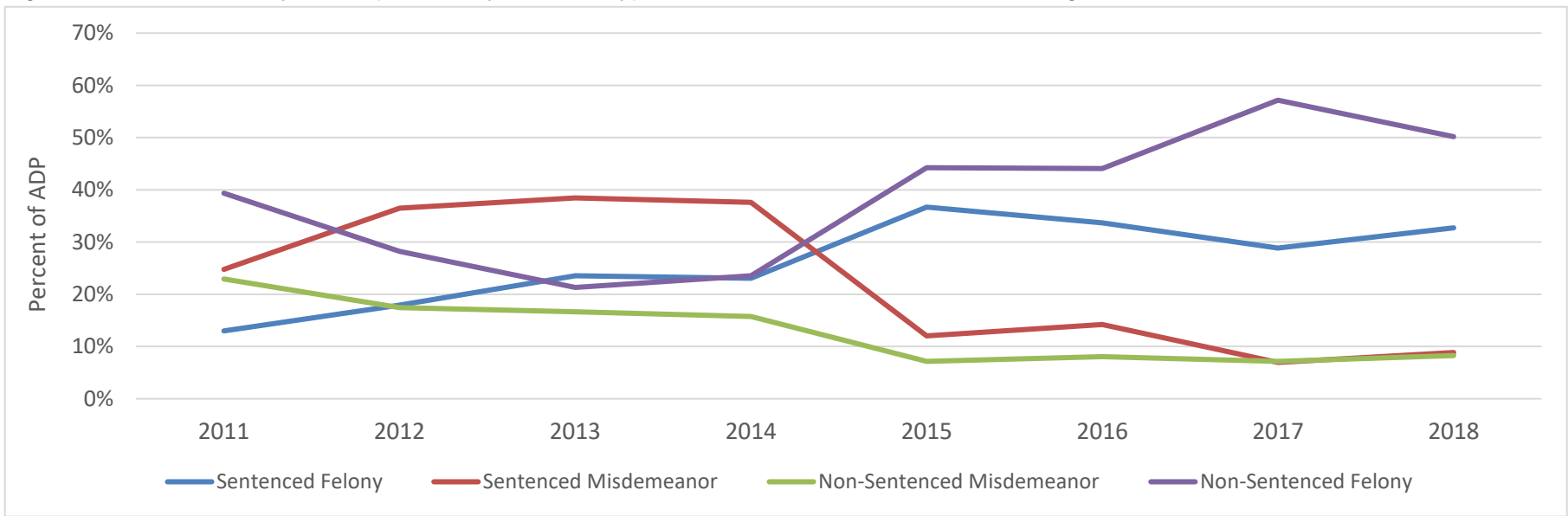


Figure 55. Lassen County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 56. *Los Angeles County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

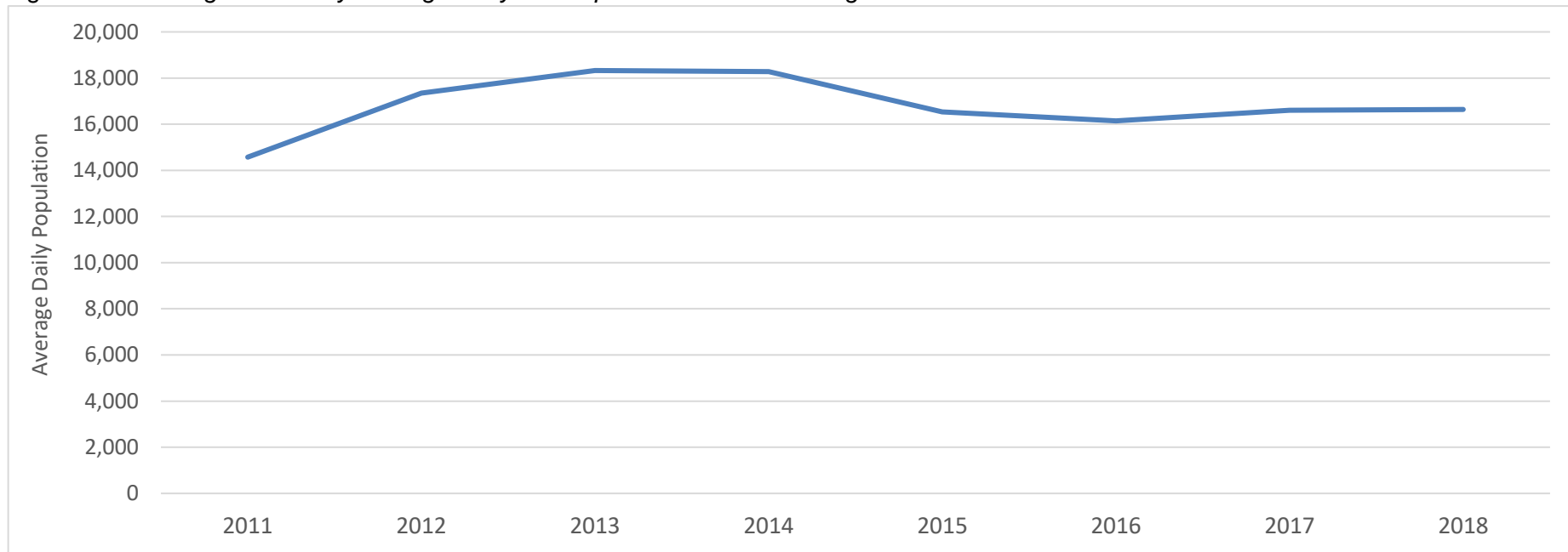




Figure 57. Los Angeles County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

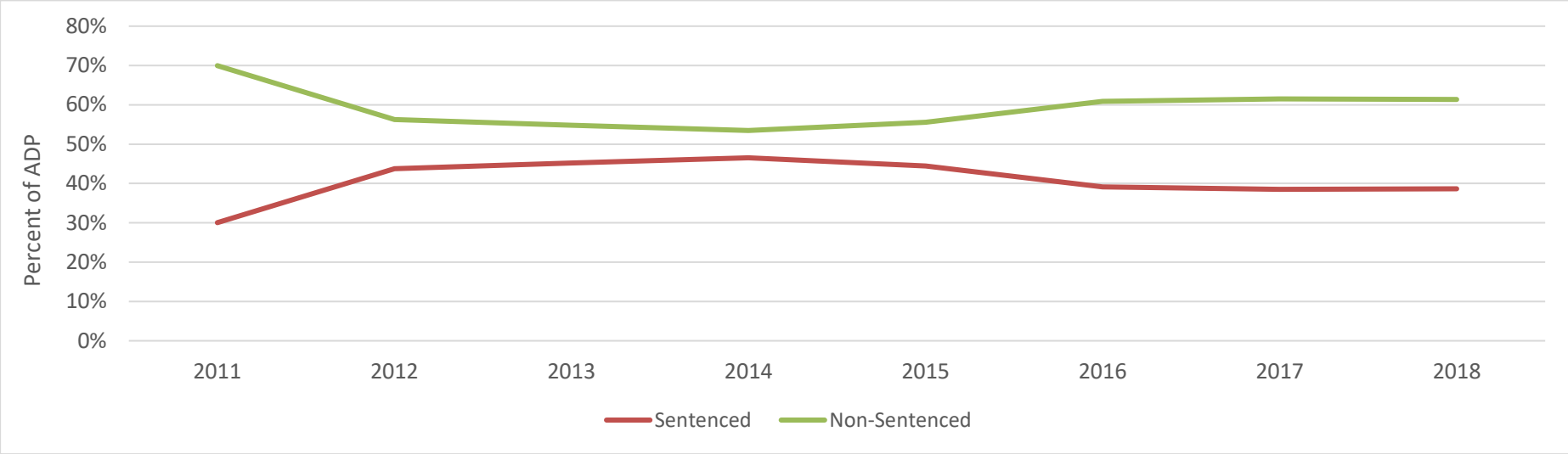
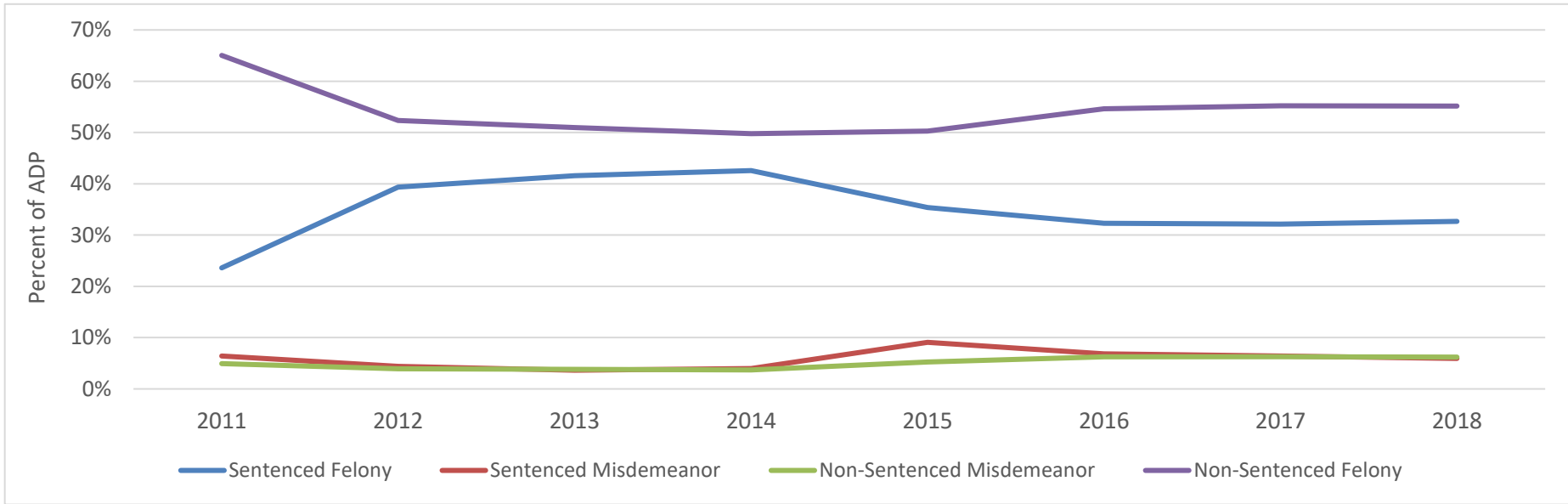


Figure 58. Los Angeles County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 59. *Madera County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

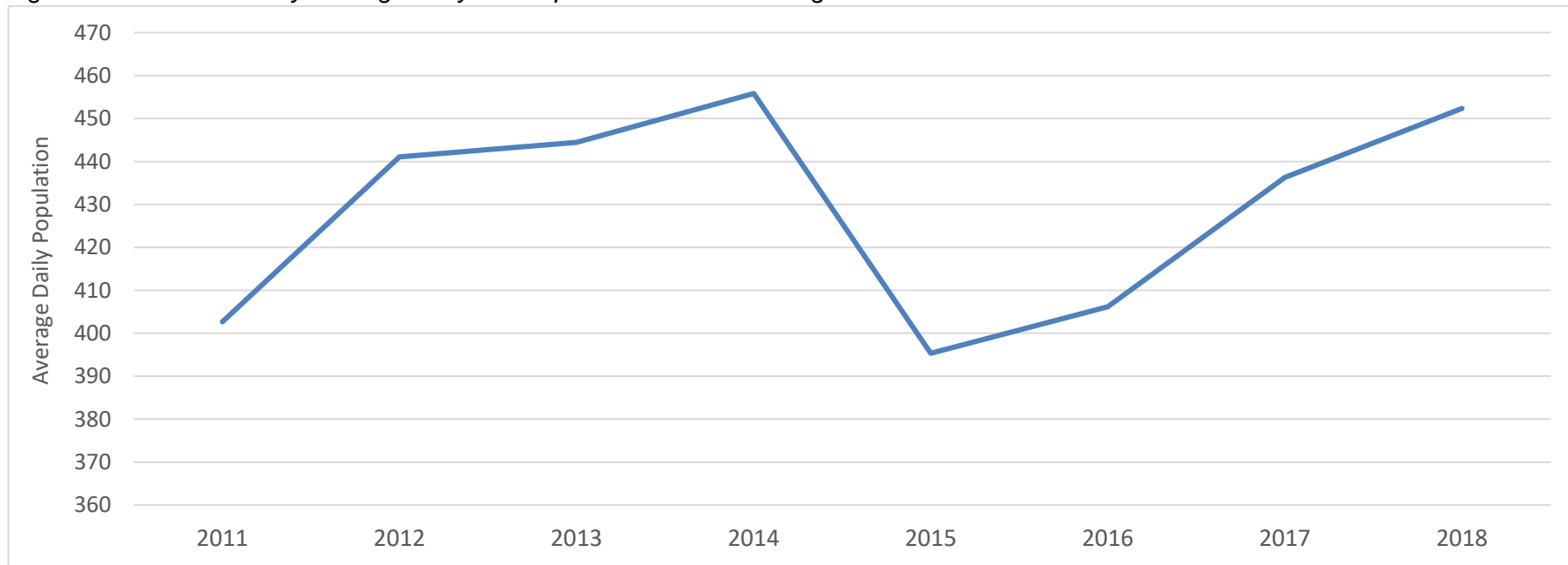


Figure 60. Madera County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

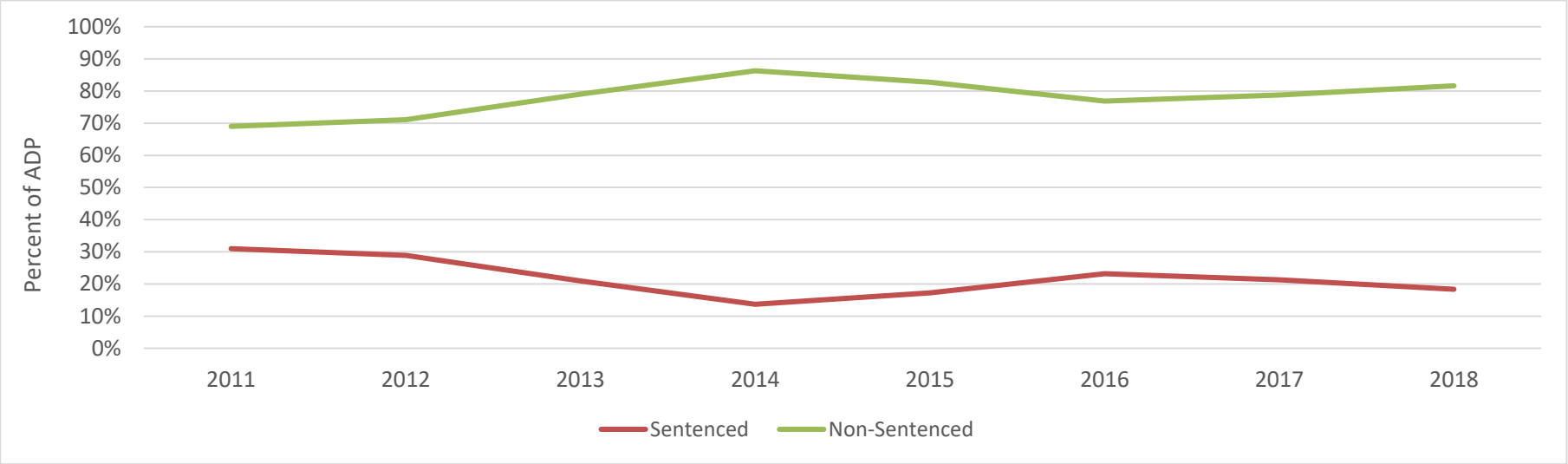
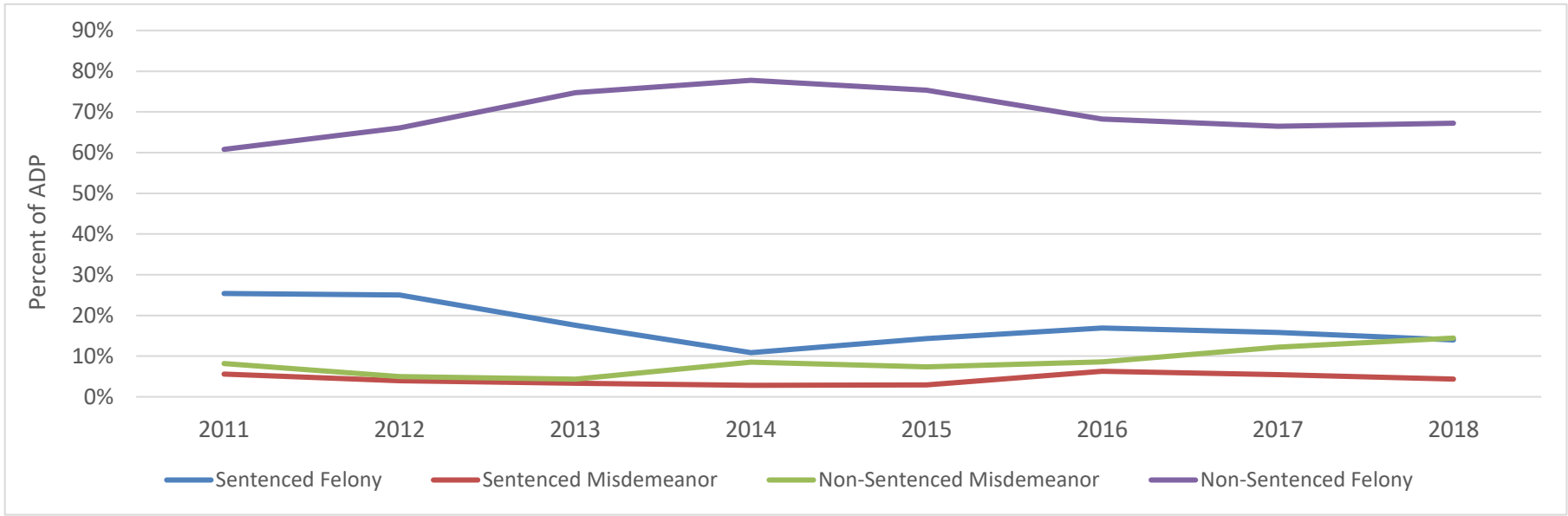


Figure 61. Madera County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 62. Marin County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

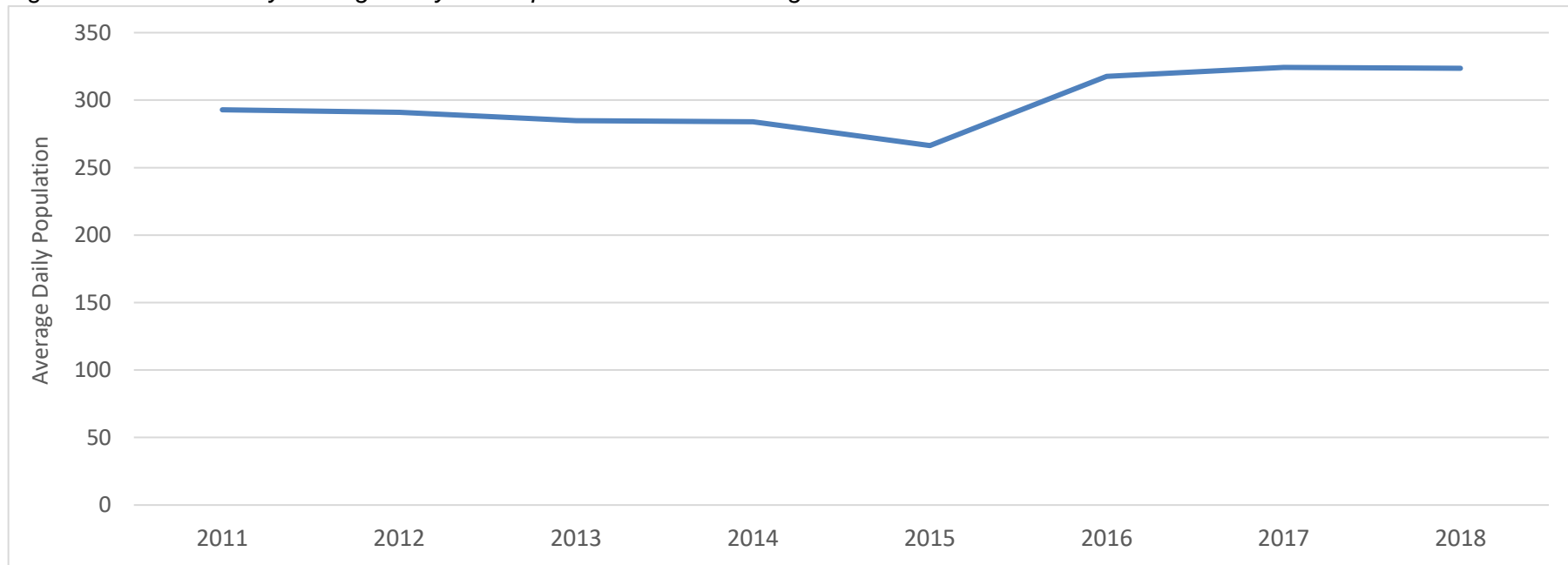


Figure 63. Marin County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

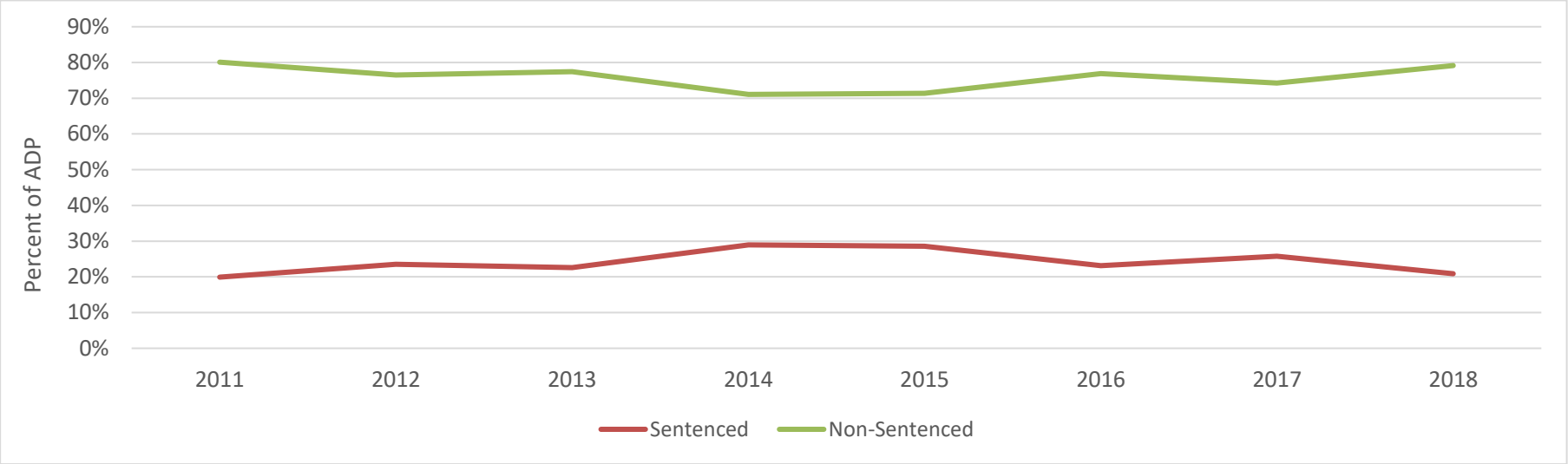
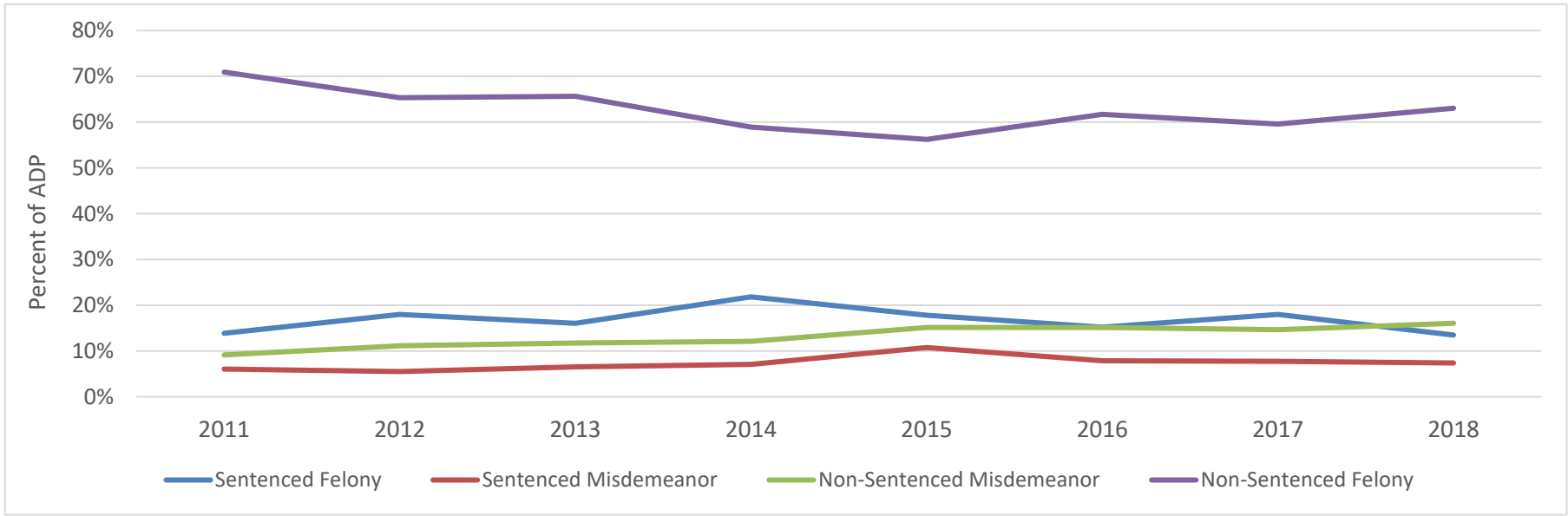


Figure 64. Marin County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 65. *Mariposa County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

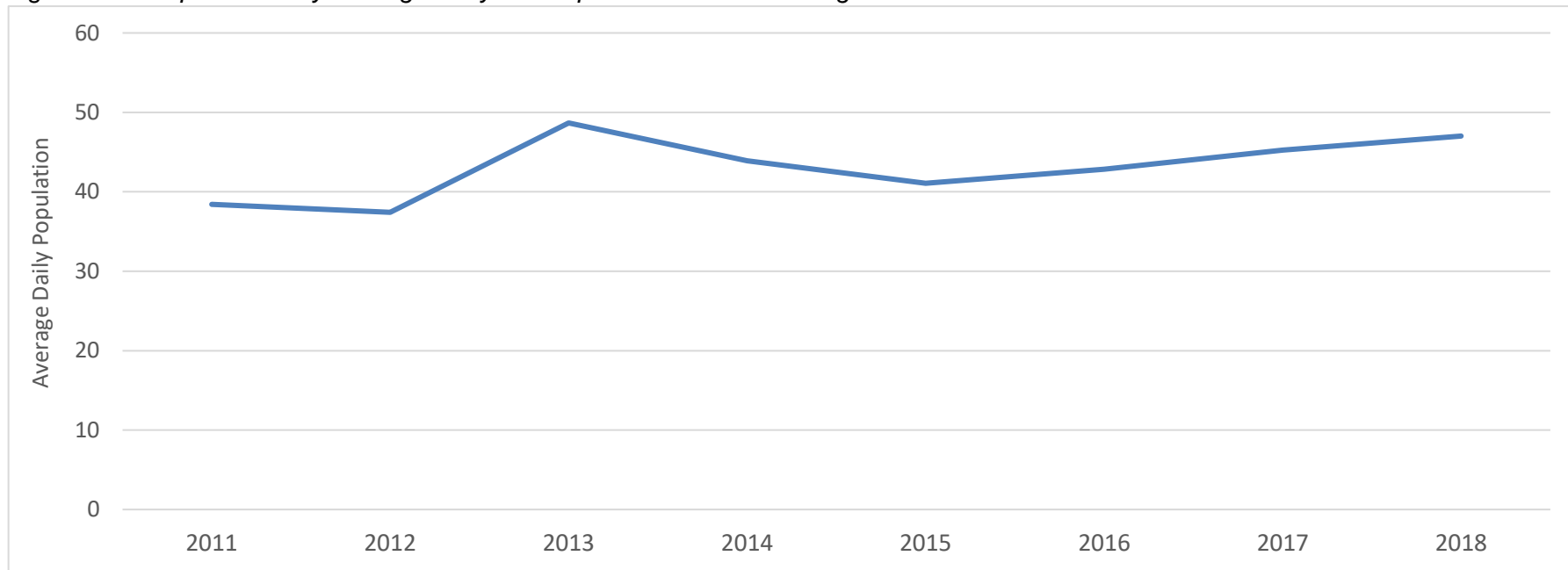


Figure 66. Mariposa County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

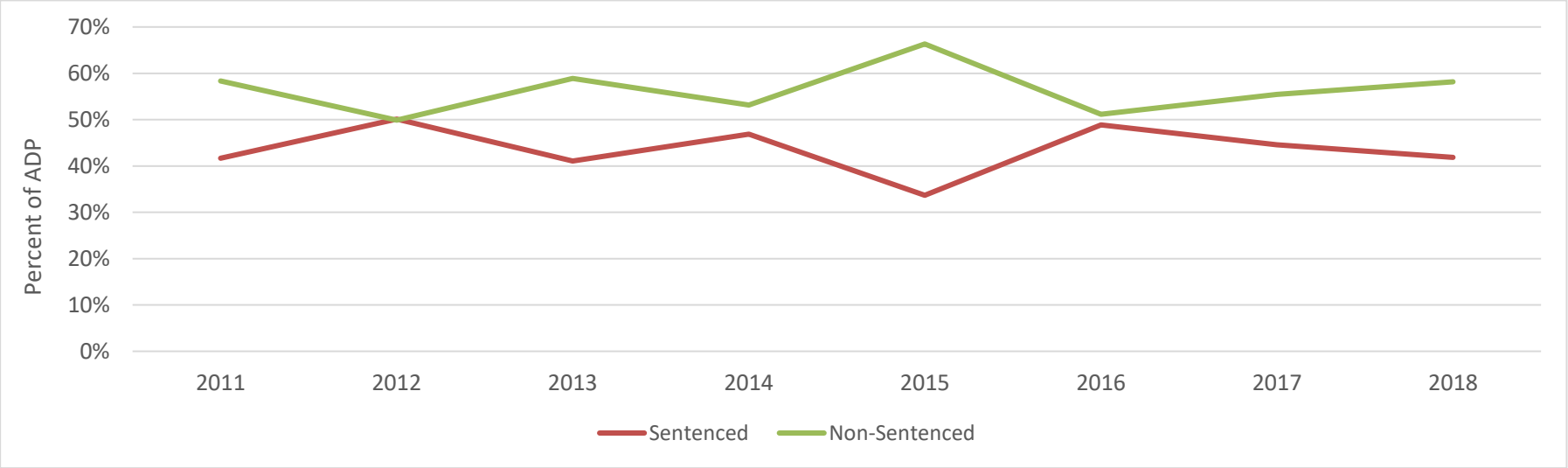
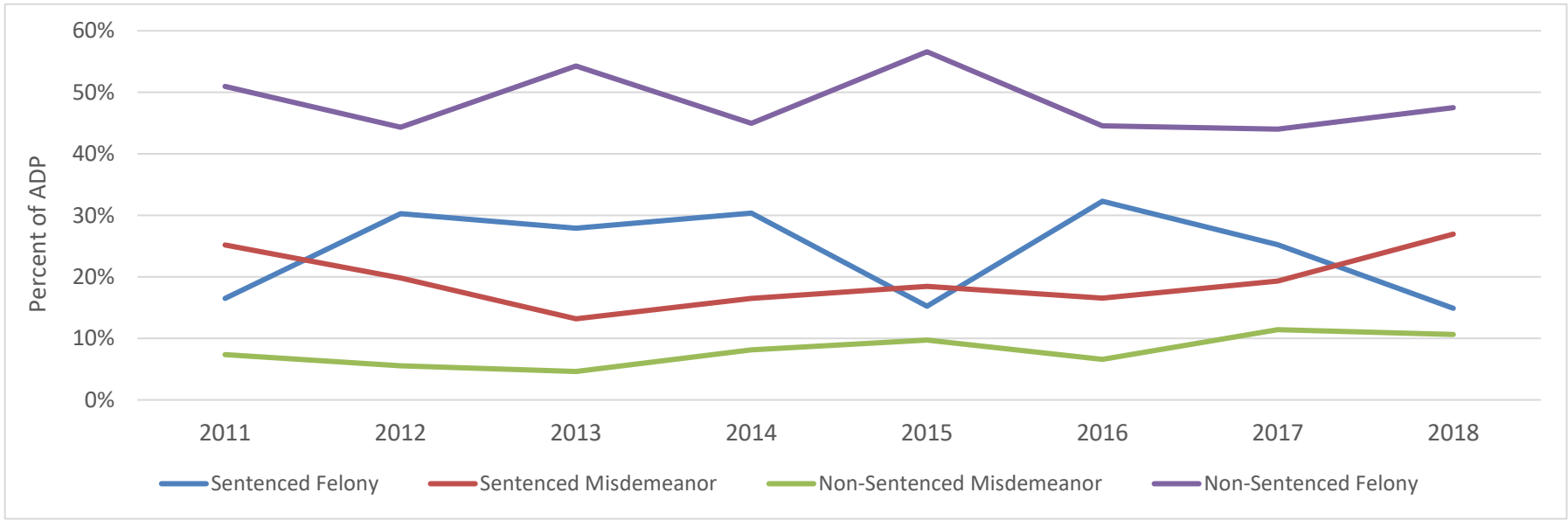


Figure 67. Mariposa County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 68. Mendocino County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

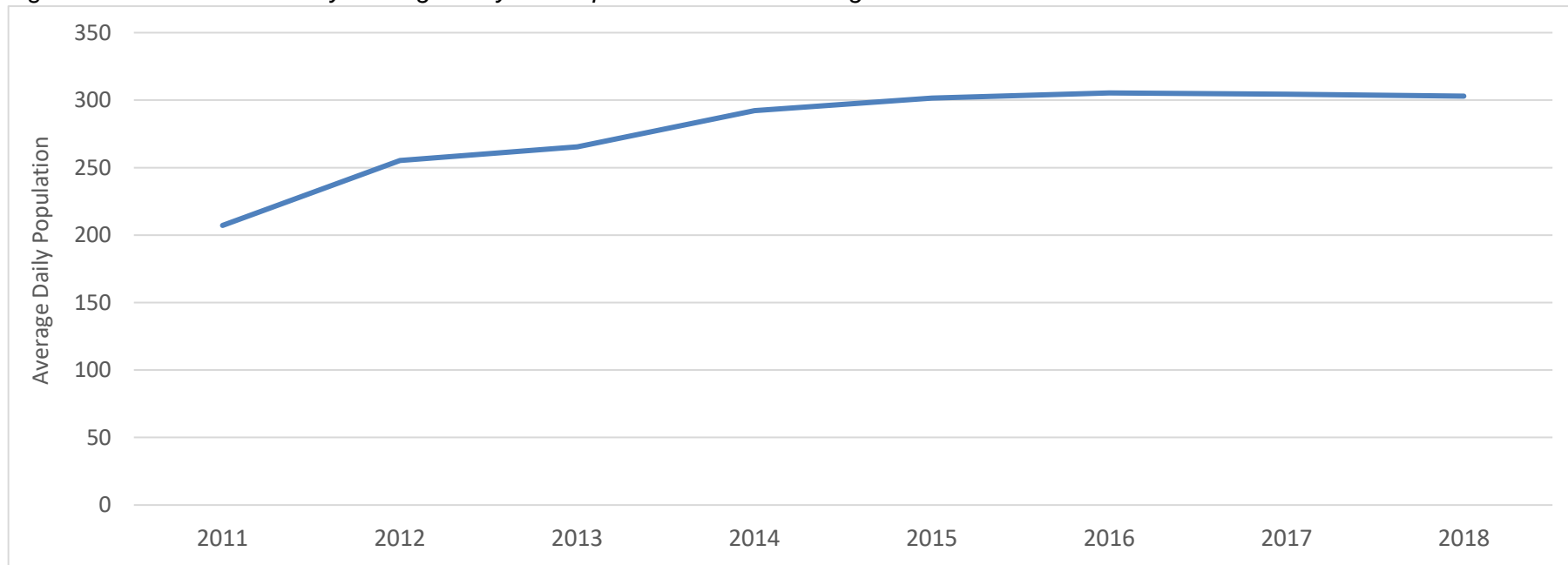




Figure 69. Mendocino County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

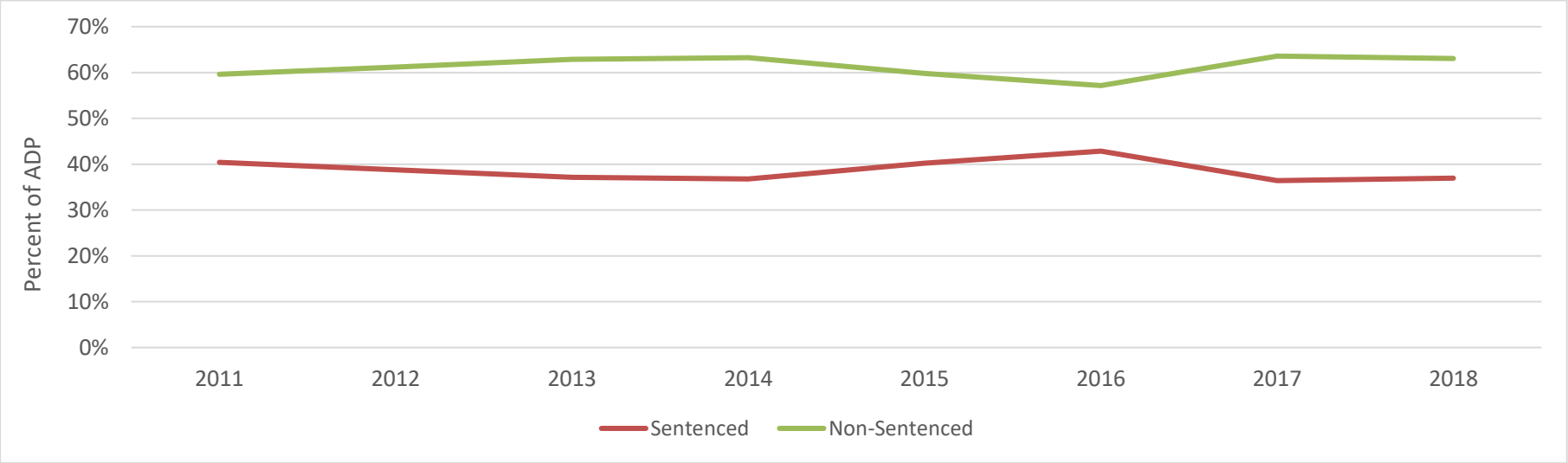
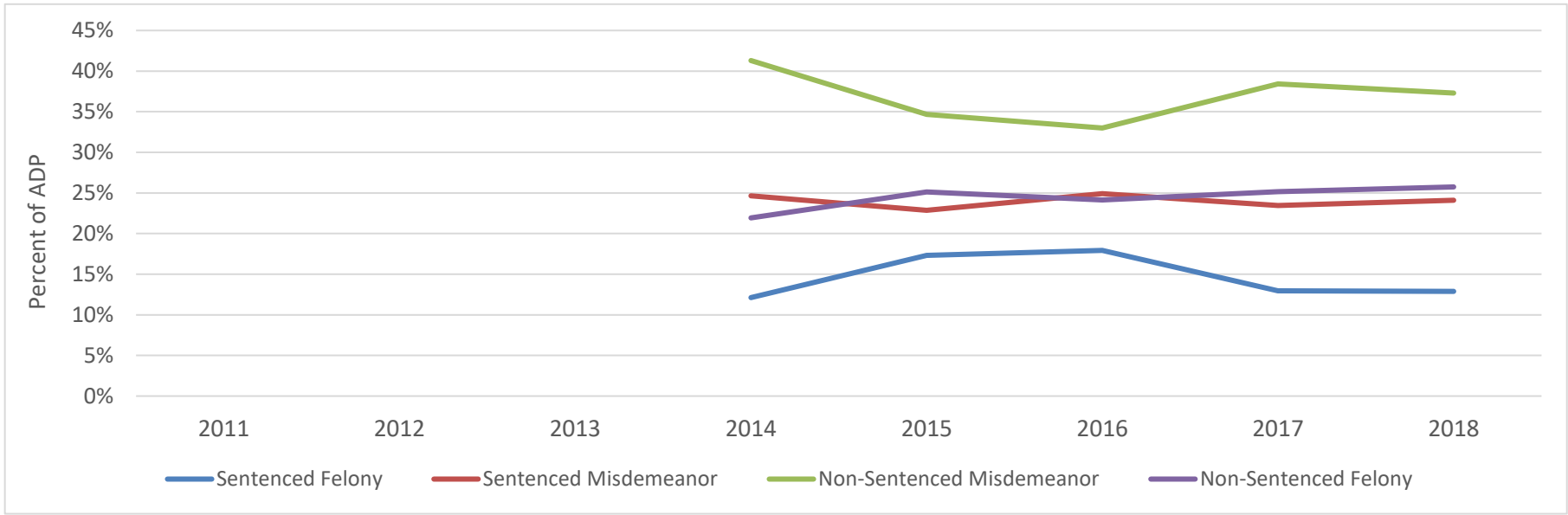


