- Organized under the Governor appointed Board made up 13-Members.
- Agency charge:
  - Statewide leadership
  - Technical assistance
  - Promote effective partnerships

### **ORTP FUNDING**

- Established in The State Budget Act of 2022 (Senate Bill 154, Chapter 43, Statutes of 2022).
- Funding available to city police departments, sheriff departments, and probation departments.
- Support local law enforcement agencies in preventing and responding to organized retail theft, motor vehicle theft (or accessory theft) or cargo theft.
- Total Funding Available: \$242,250,000
   October 1, 2023 JUNE 1, 2027



### RESPONSE TO RFP

- \*114 Proposals Received
  - \$341 million

- **❖38 Proposals Funded (\$242,250,000)** 
  - 11 Large Proposals
  - 23 Medium Proposals
  - 1 Partial Proposal



### **ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES**

- Grant funds must be used to, but are not limited to, purchase of technology or other equipment to help deter strategies for preventing or responding to crime.
