

California Violence Intervention & Prevention (CalVIP) Grant

Approval to Release a Request for Proposals (RFP)

GRANT REQUIREMENTS

- State Budget Act
 - CA Cities and CBOs eligible to apply
 - 100% match (cash or in-kind)
- **AB** 1603
 - Eligible cities are those disproportionately impacted by violence
 - Cities must pass through 50% of grant funds to:
 - Community-based organizations
 - Public agencies dedicated to violence prevention



GRANT REQUIREMENTS CONT.

- Disproportionately impacted by violence defined:
 - (1) 20 homicides or more
 - (2) 10 homicides & homicide rate 50% higher than state rate
 - (3) "otherwise demonstrates a unique & compelling need" as defined by the ESC
 - 5 homicides or more