Figure 70. Mendocino County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 71. Merced County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

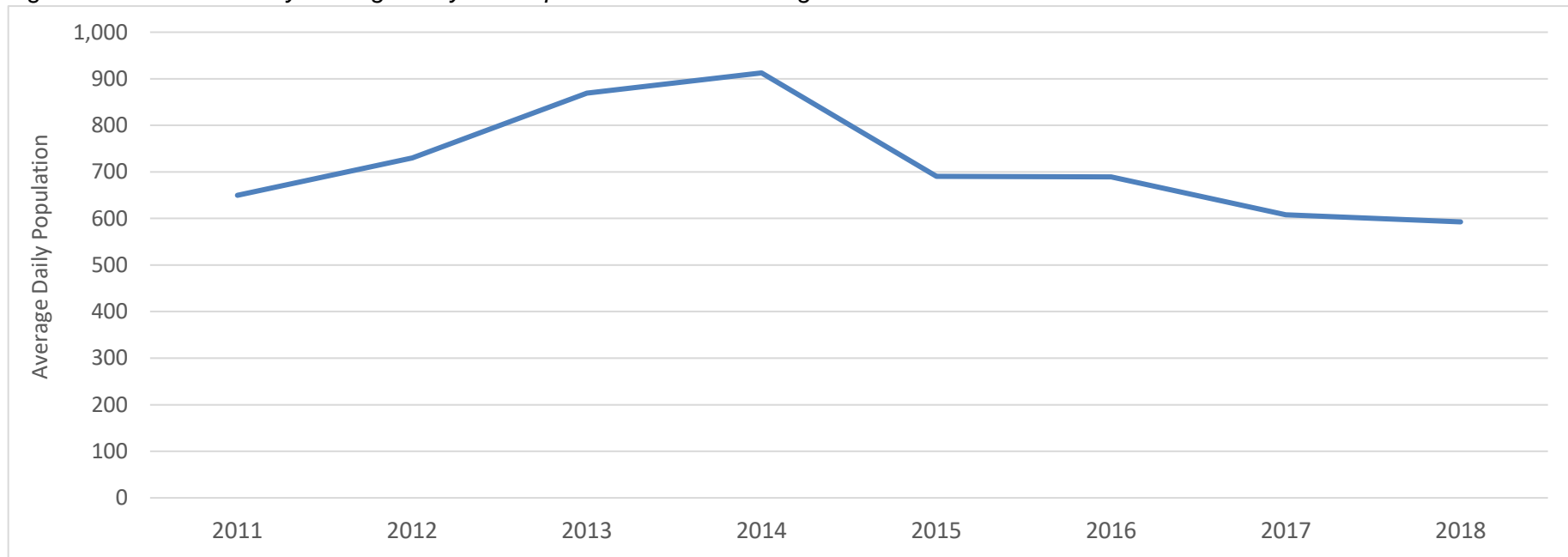


Figure 72. Merced County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

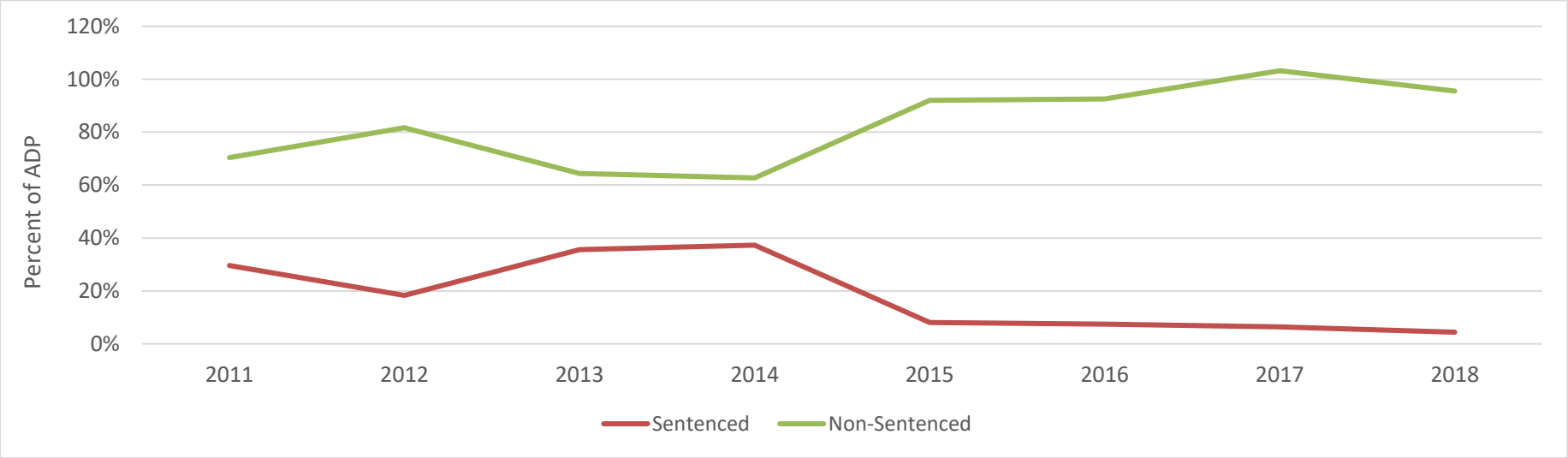
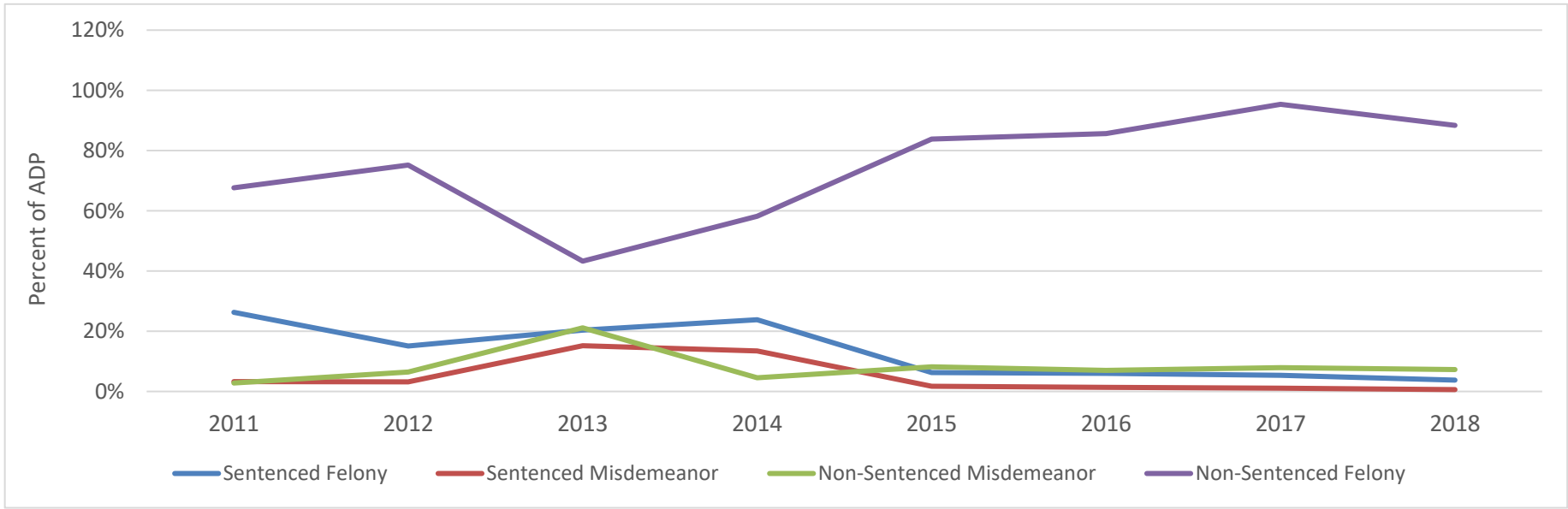


Figure 73. Merced County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 74. Modoc County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

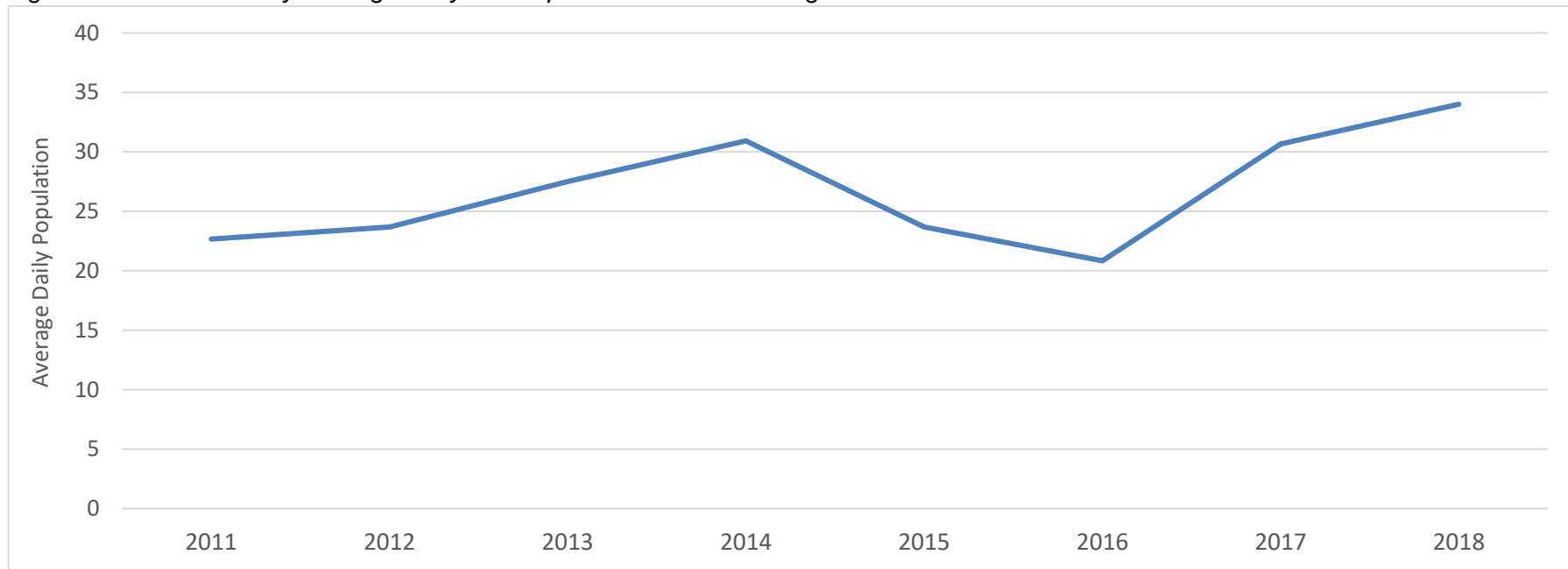


Figure 75. Modoc County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

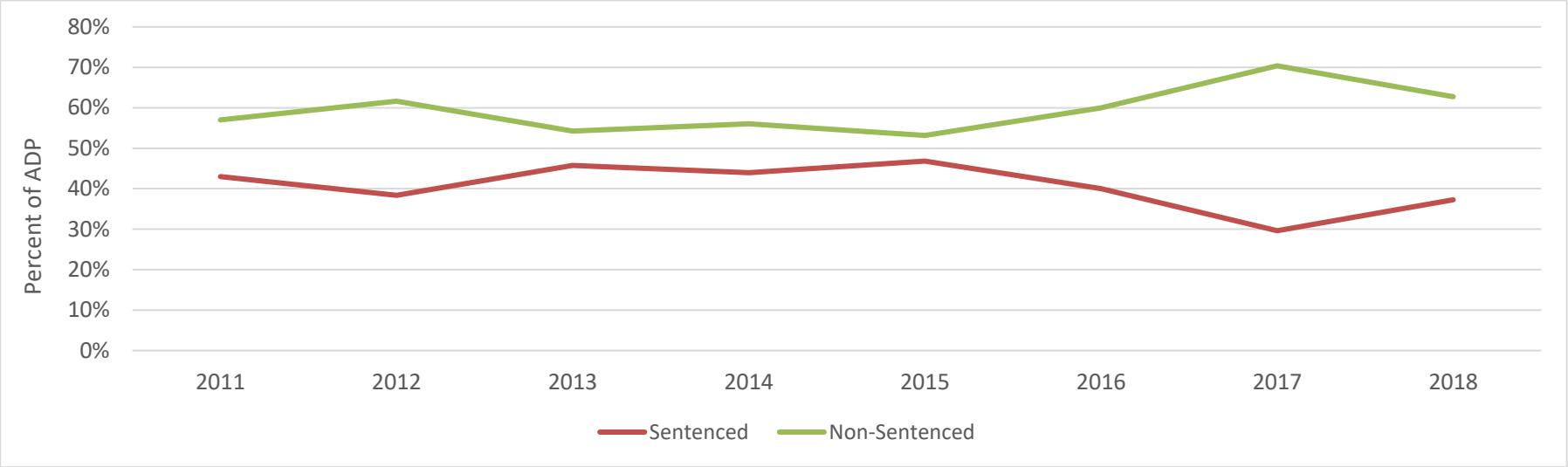
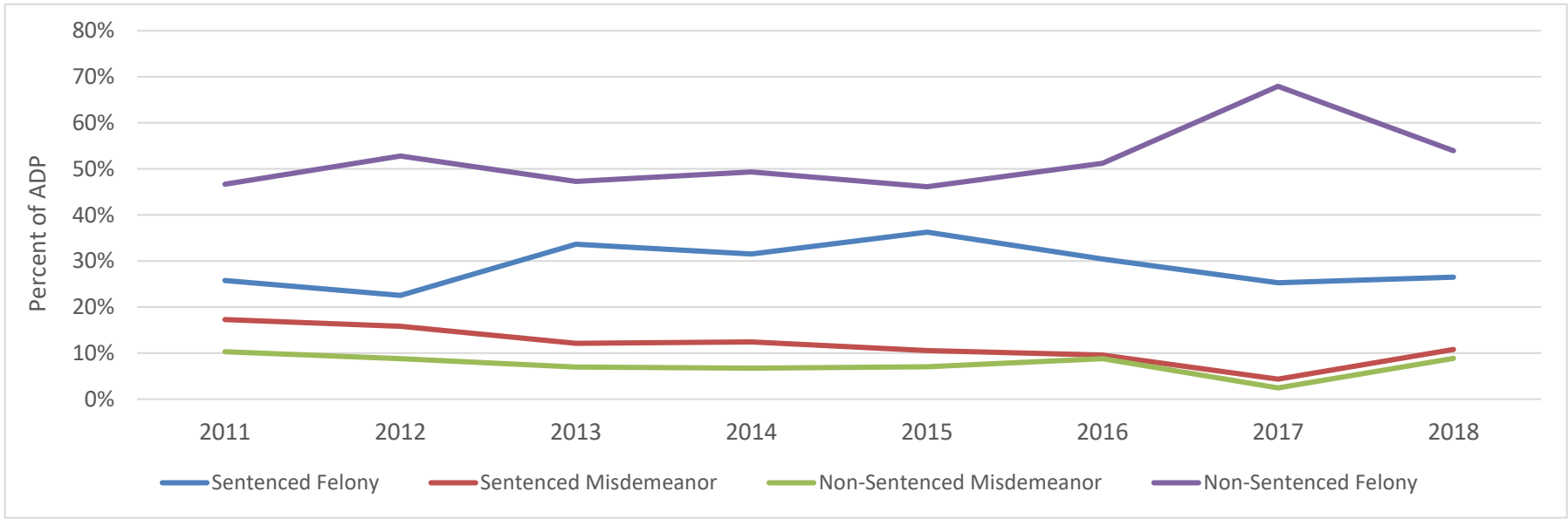


Figure 76. Modoc County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 77. Mono County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

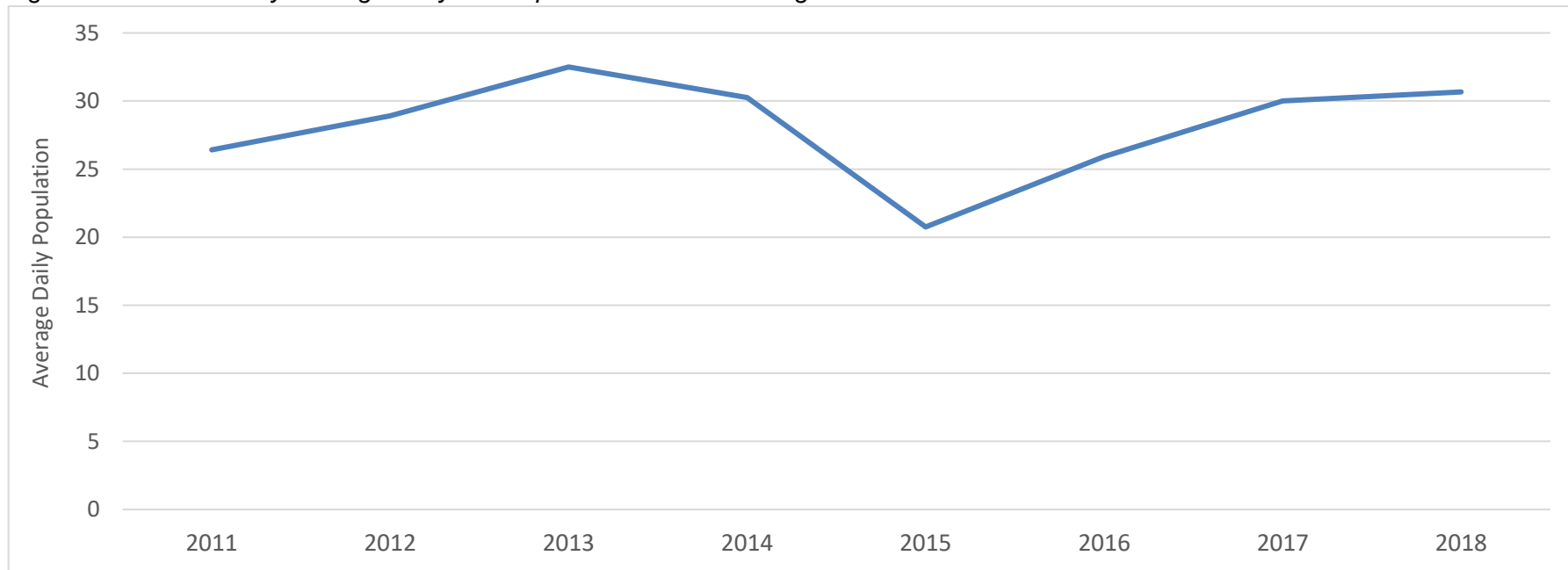


Figure 78. Mono County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

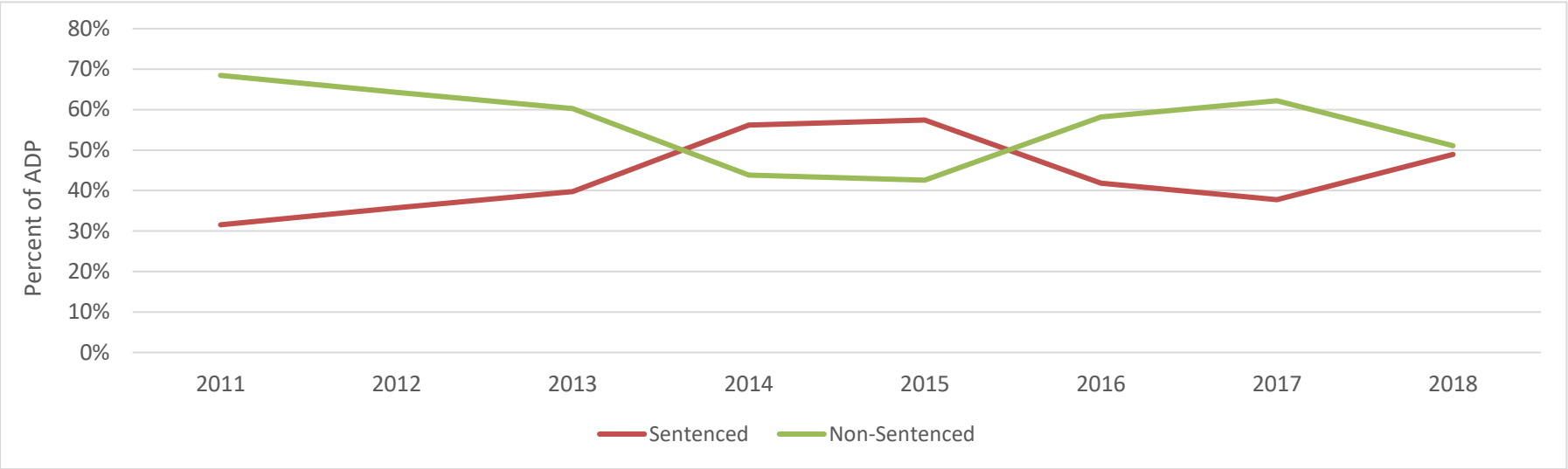
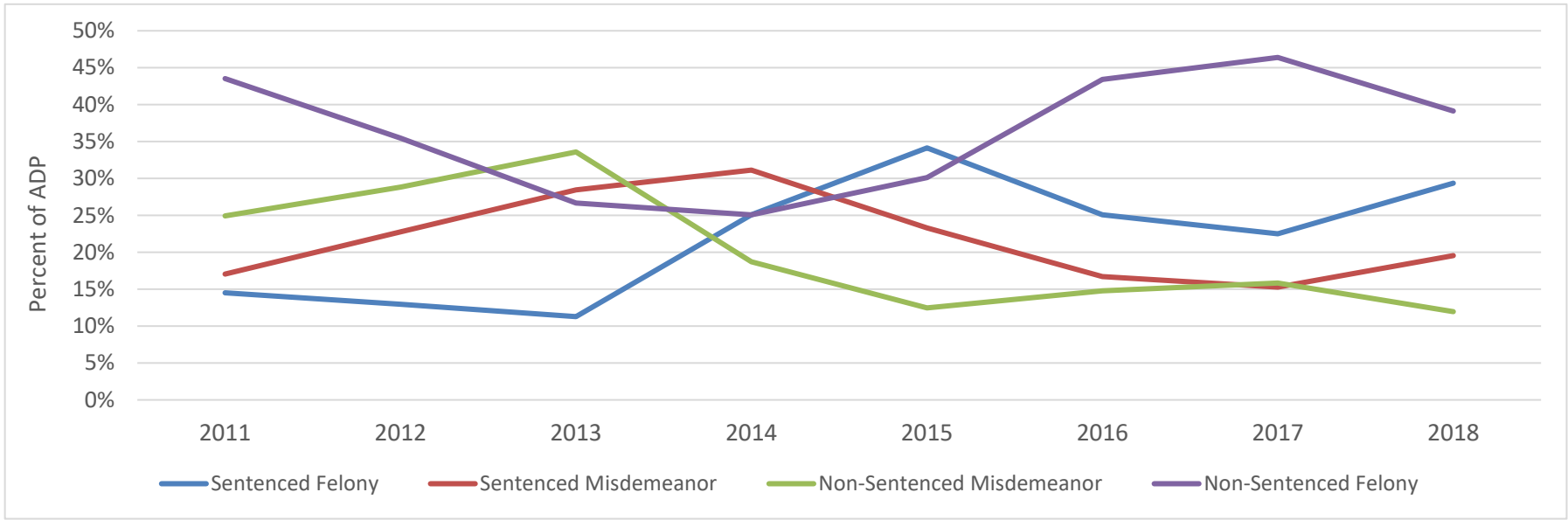


Figure 79. Mono County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 80. *Monterey County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

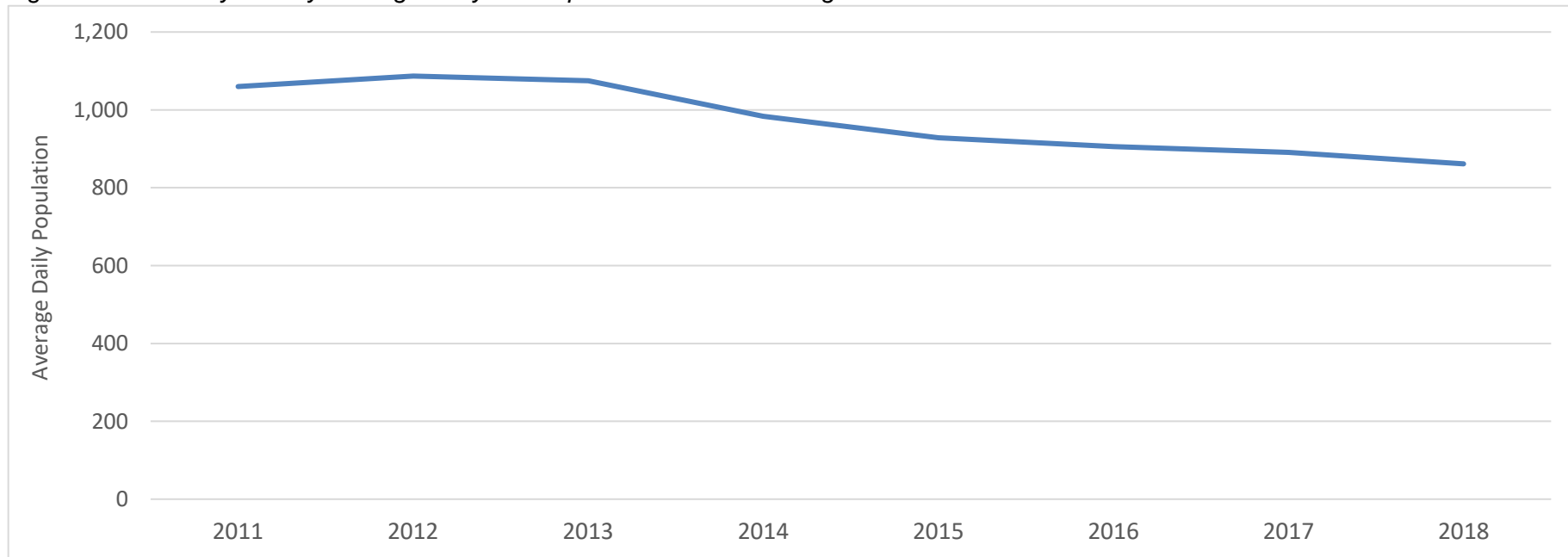




Figure 81. Monterey County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

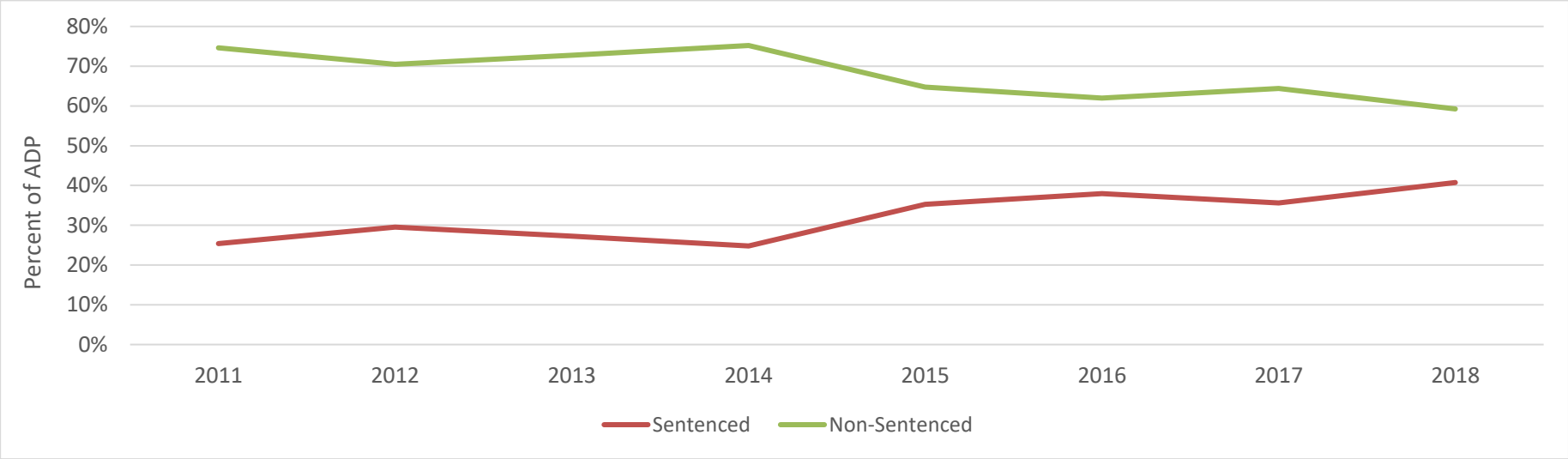
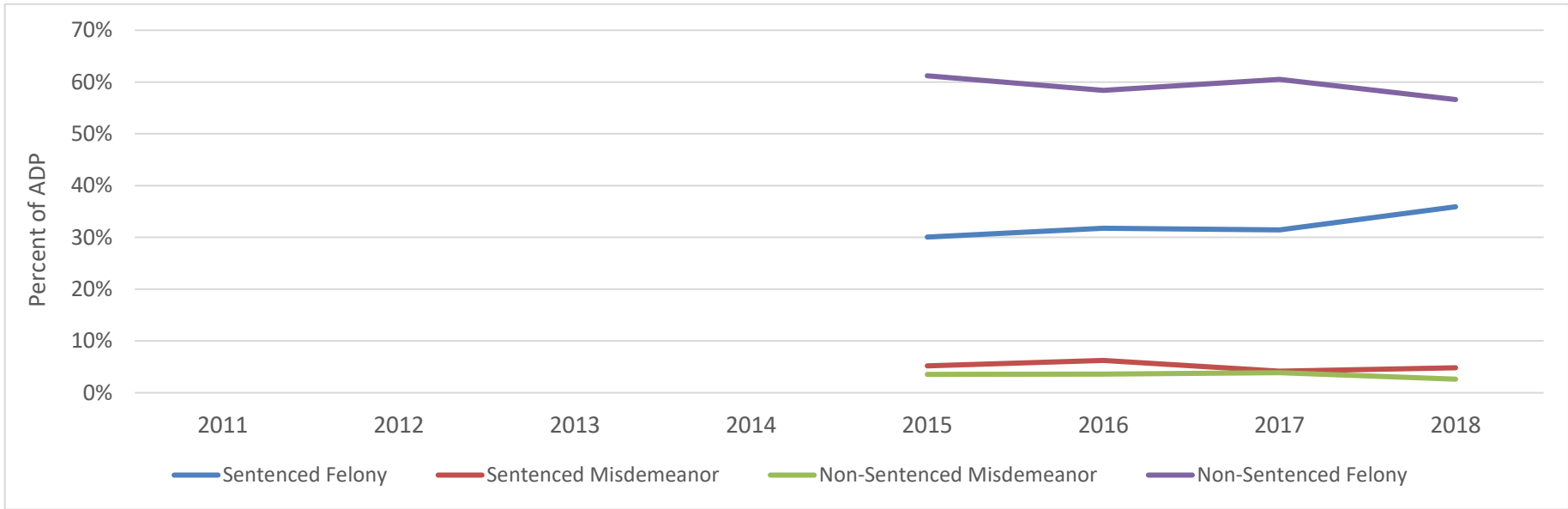


Figure 82. Monterey County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 83. *Napa County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

