Scope of Position:

Under the general supervision of the Chief Information Officer (CIO), an Information Technology Supervisor II, the Information Technology Associate functions in the domains of Software Engineering and Business Technology Management. The Information Technology Associate will serve as the Web Services Front-End Developer for the Board of State and Community Corrections. The primary responsibility of the Web Services developer will be the creation, management, and maintenance of frontend web interfaces for BSCC's numerous data collection web applications. Additional duties will include the design, development, testing, implementation, and ongoing support of enhancements to all those systems and any new development efforts. The IT Associate also supports the BSCC by working with the BSCC business team in the creation and design of web applications, web content and workflows.

Duties and Responsibilities:

(Candidates must perform the following functions with or without reasonable accommodations.)

- Front-End Web Development Work collaboratively with programming staff to architect, design, develop and code front-end web interfaces for the BSCC's data collection and web-applications. Use industry standards such as HTML, CSS, .NET, C#, and JavaScript in the development of web interfaces with cross-platform compatibility and usability. Modify existing data collection interfaces as necessary to meet changing business requirements. Incorporate coding and validation mechanisms and processes in front-end web interfaces to ensure data integrity and validity. Develop and enhance technical solutions to meet changing business needs. Ensure all developed web content and formatting are compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) section 508 and WCAG 2.0 requirements.
- Website Content Development Develop web layout design and content for BSCC's public facing web and intranet site using industry standard web development standards and technologies. Employ industry best practices and

- Business Analysis The incumbent will be involved in the elicitation and gathering of business requirements for new application development as well as system enhancements. Ensure business needs and application requirements are clearly identified and understood. Document the results of all requirements gathering sessions. The incumbent will prepare technical specifications to meet the business needs of the Board and ensure the organization's customers, stakeholders and business priorities are met while also meeting Federal and State mandated legislation and requirements.
- Research The incumbent keeps current with industry trends, new technologies and industry practices by independently reviewing technical literature, having technical discussions with colleagues, and performing independent research.
- Other Duties The incumbent may perform additional IT tasks such as assisting IT staff in the maintenance, patching, and updating of Server Software. The Front-end Web developer may be required to install, configure, or modify web-related software and content management systems. Additionally, the position may be assigned duties of assisting the IT unit in completing general IT related tasks during system wide upgrades and rollouts.
