CESF PROGRAM

- ❖ **Administered by the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance**
- ❖ **Provides federal funding to states, local governments, and tribes to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus**

CESF FUNDING

- ❖ California received a total CESF allocation of \$93,684,166
 - ❖ \$58,518,568 to the BSCC
 - ❖ \$35,165,598 to local governments
- ❖ BSCC Allocation
 - ❖ \$41,763,011 available to counties
 - ❖ \$15,000,000 to the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR)*