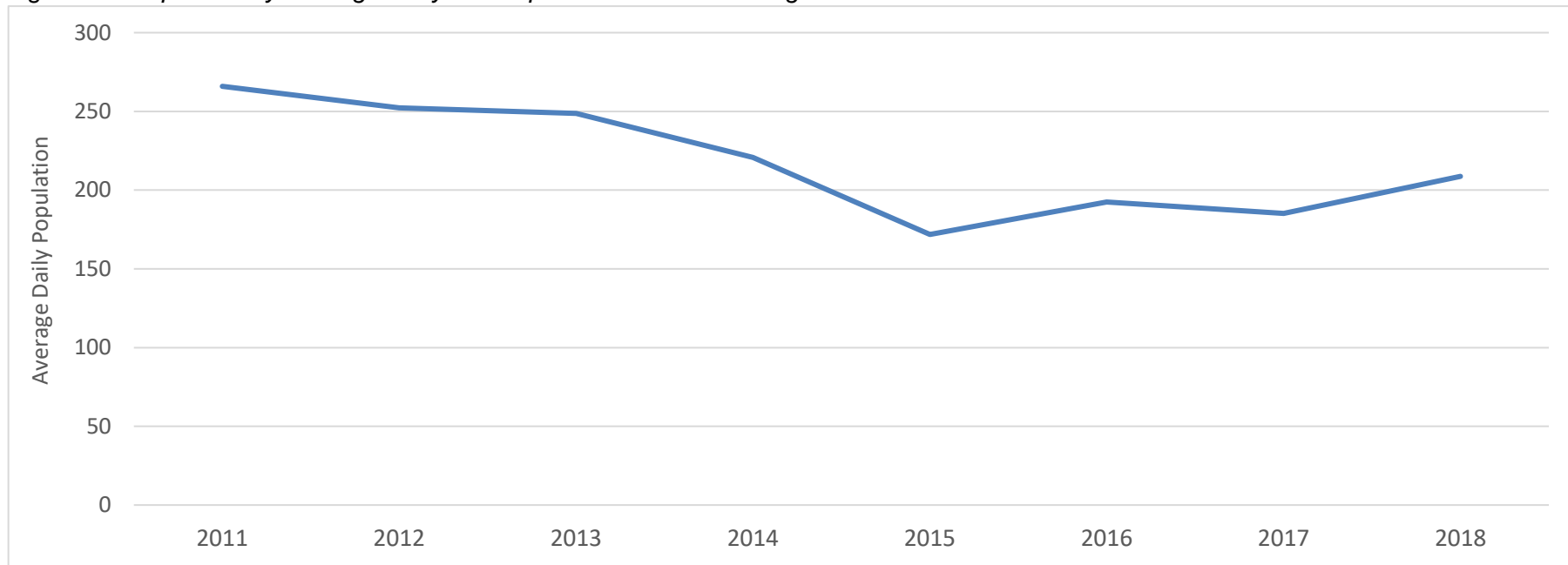


Figure 84. Napa County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

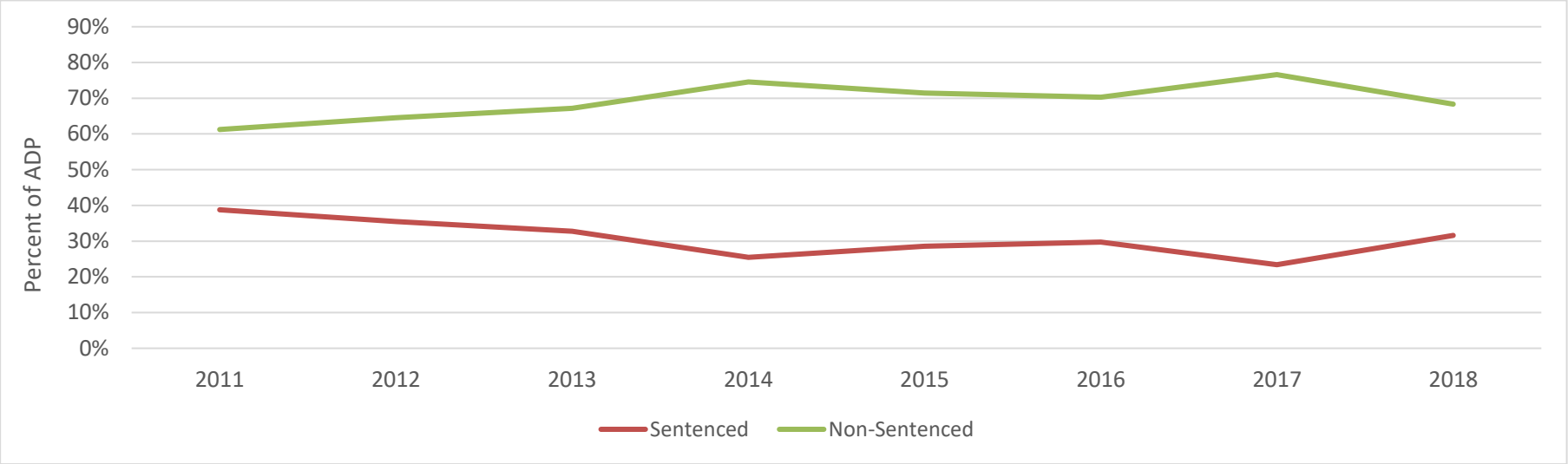
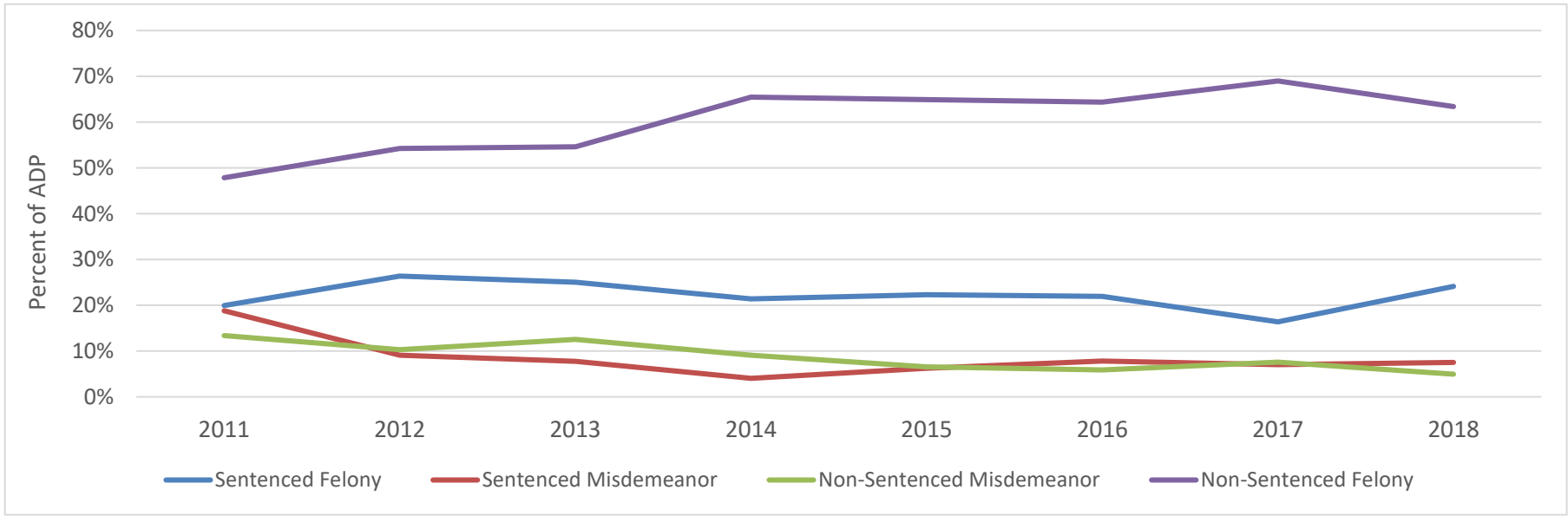


Figure 85. Napa County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 86. Nevada County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

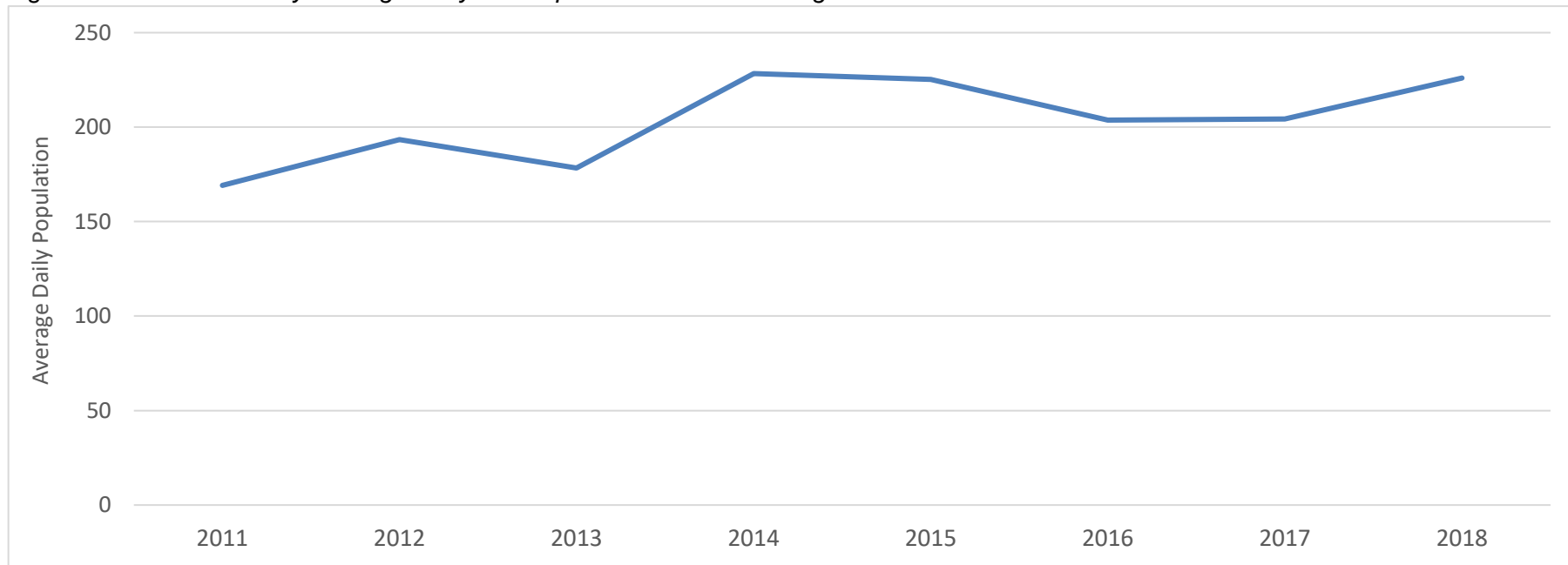


Figure 87. Nevada County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

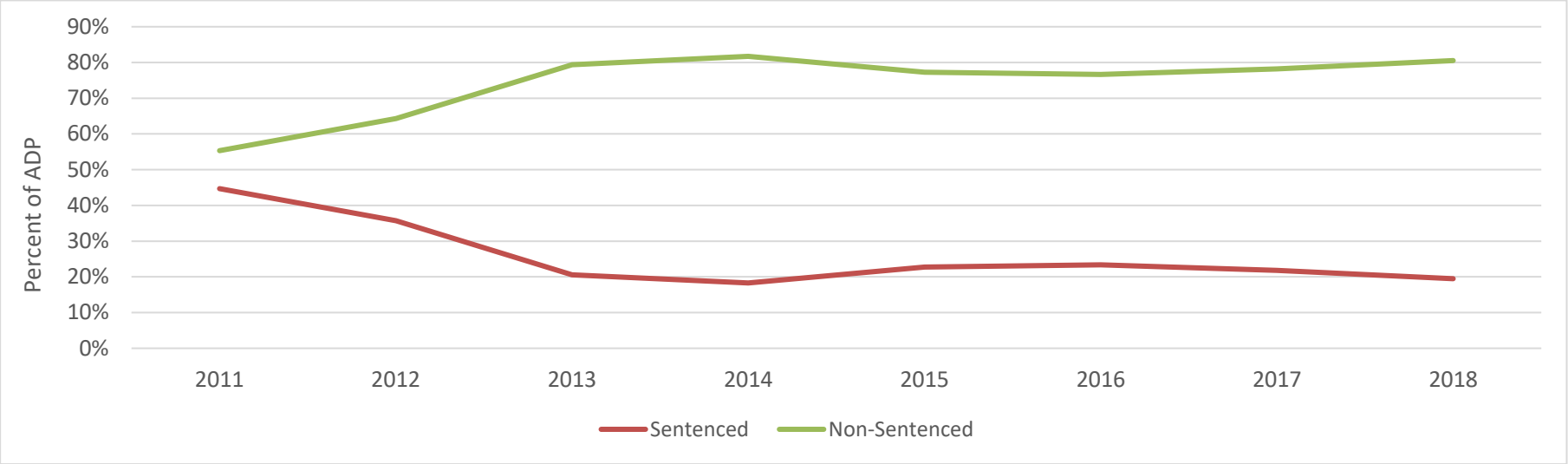
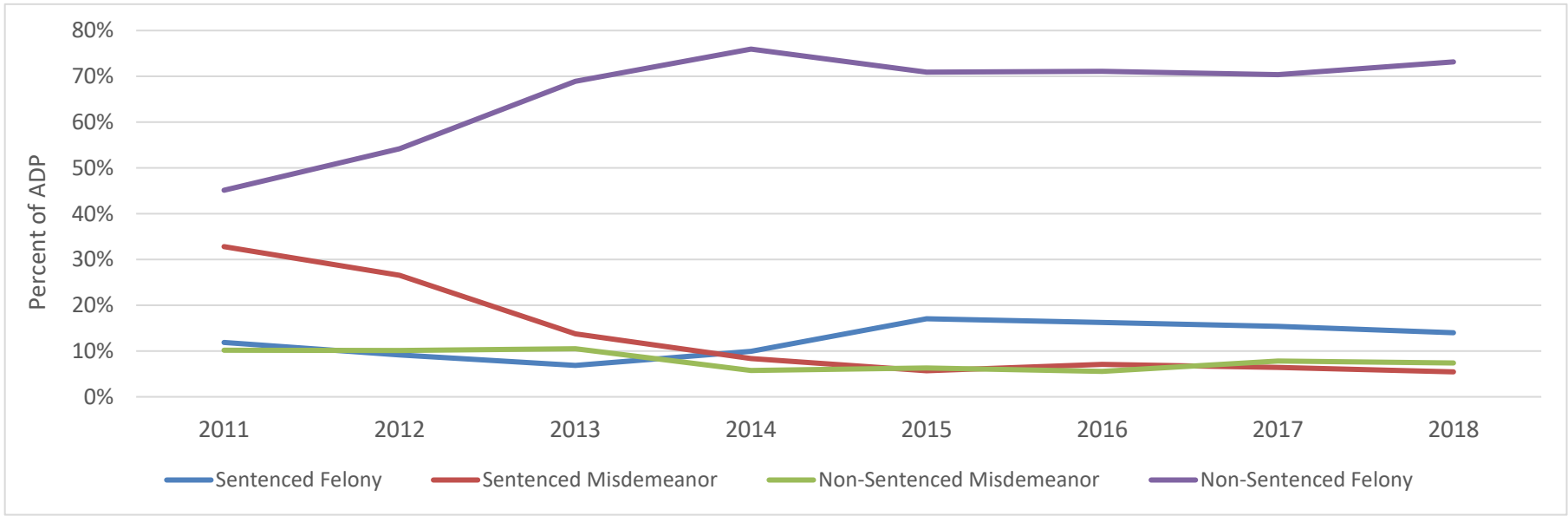


Figure 88. Nevada County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 89. Orange County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

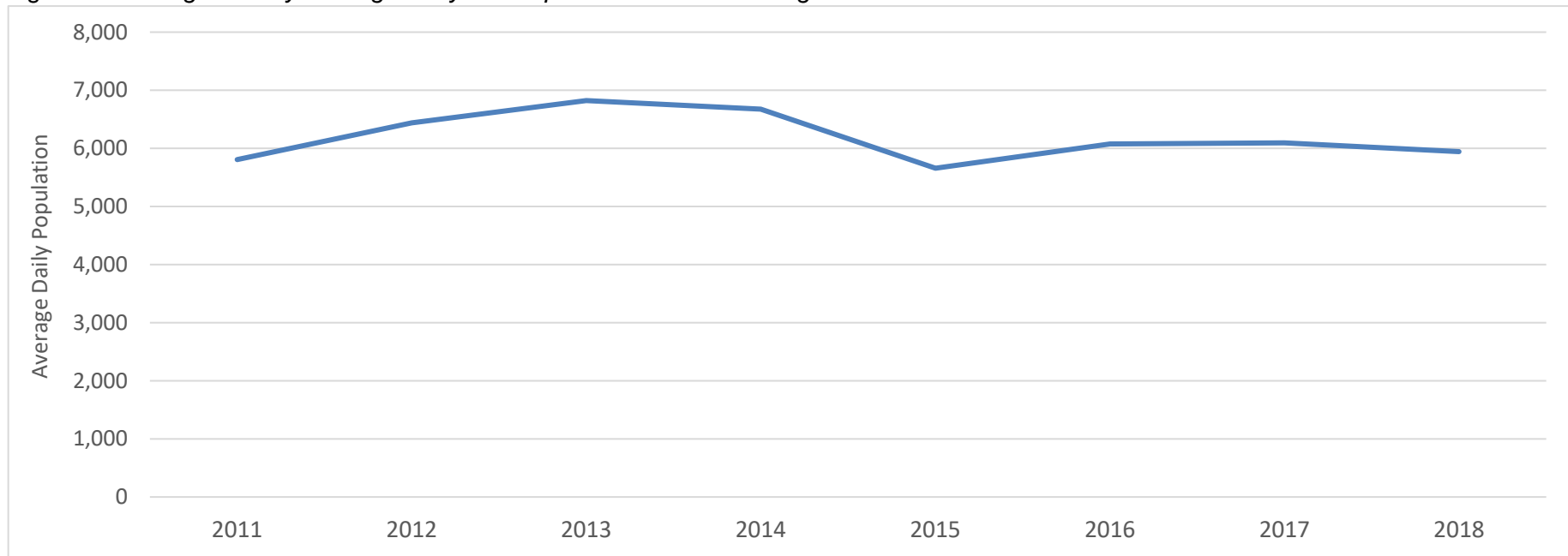


Figure 90. Orange County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

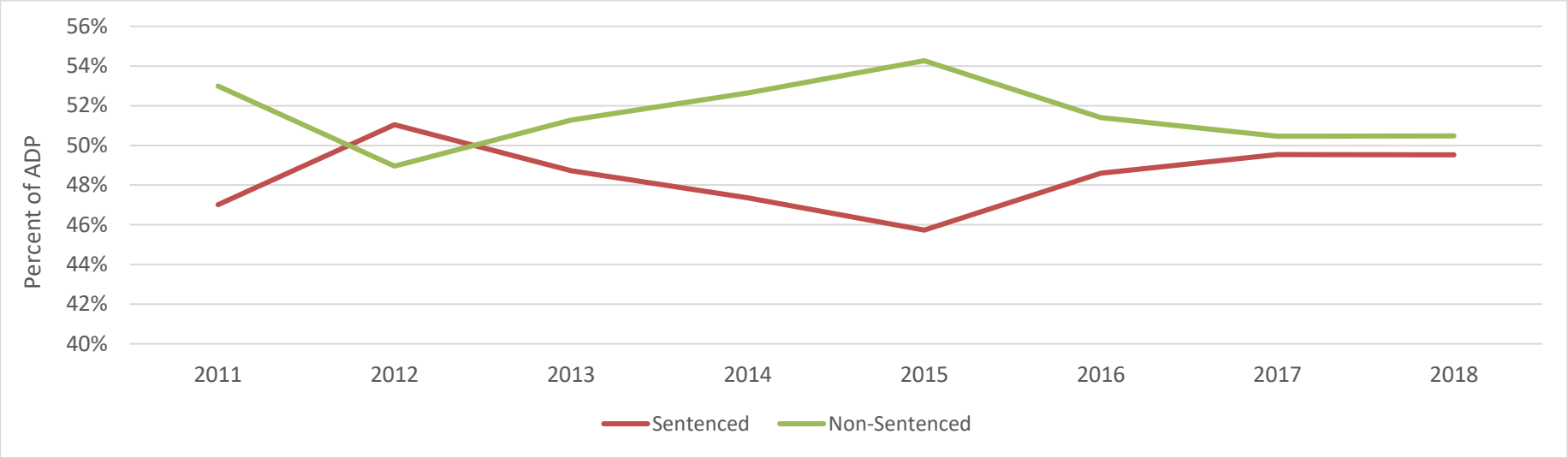
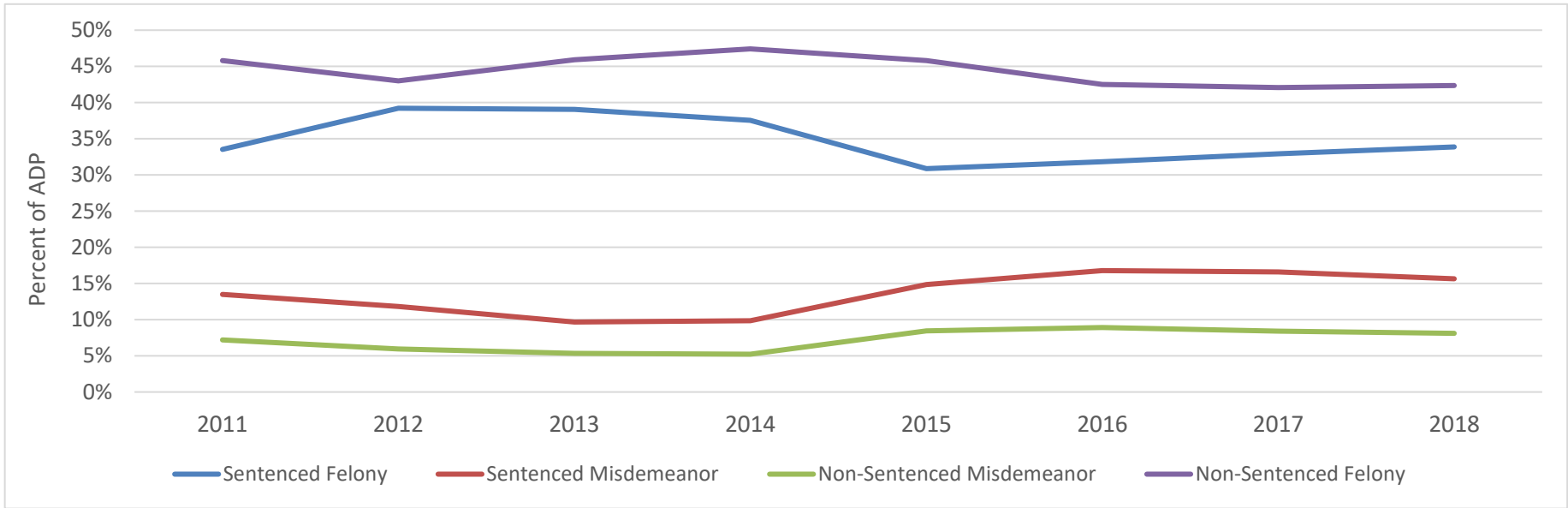


Figure 91. Orange County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 92. Placer County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

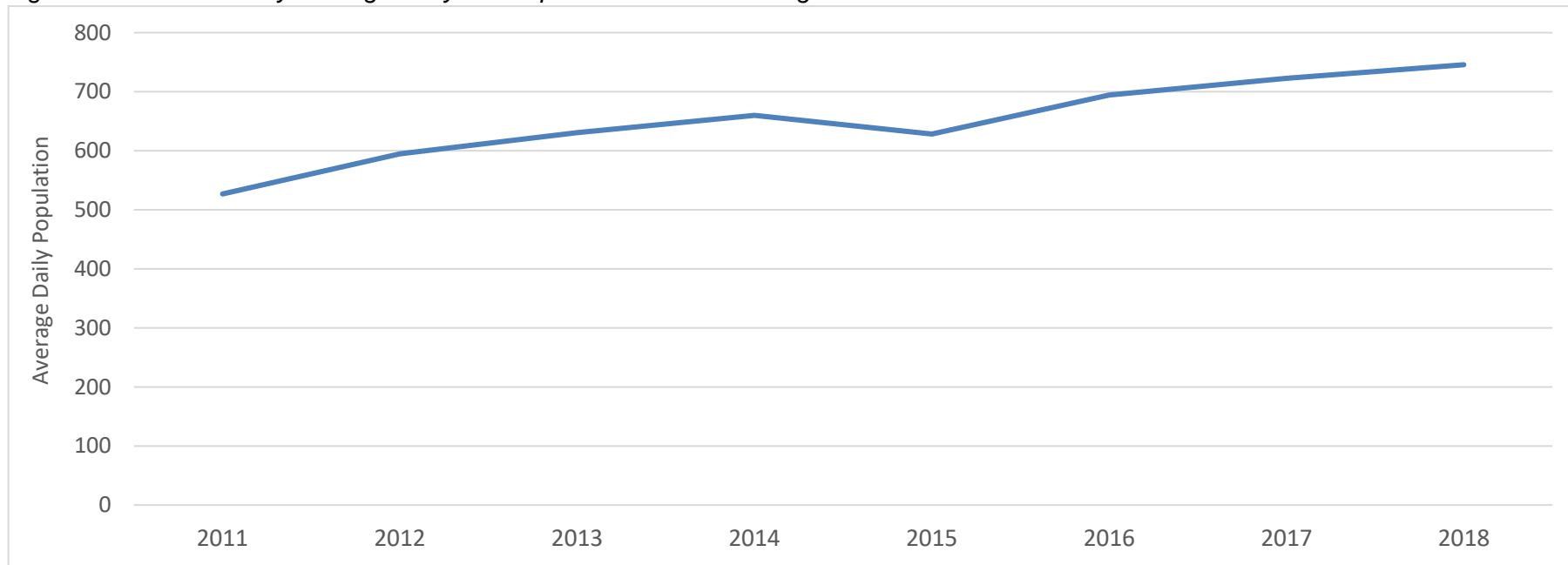




Figure 93. Placer County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

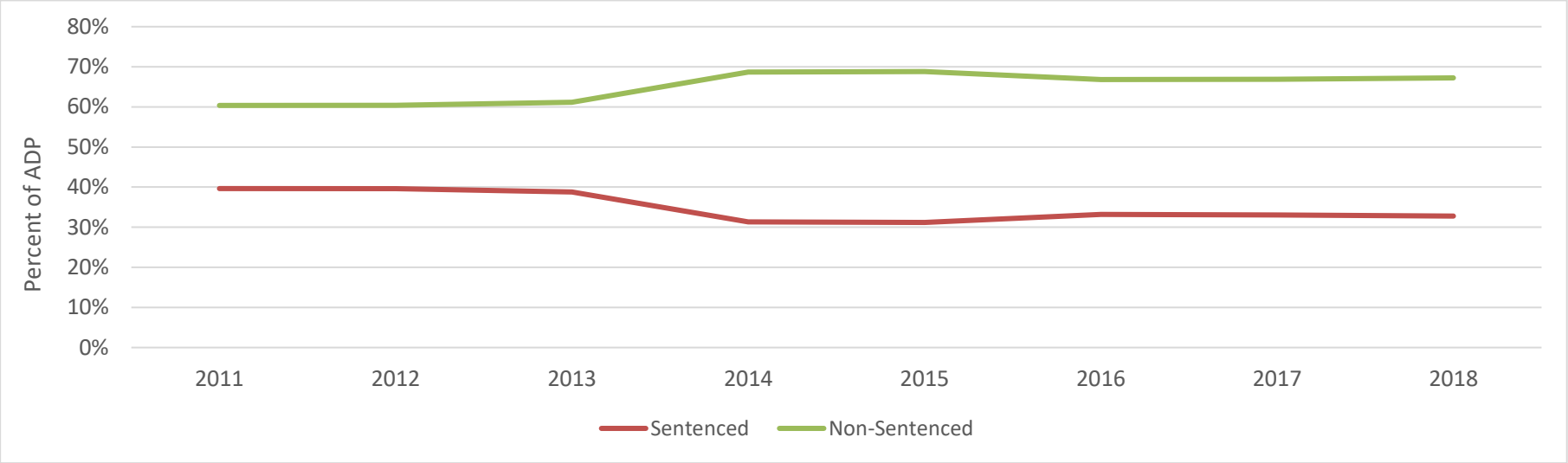
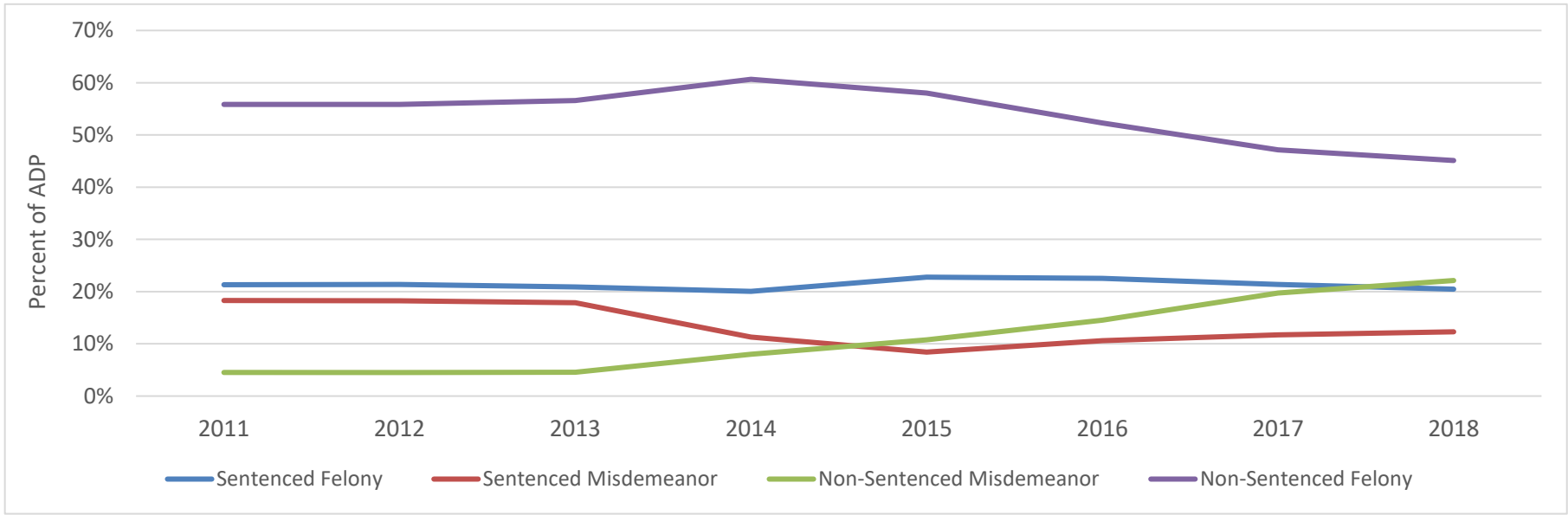


Figure 94. Placer County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 95. *Plumas County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

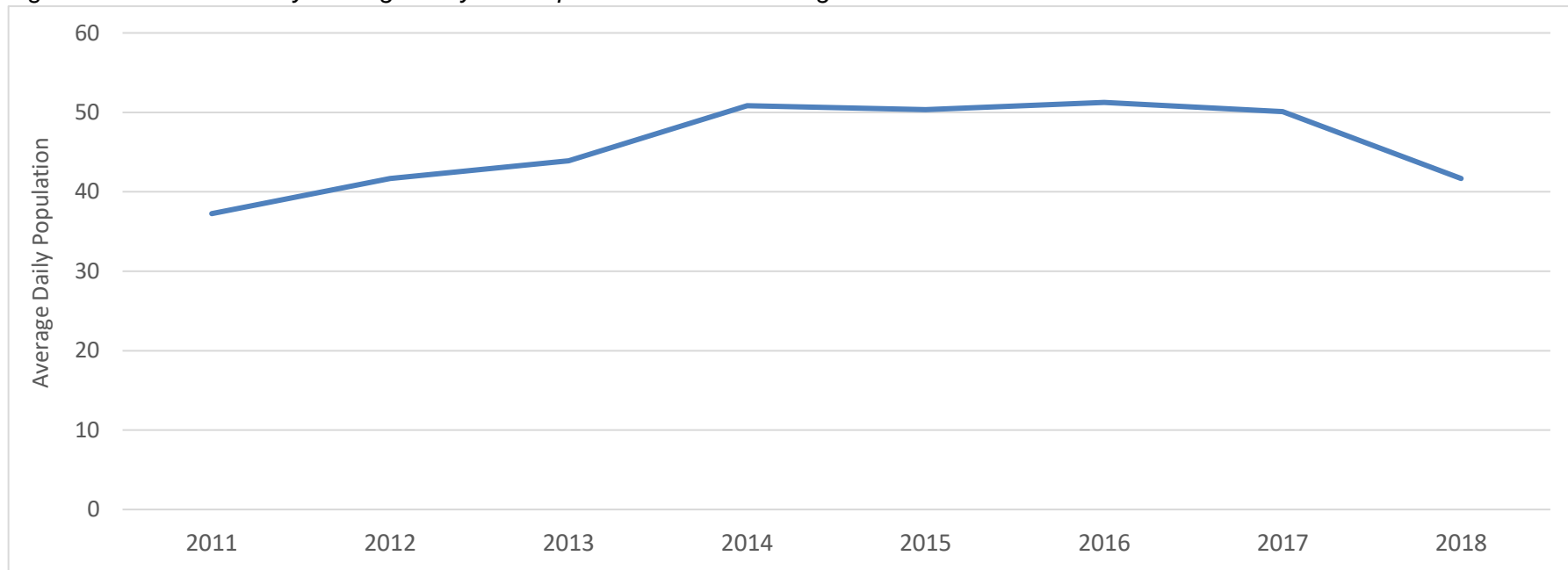


Figure 96. *Plumas County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

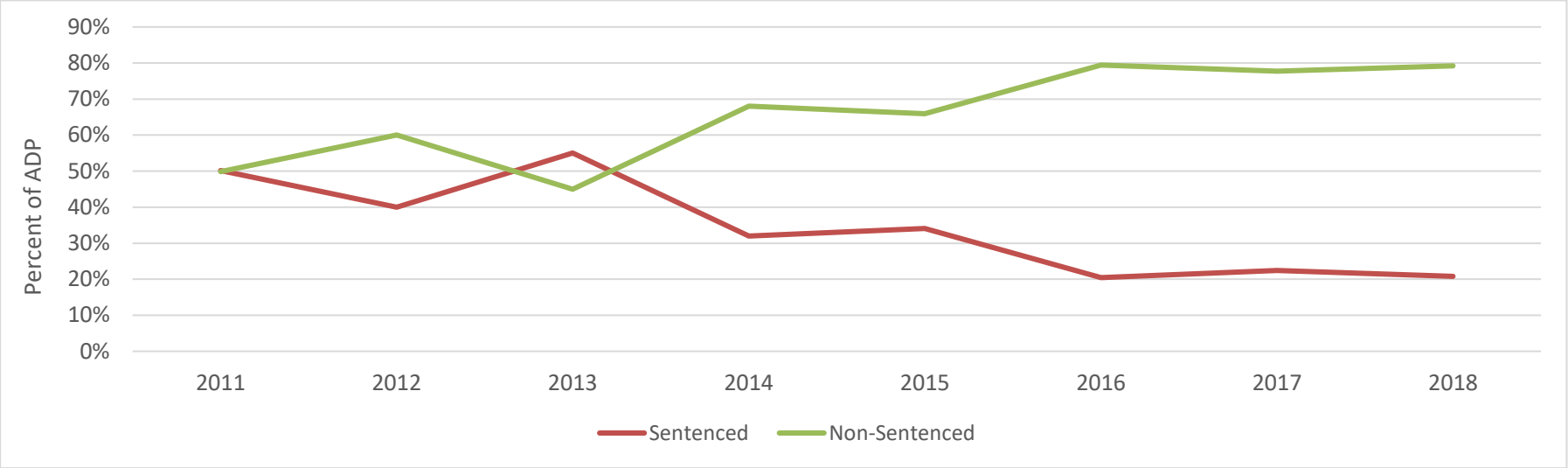
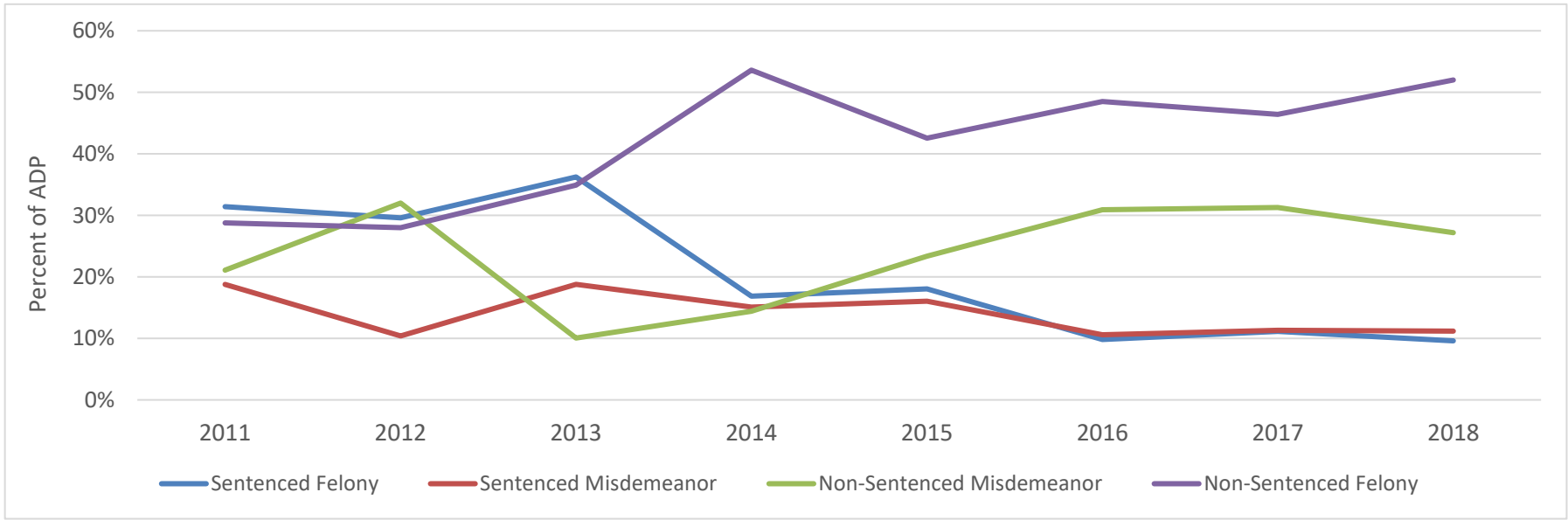


Figure 97. *Plumas County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

Figure 98. *Riverside County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

