LESSON PLAN DEVELOPMENT AND TESTING IN CORE COURSES

Standards and Training for Corrections (STC #0617-071586)

Core Lesson Plan Development Course - This course assists core coordinators and instructors with developing lesson plans that promote the learning process through active learning. During this course, instructors will:

- describe various instructional system design models;
- explain the difference between a course outline and a lesson plan;
- discuss the various methodologies that may be chosen to deliver course material; and,
- list the steps involved in writing a lesson plan and guide students in the development of a lesson plan.

Testing in Standards and Training for Corrections (STC) Core Courses - Instructors for STC core courses are required to develop tests that are used to assess the outcome of core training. In this course:

- general guidelines and principles for developing the three types of tests utilized in core courses will be discussed;
- basic principles of test development and guidelines for development will be demonstrated, and key aspects for review and evaluation will be covered;
- practice developing the three types of test will be provided; and,
- test security components trainers should implement will be identified.
