AVERAGE DAILY POPULATION

The jail population in California continues to rise. There were an average of 68,408 prisoners in county jails in California in 1989 (excluding Type I facilities). This represents a 37% increase since 1985, the first year this summary was based on a full calendar year's data, and a 6% increase over 1988 (see Table 1).

The statewide average daily population (ADP) totals include 59,981 males (88%) and 8,427 females (12%). The overall distribution of male and female prisoners has remained fairly constant in county jails for the past decade.

There were 35,037 pretrial inmates (51%) and 33,371 sentenced inmates (49%). The pretrial category included 89% (31,219) males and 11% (3,818) females. The vast majority of sentenced inmates were also males--86% (28,762). Fourteen percent (4,609) were females (Table 2).

On the average, there were 28 juveniles held in adult detention facilities on any given day in 1989. The number of juveniles held in county jails in 1989 decreased 68% compared to 1985 when an average of 47 juveniles were detained in adult detention facilities.

JAIL BOOKINGS

The Jail Profile Data Summary also collects data on the total number of pretrial bookings and sentenced commitments to county jails. The total number of bookings statewide in calendar year 1989 was 1,428,222, down 9,831 or .7% from 1988.

Of the total number of bookings for 1989, 19% were sentenced and 81% were pretrial. This ratio may understate the percentage of pretrial bookings. A number of counties' pretrial/sentenced ratios are based on a four-day sample (see Table 3).

AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY

The statewide average length of stay per booking (including both pretrial and sentenced bookings) based on the calendar year 1989 data was 17.5 days (see Table 4). This is somewhat higher than the 16.4 days recorded for 1988.