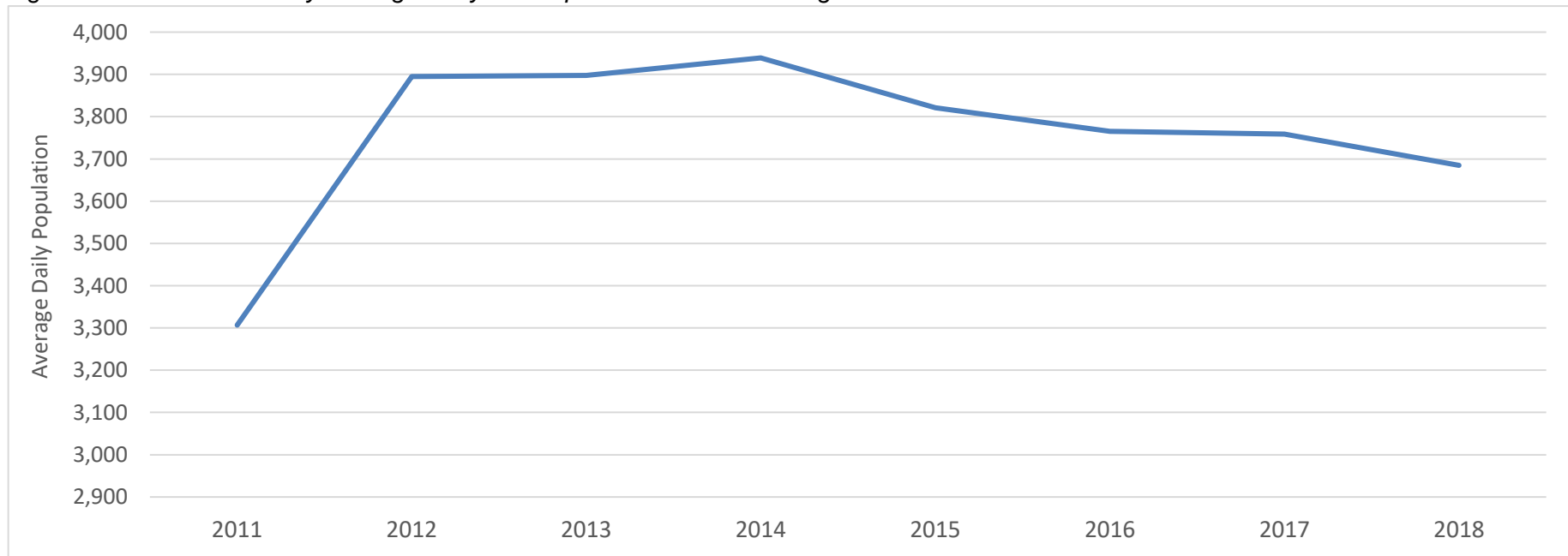


Figure 99. Riverside County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

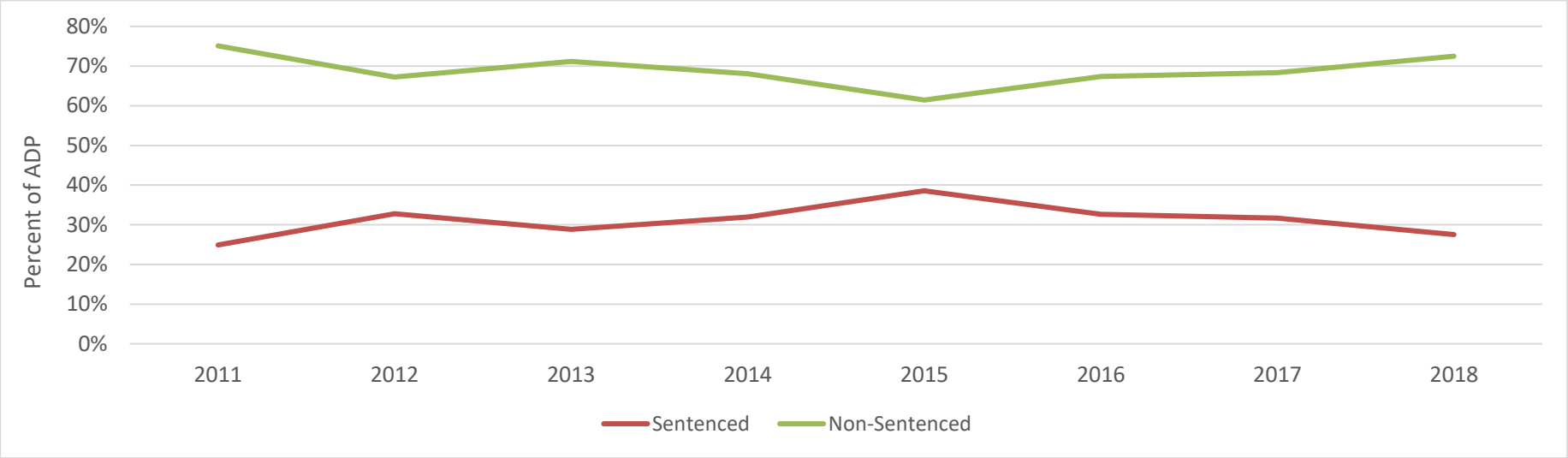
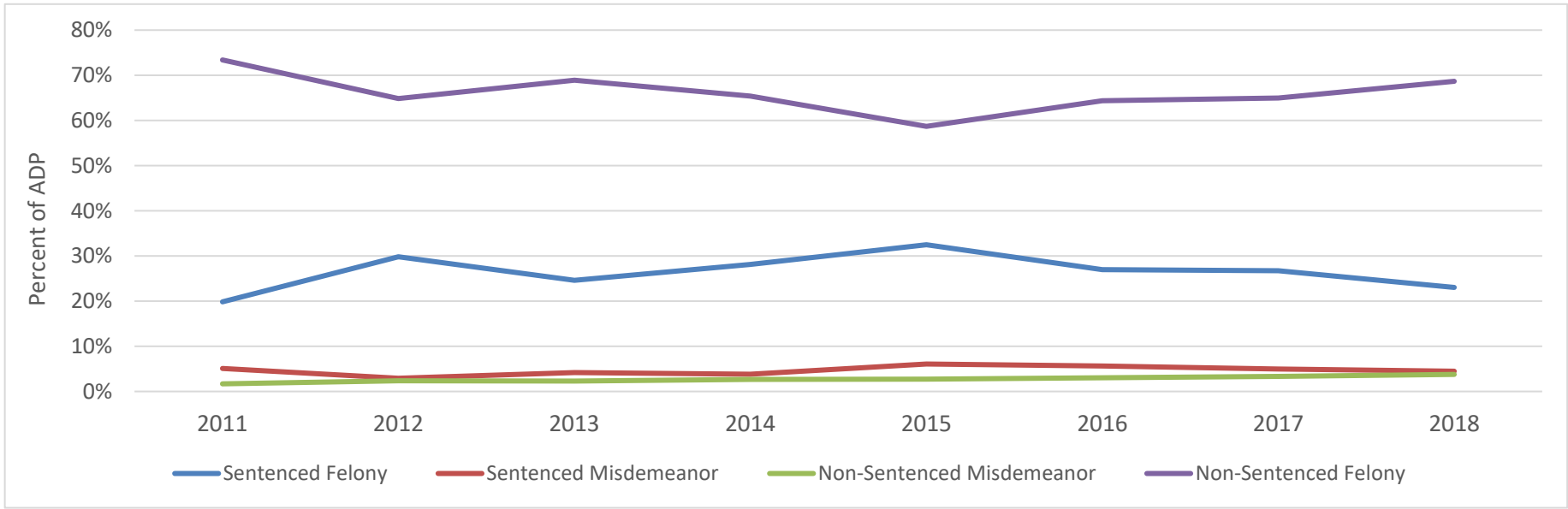


Figure 100. Riverside County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 101. *Sacramento County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

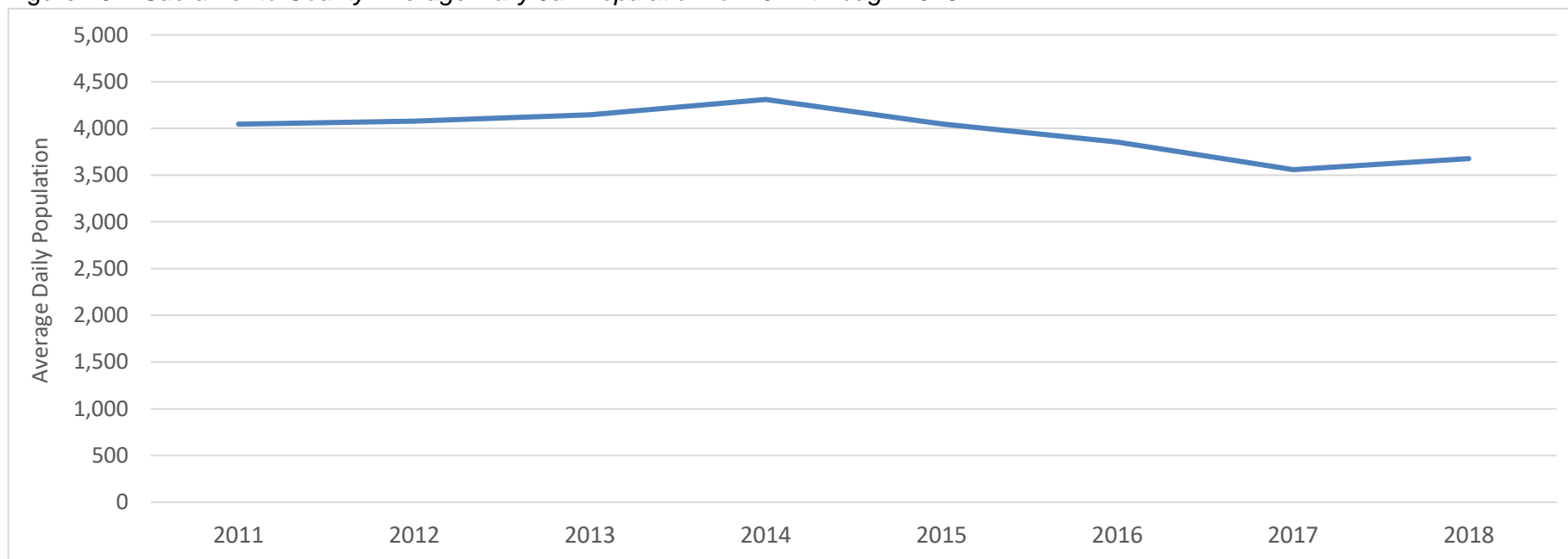


Figure 102. Sacramento County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

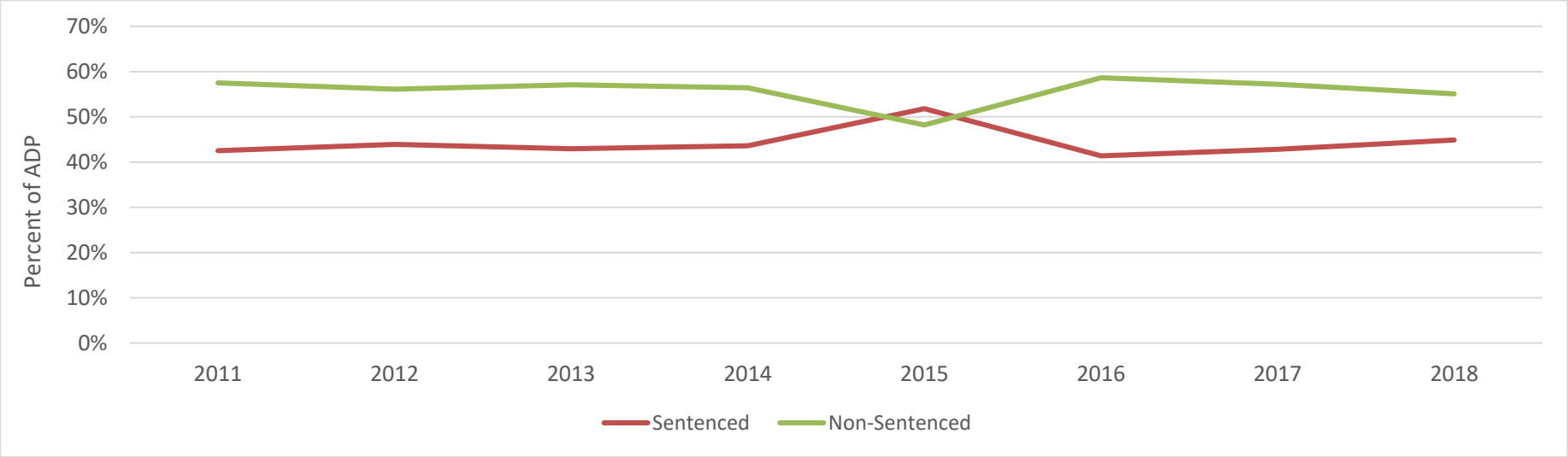
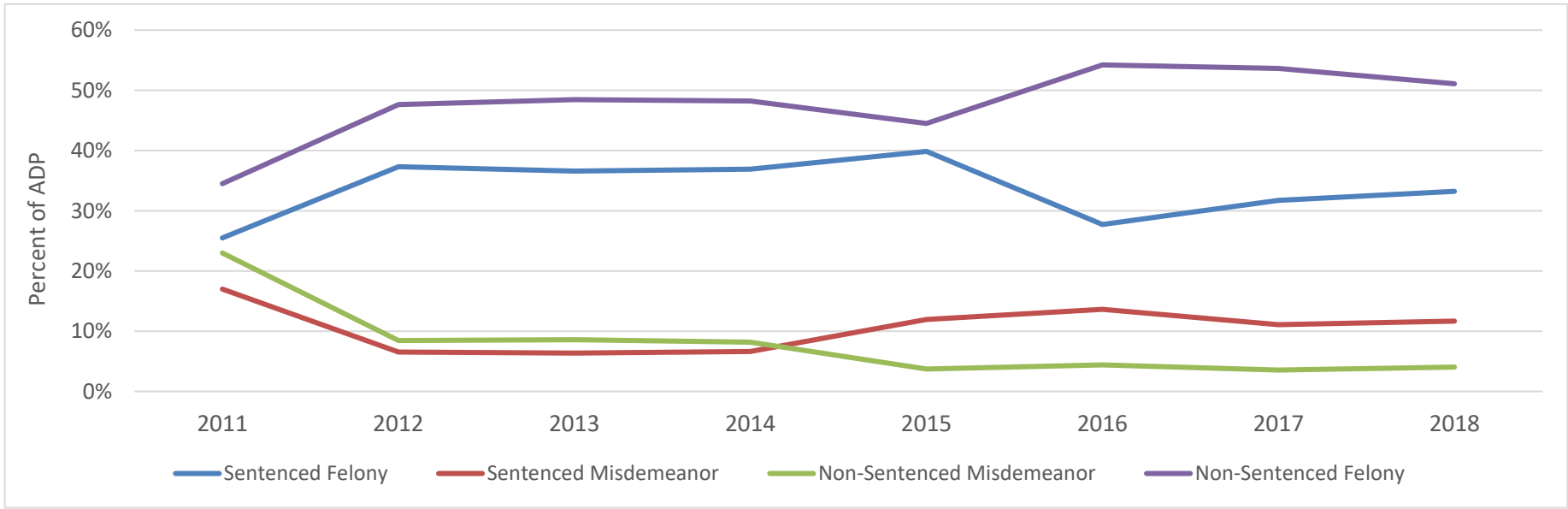


Figure 103. Sacramento County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 104. *San Benito County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

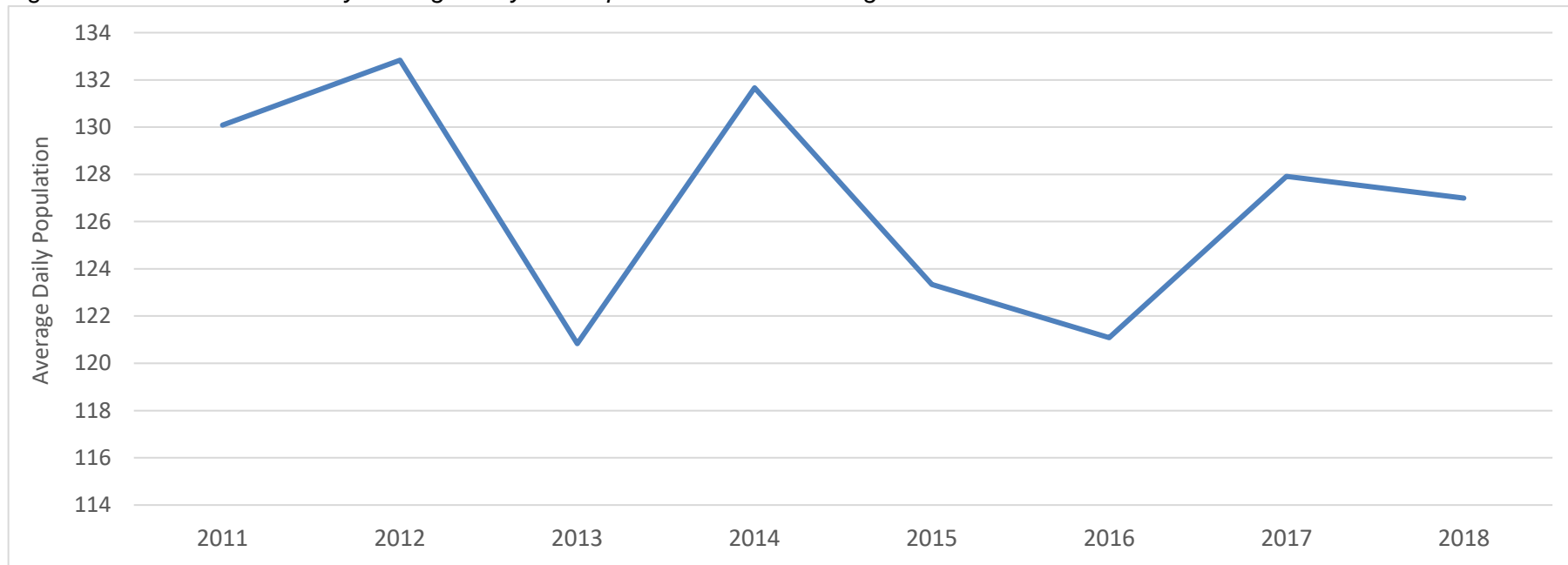




Figure 105. San Benito County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

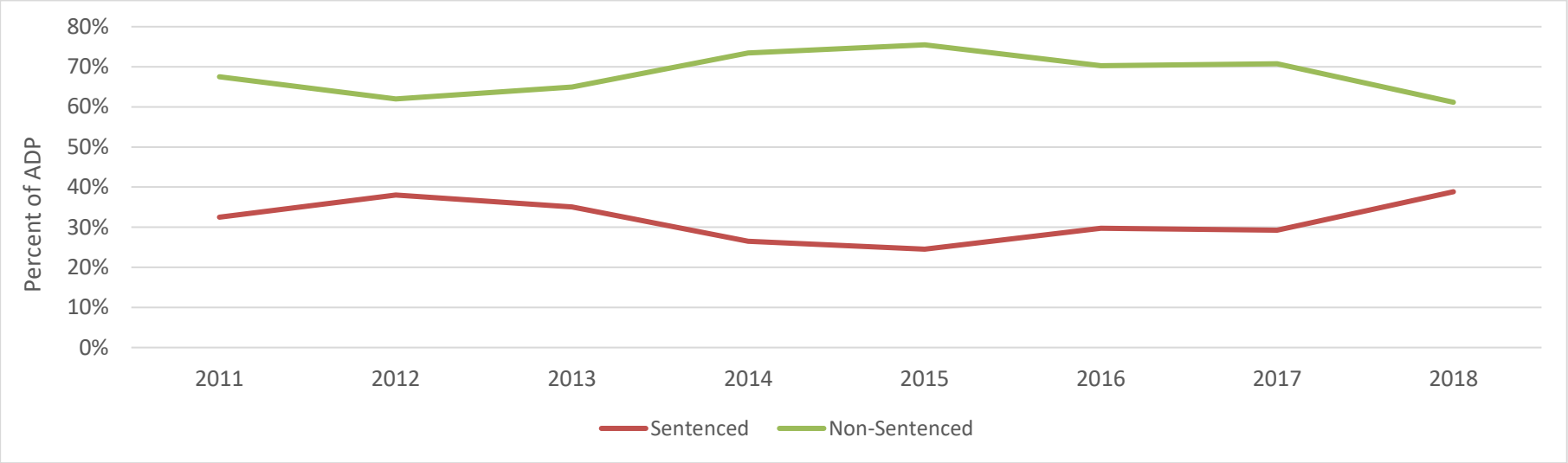
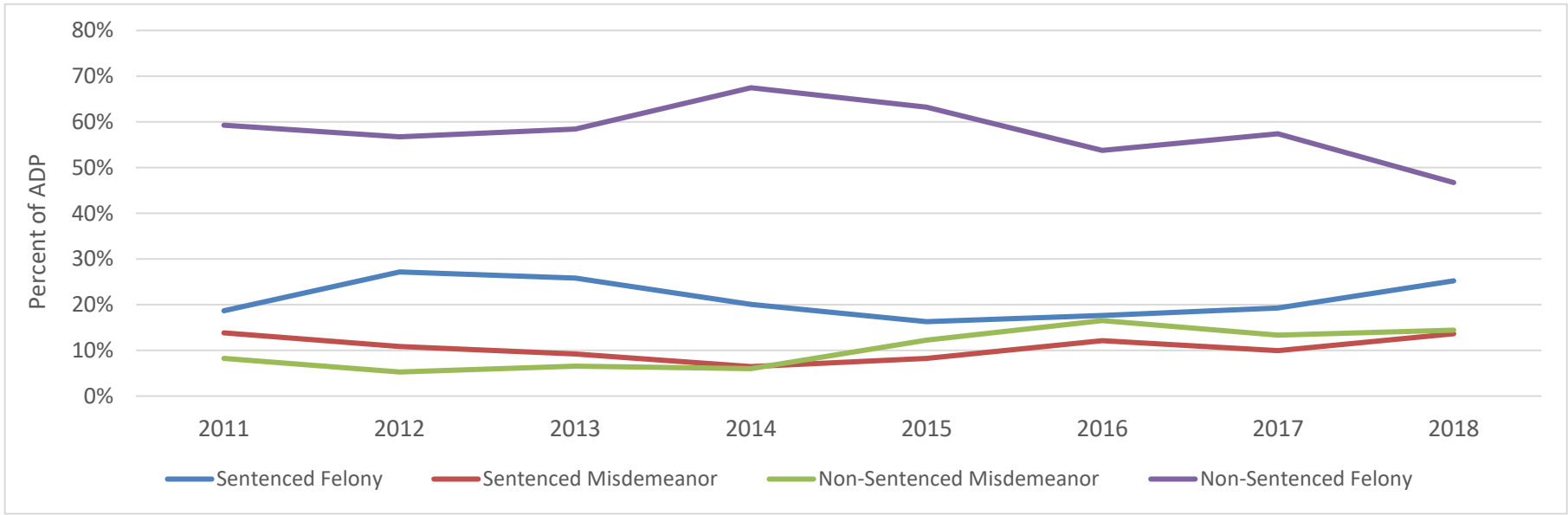


Figure 106. San Benito County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 107. San Bernardino County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

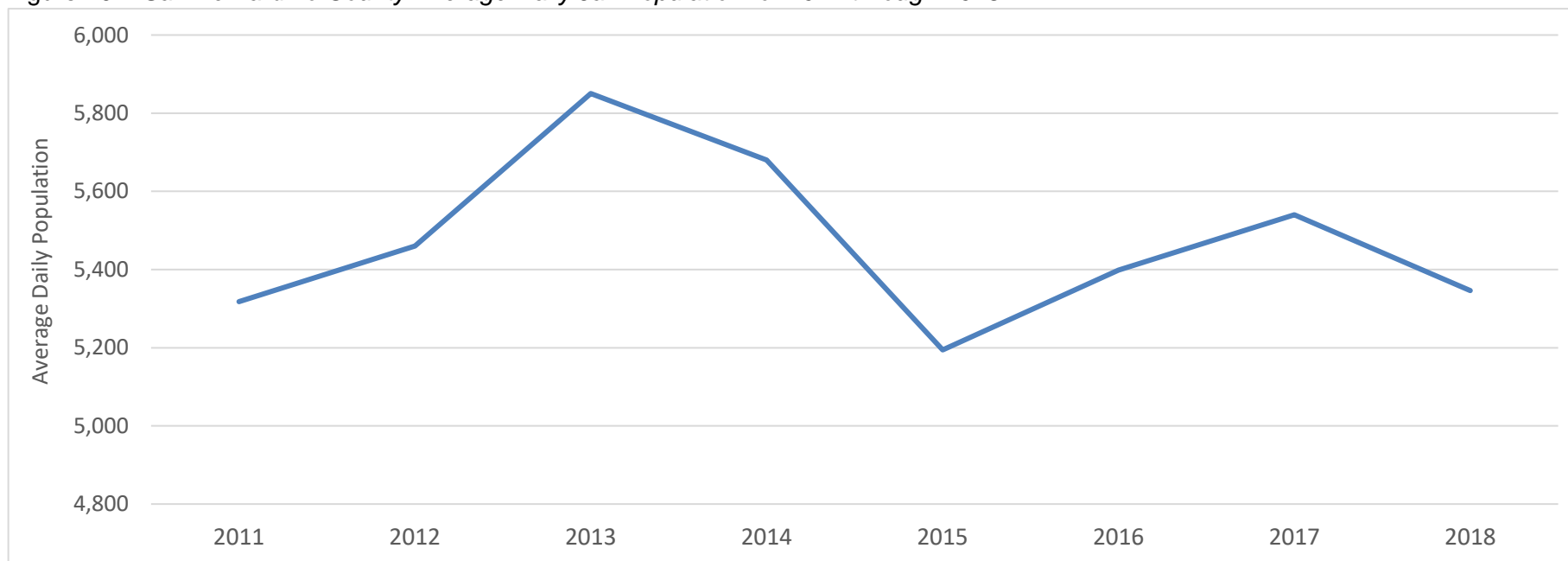


Figure 108. San Bernardino County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

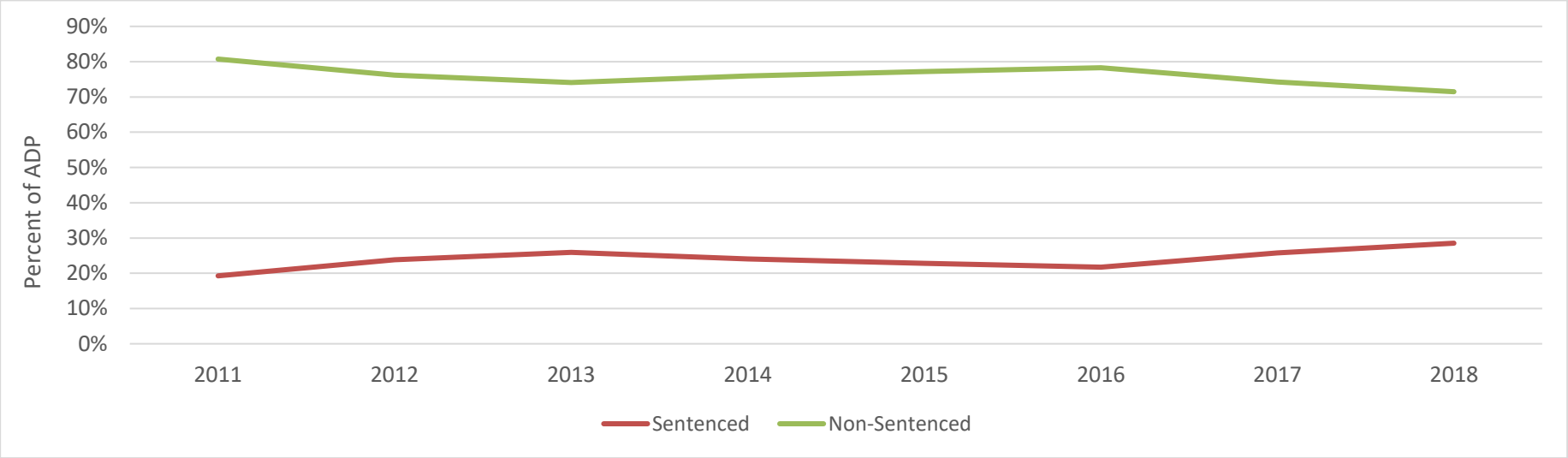
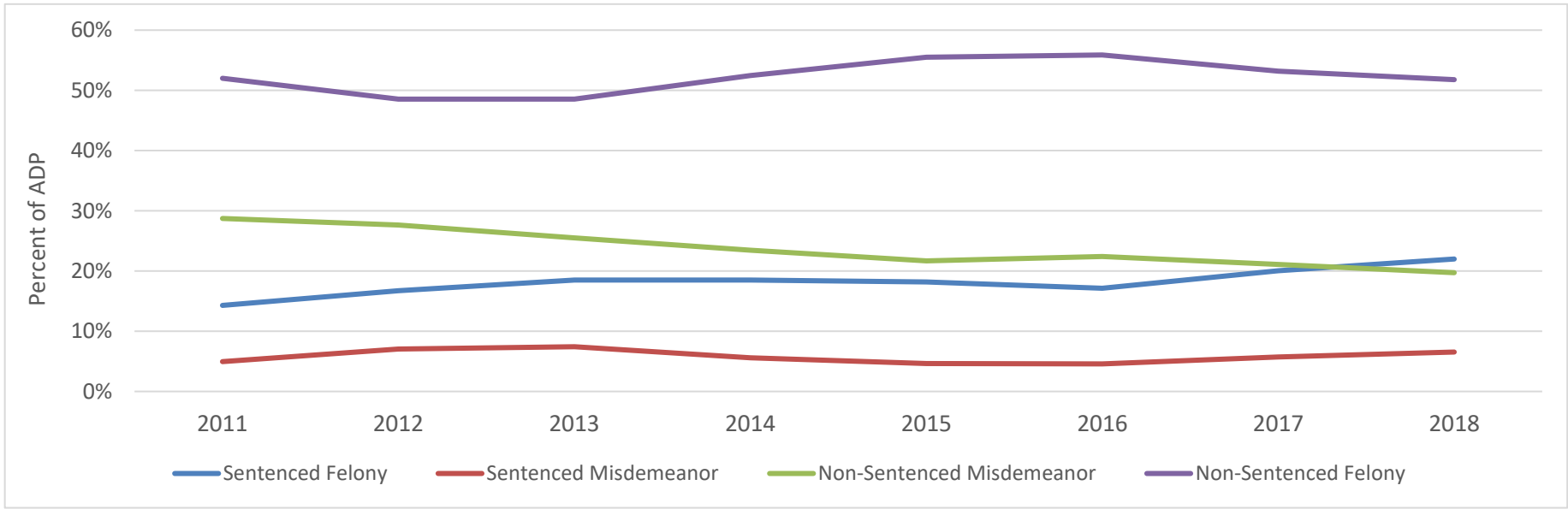


Figure 109. San Bernardino County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 110. San Diego County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

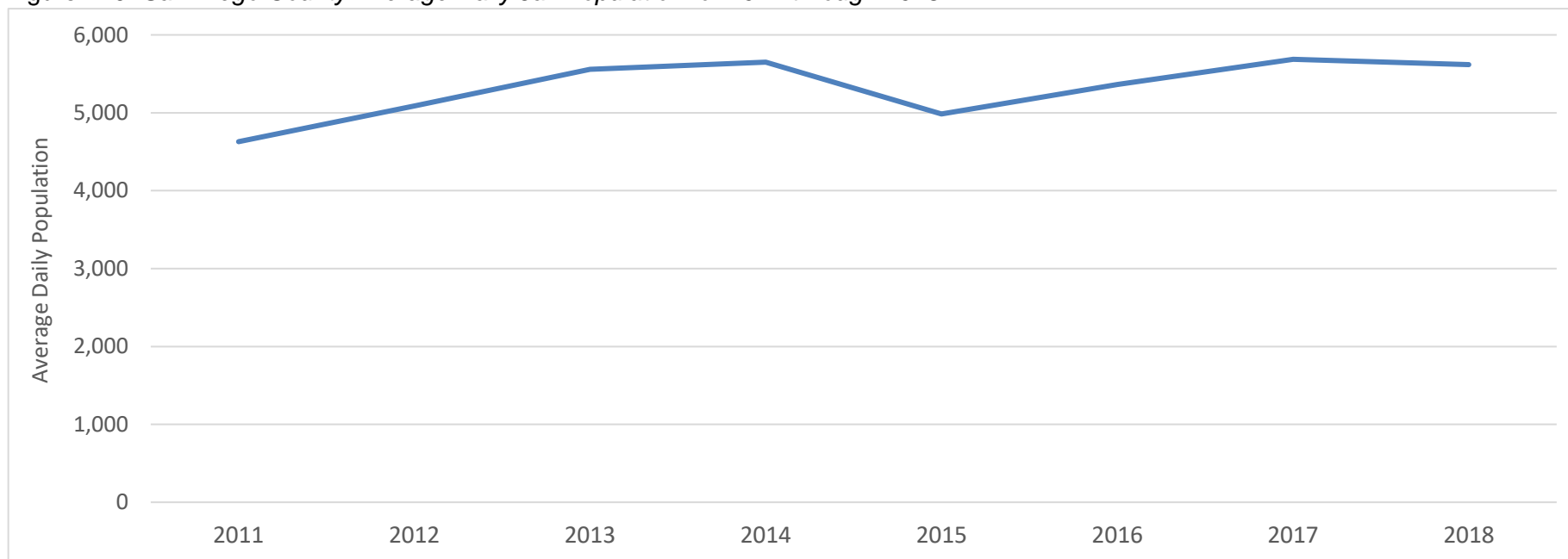


Figure 111. San Diego County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

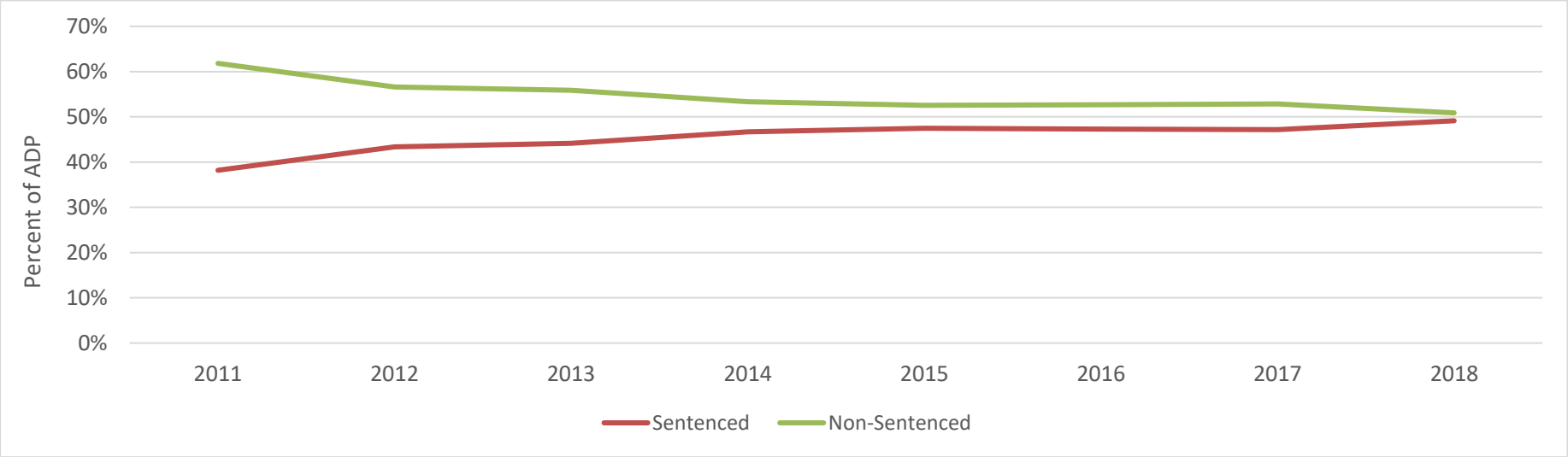
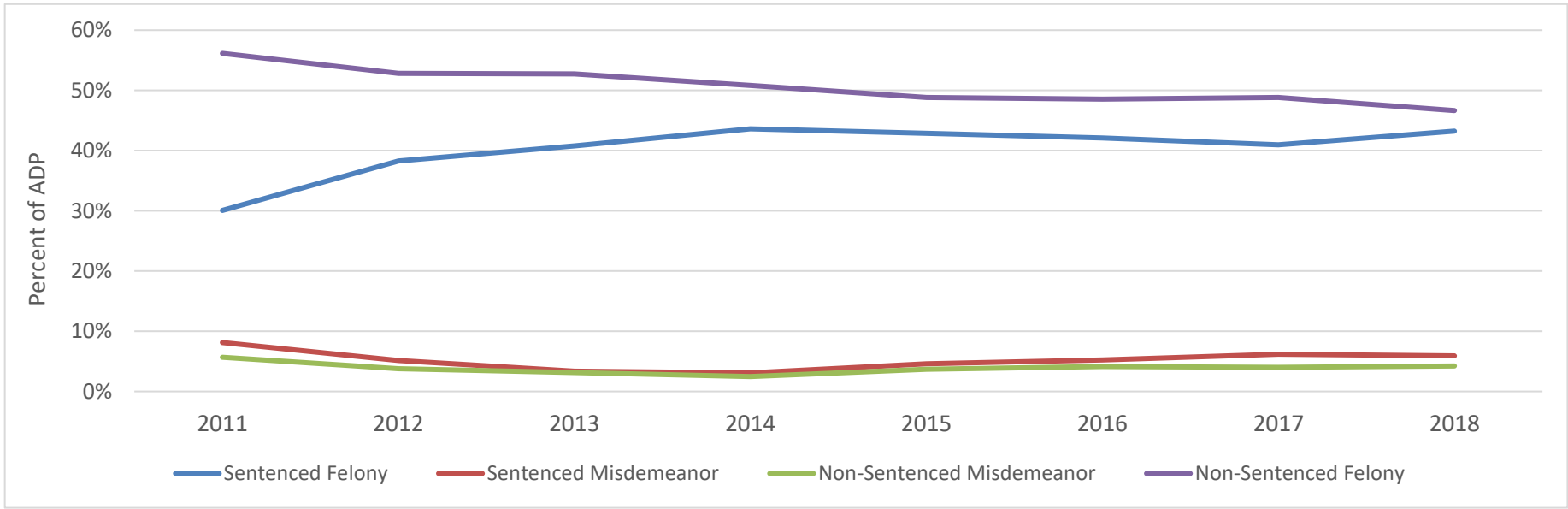


Figure 112. San Diego County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 113. San Diego Work Furlough Average Daily Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

