

**NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED EMERGENCY READOPT ACTION
AMENDMENT AND ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS
OF THE BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS**

**REGARDING CONSTRUCTION FINANCING PROGRAMS
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS
TITLE 15, DIVISION 1, CHAPTER 1, SUBCHAPTER 6**

PUBLIC NOTICE: JUNE 14, 2017

Notice is hereby given that the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) proposes to amend, adopt, codify, and publish changes to construction financing program regulations contained in the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 15, Division 1, Chapter 1, Subchapter 6.

Government Code section 11346.1(a)(2) requires that, at least five working days prior to submission of the proposed emergency readopt action to the Office of Administrative Law, the adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency readopt action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. After submission of the proposed emergency readopt action to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL), the Office of Administrative Law shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6. Upon filing, OAL will have ten (10) calendar days within which to review and make a decision on the proposed emergency rule. If approved, OAL will file the regulations with the Secretary of State, and the emergency regulations readoption will become effective for ninety (90) days.

Attached to this notice is the specific regulatory language of BSCC's proposed emergency action and Finding of Emergency Readopt Action.
