WHY? A strategic plan is the map that describes where an organization is going and how it will get there. It is also a management tool to align the energy, resources, and time of everyone in the organization.

Step 1: Goals

Where do we want to go?

The strategic planning process includes a workshop for Board members to review the vision, mission, and core values and to create clear organizational goals and priorities that consider input from stakeholders.

Step 2: Objectives

How do we get there?

Objectives are specific and measurable actions that are aligned with the goals identified by the Board. BSCC management staff and committees will recommend objectives in their program areas.

Step 3: Strategies

How do we measure success?

Once the strategic plan is approved by the Board, BSCC program staff and committees will develop specific strategies for each objective as well as performance indicators to measure success. BSCC management staff will review the recommendations, cluster similar activities, and approve the action plans.

Step 4: Results

How did we do? How can we improve?

After the strategies to accomplish the goals and objectives are identified, BSCC staff will implement the plan and report progress and accomplishments to the Board.