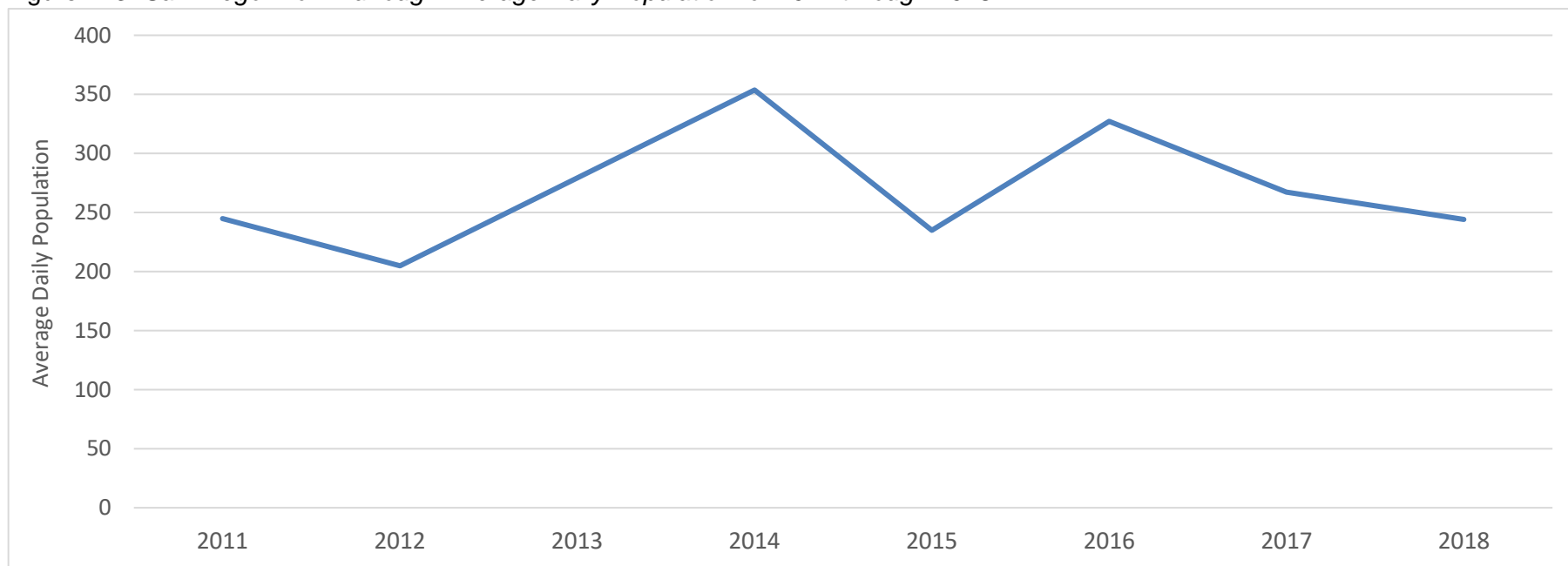
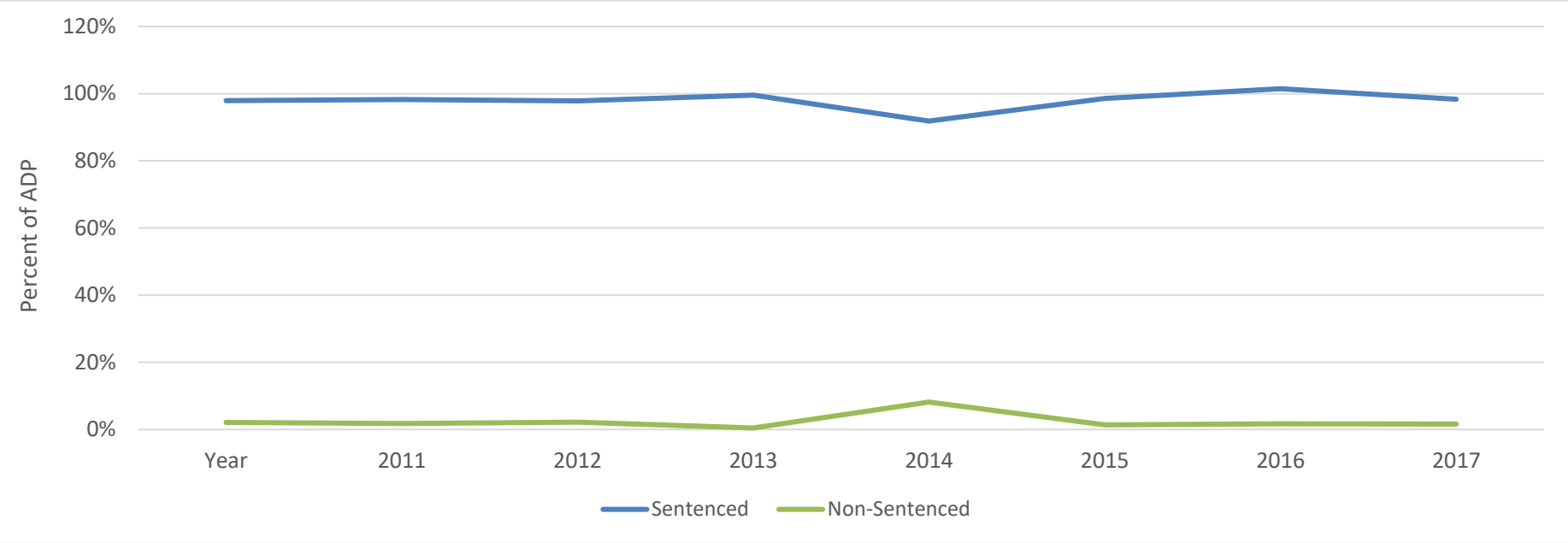


Figure 114. San Diego Work Furlough Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 115. *San Francisco County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

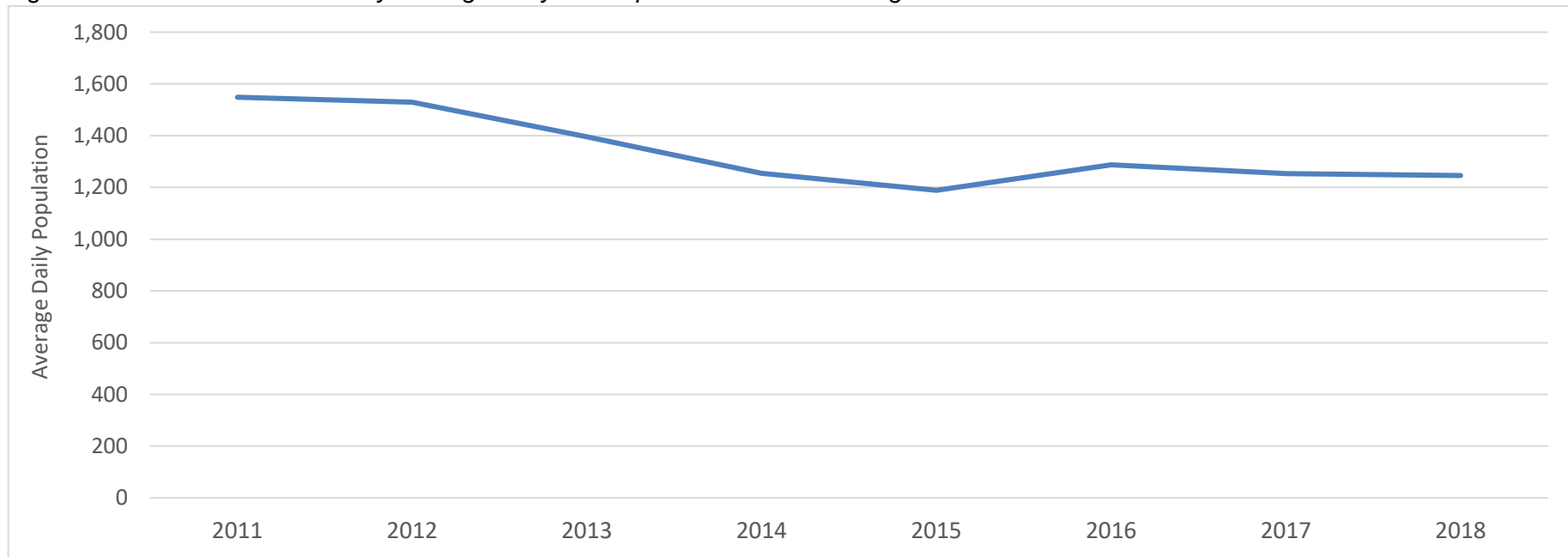




Figure 116. San Francisco County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

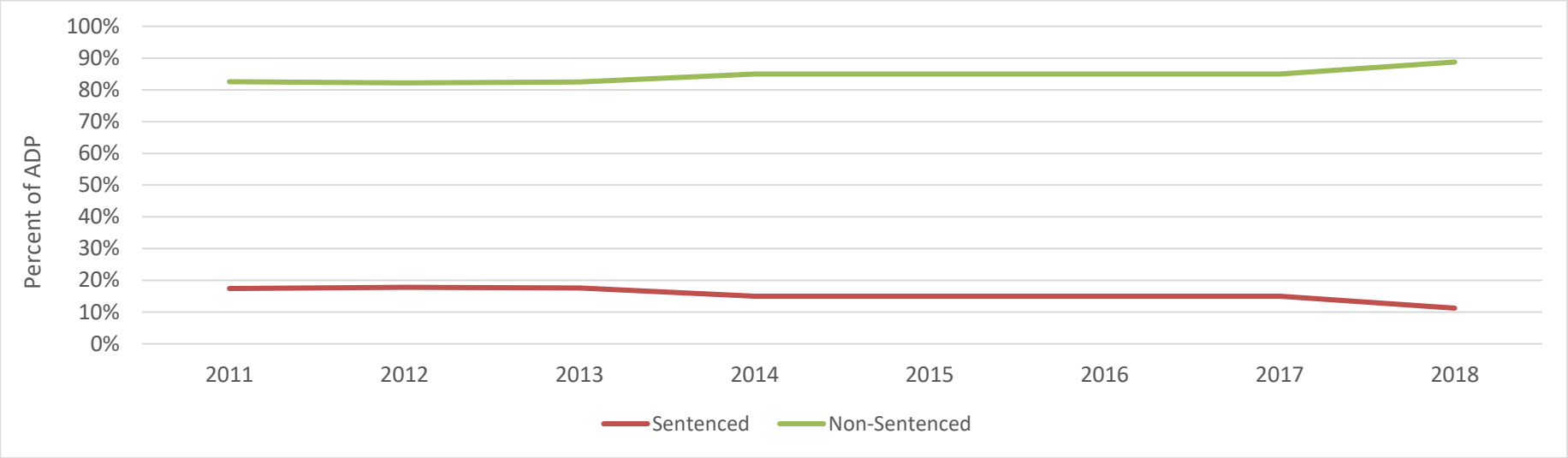
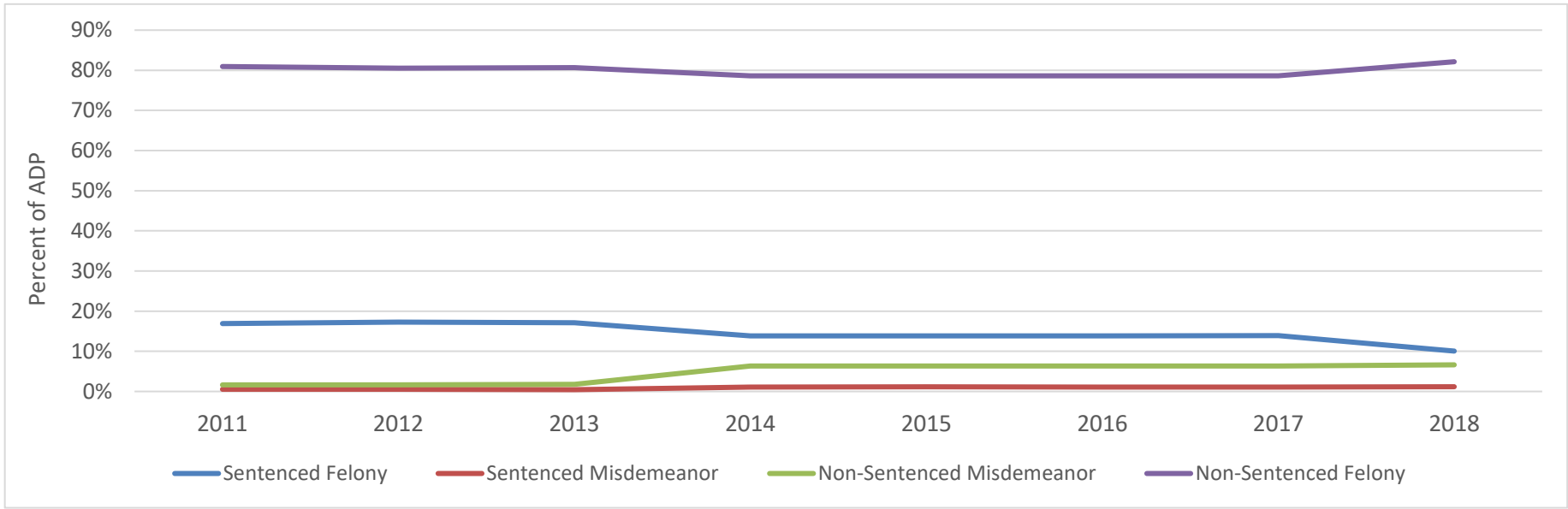


Figure 117. San Francisco County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 118. *San Joaquin County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

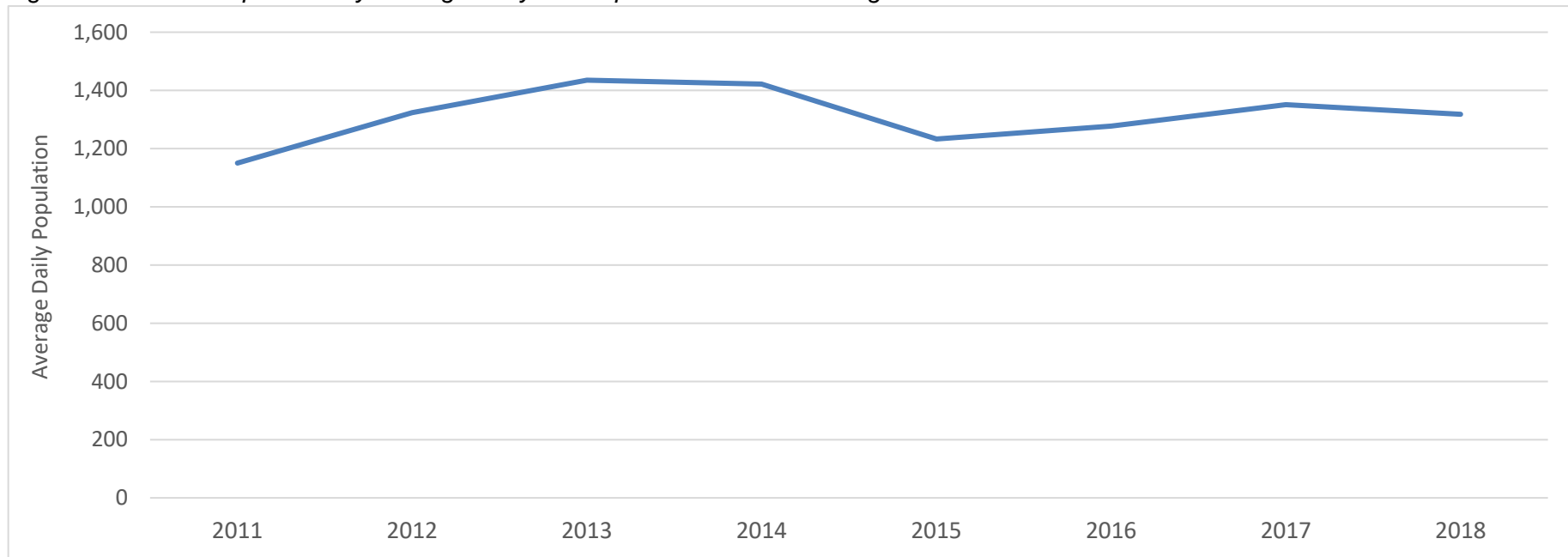


Figure 119. San Joaquin County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

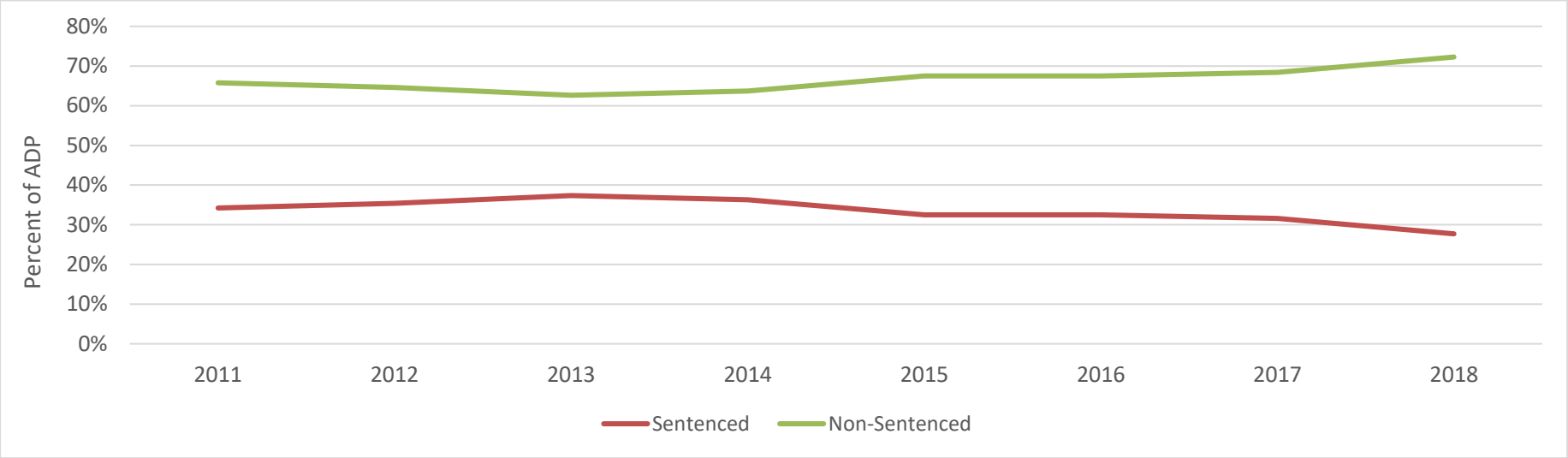
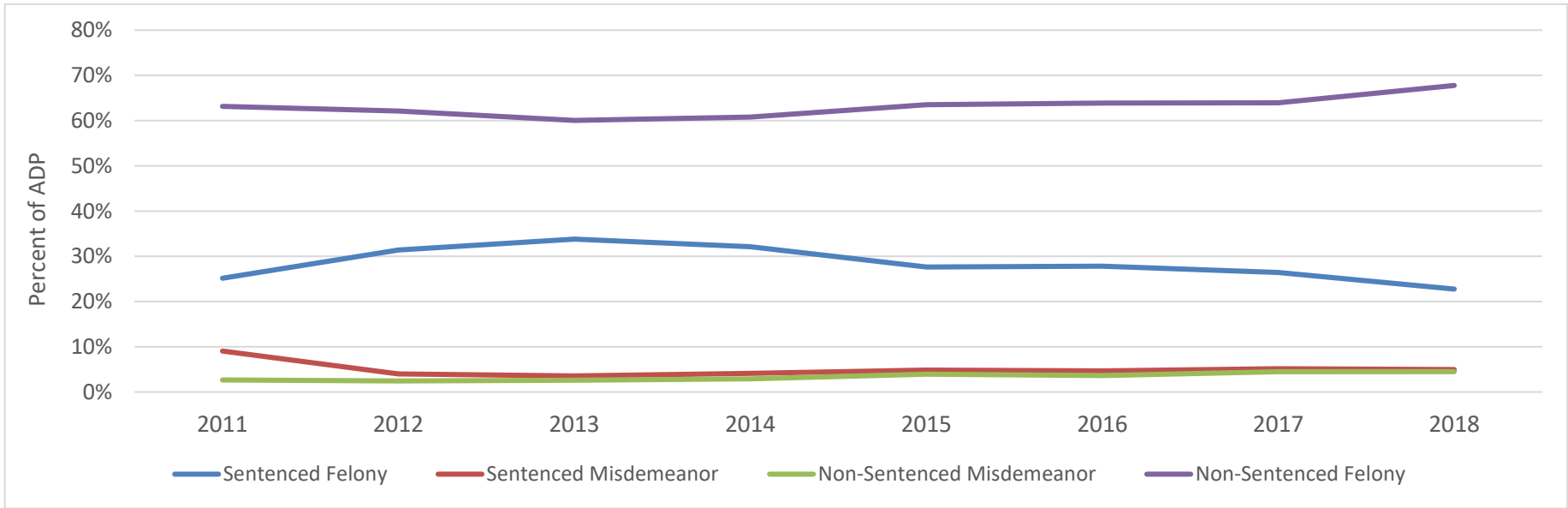


Figure 120. San Joaquin County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 121. *San Luis Obispo County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

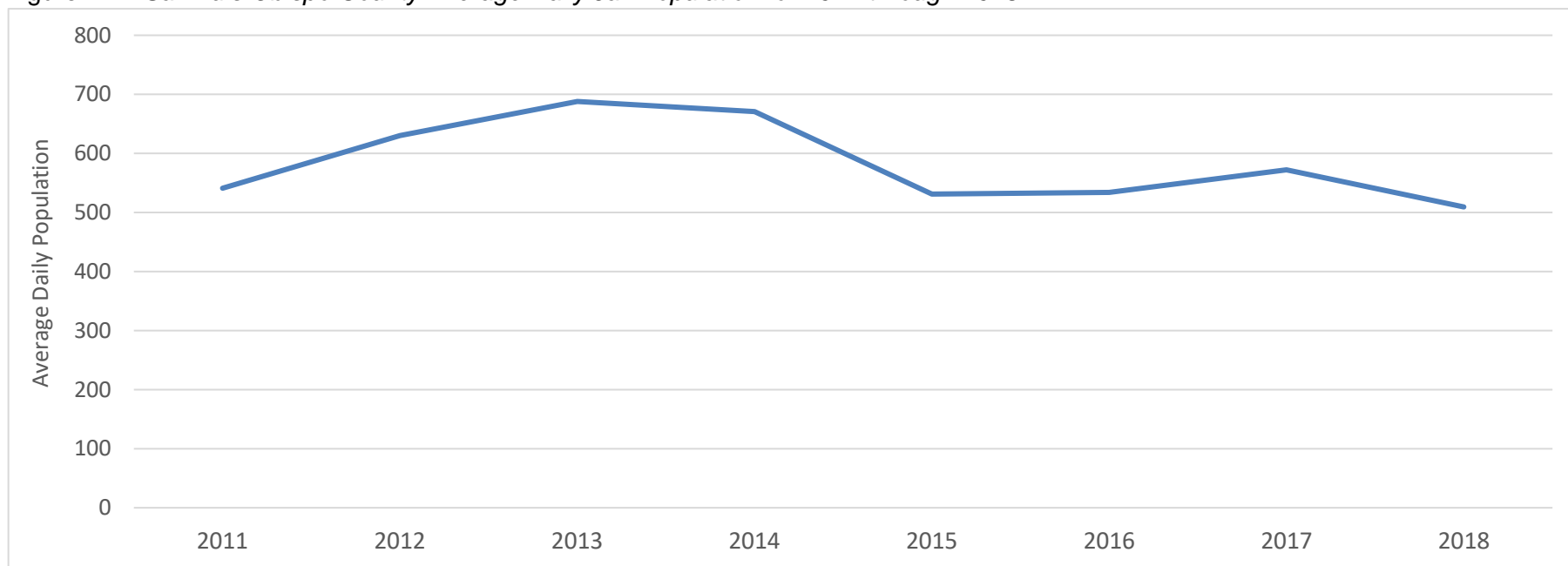


Figure 122. San Luis Obispo County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

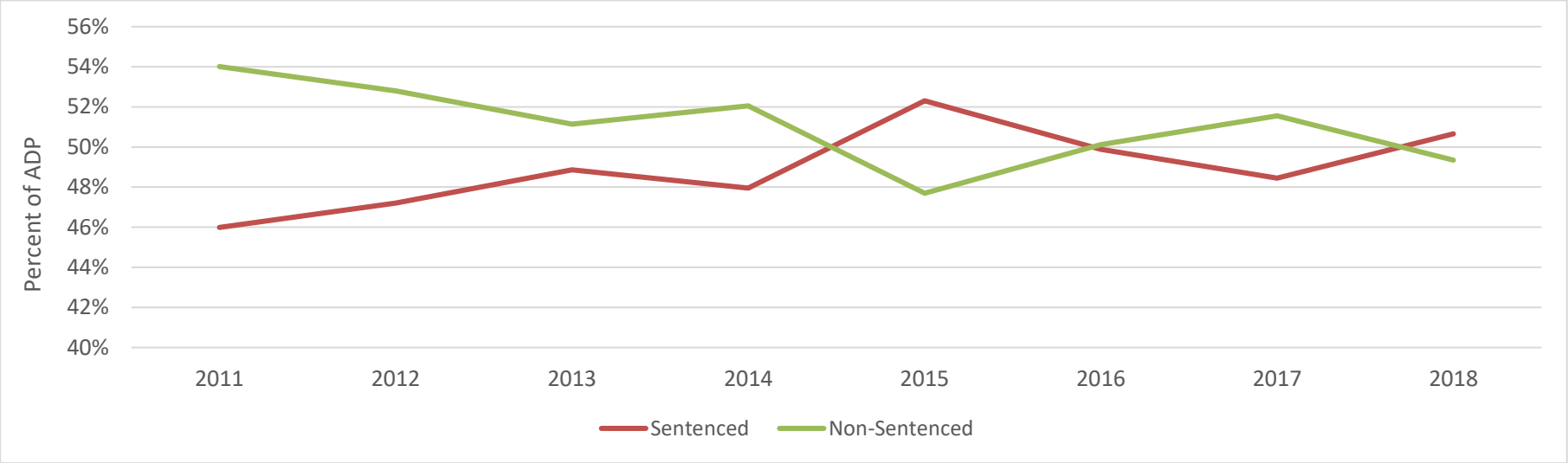
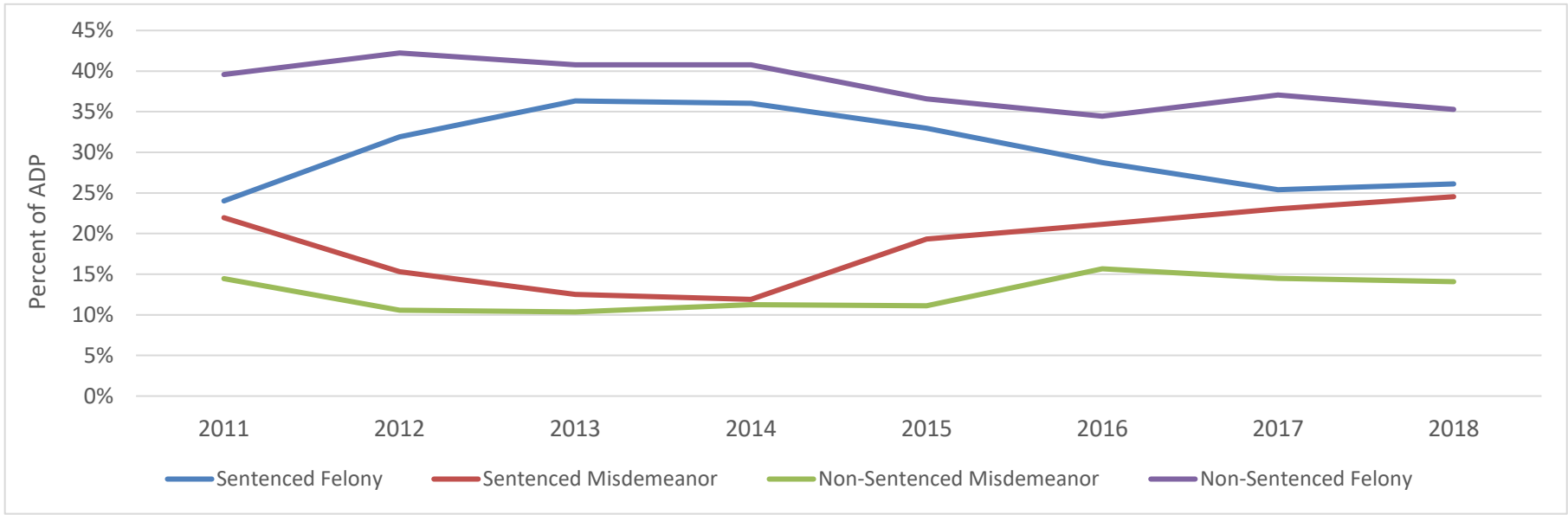


Figure 123. San Luis Obispo County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 124. *San Mateo County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

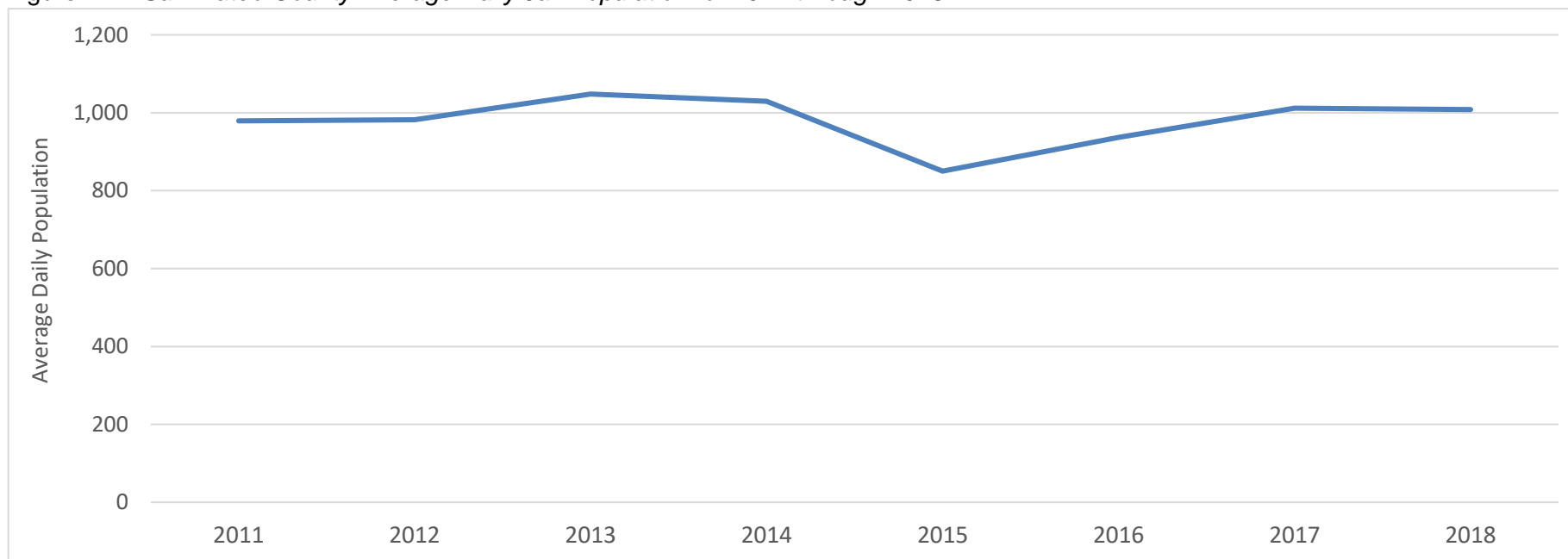


Figure 125. San Mateo County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

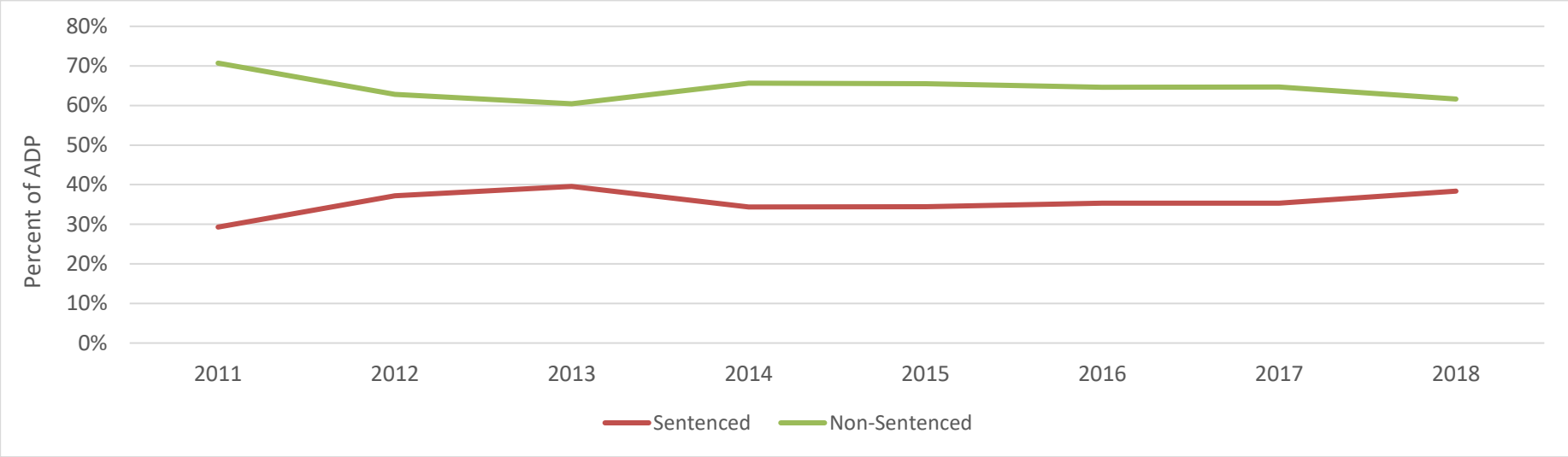
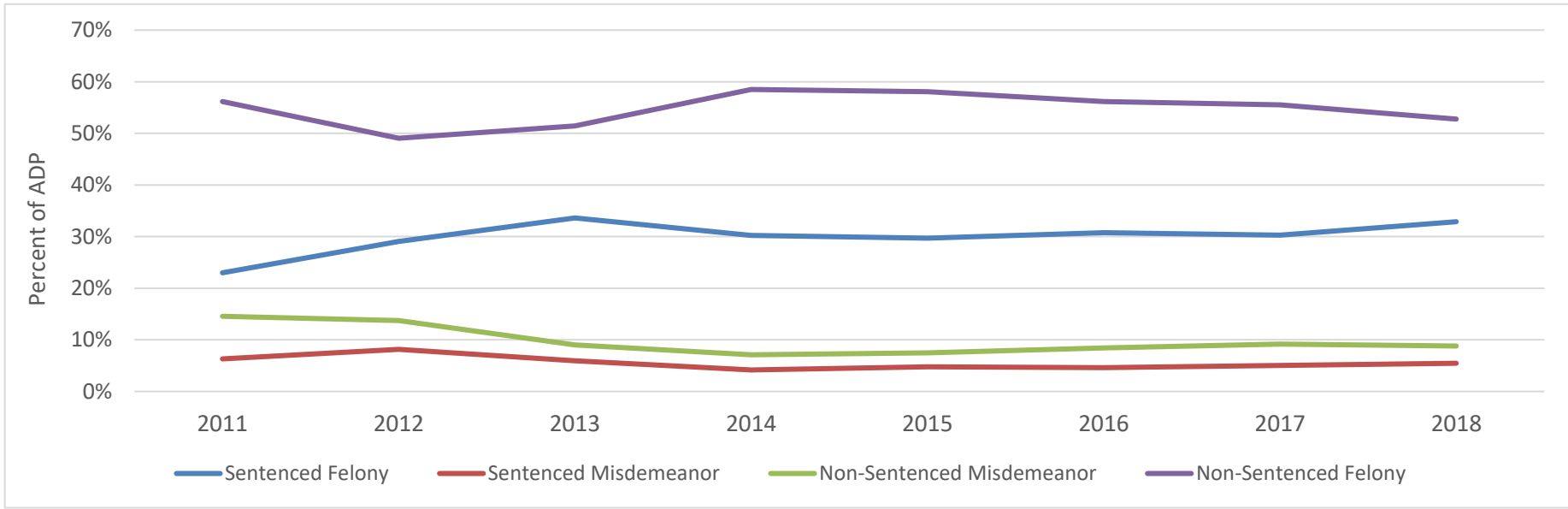


Figure 126. San Mateo County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 127. Santa Barbara County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

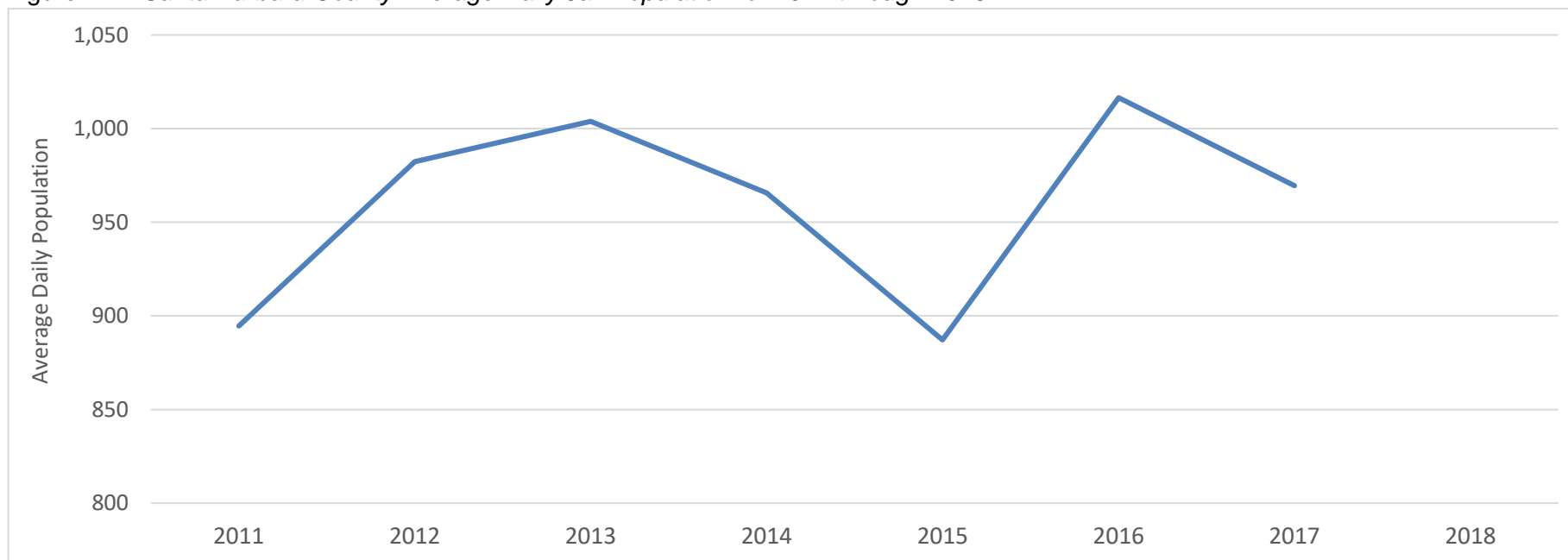
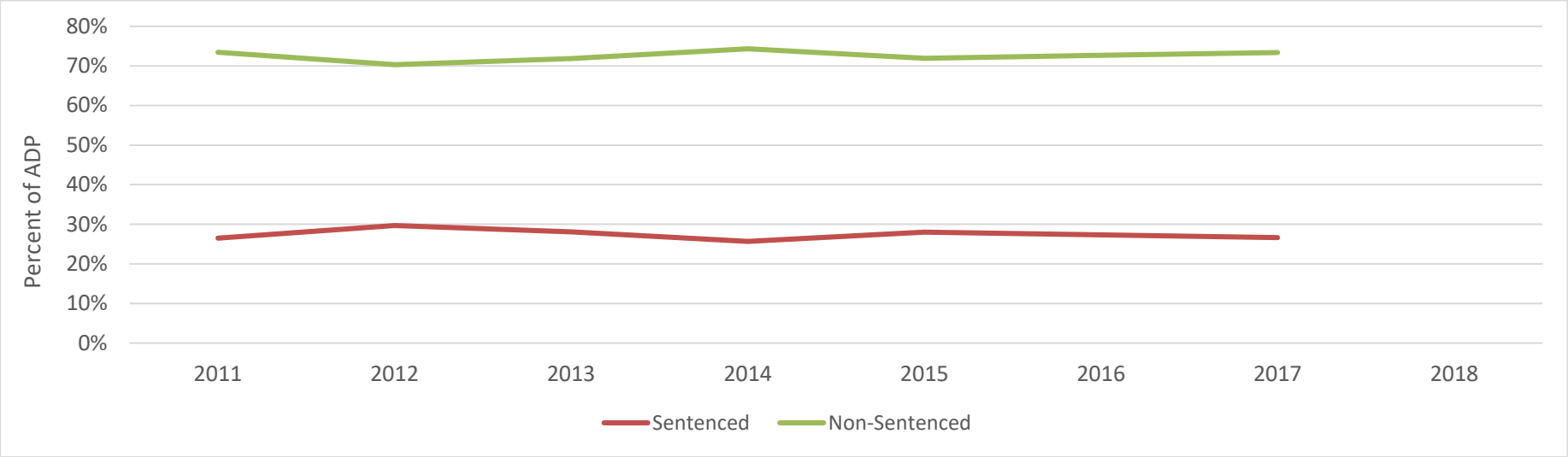




