Some of the things that they helped me with were getting my social security card and birth certificate. They also helped me get into a college. I would recommend them to anyone that needs help reentering society.
- 2. If it was not for this program, I would have been homeless and I am very grateful. Since I was released from Corcoran State Prison, Family Assistance Program has helped me enroll in forklift training, helped me obtain vital information about my court fines, and they are helping me reunify with my family.