Figure 128. Santa Barbara County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 129. Santa Clara County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

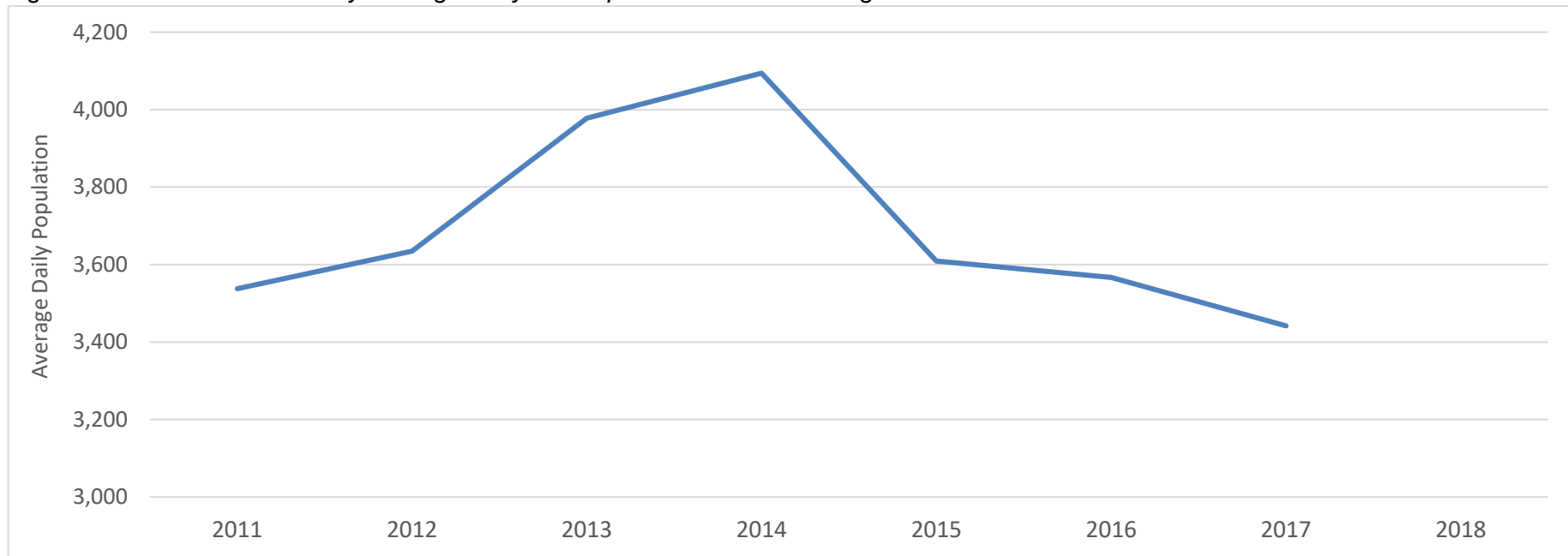


Figure 130. Santa Clara County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

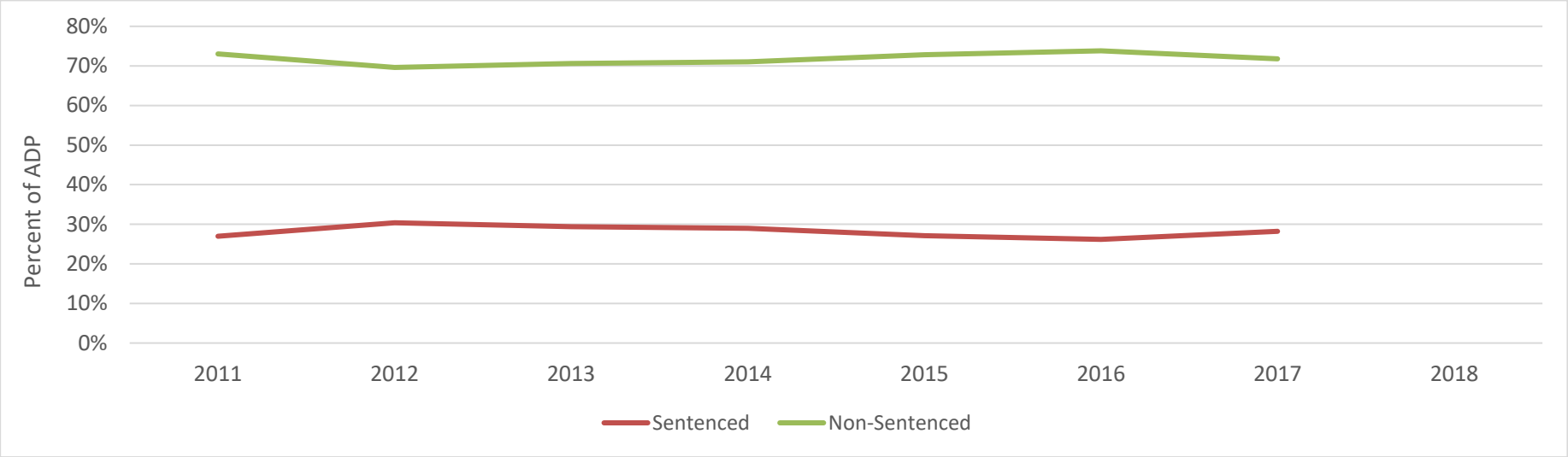
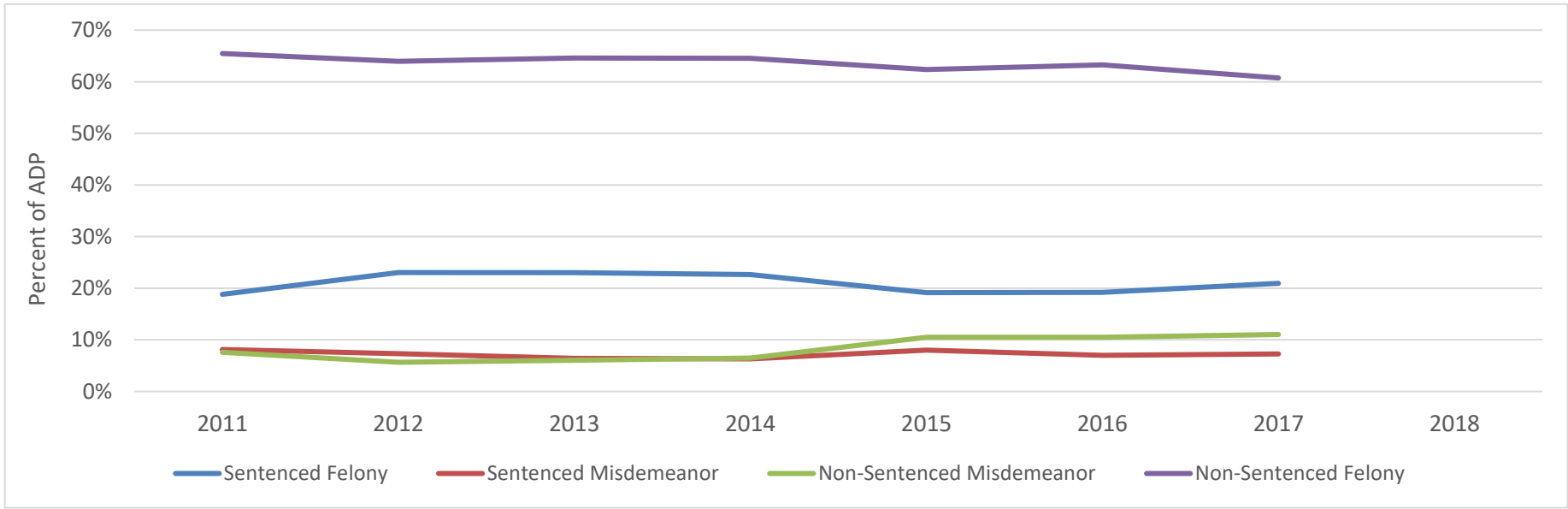


Figure 131. Santa Clara County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 132. Santa Cruz County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

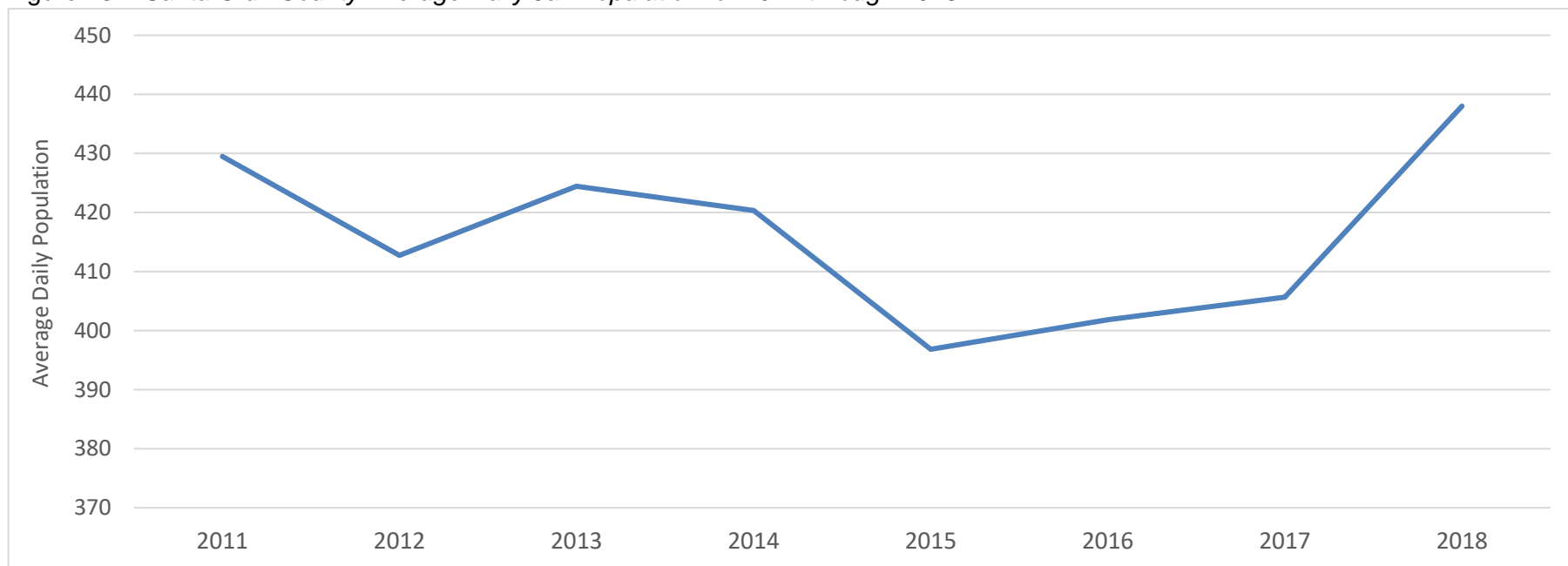


Figure 133. Santa Cruz County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

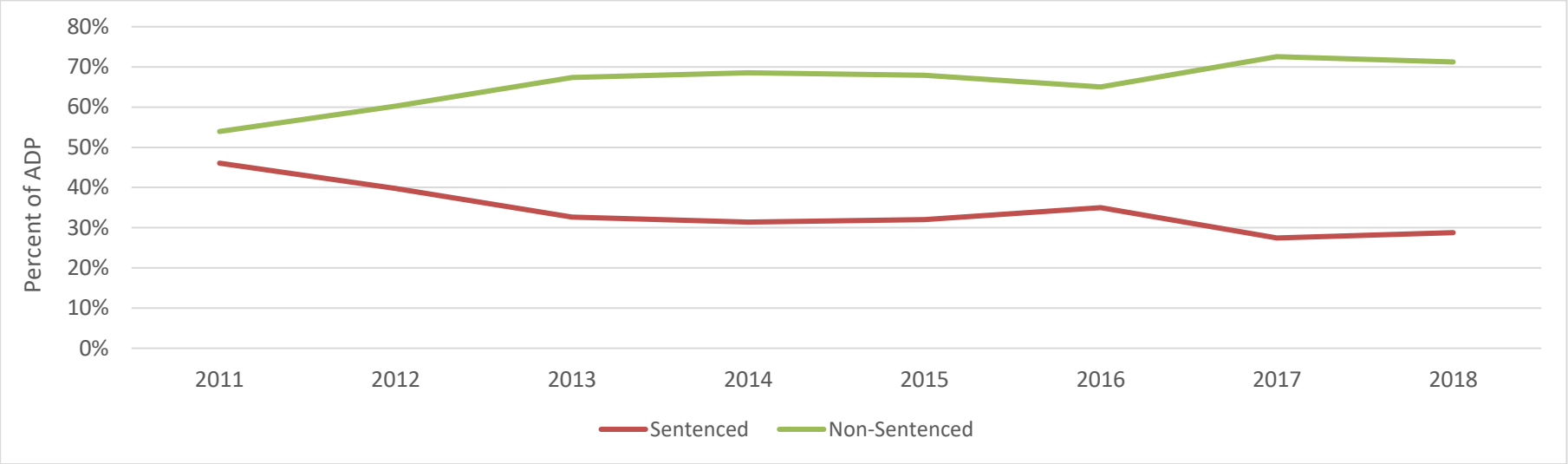
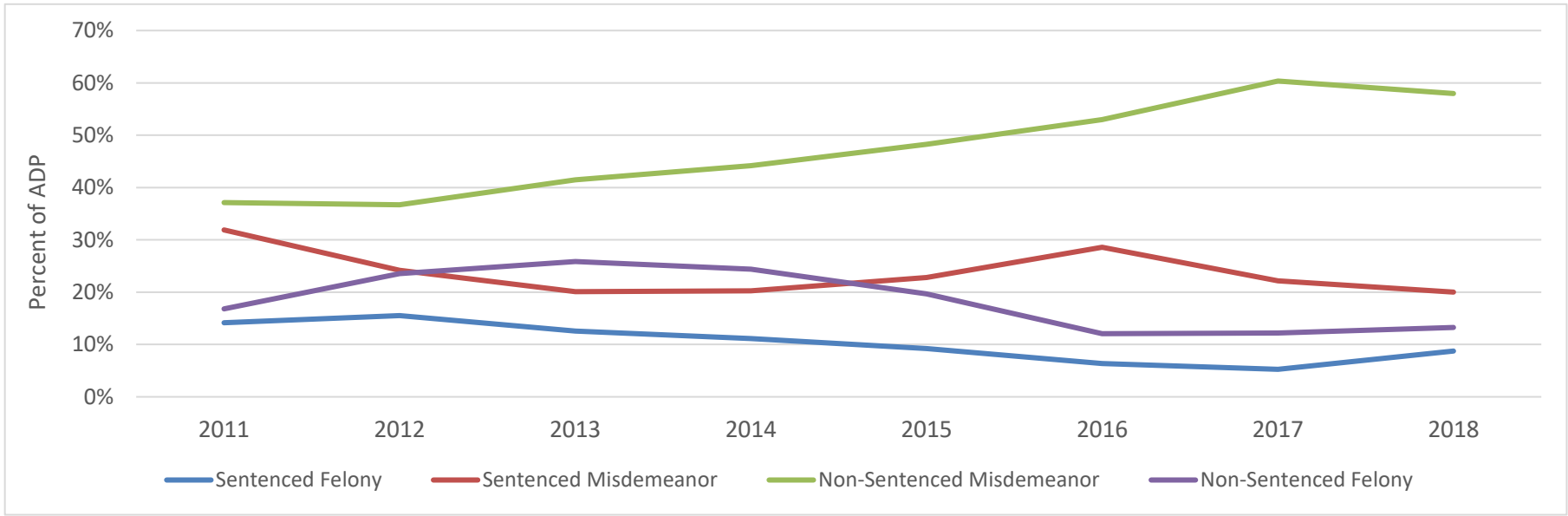


Figure 134. Santa Cruz County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 135. *Shasta County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

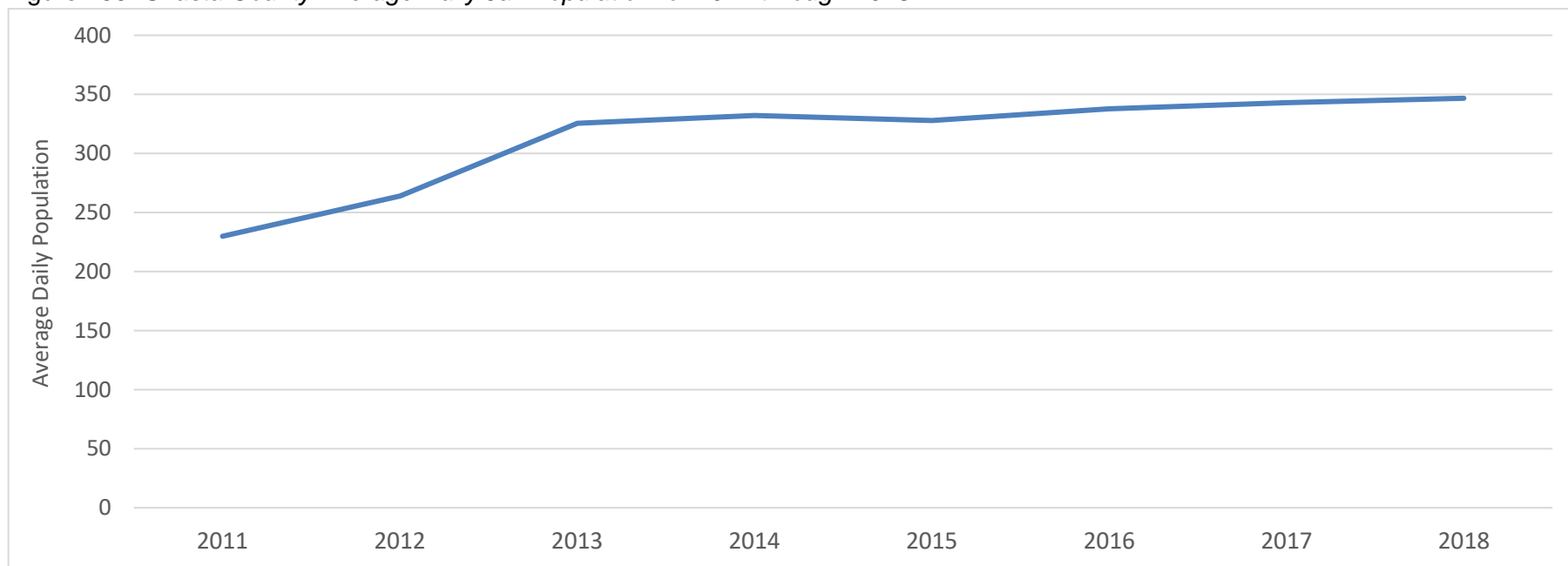


Figure 136. Shasta County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

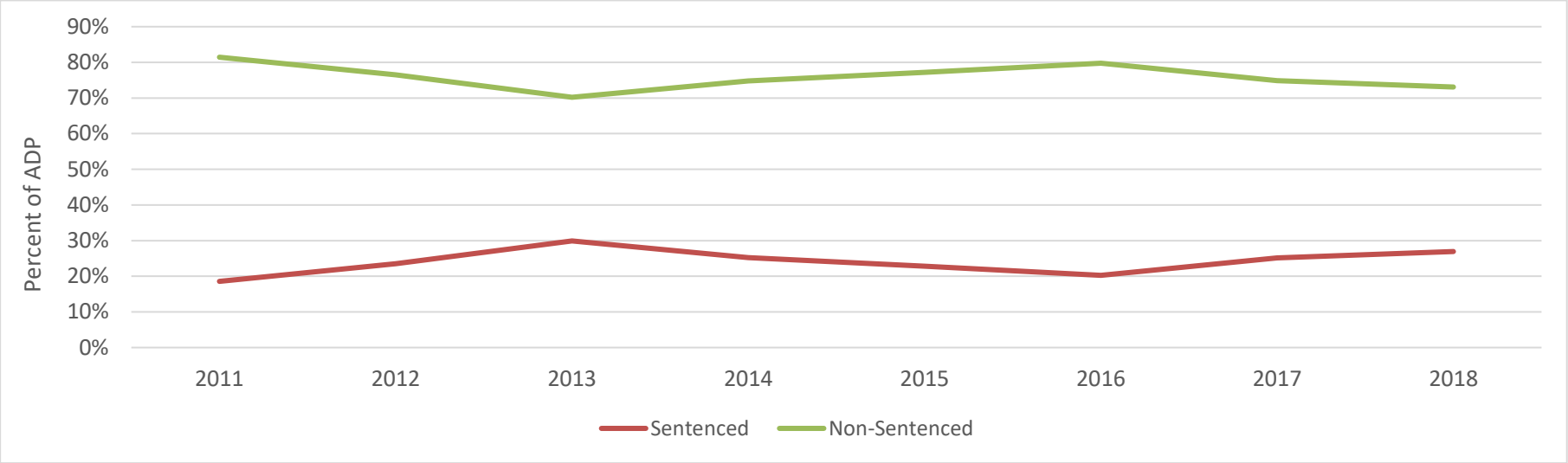
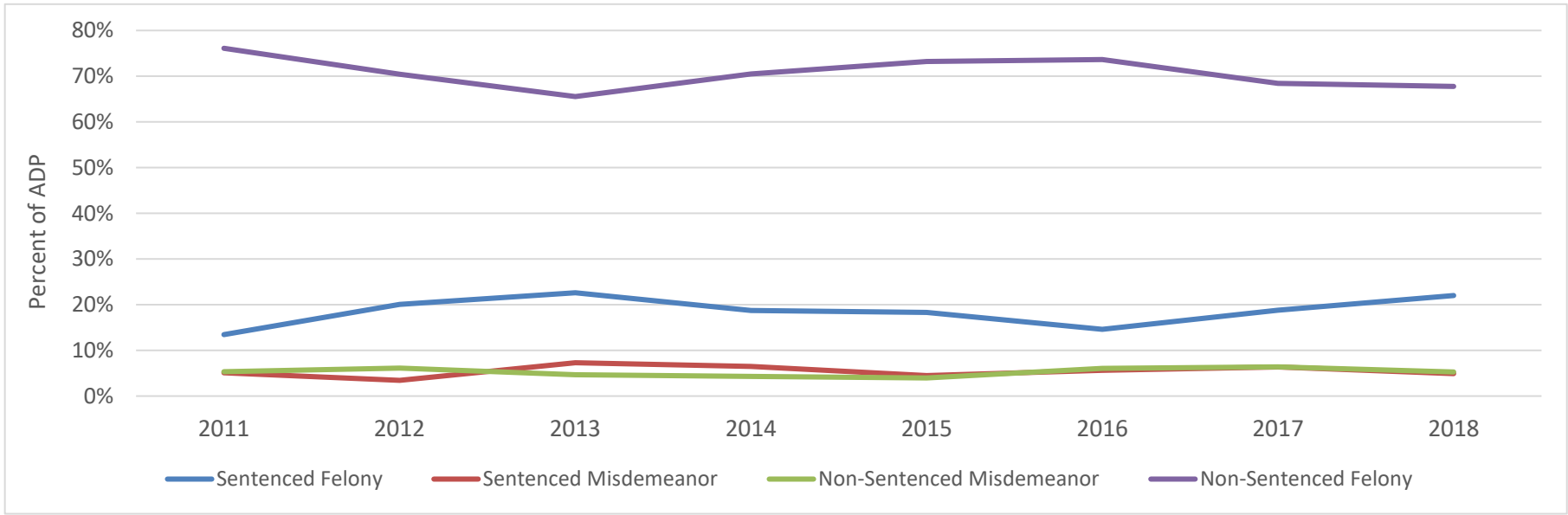


Figure 137. Shasta County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 138. Siskiyou County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

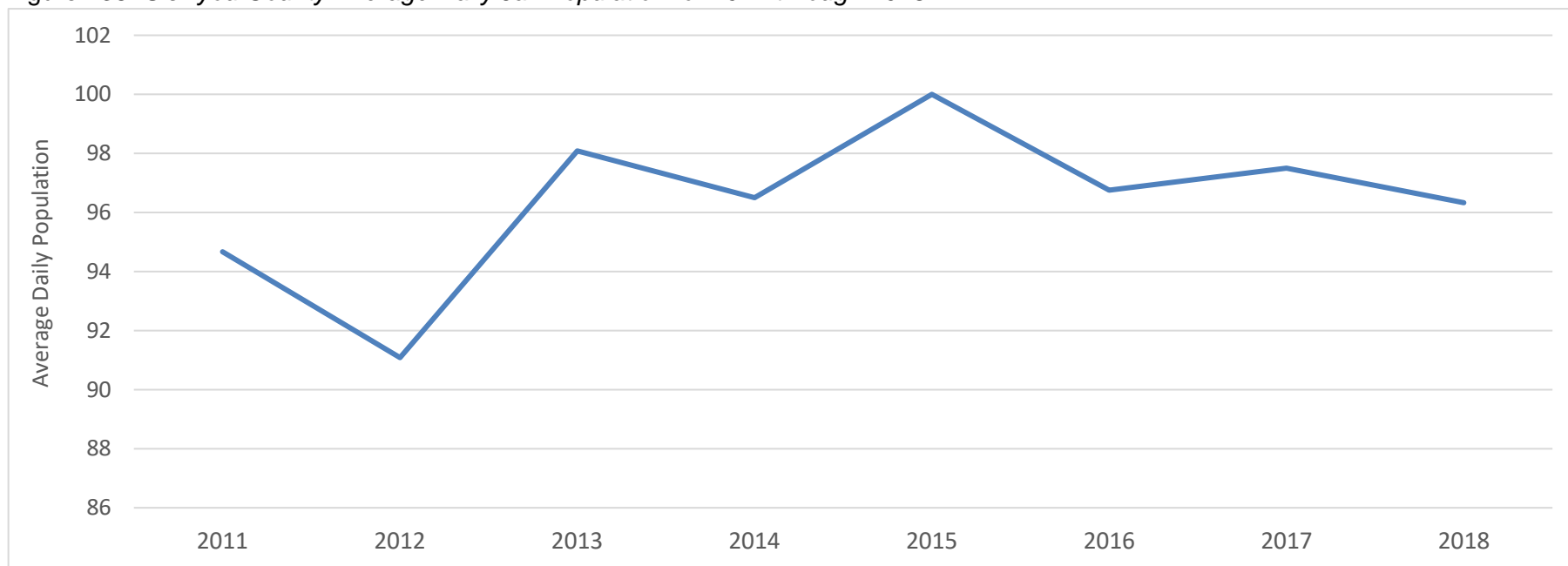




Figure 139. Siskiyou County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

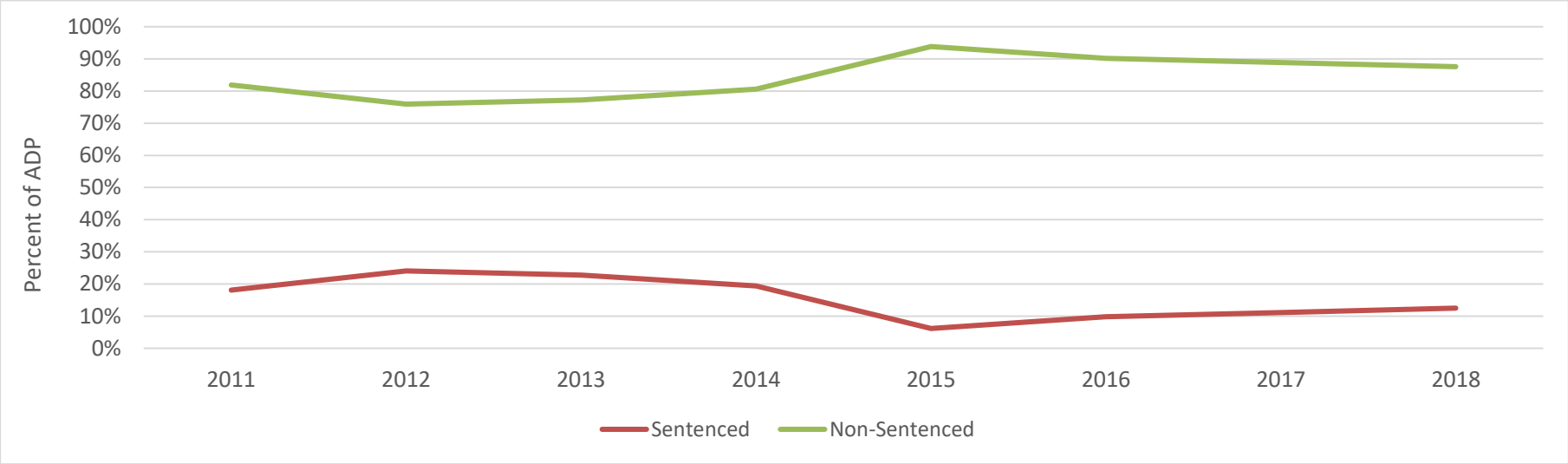
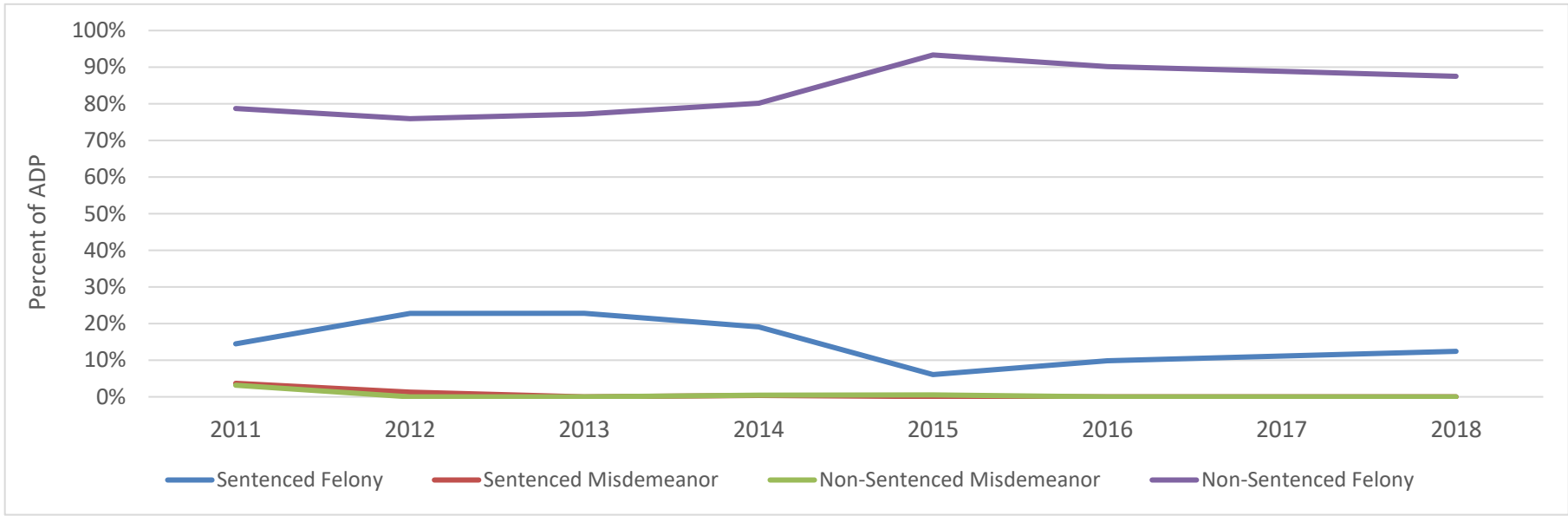


Figure 140. Siskiyou County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 141. Solano County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

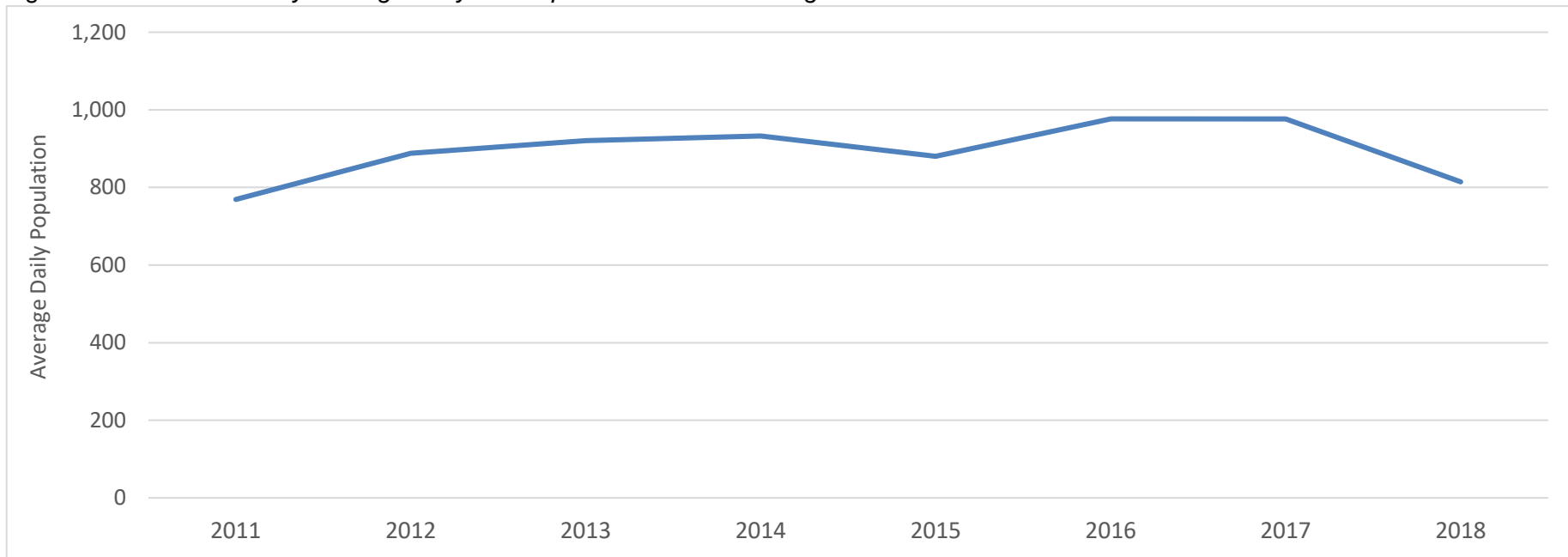


Figure 142. Solano County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

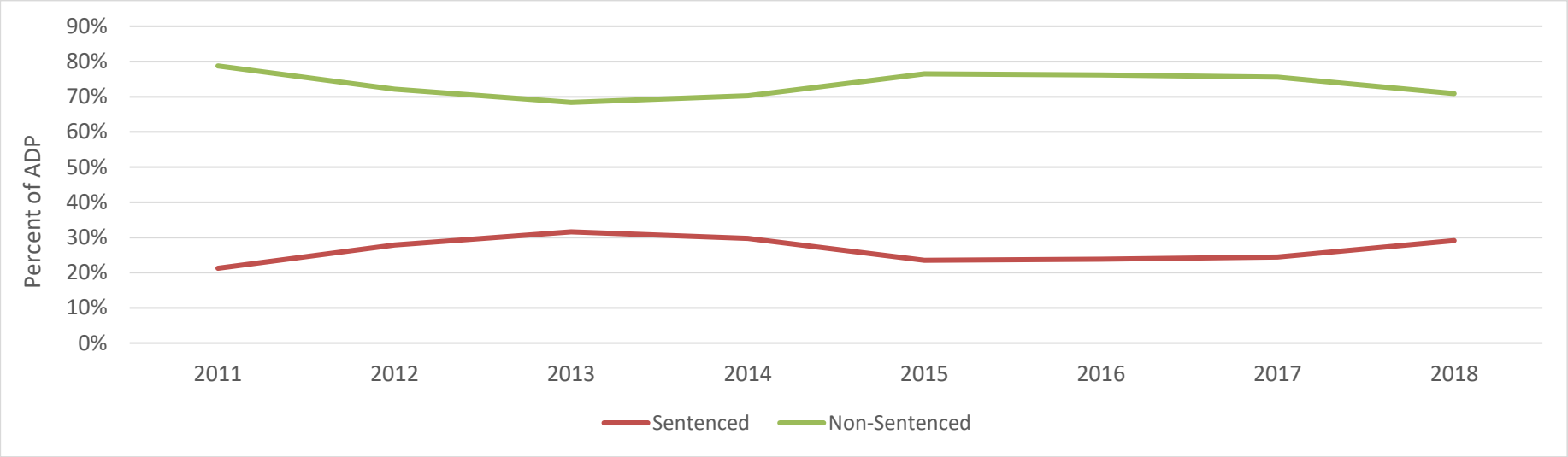
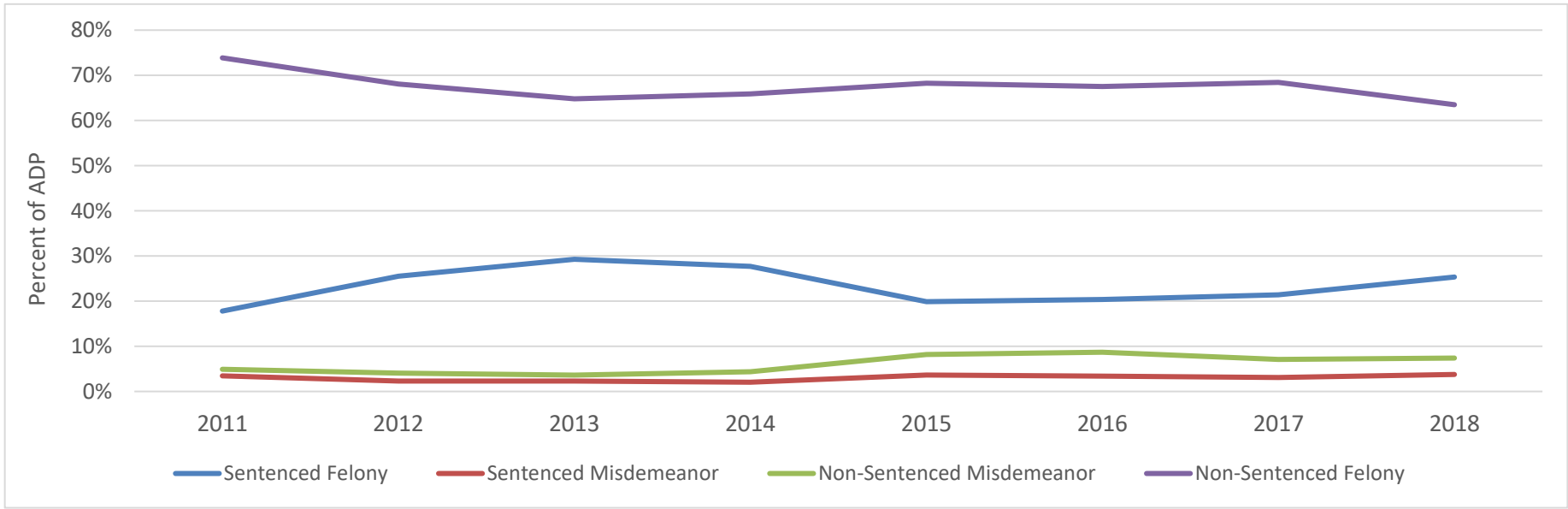


Figure 143. Solano County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 144. Sonoma County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018 <sup>1</sup>

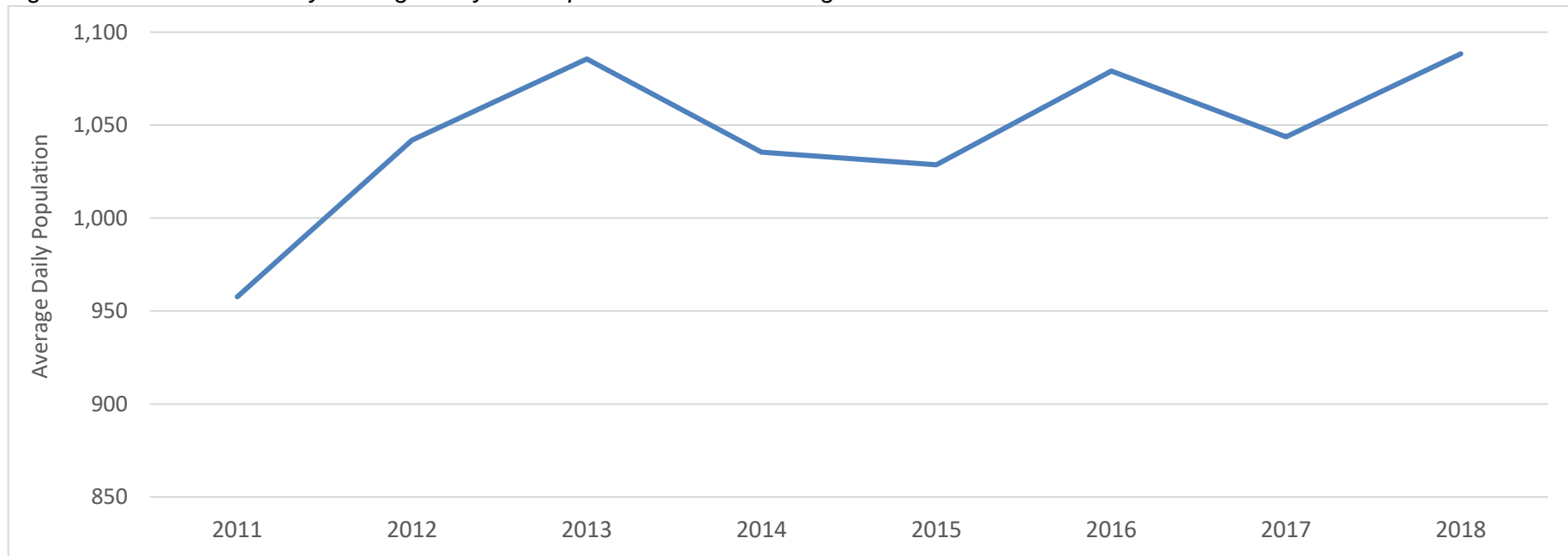


Figure 145. Sonoma County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

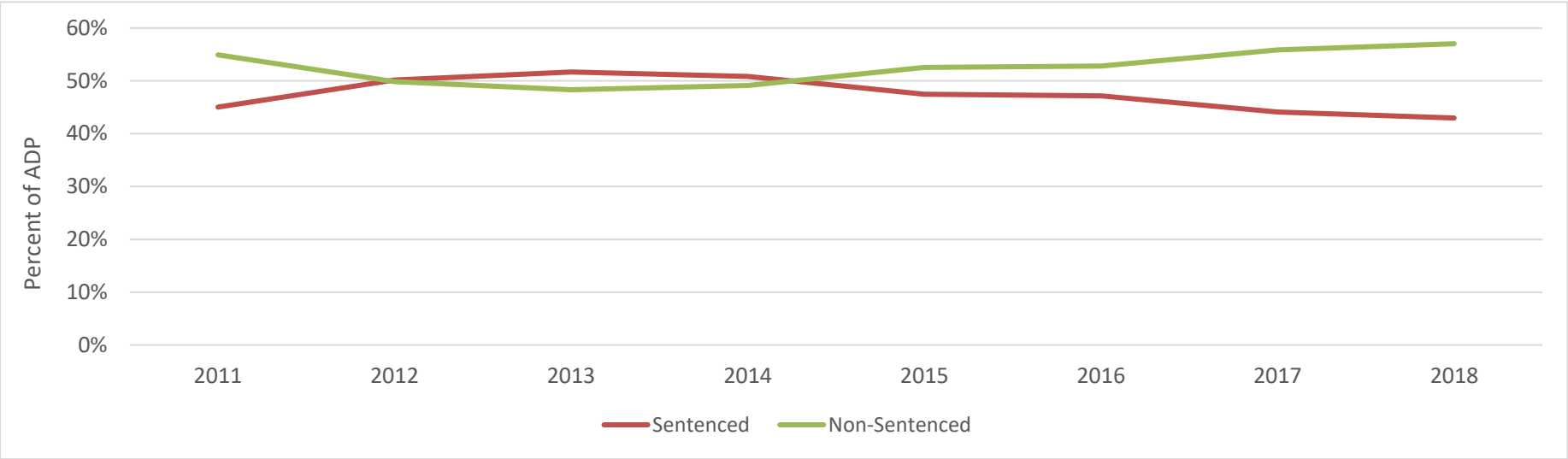
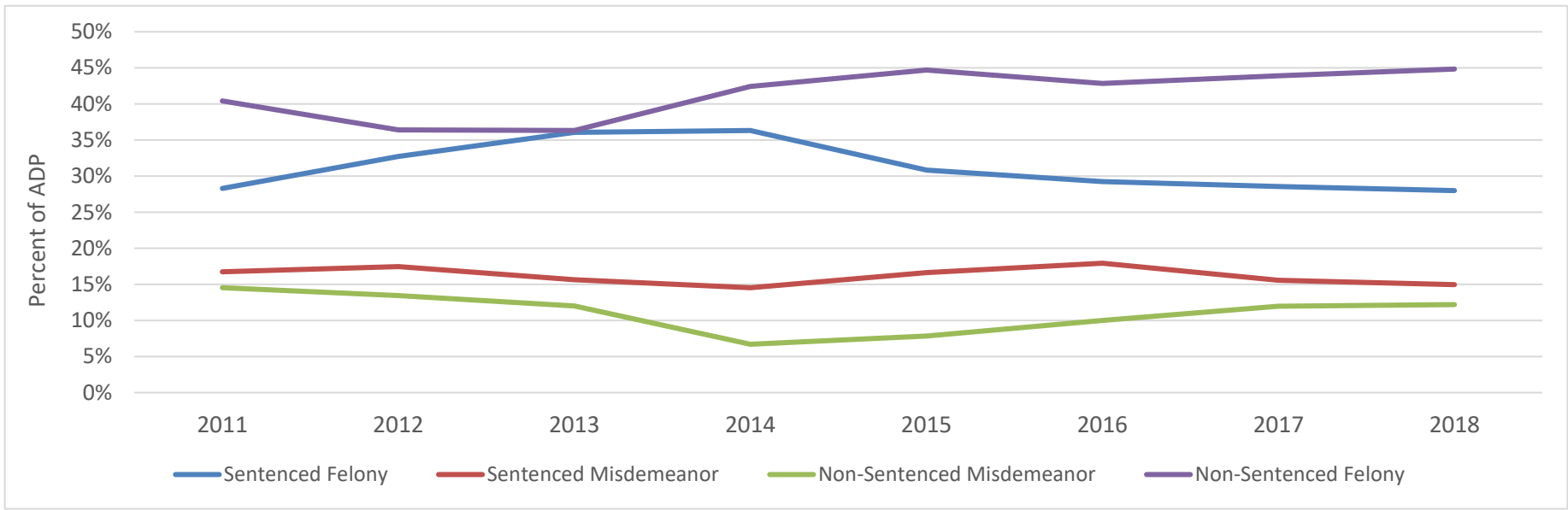


Figure 146. Sonoma County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 147. Stanislaus County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

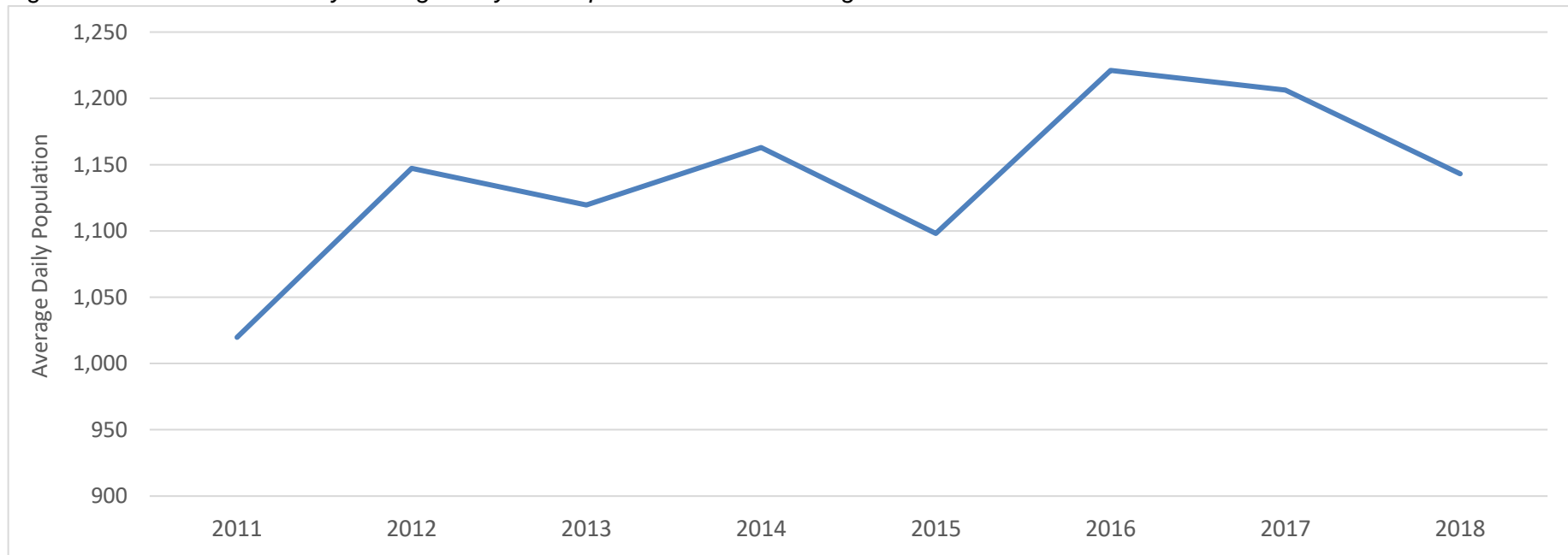


Figure 148. Stanislaus County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

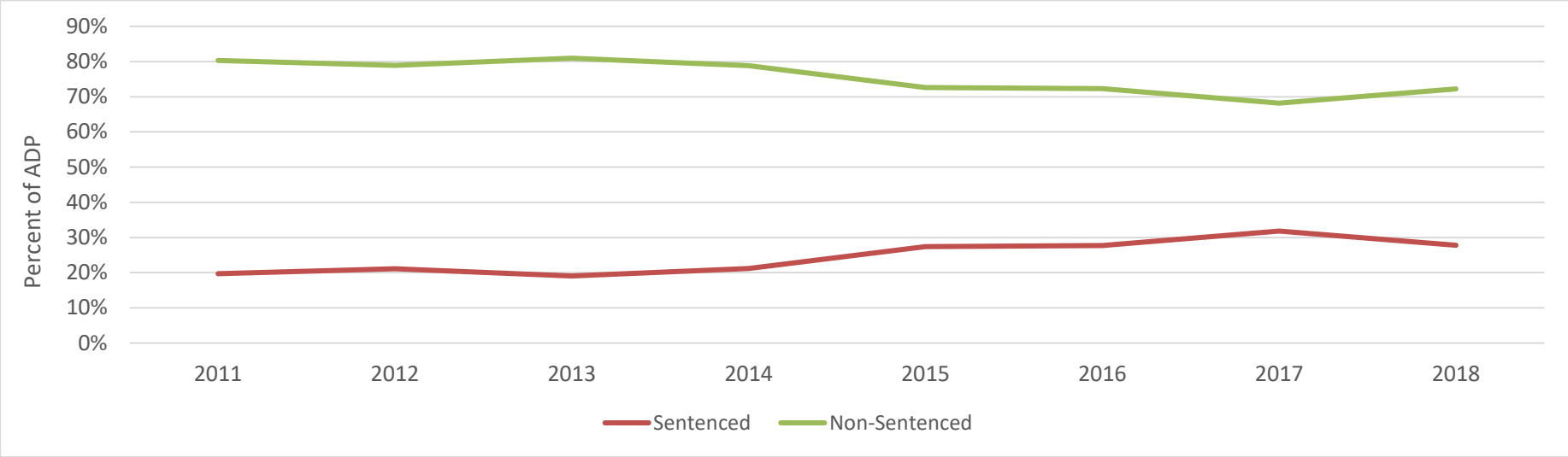
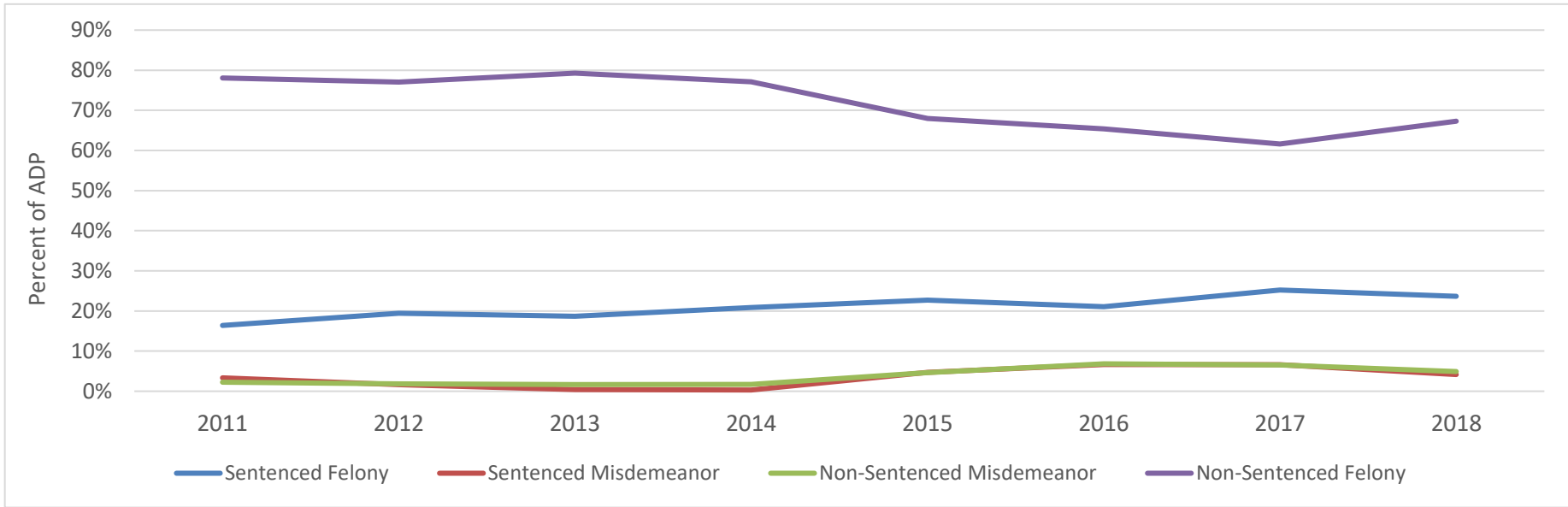


Figure 149. Stanislaus County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 150. Sutter County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

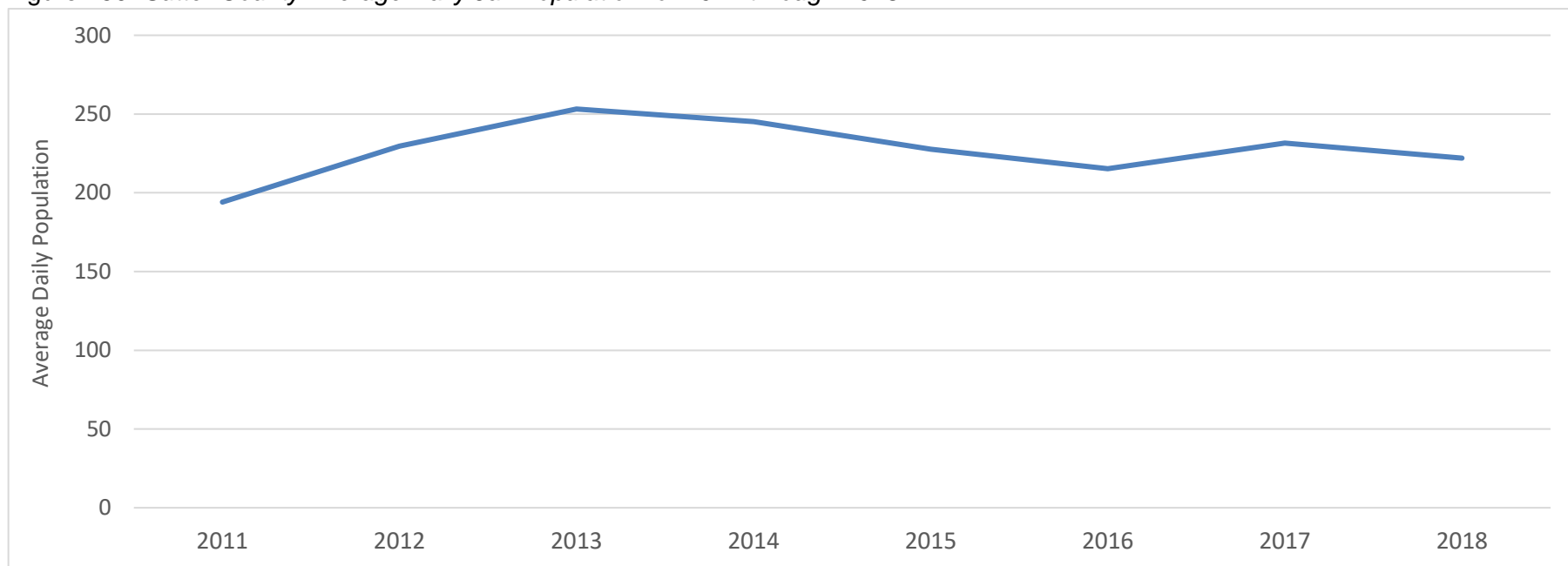




Figure 151. Sutter County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

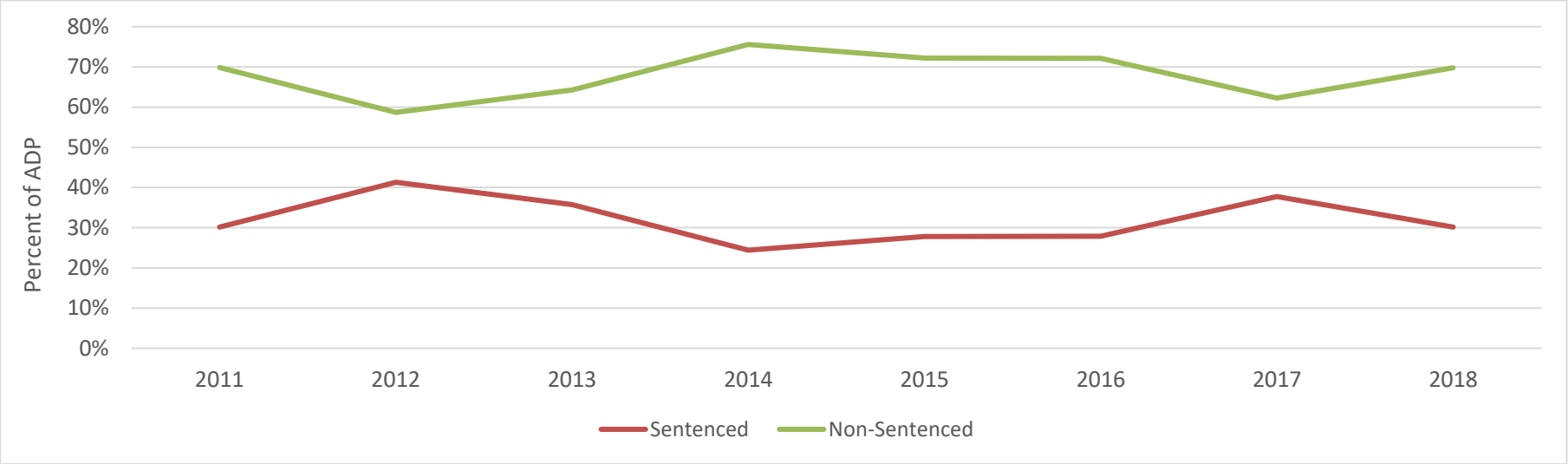
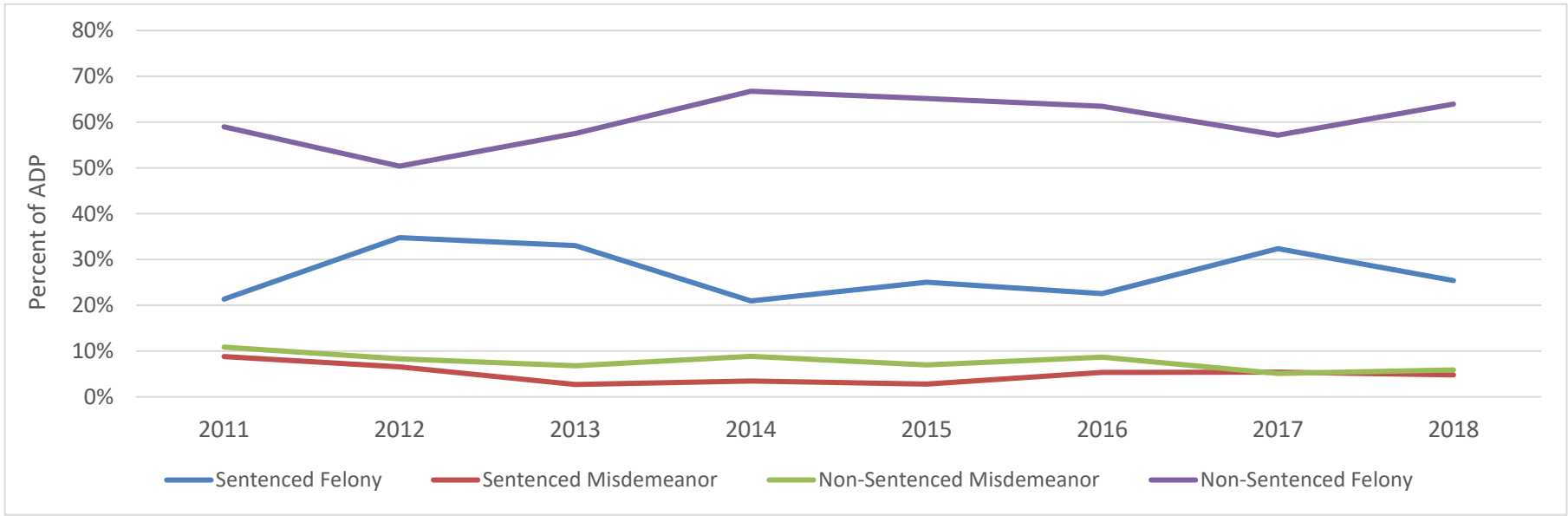


Figure 152. Sutter County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 153. Tehama County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018 <sup>1</sup>

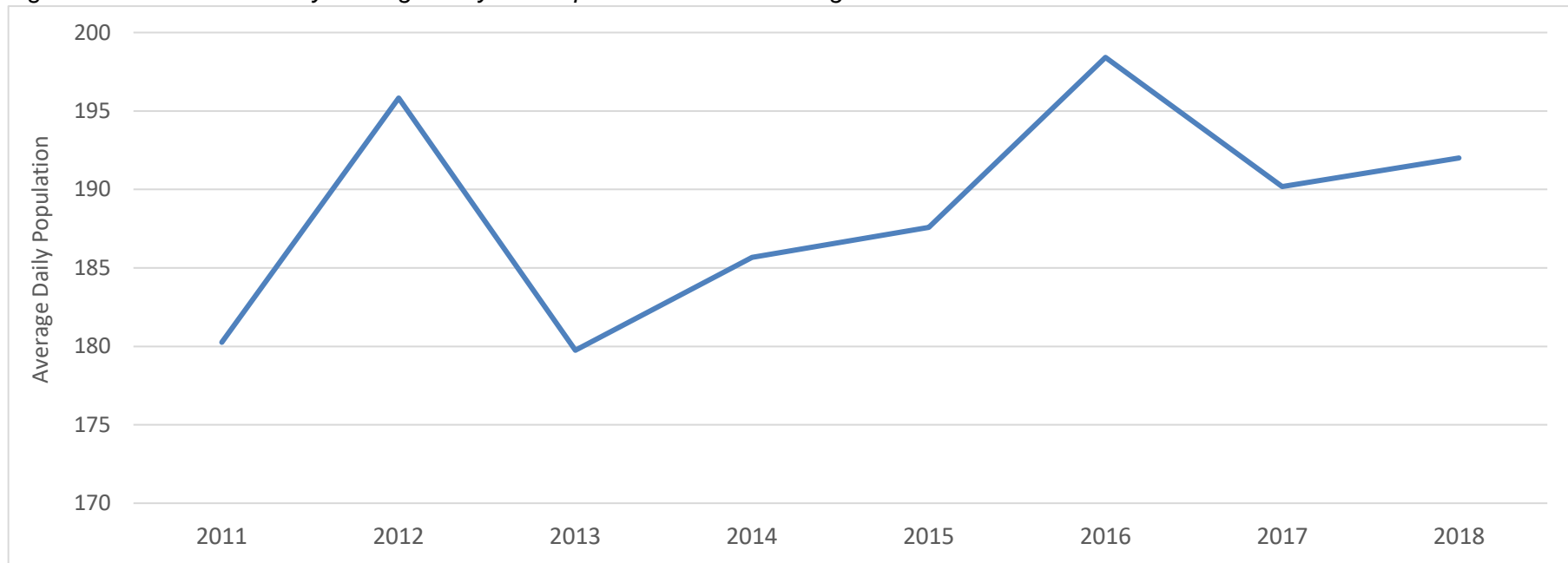
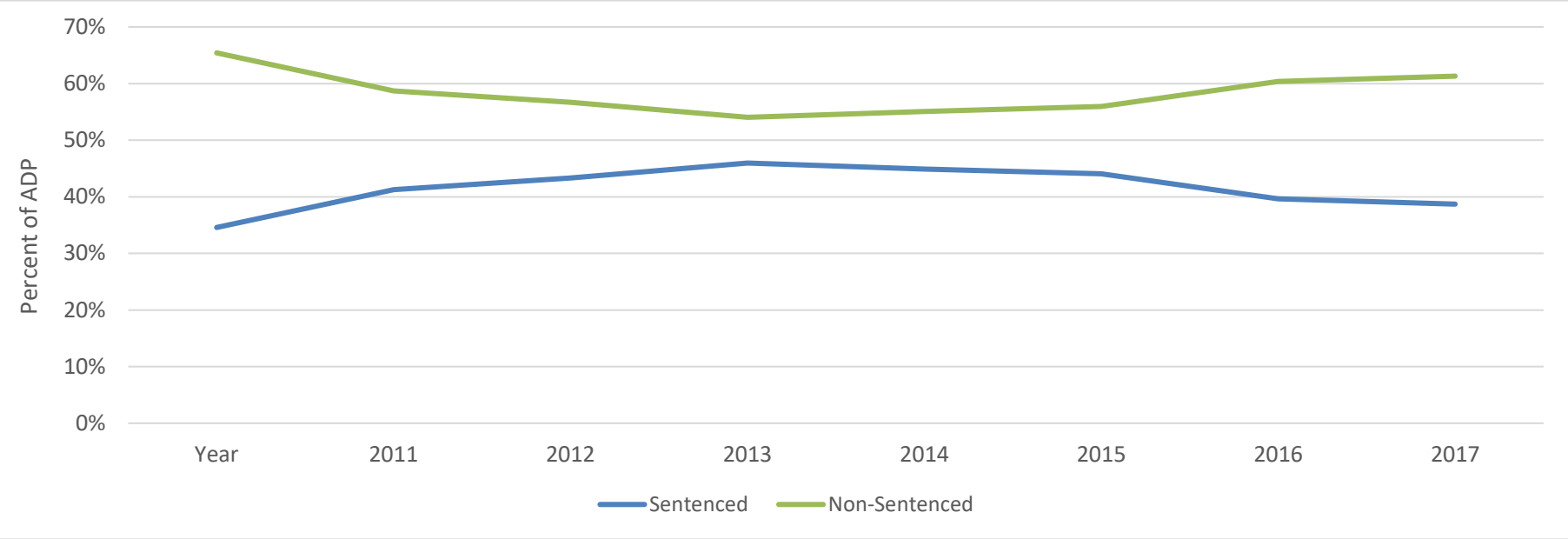


Figure 154. Tehama County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 155. Trinity County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

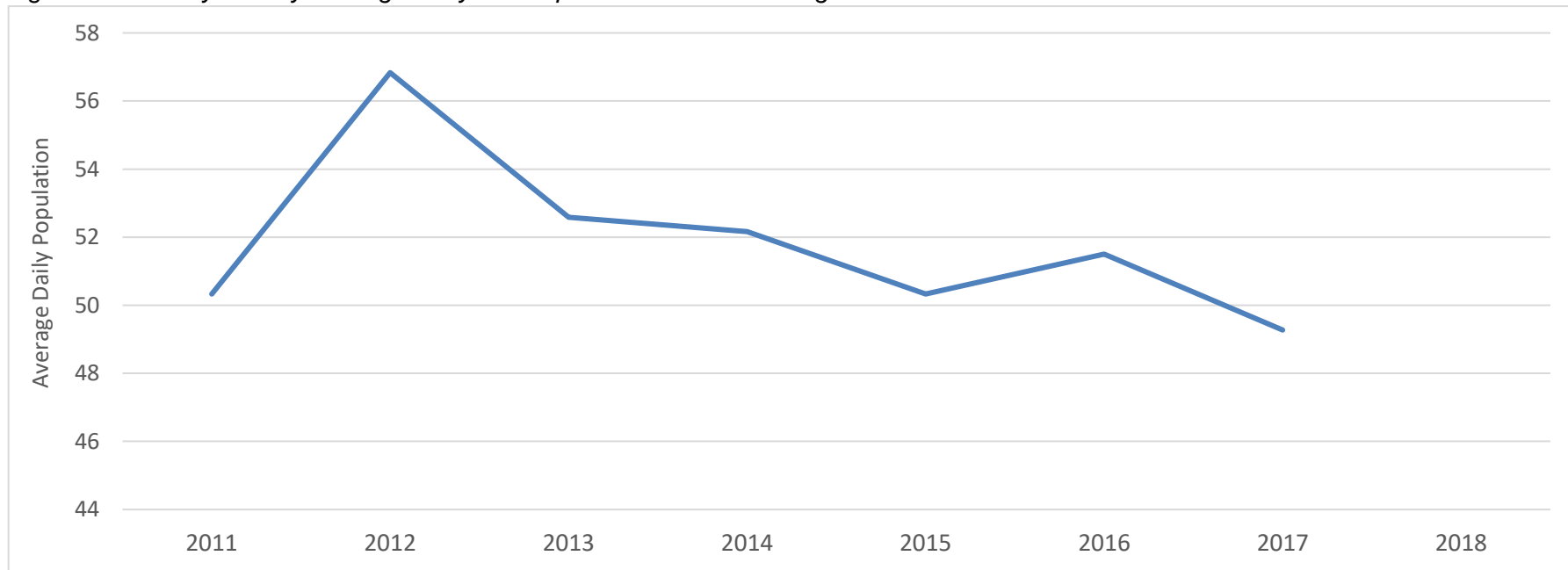


Figure 156. Trinity County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

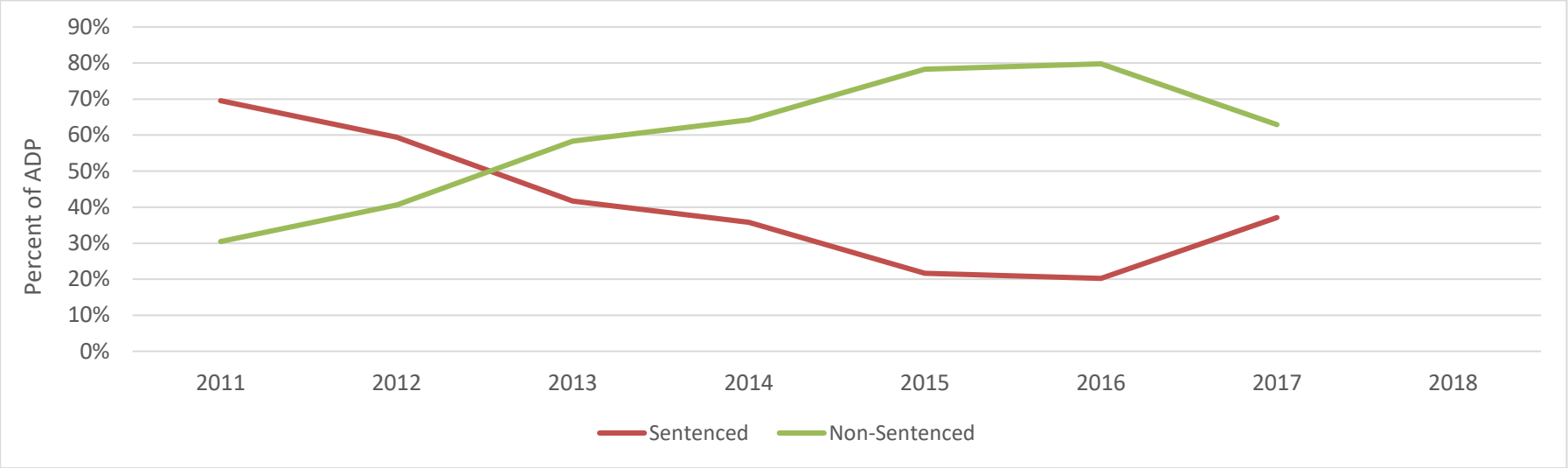
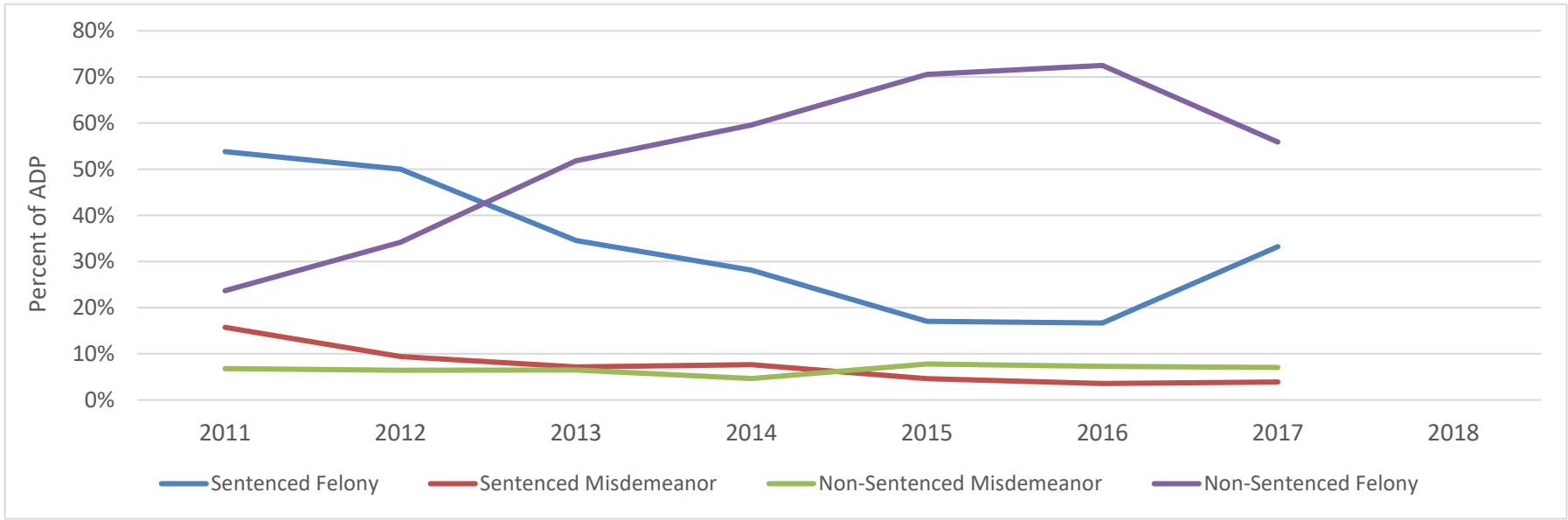


Figure 157. Trinity County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 158. Tulare County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

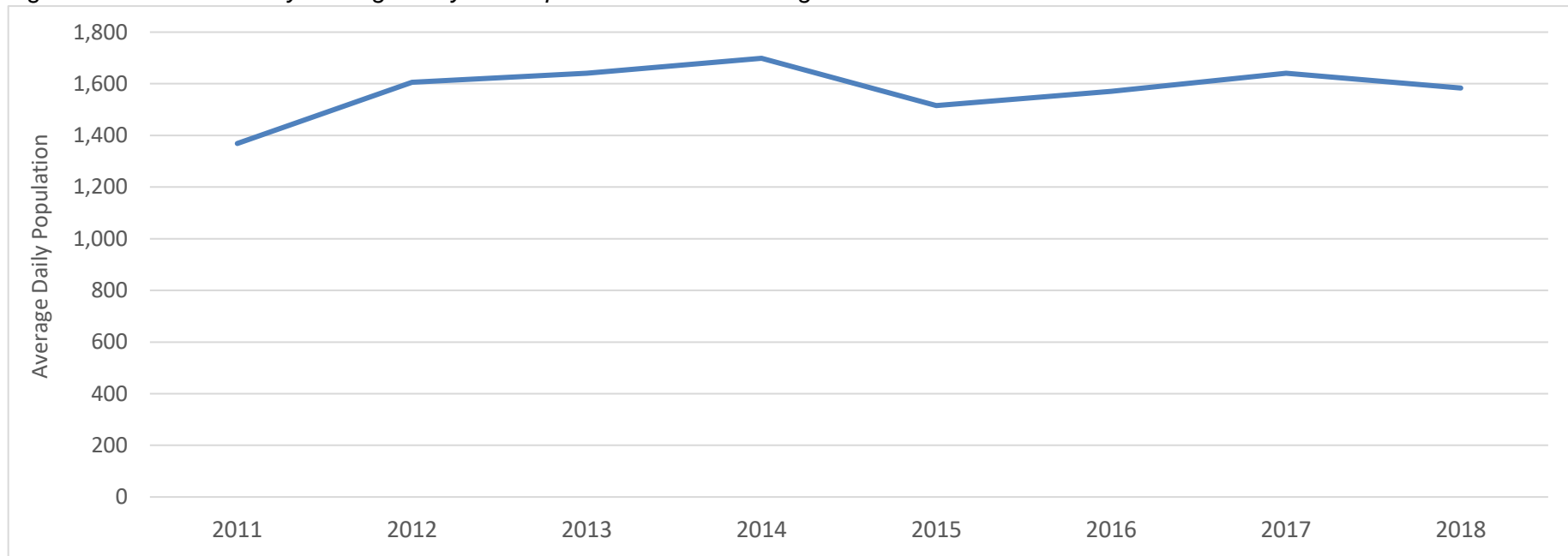


Figure 159. Tulare County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

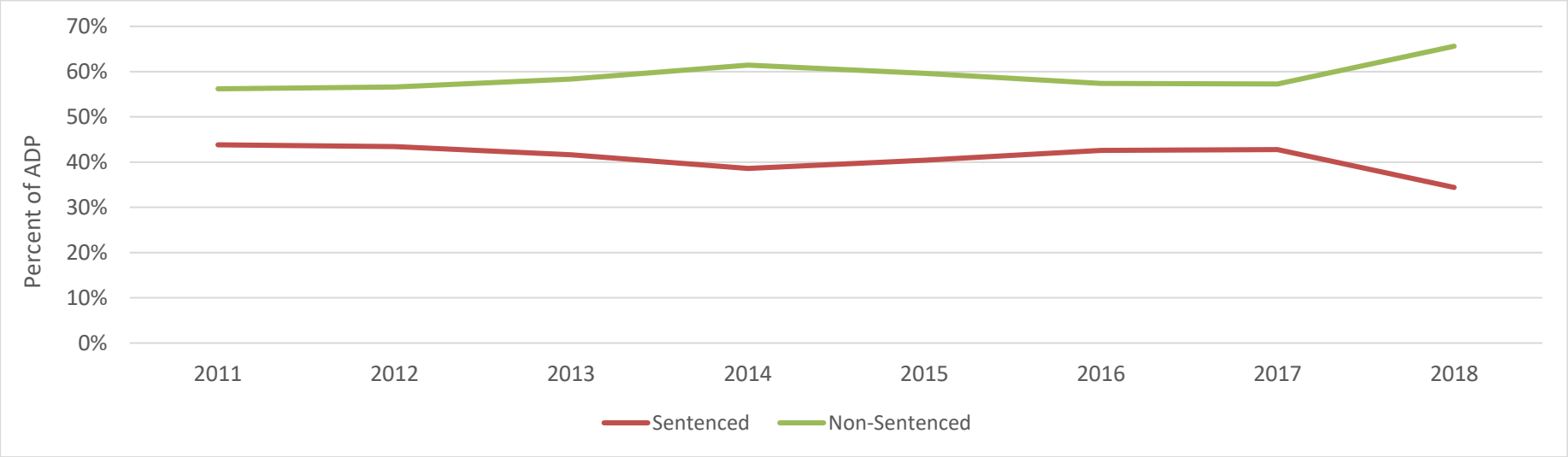
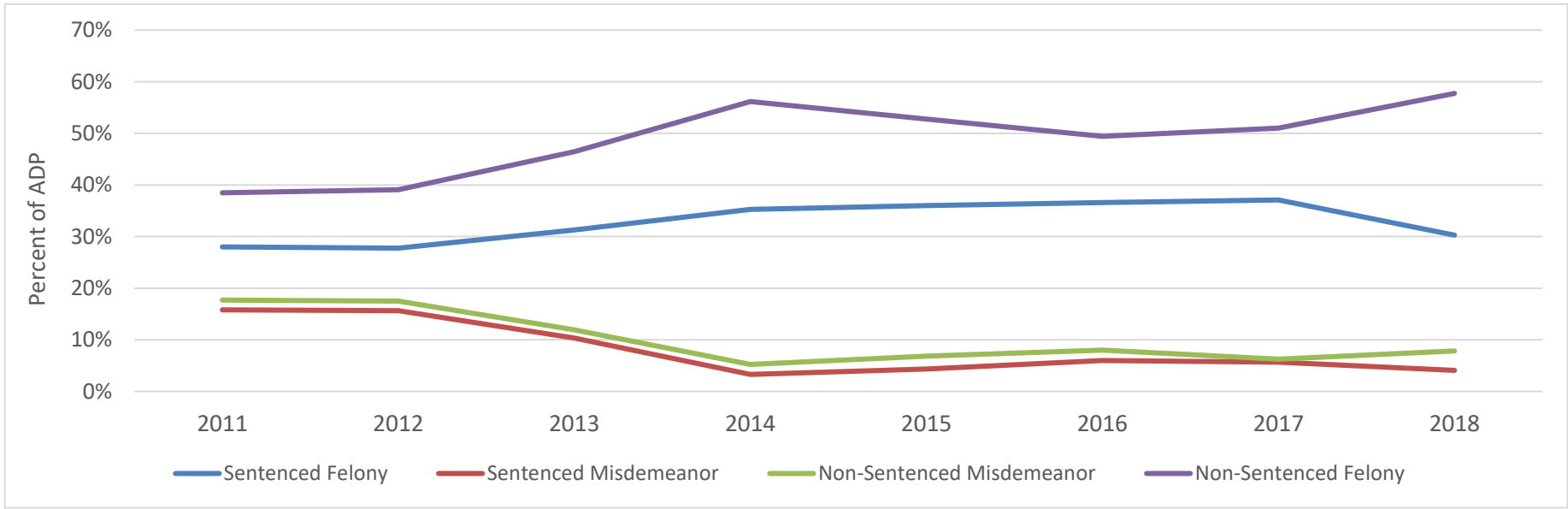


Figure 160. Tulare County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 161. *Tuolumne County Average Daily Jail Population for Calendar Years 2011 through 2018*<sup>1</sup>

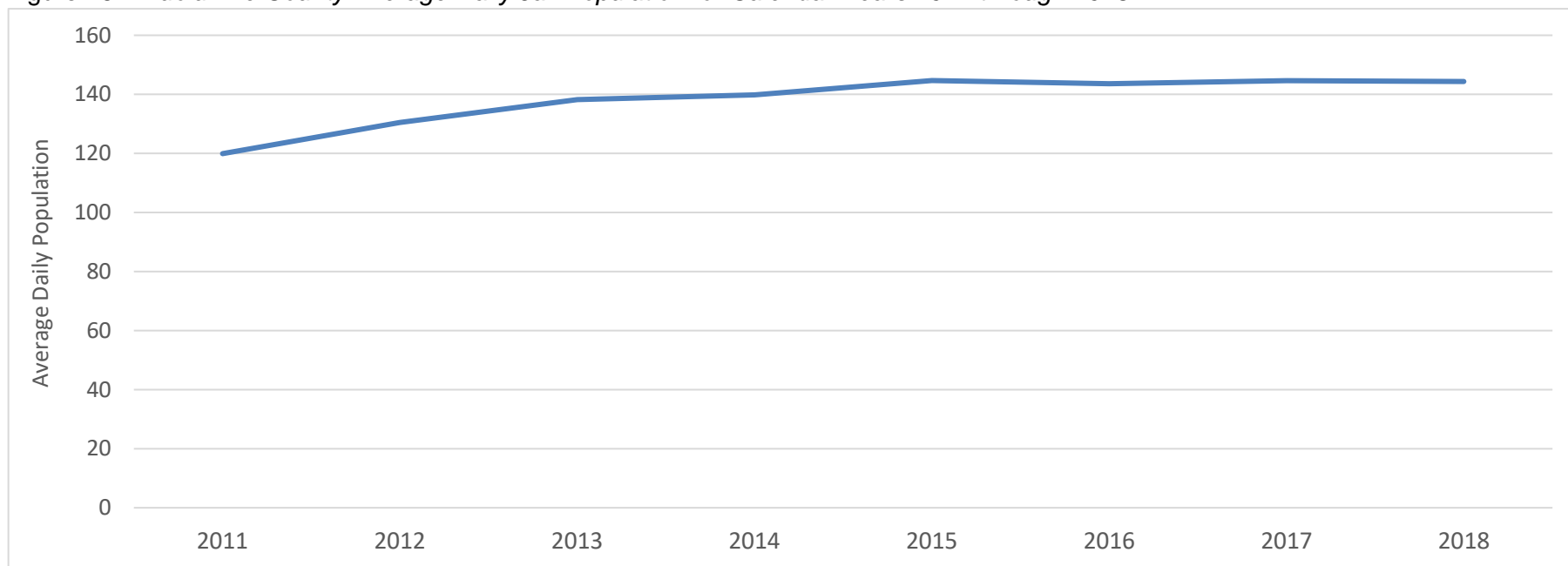




Figure 162. Tuolumne County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

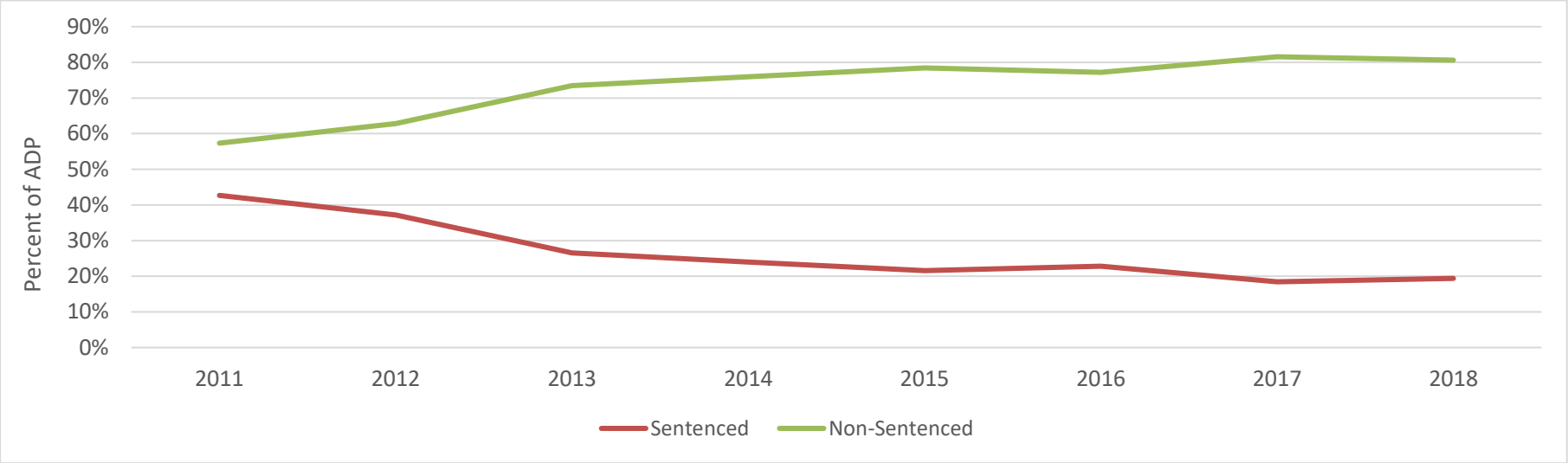
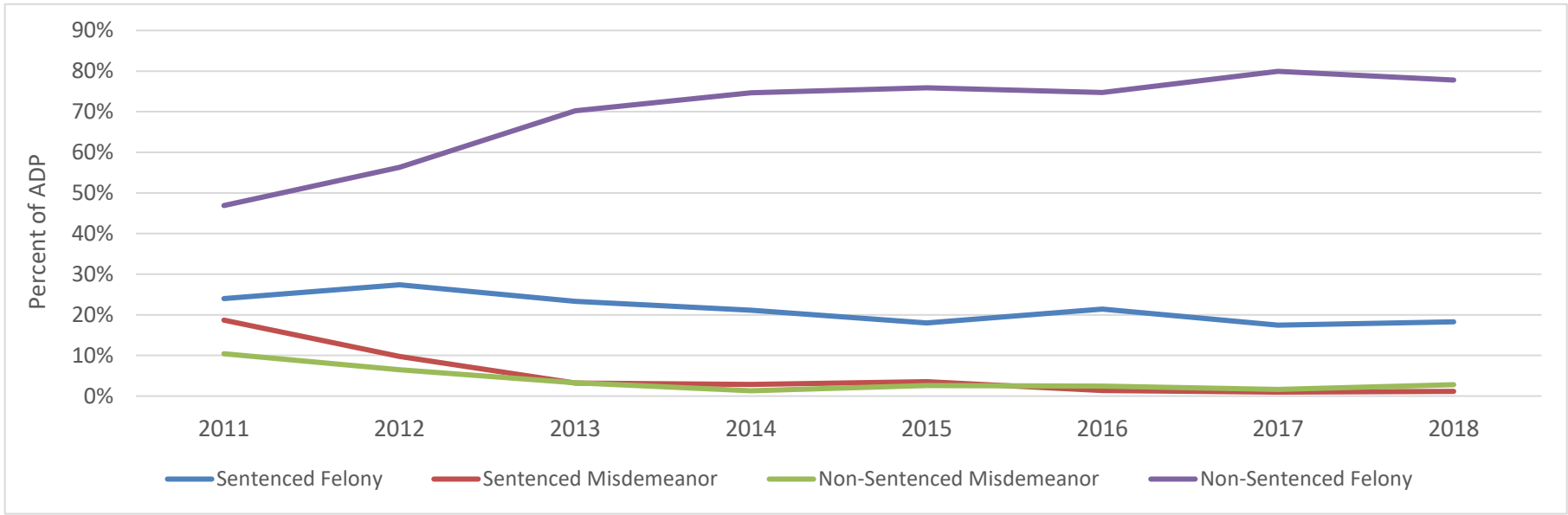


Figure 163. Tuolumne County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

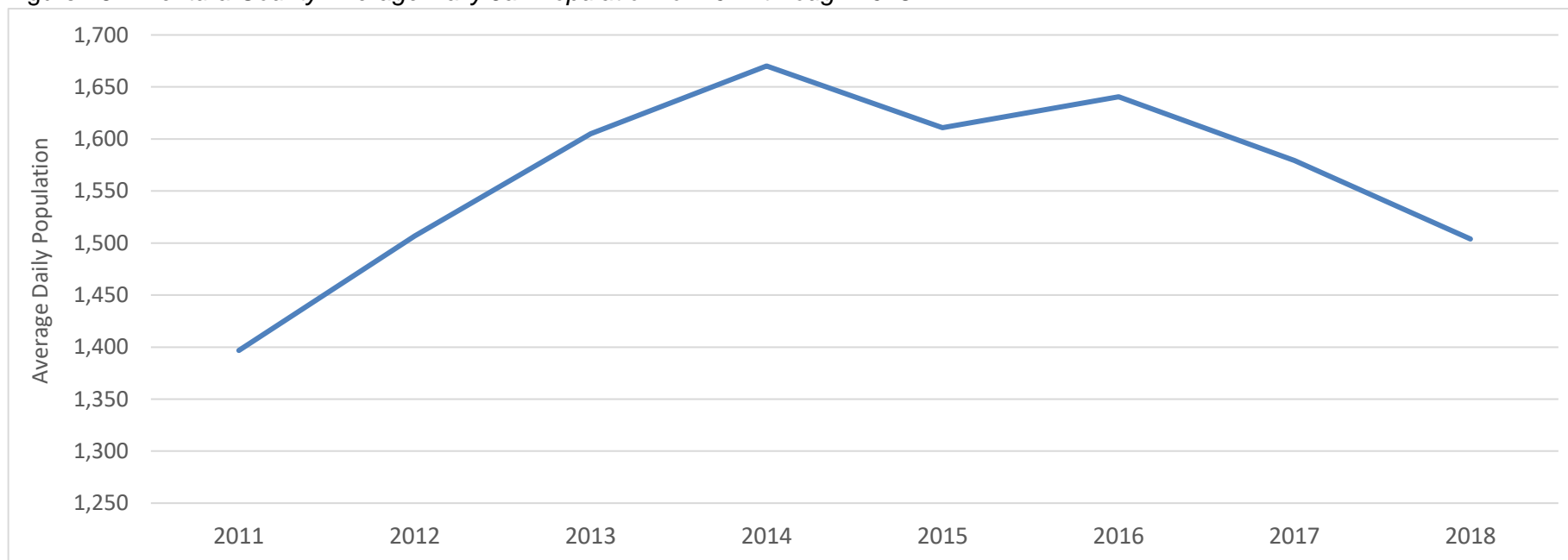


Figure 165. Ventura County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

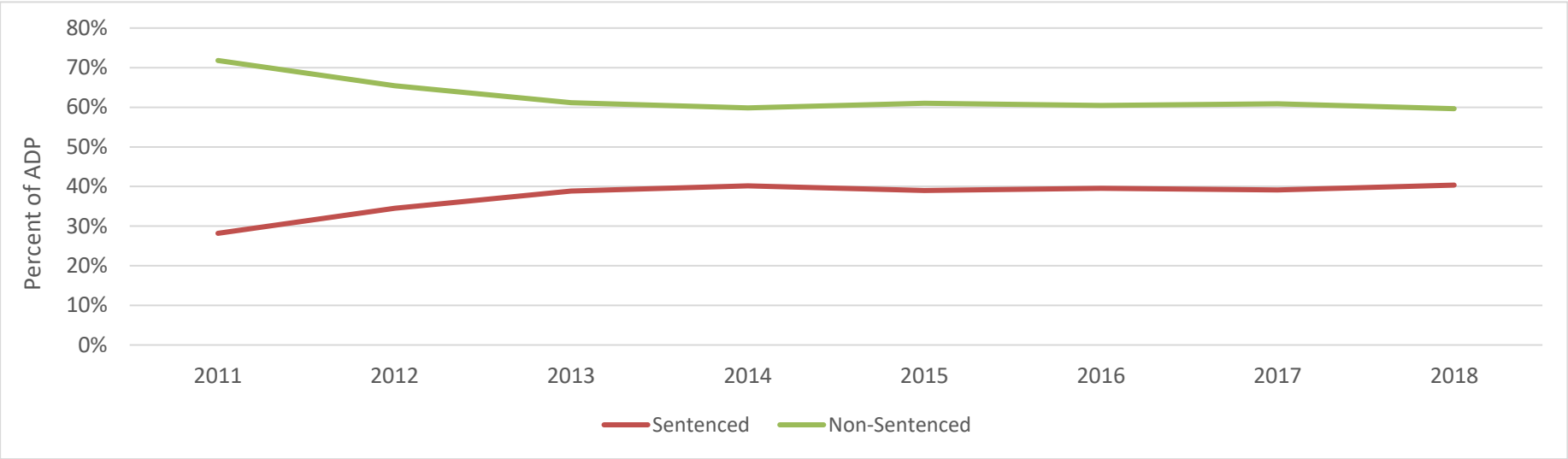
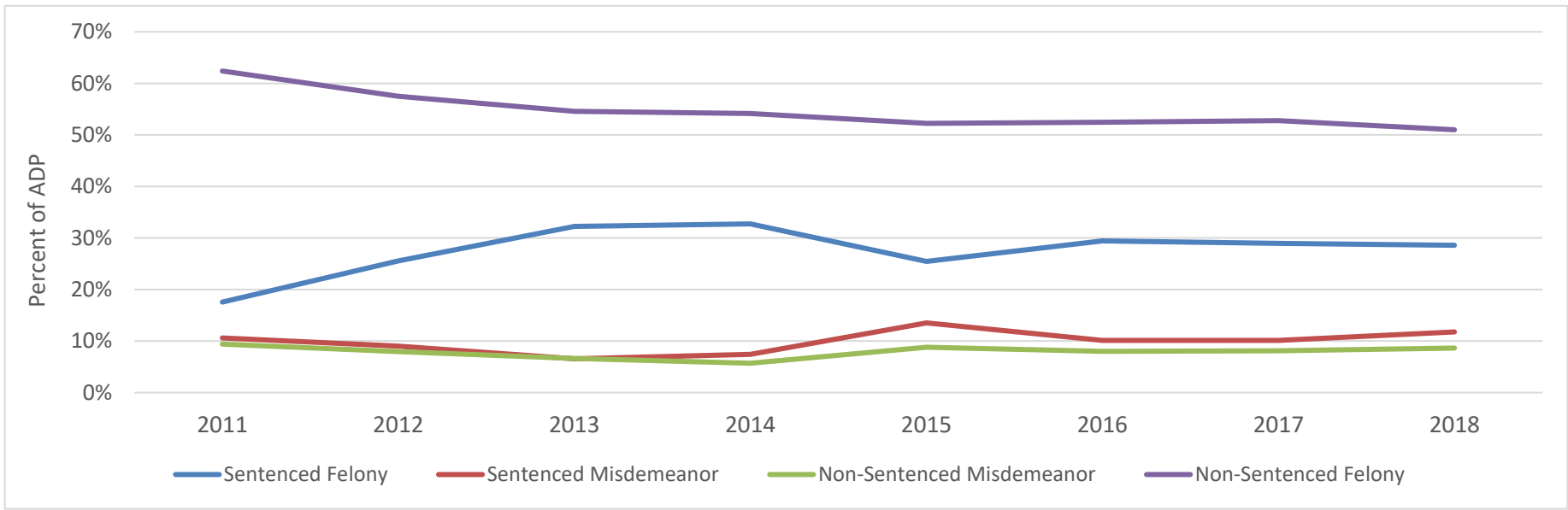


Figure 166. Ventura County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 167. Yolo County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

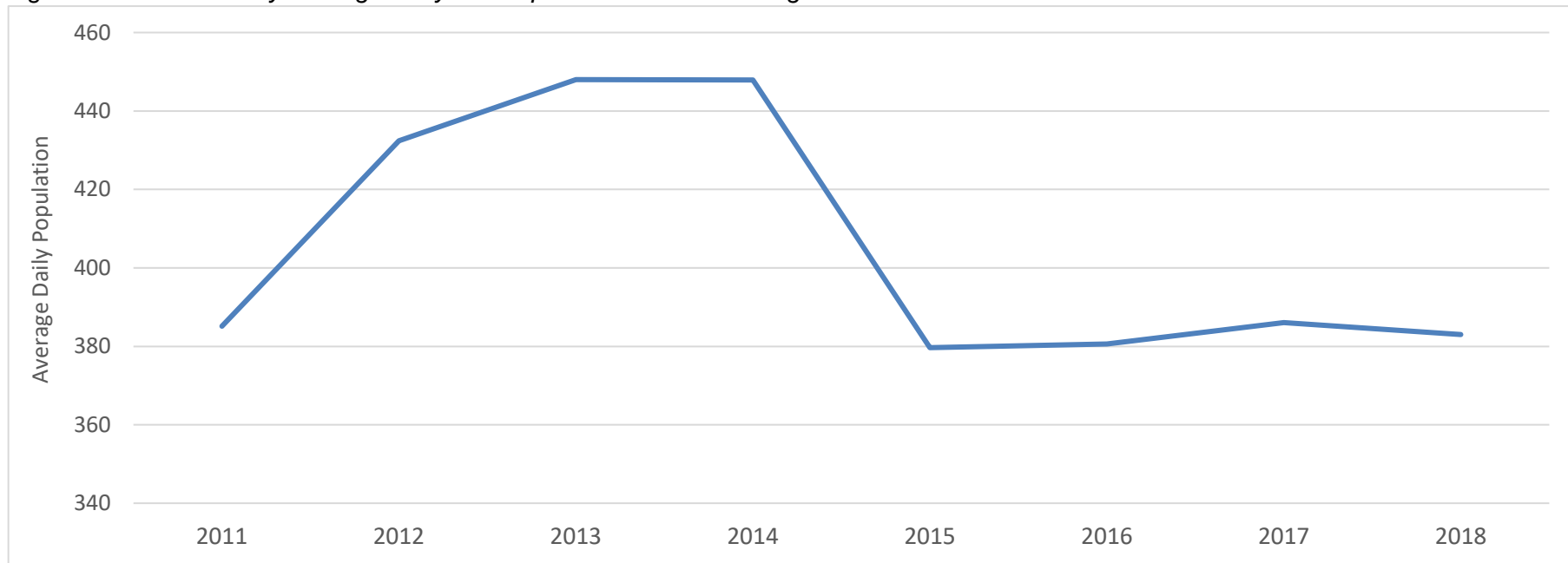


Figure 168. Yolo County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

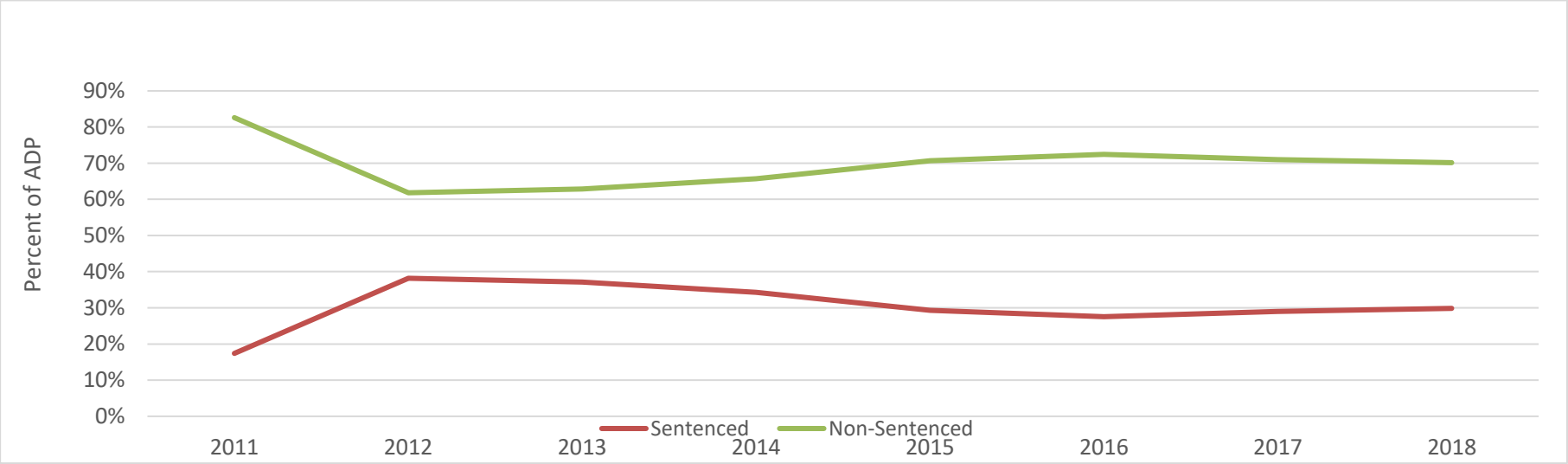
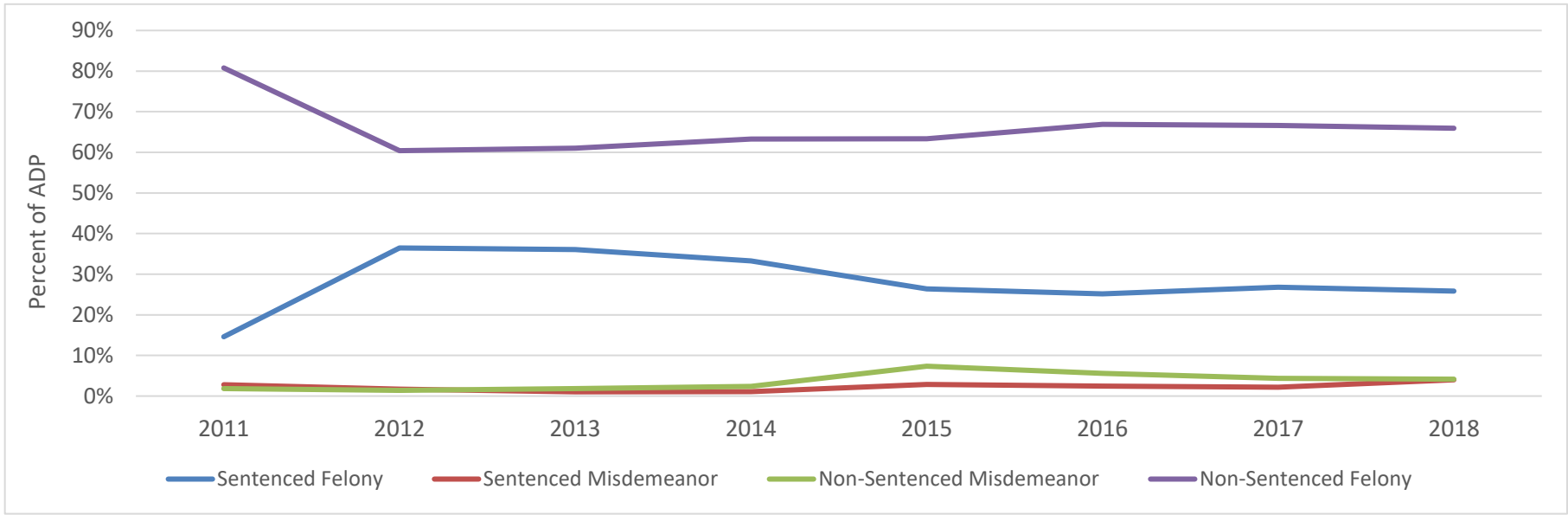


Figure 169. Yolo County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

Figure 170. Yuba County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

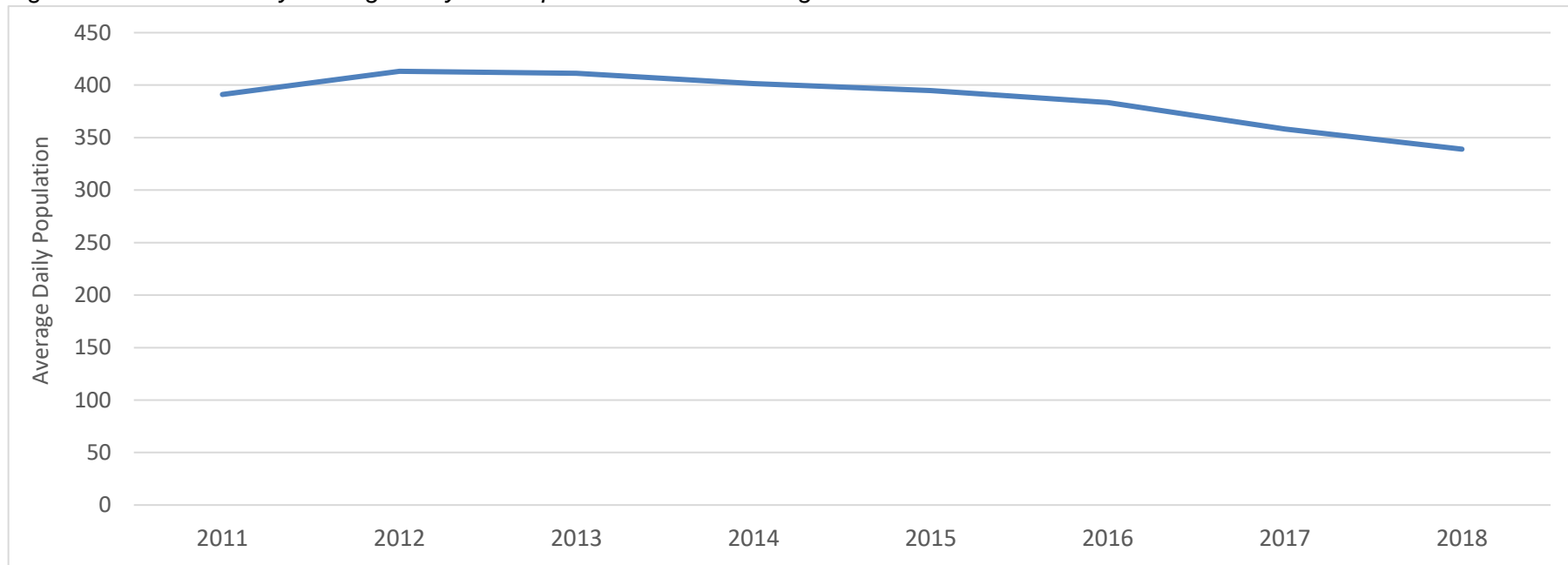


Figure 171. Yuba County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>

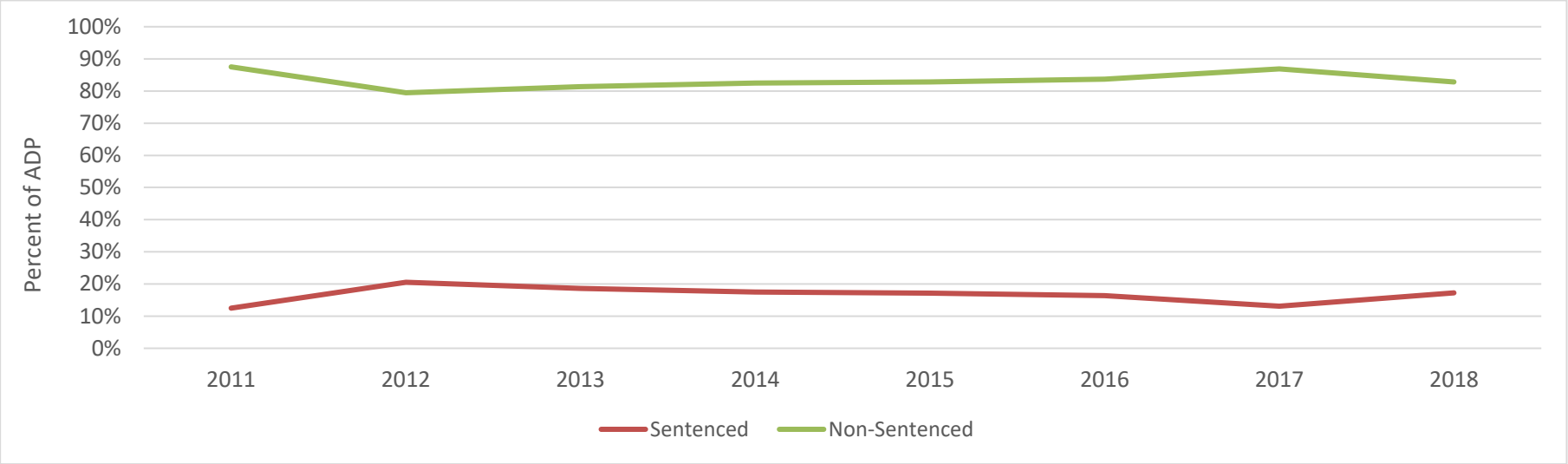


Figure 172. Yuba County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2018<sup>1</sup>
